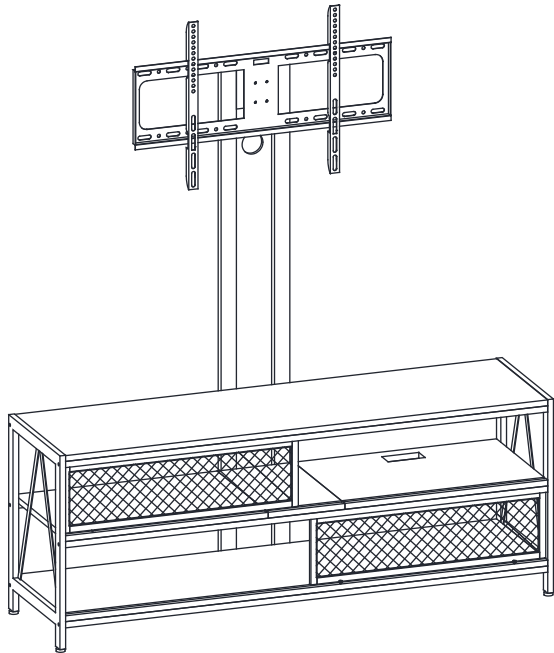

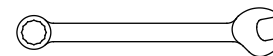
SWIVEL TV STAND WITH MOUNT

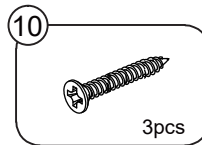
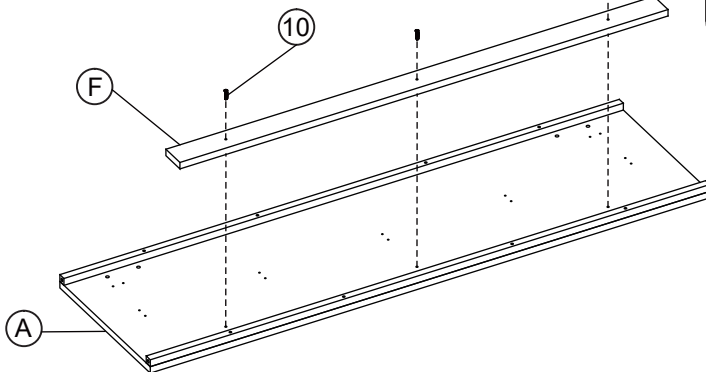
step 1

Use 8 pieces of hardware 10 to assemble I and J onto board A



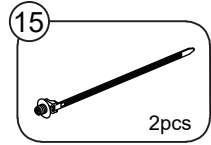
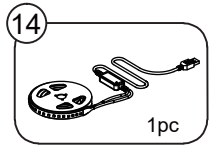
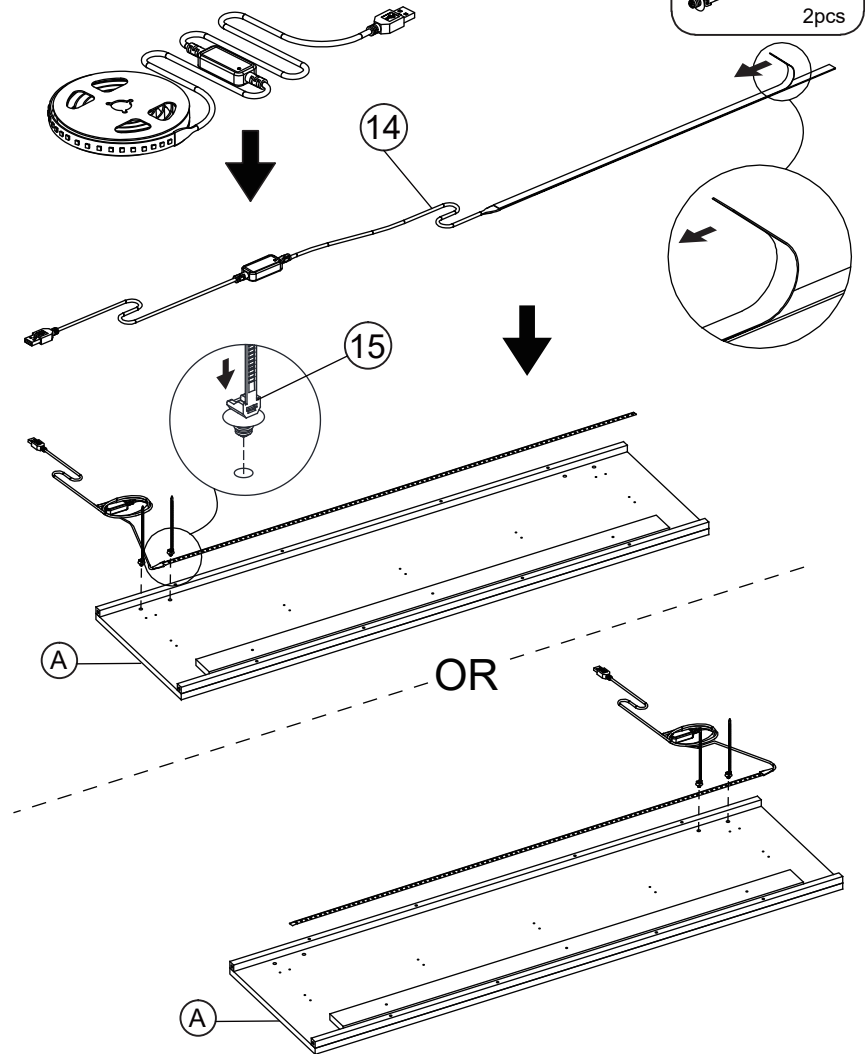
step 2

Use 3 pieces of hardware 10 to assemble crossbar F onto board A



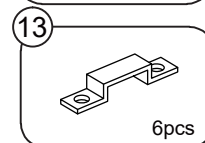
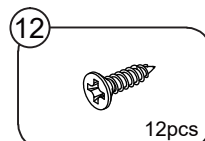
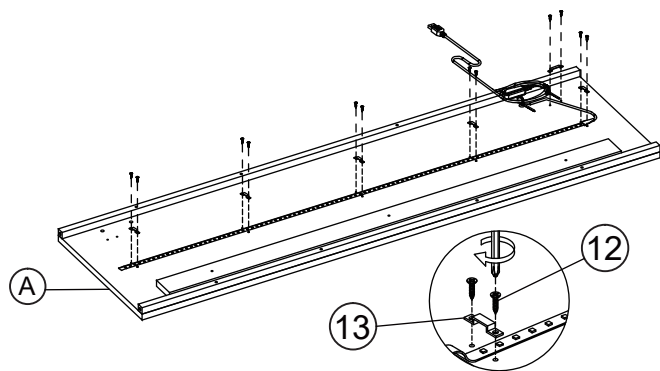
step 3

Peel off the adhesive backing on the back of the LED strip. Depending on the position of the connector, it can be installed on the left or right side. Place hardware 15 in the corresponding left or right position based on the location of the LED strip wires, and secure any excess wires from the LED strip.



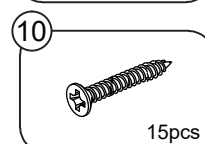
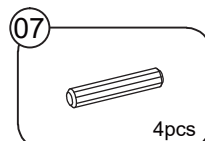
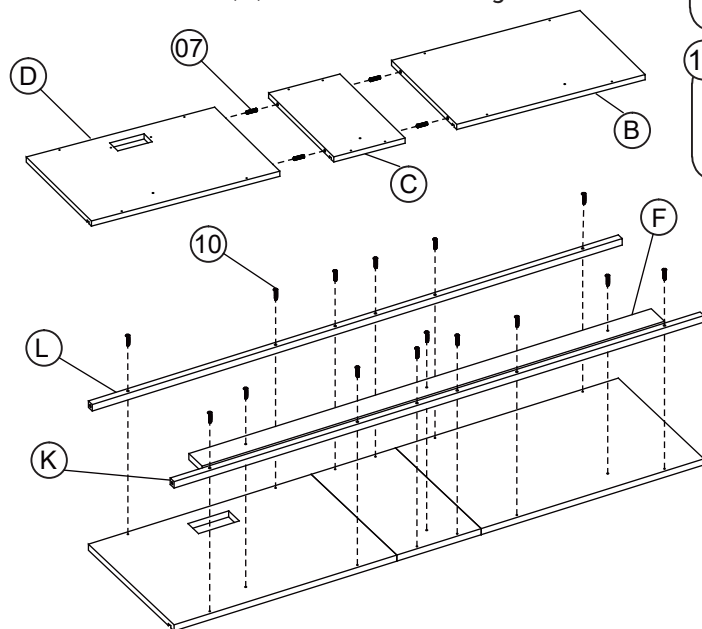

Assemble hardware 13 onto board A using hardware 12 to secure the LED strip



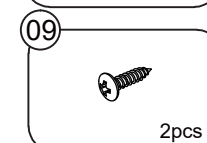
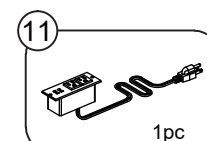
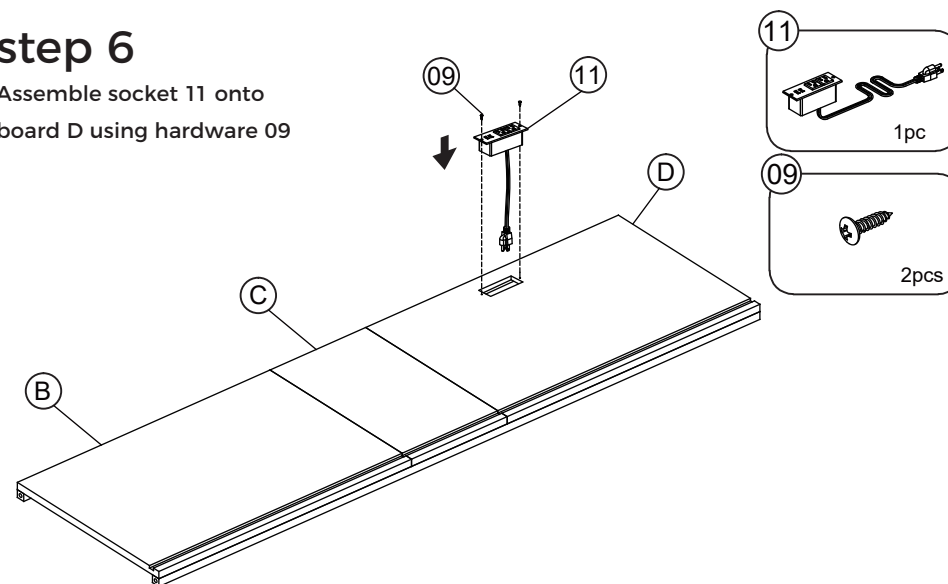

Assemble crossbars F, L, and K onto BCD using hardware 10



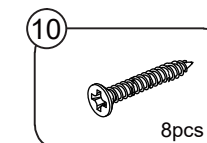
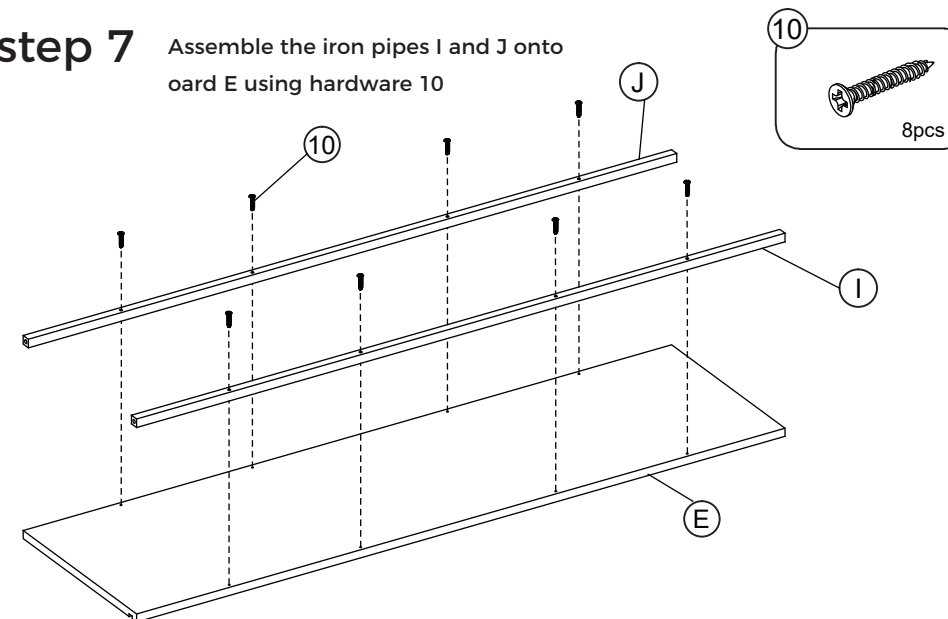

Assemble socket 11 onto board D using hardware 09



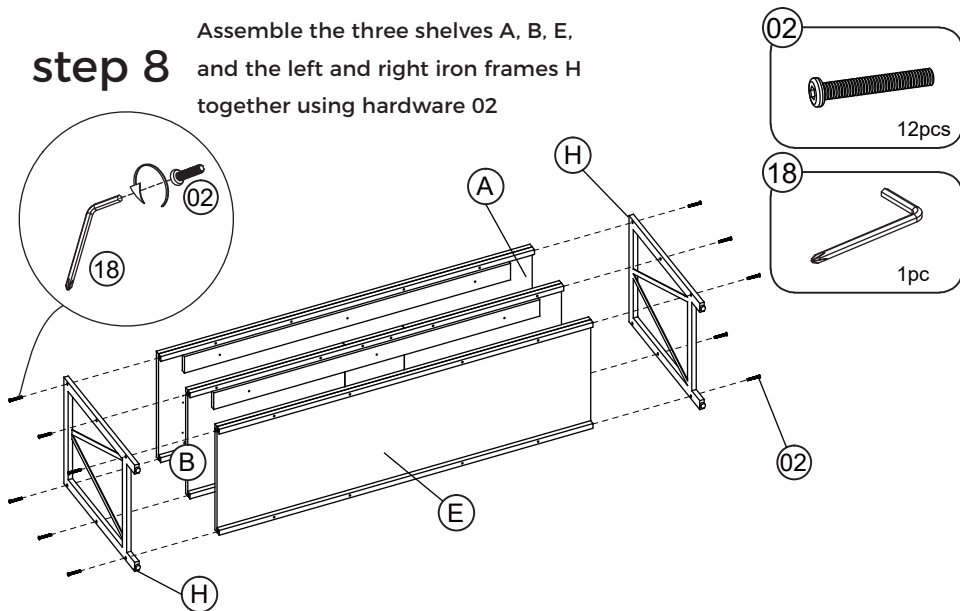

Assemble the iron pipes I and J onto board E using hardware 10



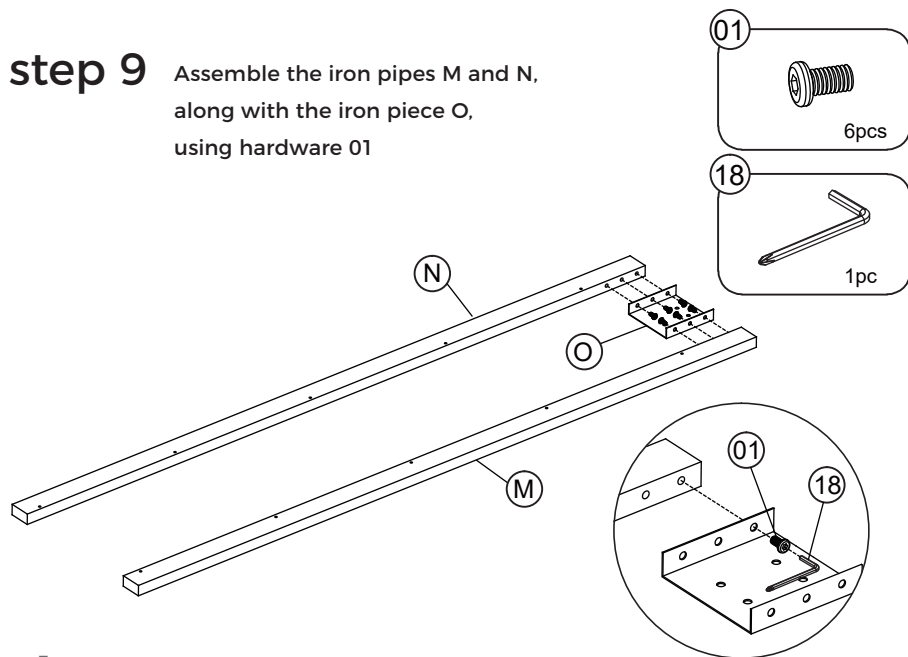

Assemble the three shelves A, B, E, and the left and right iron frames H together using hardware 02



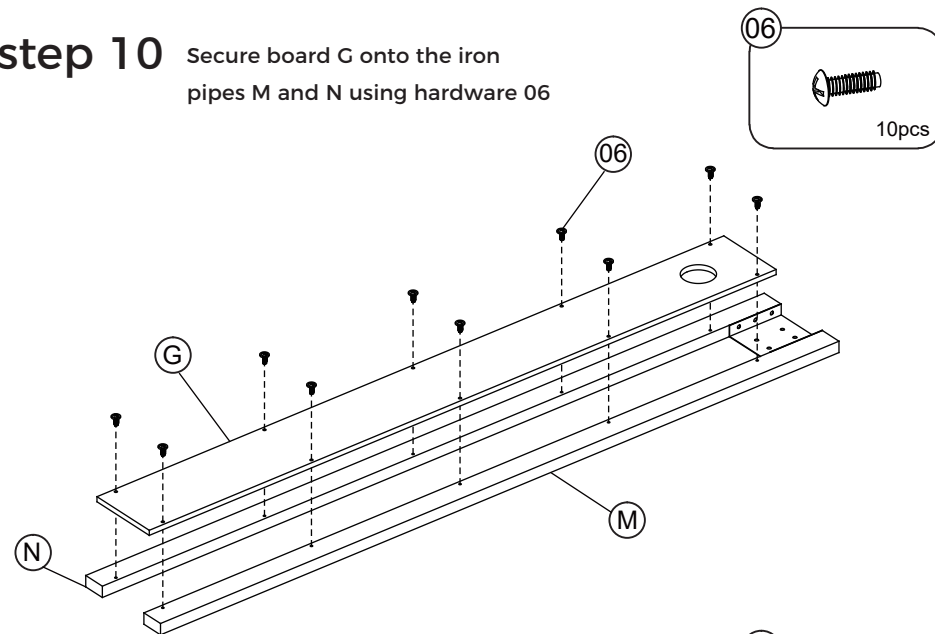

Assemble the iron pipes M and N, along with the iron piece O, using hardware 01



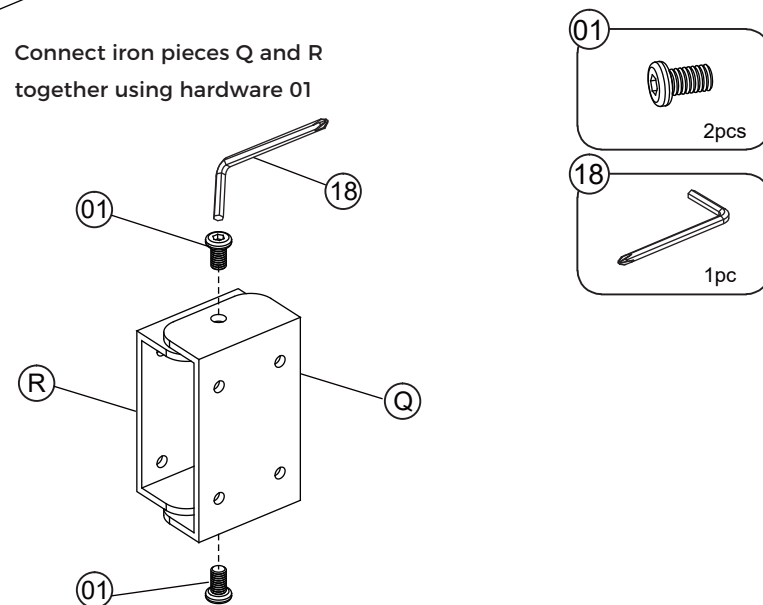

Secure board G onto the iron pipes M and N using hardware 06



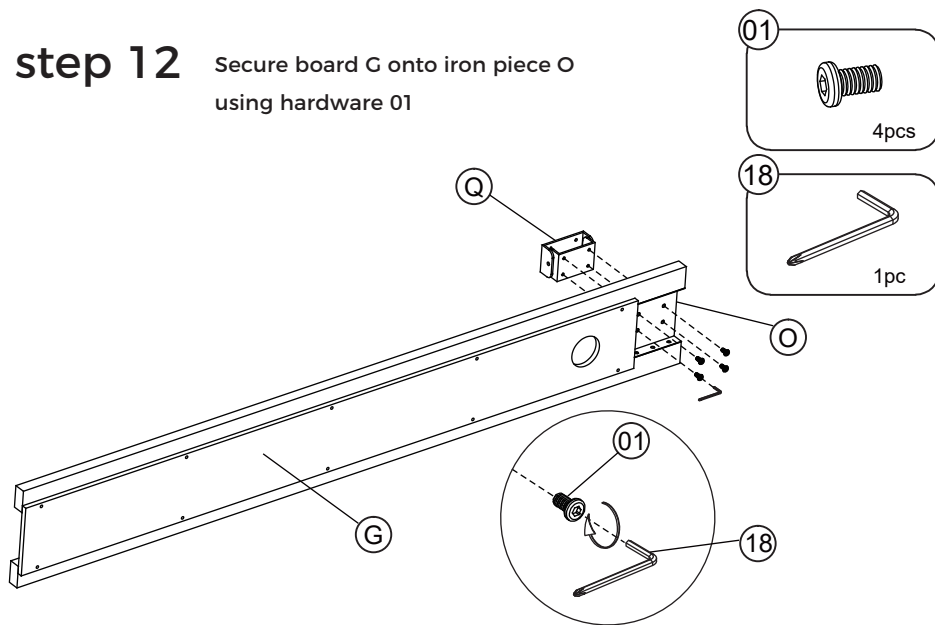

Connect iron pieces Q and R together using hardware 01



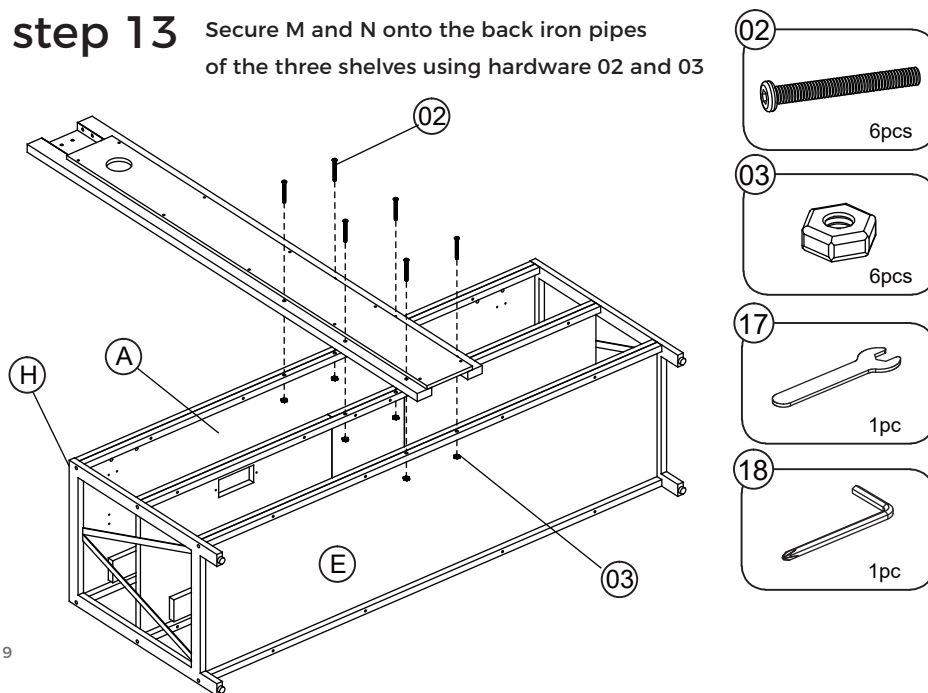

Secure board G onto iron piece O using hardware 01



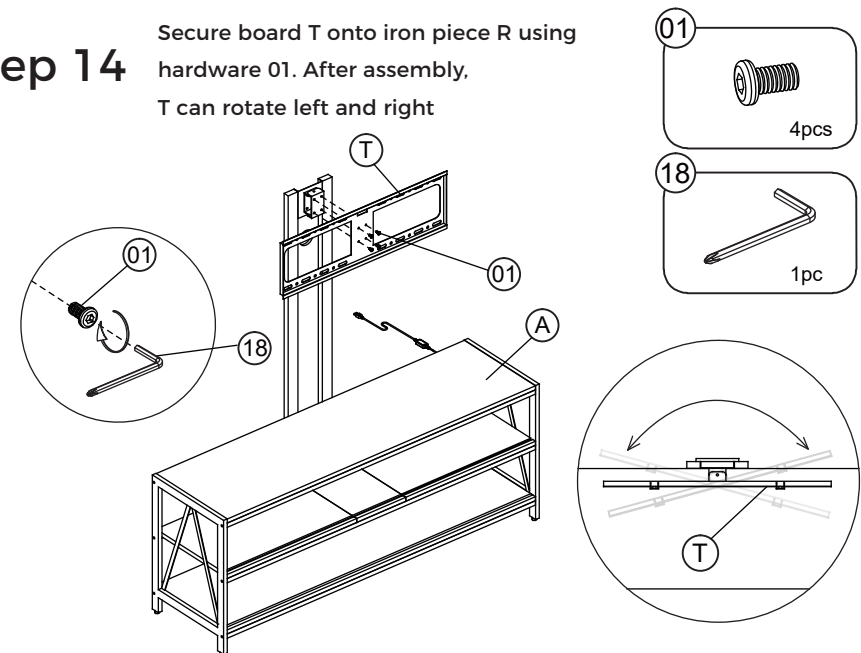

Secure M and N onto the back iron pipes of the three shelves using hardware 02 and 03



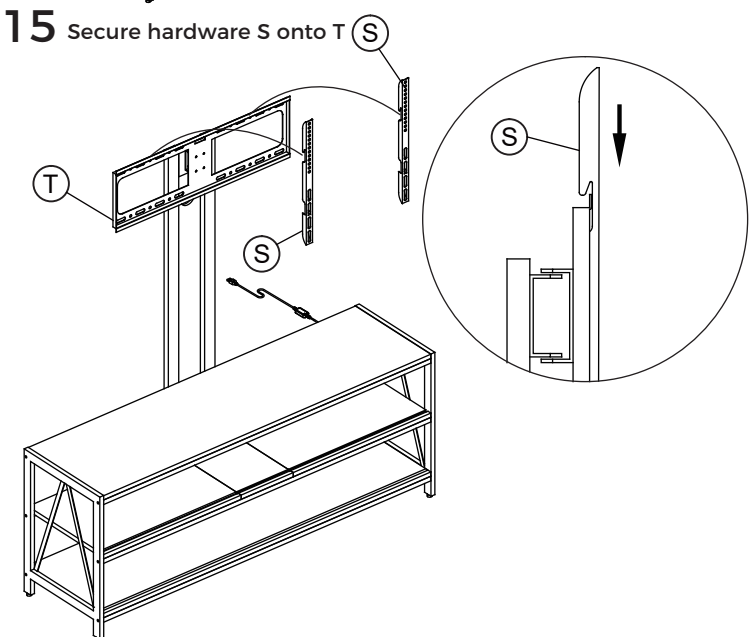

Secure board T onto iron piece R using hardware 01. After assembly, T can rotate left and right

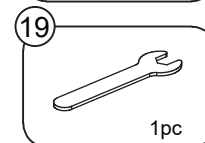
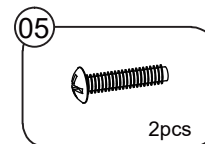
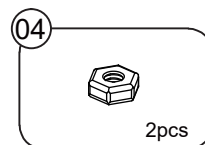
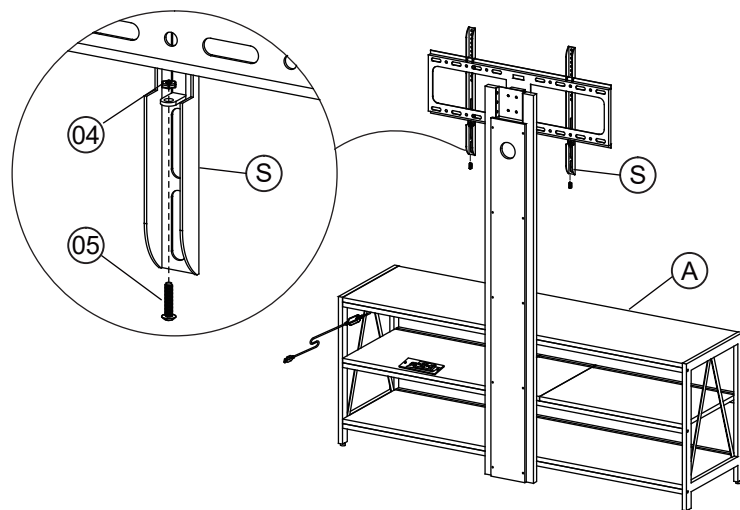

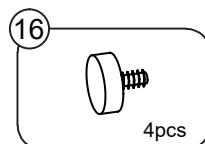
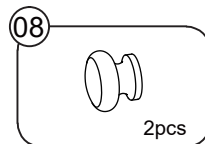
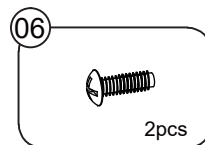
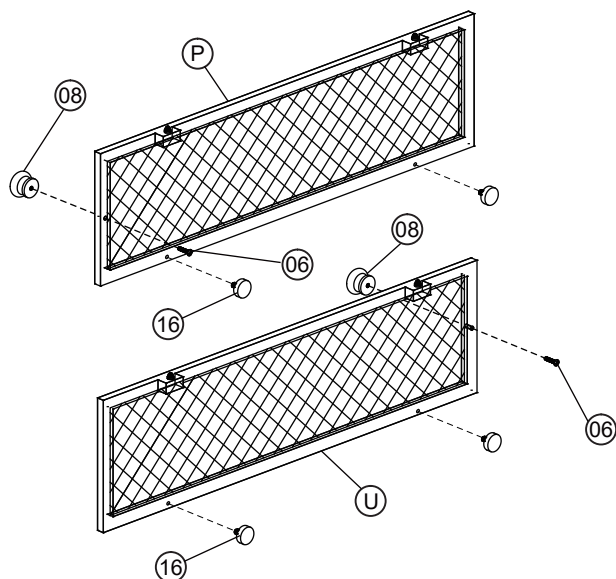
Secure hardware S onto T



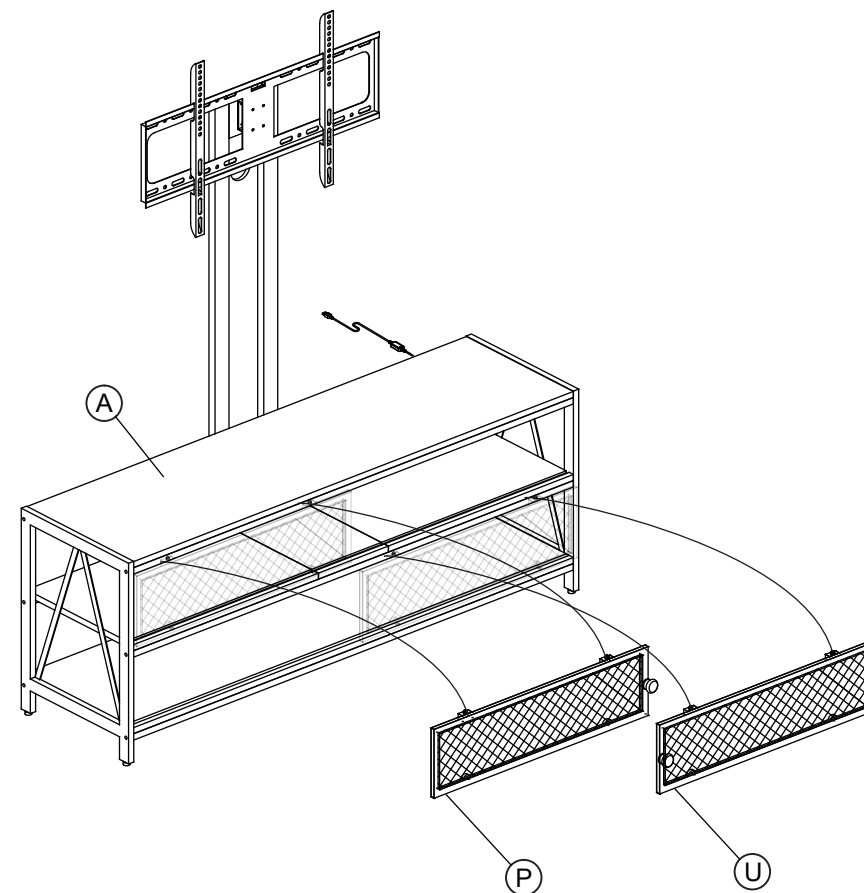
step 16 Secure hardware 04 and 05 onto S to prevent S from detaching from T



step 17 Assemble handle 08 onto doors P and U using hardware 06. Attach hardware 16 to doors P and U



step 18 Assemble the upper and lower doors into the corresponding track grooves on the three shelves



MAINTENANCE AND CARE



1. **Moisture Avoidance:** Laminate furniture, often composed of materials like MDF or particleboard, is susceptible to moisture. To prevent swelling and damage, keep it in a dry environment, away from damp areas.
2. **Sunlight Protection:** Prolonged sunlight exposure can cause discoloration. Use curtains or blinds to shield furniture from direct sunlight.
3. **Regular Cleaning:** Prevent dust and stains by gently wiping the surface with a damp, soft cloth. Avoid using wet cloths or brushes.
4. **Scratch Prevention:** Avoid placing hard objects like keys or scissors on the surface of laminate furniture to prevent scratches. When moving it, be careful not to scrape the furniture legs on the ground.
5. **Weight Distribution:** Laminate furniture can't withstand heavy pressure. Place heavy objects on stable support surfaces rather
