Window Curtain Installation Guide









1. SELECTING THE RIGHT HARDWARE:

Heavier weight fabrics and longer lengths require heavier rods than lightweight sheers and laces. Curtain rods should be at least as wide as your final measured curtain width. If your rod has decorative finials on the ends they should extend beyond the final measured width so they are visible.

2. CHECK HARDWARE INSTALLATION GUIDE:

Follow your hardware's specific hardware installation instructions with regard to the below curtain panel installation guidelines in mind. Ensure you have all necessary tools for safe and secure installation.

Pay special attention to the length of your curtains as it will directly impact the height at which you install the hardware. When you measure, it is important that you factor in your preferred curtain height in reference to the floor so the curtains drape accordingly.

3. HANGING YOUR CURTAINS:

Refer to the image above for the most common types of headers. For these and most other window treatments, you can simply slide a standard size curtain rod or decorative pole through the curtain header. Adjust the fabric so that the panels fall in even folds.
