1. Separate and count all parts and hardware.
2. Read through each step carefully and follow the proper order.
3. All assembly fittings shall always be correctly tightened and checked regularly.
4. We recommend that, where possible, all items are assembled near to the area in which they will be placed in use, to avoid moving the product unnecessarily once assembled.

FALL HAZARD Children have suffered serious injuries after falling from changing table. Falls can happen quickly.

- **STAY** within arms reach,
- **ALWAYS** secure this unit/pad to the support surface/frame by manufacturer's instructions for securing the changing unit/pad. See instructions.

SUFFOCATION HAZARD: Babies have suffocated while sleeping in changing areas. Changing areas are not designed for safe sleeping.

- **NEVER** allow baby to sleep in/on changing table/pad/area.
- The changing table is intended for children from **birth** to maximum weight **24.2lbs**

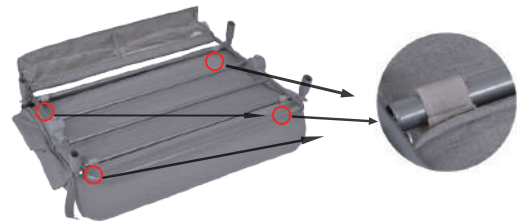

ASSEMBLY / OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Unfold upper shelf

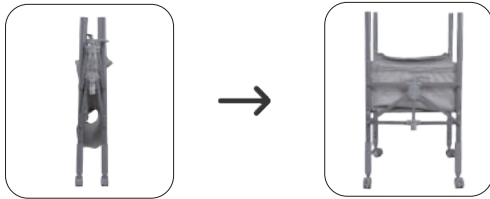


2. Assemble the cover and the upper shelf



 Important: Remember to fix the safety buckle at the bottom.

3. Unfold the brackets. Press it down until it's horizontal and locked. Repeat on the other one.



4. Connect the brackets with the upper shelf, making sure the spring buttons on the tubes come up through the holes.



5. Insert the support tube into the hole of the fabric layer.



6. Fix the support tube into the holes of the brackets. Make sure the hook and loop fastener on the fabric is facing up.



*Use screws and washers. Then, screw them into place.

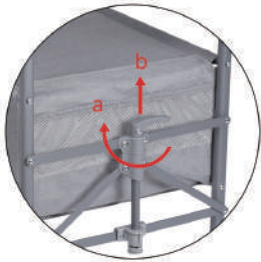


*Close the hook and loop fastener as shown.

NOTE

- * For easier assembly, you may fold the changing table first. Then fix the support tubes into the brackets.
- * The wheels shall be locked when the changing table is in use.

7. Fold the changing table when not in use.



* Hold the handle, turn left and lift it up. **(Step a & b)**

* Repeat on the other side of the changing table.



* Press the buttons on both sides and lift it up. **(Step c)**



* Fold the changing table and fasten the belt.

8. Assemble the drawer and put them onto the changing table.

* Unfold drawer part A, and place the plate B into the bottom.



* Place the drawers into changing table.



.Instructions for the use of the safety belt.

*Place your child on the changing table and ensure they are centered. Fasten the safety belt across their waist to secure them in place.

*Adjust the length of the safety belt to fit your child snugly, avoiding excessive tightness while providing a secure hold.

* Always keep a close eye on your child while using the changing table and make sure the safety belt remains securely fastened throughout the process.

NOTE

* Periodically inspect the safety belt for any signs of wear, damage, or malfunction. Replace the belt if any issues are identified.

How to care for your childcare change table

CLEANING

- * To ensure the long-lasting use of your change table, dry it with a soft absorbent cloth after use.
- * Use a damp cloth to clean the frame. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- * Removable and non-removable fabrics covers and trims maybe cleaned using a damp cloth with soap or mild detergent.
- * Allow it dry completely before folding or storing it away.
- * Do not machine wash, tumble or spin dry, unless the care label on the product permits these methods.

MAINTENANCE

- * Check changing table regularly to ensure that locking devices and components are secure and working properly. Always check parts regularly for tightness of screws, nuts and other fasteners — tighten or replace if required.
- * To maintain the safety of your changing table, seek prompt repairs for bent, torn, worn or broken parts. Use only those parts and accessories approved by us.
- * To prevent mould or mildew, do not fold or store the product if it is damp or wet. Allow it to dry thoroughly. Always store the product in a well ventilated area and away from direct sunlight.
