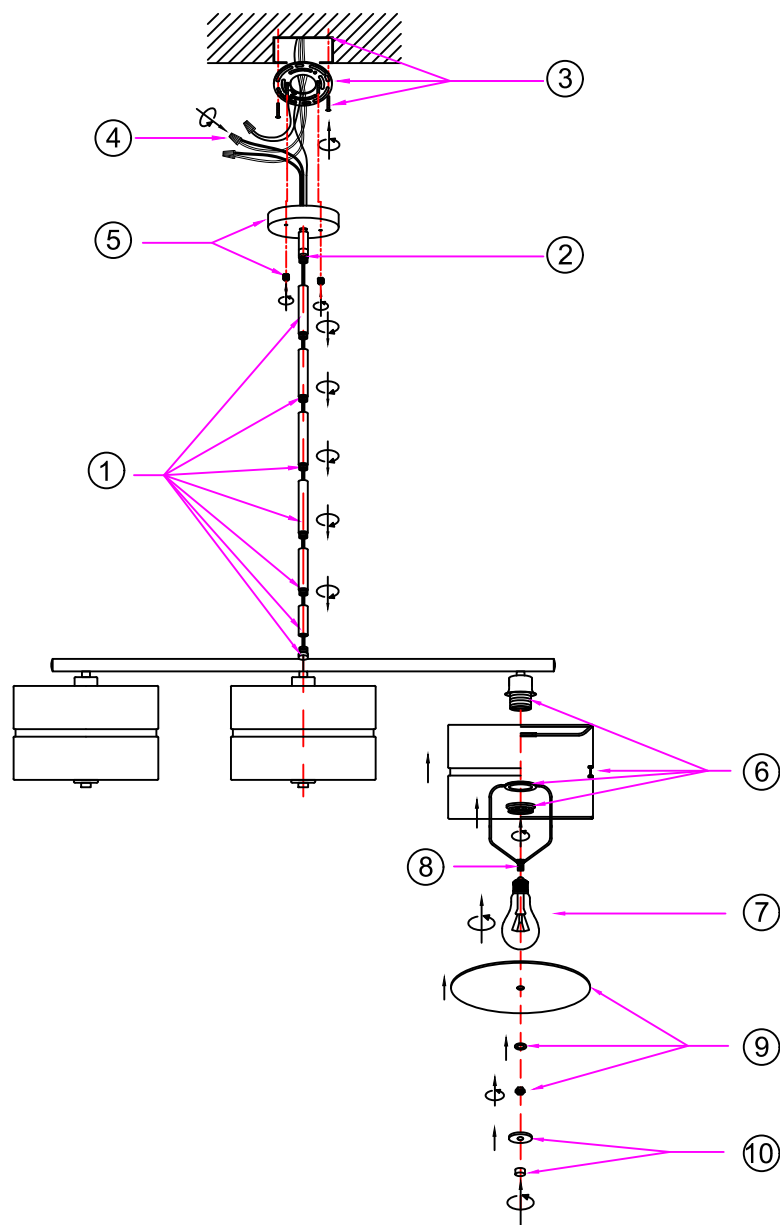


# ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

**WARNING:** TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



## Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

## Step-by-Step Installation:

- 1.Thread the power cord through the suspension rod and secure it to the lamp body. Adjust the rod length as needed.
  - 2.Pass the power cord through the ceiling plate. Secure the plate to the suspension rod using the swivel nut.
  - 3.Use mounting screws to fix the mounting plate to the electrical box.
  - 4.Connect incoming and outgoing wires with wire caps. (Note: Connect black wires (live) to black, white wires (neutral) to white, and ground wires to the grounding terminal. Avoid exposed wires during connection.)
  - 5.Use the iron bead to secure the ceiling plate to the mounting plate.
  - 6.Place the lampshade and bracket onto the lamp head and tighten with the outer ring.
  - 7.Screw the bulb into the lamp head.
  - 8.Adjust the bracket pipe length as needed.
  - 9.Place the glass washer onto the bracket pipe. Add a rubber washer and iron washer, then secure with a nut.
  - 10.Place the flat cover over the bracket pipe and secure with a locknut.
  - 11.Turn on the power to test if the bulb works properly.
- Installation is complete.

## Safety Instructions:

**To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.**

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
