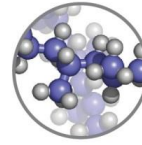

PSW vs. FIBERGLASS

- Damage in paint layer shows the white colored material underneath
- Breaks in extreme weather conditions
- High cost

PSW vs. FOAM

- Weak durability and not weather resistant
- Wear and tear exposes the raw material underneath, making damage obvious
- Short outdoor lifespan



PSW's durability offers a sturdier, more convincing stone or clay appearance than its fragile foam counterparts.

PSW vs. CERAMIC

- Chips and scratches to expose the uncolored material underneath
- Susceptible to cracking in extreme weather conditions
- Heavy and expensive
