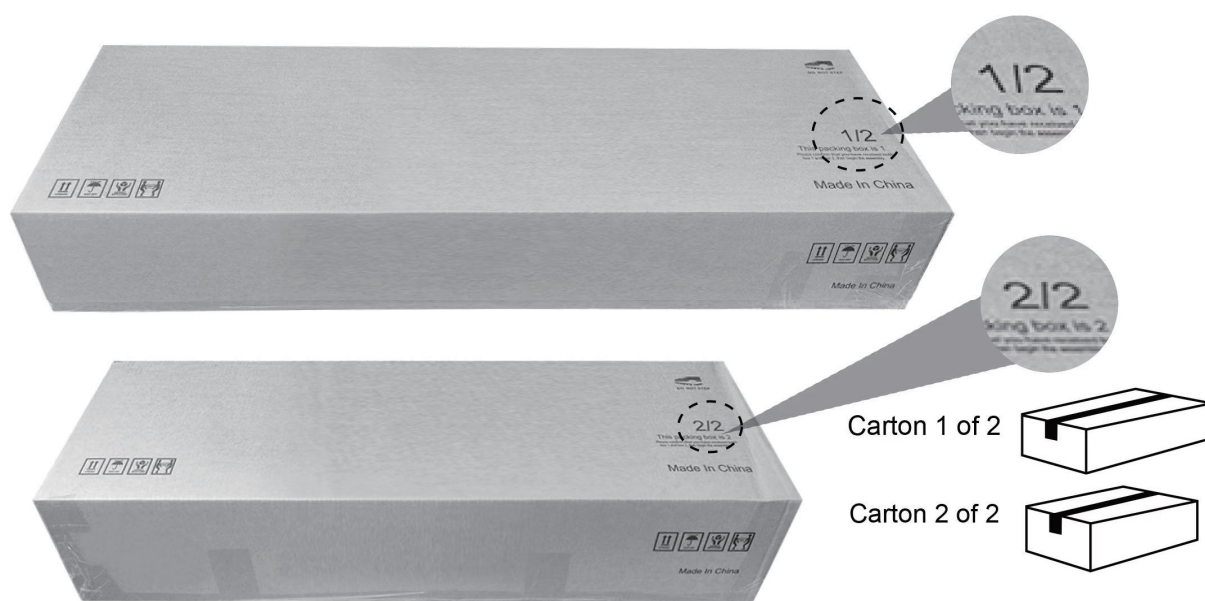

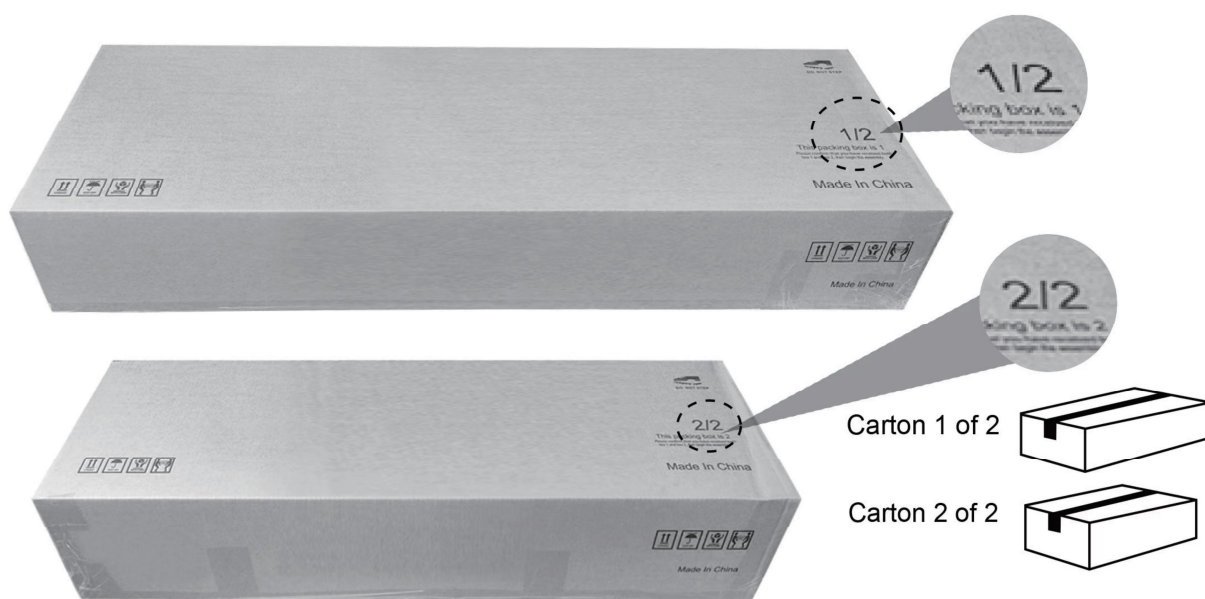
The product comes in **2 BOXES**. Do not proceed with unpacking or assembly until both boxes are received.

- Do not expose the furniture to acidic, alkaline, or corrosive liquids. Handle with care during installation to avoid scratches or damage.



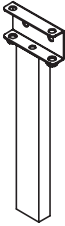
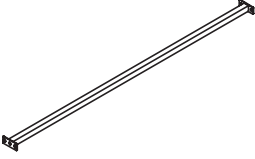
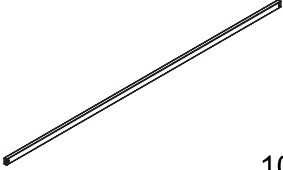
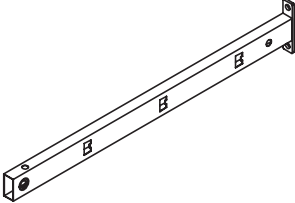
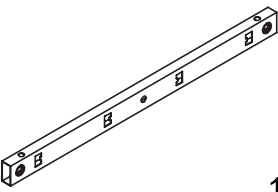
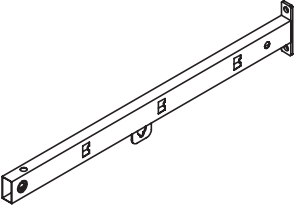
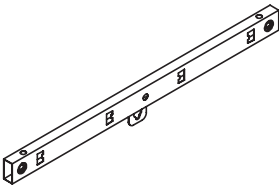
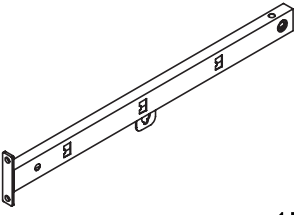
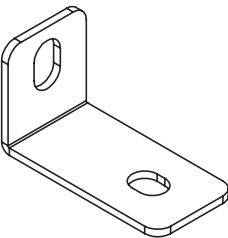
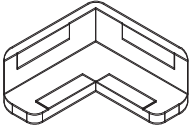
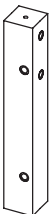
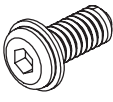
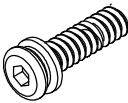
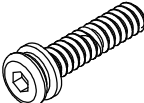
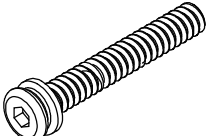

SIMPLE ASSEMBLY STEPS

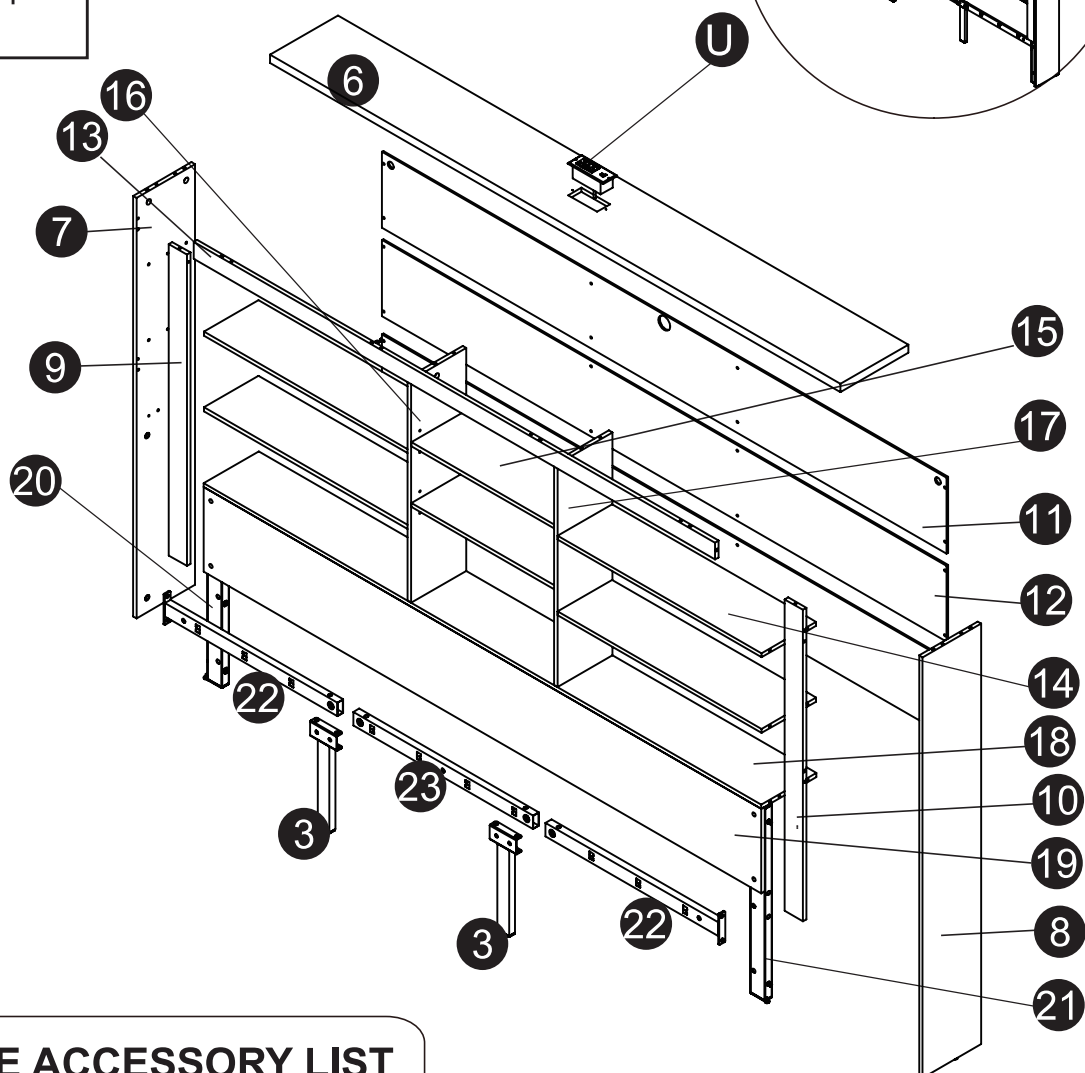
1. Read the manual carefully.

1. Position the plastic clasp:

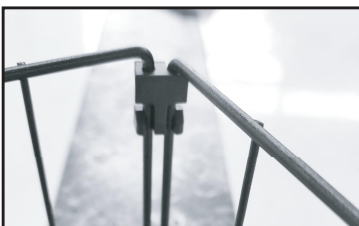
Place the plastic clasp at the connection point of the two side panels.

Ensure that the middle notch of the clasp is oriented correctly (as shown in the diagram) to facilitate the subsequent assembly.



2. Secure the plastic clasp:

Flip the plastic clasp into the correct position, ensuring it completely covers the metal wire and locks firmly. Gently press or push it in with your hand until you hear a "click," indicating that the clasp is securely fastened onto the wire.

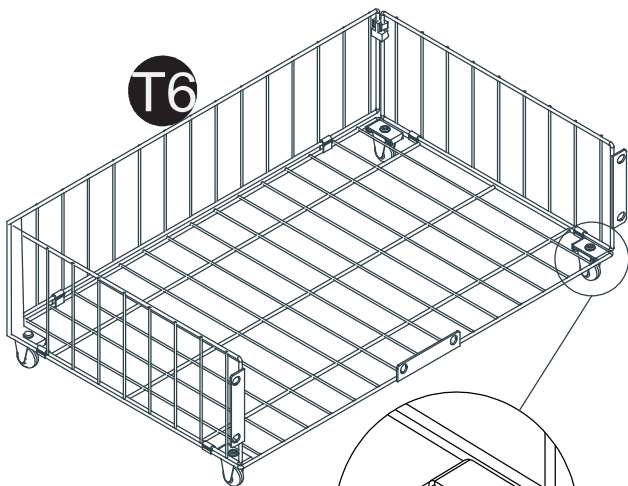


3. Check the connection stability:

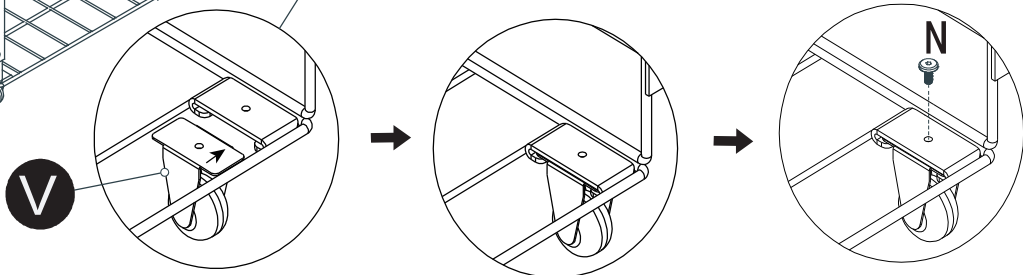
Gently shake the side panel and the drawer back panel by hand to ensure they are tightly connected through the clasp and metal wire, with no looseness.

DRAWER ADJUSTMENT STEPS

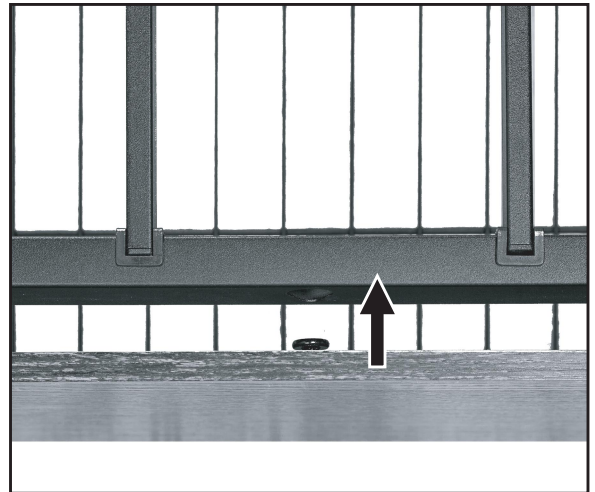
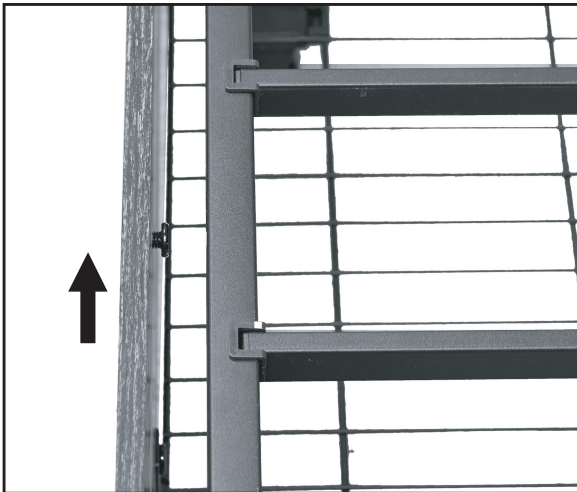


NOTE:

Gently lift the drawer, align the screw with the gourd-shaped hole, and then snap it in



Stick component 32 onto the two outer corners of component 30



Installing the Bed Drawer:

Carefully lift the drawer from the bottom with your hand to provide proper support. Align the hooks on the drawer with the notches on the bed frame. Once aligned, gently push the hooks into the notches on the bed side until they are securely locked in place. Ensure the drawer is stable and properly connected before releasing it.



MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Daily Maintenance Tips

1. Prevent Pests

Keep wooden furniture away from damp areas to avoid pests and wood damage. Use a dehumidifier or air conditioner in humid seasons to keep the room dry

2. Protect from Sunlight

Avoid placing furniture in direct sunlight to prevent cracking, discoloration, or fading. Use curtains or shades if sunlight is unavoidable.

3. Keep Away from Fire

Place furniture away from heat sources or open flames to avoid damage and maintain its condition

4. Regular Care

Apply furniture oil regularly to keep the wood shiny, prevent cracks, and extend its lifespan

5. Clean Often

Vacuum dust and debris, especially under beds, to keep the furniture clean and hygienic.

6. Stay Dry

Ensure good ventilation to prevent moisture buildup. Use a dehumidifier if needed to protect the wood.

7. Avoid Corrosive Liquids

Keep the furniture away from acidic or alkaline substances to protect its surface and durability.

8. Use a Damp Cloth

Clean with a well-wrung damp cloth to avoid water damage or swelling.
