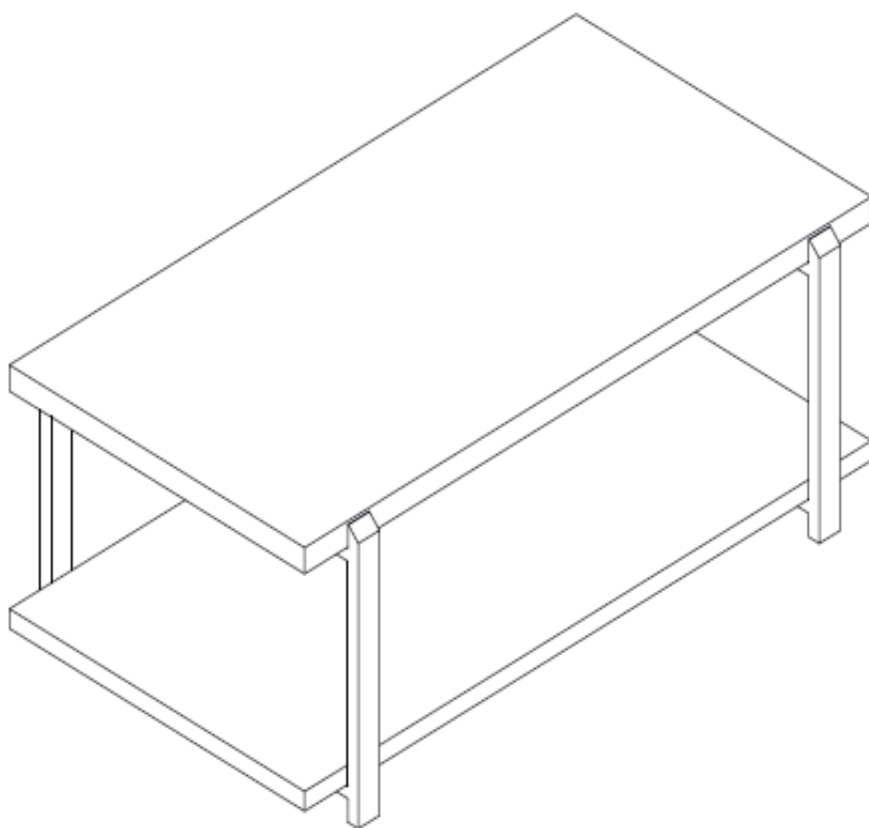



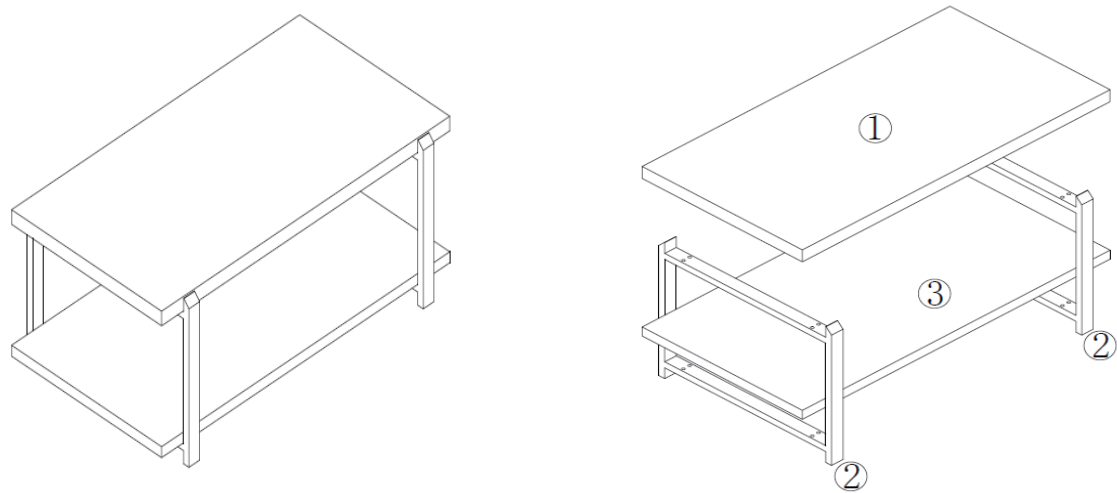

## Coffee Table

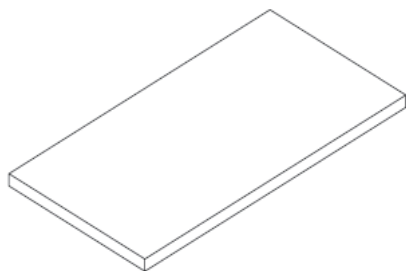


# Part Identification

 While not all parts are labeled, some of the parts will have a label to help distinguish similar parts from each other. Use this part identification to help identify similar parts.



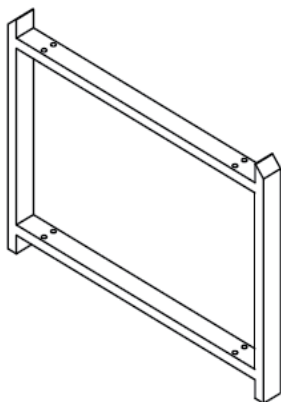

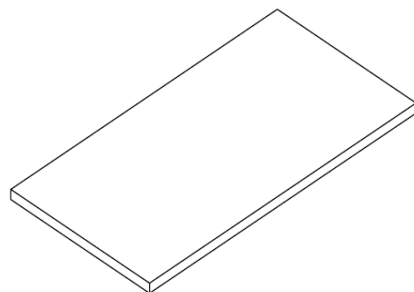

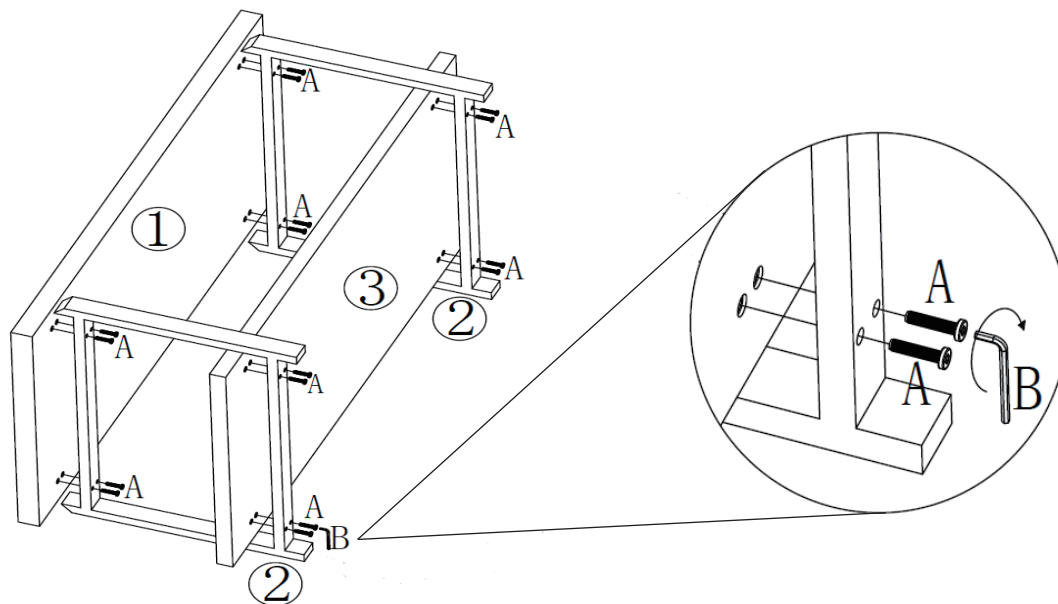

# Step 01

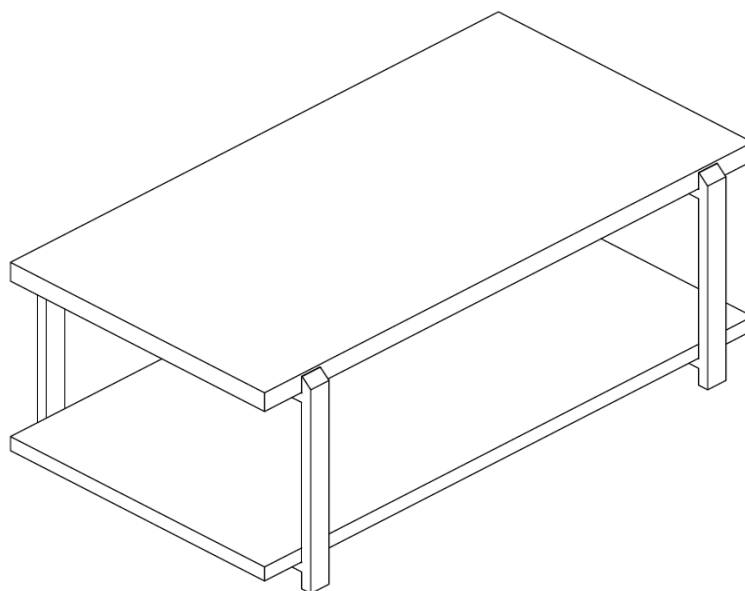
-  Lay the Metal Frames(②) Parallel to each other on a clean smooth surface such as carpet or cardboard. Attach Table Top (①) and Shelf(③) into metal frames(②) with Screws(A) by Allen key(B). Do not fully tighten all bolts until all parts are in place.



# Step 02

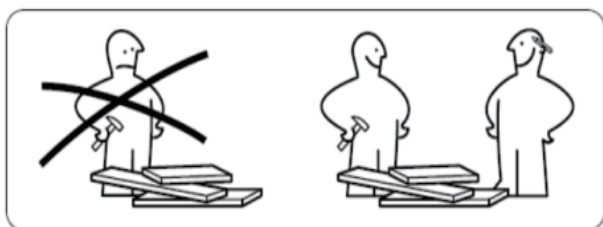
NOTE: If holes don't align, loosen all bolts and adjust the holes slightly. After all holes are aligned, fully tighten all bolts.

Flip the table upright.

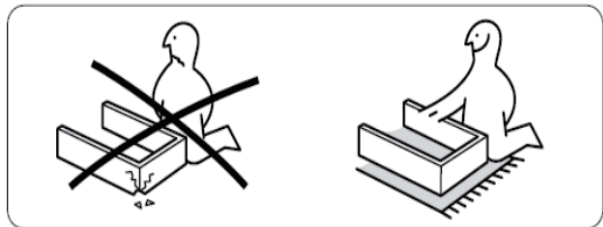


## ASSEMBLY TIPS

1. Please read the assembly instructions first and become familiar with the parts.
2. Proper assembly of this item requires 2 people.



3. Unpack and assemble this unit in an spacious area, assemble the unit on top of the empty carton or carpet to prevent scratches.



4. To avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware, DO NOT dispose of any contents until assembly is completed.
5. **Do not fully tighten all bolts until all parts are in place.** Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.

## CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- (1) Hardware may loosen overtime. Periodically check that all connections are tight.
- (2) Wipe with a soft, dry cloth. To protect finish, avoid the use of chemicals and household cleaners.
- (3) All hot serving dishes should be placed on a pad.
- (4) Any liquid spilled onto the furniture should be cleaned up immediately with a dry cloth.
