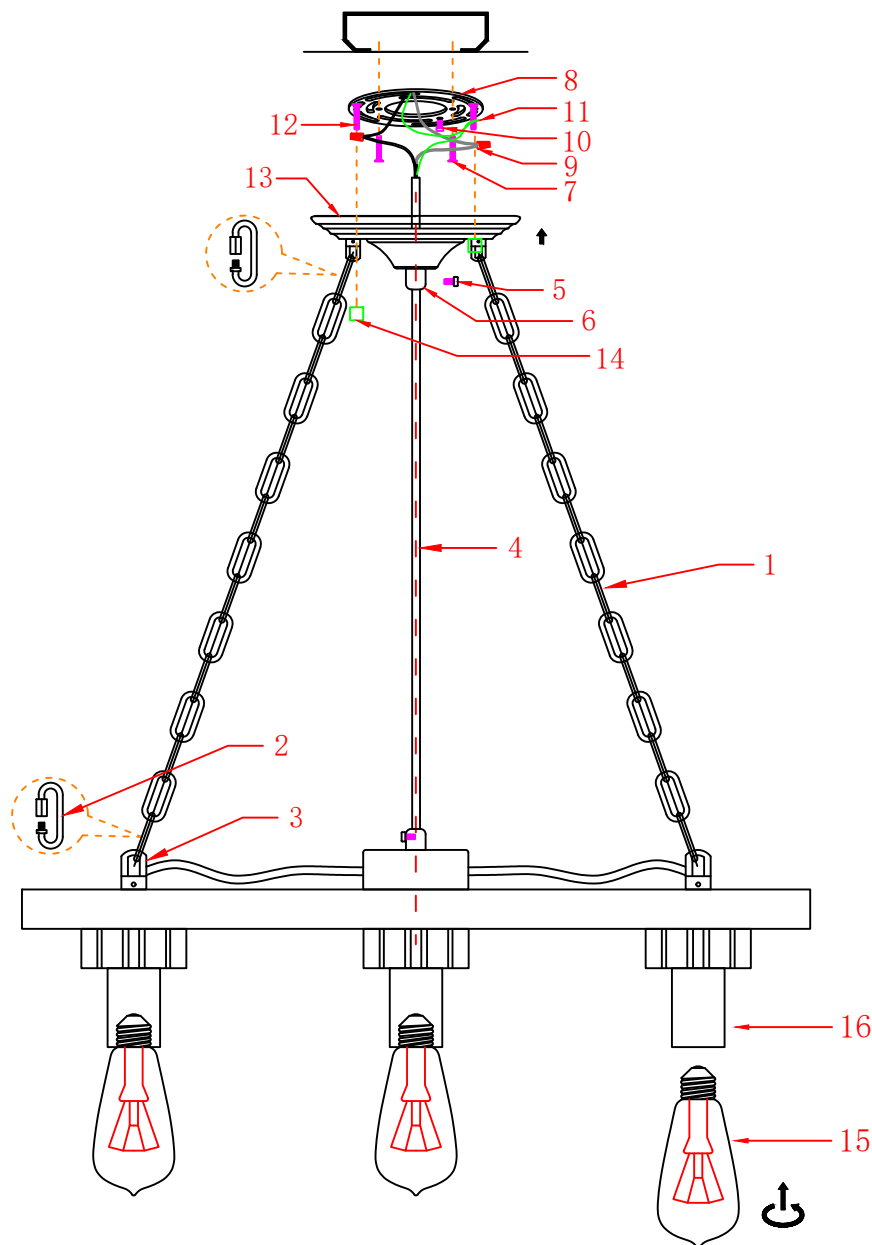


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

- Step A: Use quick links (2) to connect the chains (1) of the desired length and the suspension rings (3) on the fixture.
- Step B: Thread the main wire (4) through the strain relief (6) and adjust the length by tightening the screws (5).
- Step C: Secure the mounting plate (8) to the junction box using the provided screws (7).
- Step D: Connect the fixture wires to the supply wires using wire connectors.
- Connect the live wire (black) from the fixture to the live wire (+) in the junction box using the connector (9).
 - Connect the neutral wire (white) from the fixture to the neutral wire (-) in the junction box using the connector (9).
- Use the green screw (10) to secure the ground wire (11) from the fixture to the grounding terminal.
- Ensure no exposed conductors remain outside wire connectors or outside the junction box.
- Step E: Align the holes in the canopy (13) with the mounting studs (12). Slide the canopy up against the ceiling and secure it by tightening the finial nuts (14).
- Step F: Screw the light bulb (15) into the socket (16) as indicated, and illuminate the fixture.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
