

Hey! Play! Rope Toss Game



Object: Be the first player or team to earn 300 points by tossing rope rings onto posts for points.

Set-up: 2-4 players or teams

Start by assembling the ring toss target. Place the two cross bars on top of each other so they form a plus sign "+" with the printed numbers facing up. Note that the board with the cut on the same side as the printed numbers should be placed on the bottom. Next, screw in each of the 5 posts to the threaded holes. It does not matter which color post goes into which hole. (Be careful to not over tighten the posts into the cross boards). Place the game board 10-15' from the players and mark the spot to indicate the throwing line.

Playing the Game: Players flip a coin to determine who begins play. Players toss the rings at the target and count points according to where the rings land. Players can choose at the beginning of the game if they want to throw all 5 rings each, or alternate between players.

How to Score:

- **Ringer:** Score value indicated on game board at base of post is earned.
- **Two Ringers:** Score double the points shown on the game board for two ropes on the same post by the same player.
- **One Point:** If a player does not make any ringers, the ring closest to a post gets one point.
- **No Score:** If two opposing players make ringers on the same post, there is no score because the two ringers cancel each other out.

Winning: The first player or team to collect 300 points wins the game. (If there is a tie, the game continues until the tie is broken.)

Variations:

1. Point total to win the game can be adjusted to suit the players.
2. Teams can be formed by: each team throwing all 5 rings, or dividing the colors of the rings between the teams and each team throwing the colors of their choice.
3. The distance the players stand to the target can be adjusted to suit the players.
4. The total points required to win the game can be adjusted to suit the players.
