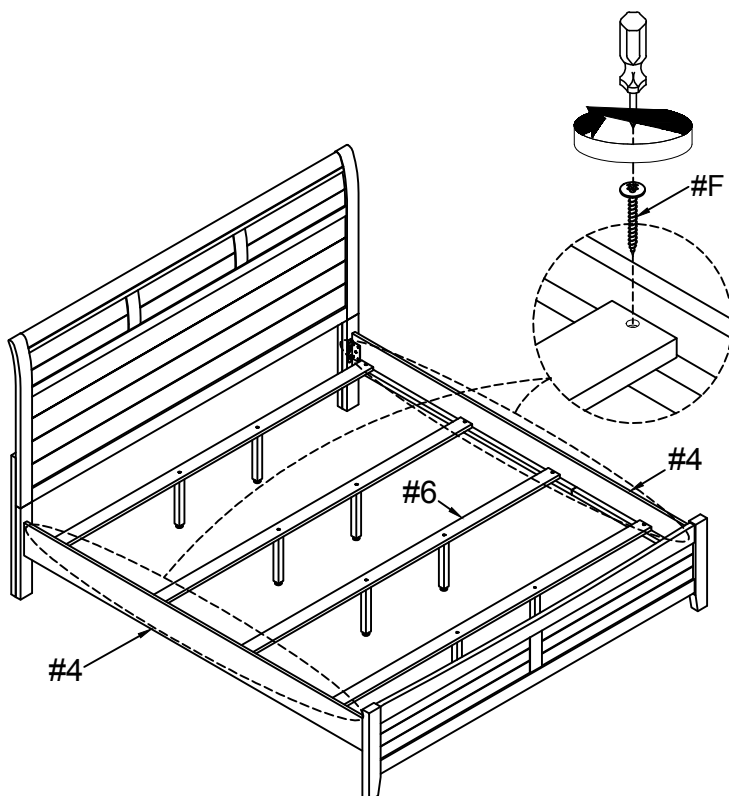
Attach support legs (#5) to the slats (#6). Adjust the leveler of the support legs (#5) according to ground level.
