Assembly Preparation

Before Beginning Assembly:



- Read instructions, cover to cover-



- Have 2 adults on hand for assembly-



- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-

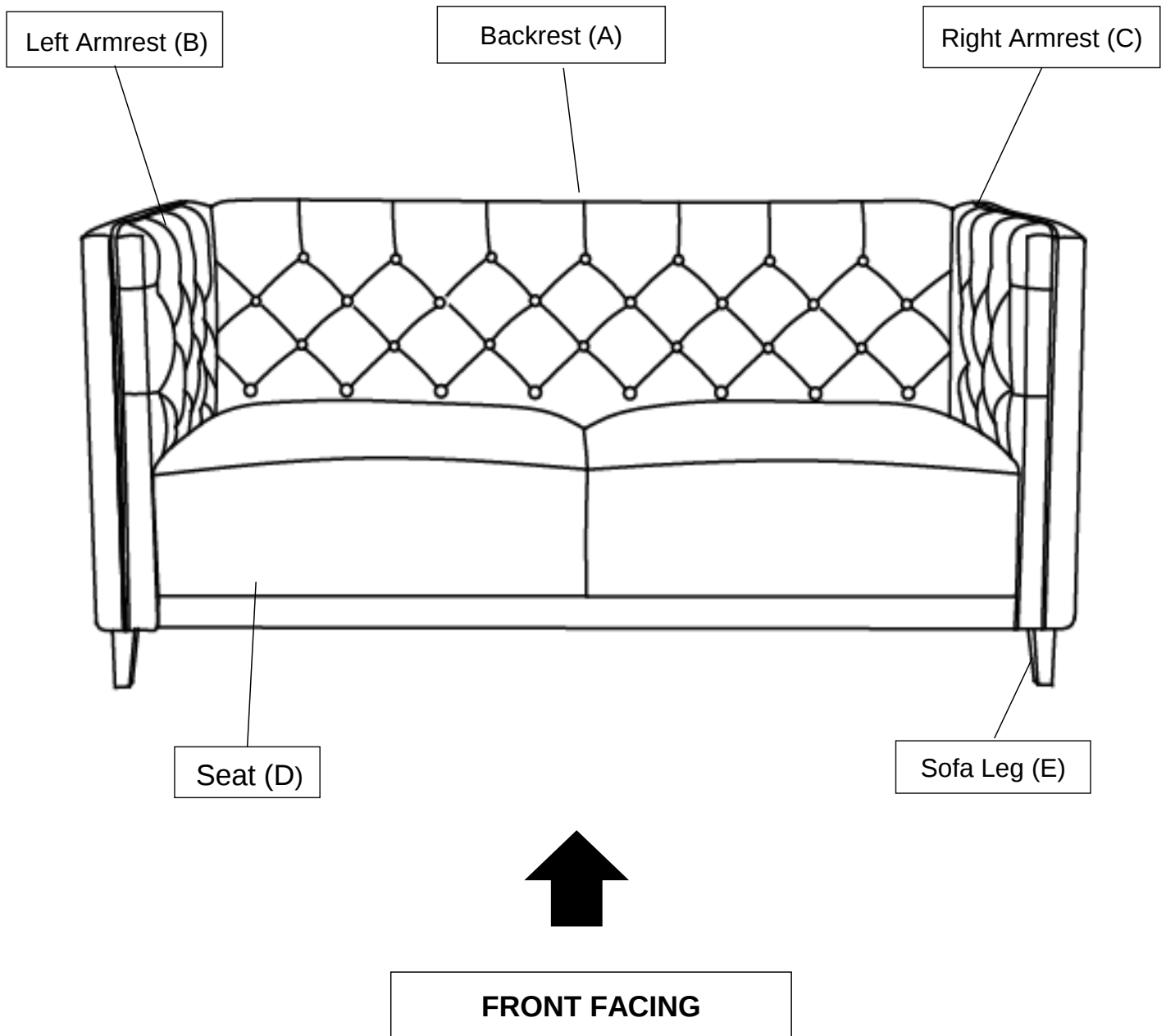


- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-

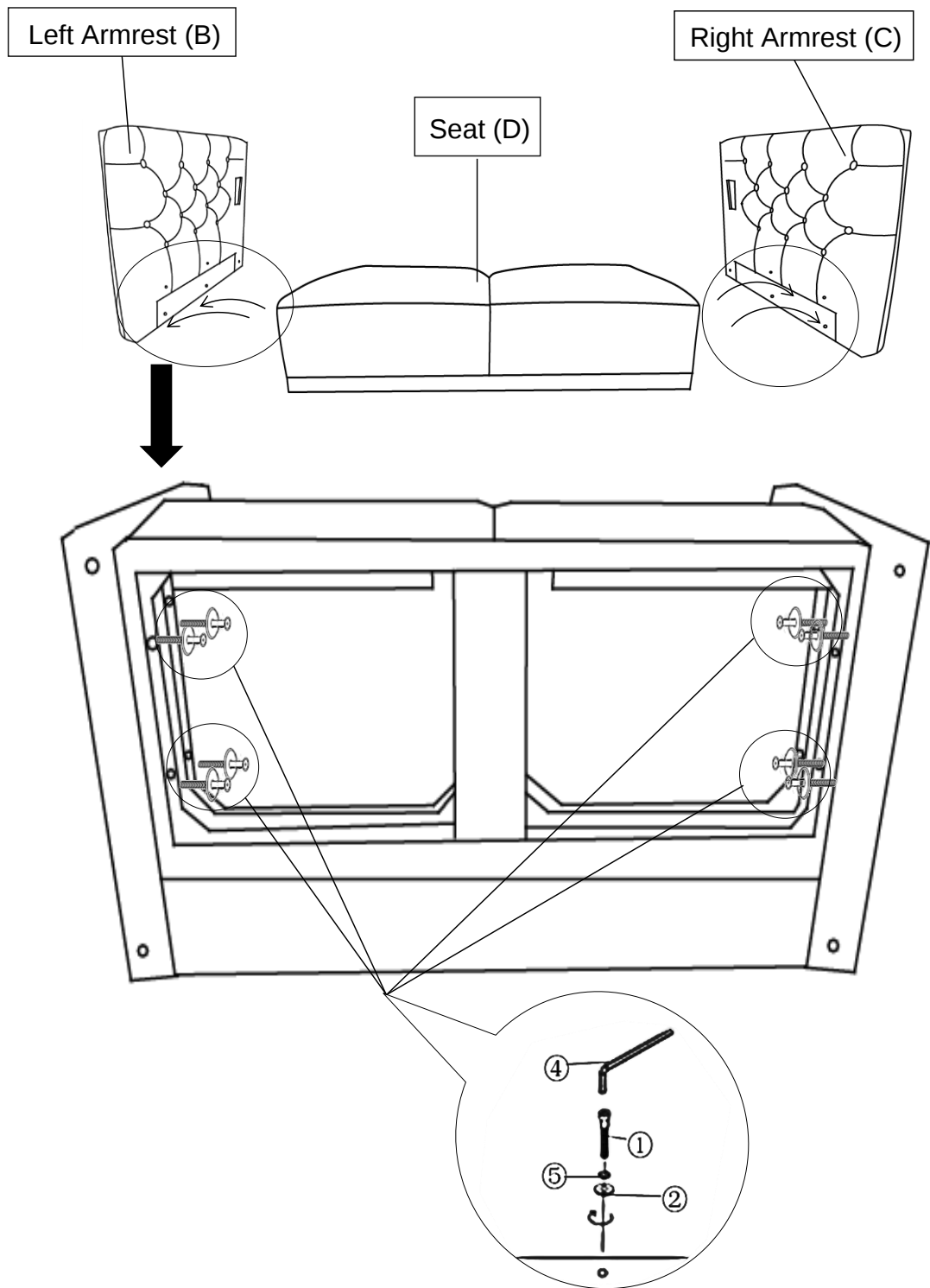
Assembly Steps



This sofa has multiple parts and may require up to 60 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the sofa parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Note: It is recommended that you have an adult partner to assist during the entire assembly process.

Step 1



Open the carton and place all the parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

With the assistance of your partner, attach the Seat(D) to the Armrests(B&C) using Bolts(①), Spring Washers(⑤), and Washers(②) with the Allen Wrench(④) as pictured above.

Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.

DO NOT fully tighten a Bolt in one go and then move on to the next.

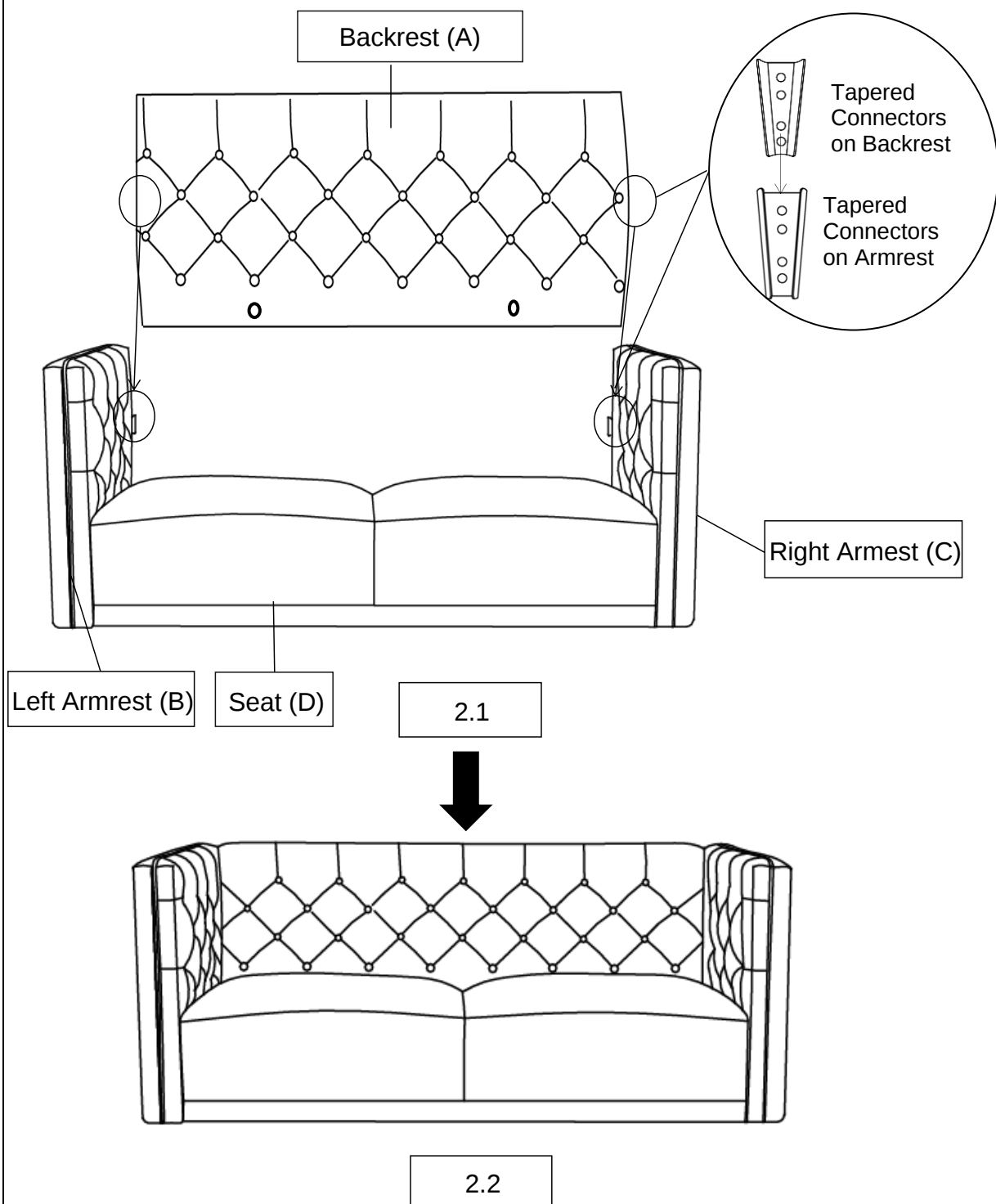
Rather, In a sequential manner, gradually tighten each Bolt until all Bolts are evenly secured. This methodology will ensure maximum evenness once all Bolts are fully tightened.

Make sure the bottoms of the Seat(D) and Armrests(B&C) are aligned and level with each other.

Assistance from an adult partner is needed for this assembly process.

Caution: Ensure that your fingers do not get caught or pinched in the assembly process.

Step 2



With the assistance from your partner.

2.1) Lift the Backrest(A) up, make sure the Backrest(A) is vertical and aligned to the Seat and Armrests. Align the Tapered Connectors on the Backrest(A) with those on the Armrest(B&C). Your adult partner may need to push the Armrests in towards the Backrest(A) to allow for better alignment.

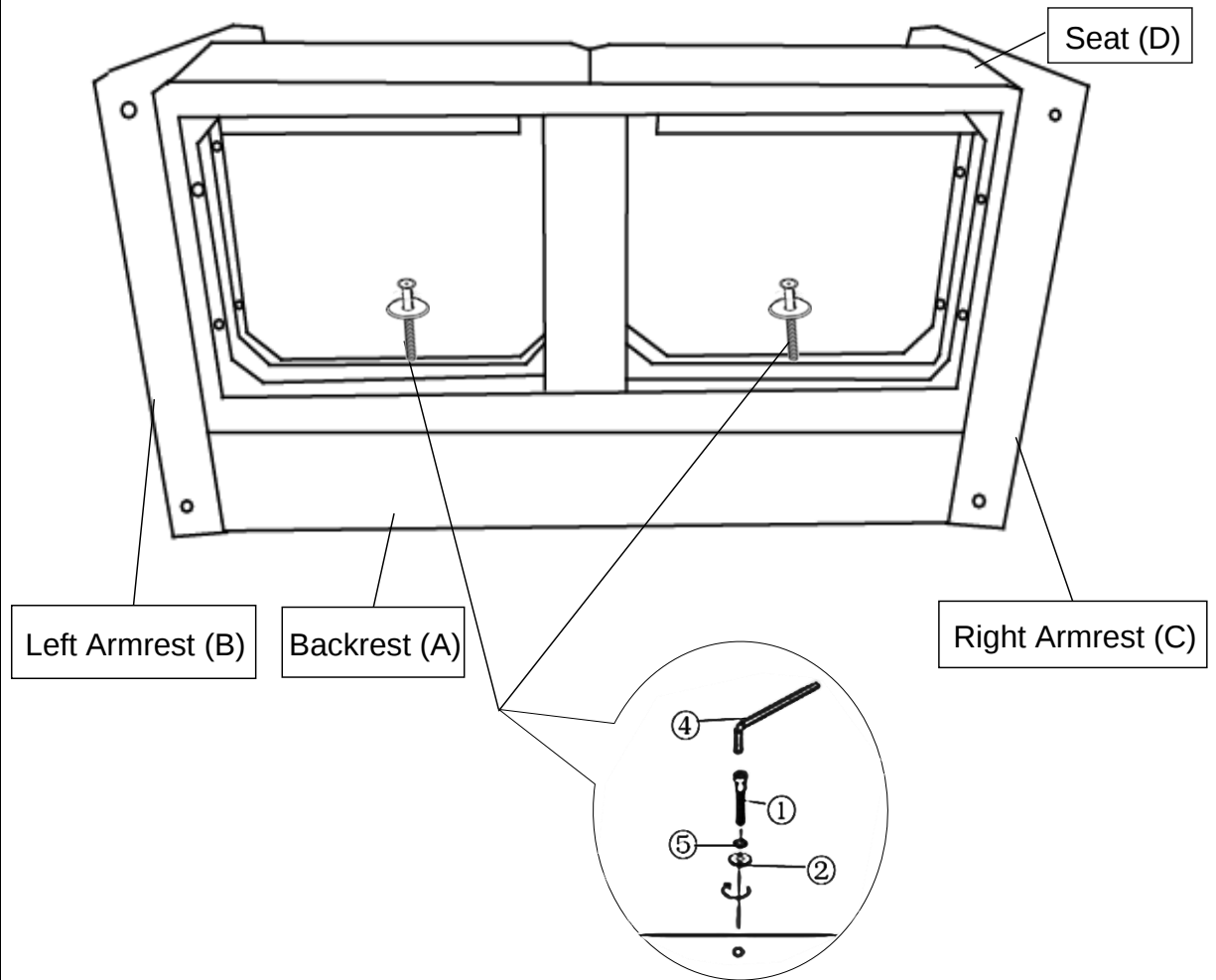
Slip and slide the Backrest, in a gradual and balanced manner into the Tapered Connectors.

2.2) Push the Backrest(A) downwards until it is fully slotted and locked into position.

Note: Make sure the Tapered Connectors on the Backrest(A) lock into the Tapered Connectors on the Armrests(B&C).

Fully locked position: Check and assess that the base of the Backrest(A) and Seat(D) are aligned and level.

Step 3



Tilt and lay the sofa on its Back onto a flat surface.

Attach the Seat(D) to the Backrest(A) using Bolts(①), Spring Washers(③), and Washers(②) with the Allen Wrench(④).

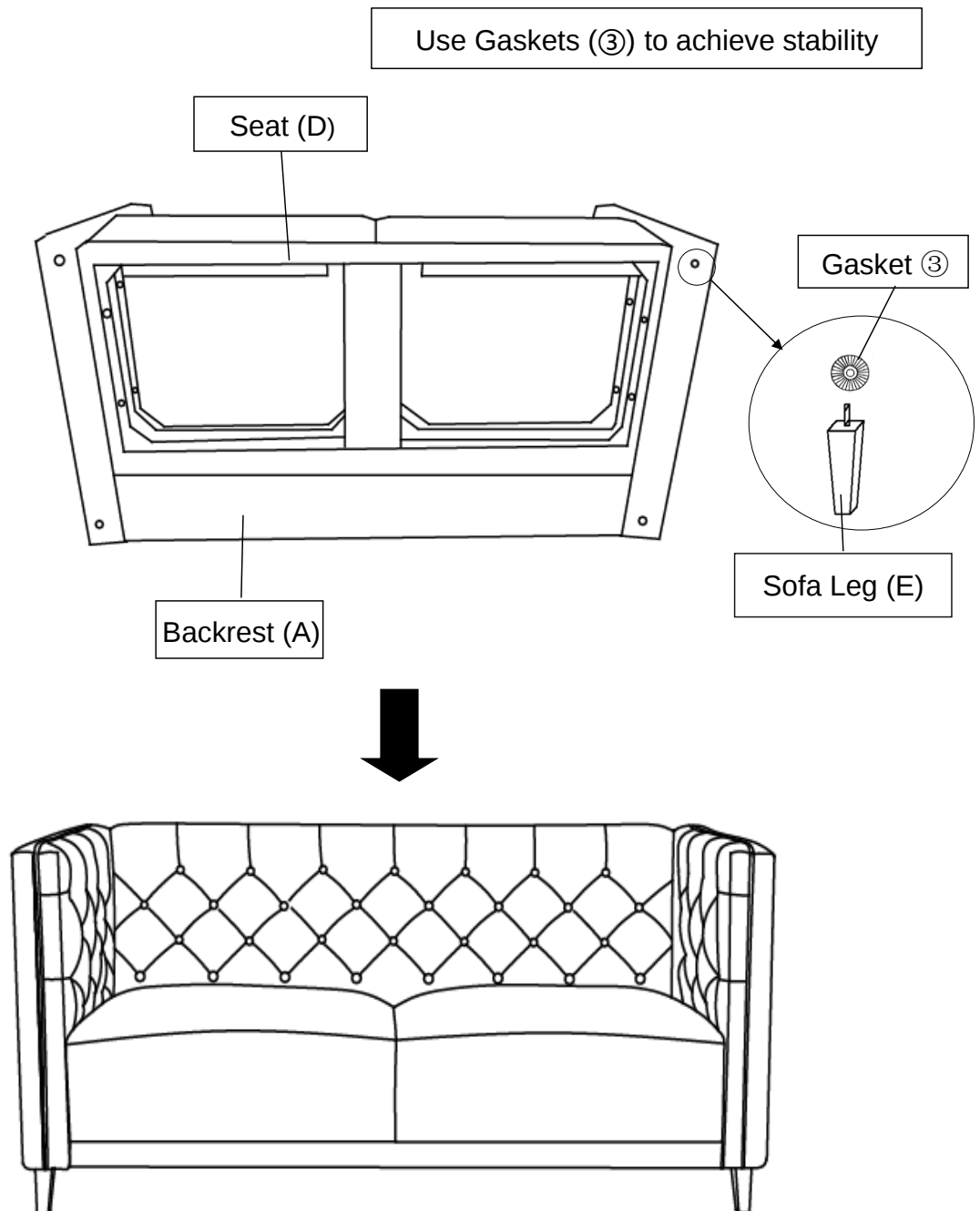
Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.

DO NOT Fully tighten a Bolt in one go and then move on to the next.

Rather, In a sequential manner, gradually tighten each Bolt until all Bolts are evenly secured. This methodology will ensure maximum evenness once all Bolts are fully tightened.

Note: If you can not insert the Bolts into position, please go back to Step 2 to "push the Backrest downwards".

Step 4



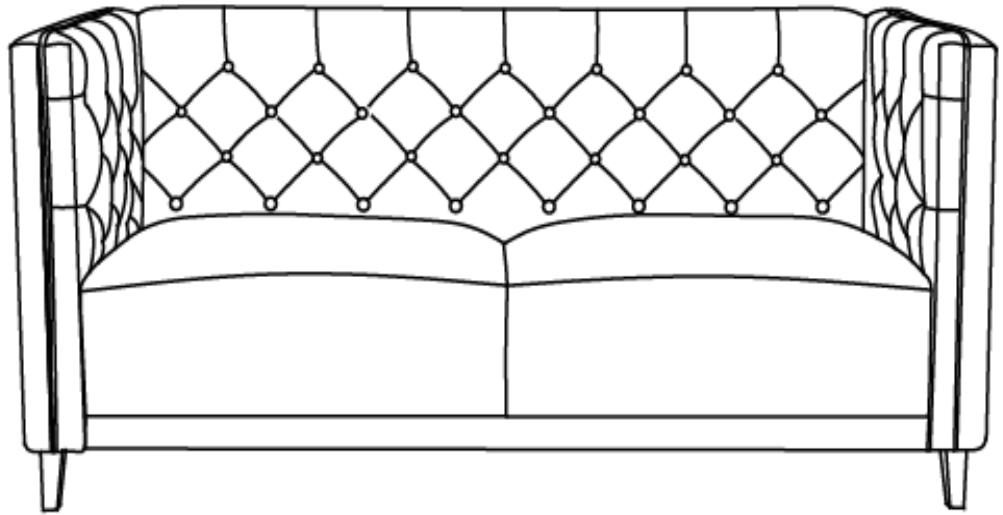
Attach the sofa Leg(E) to the bottom of the sofa by placing one Gasket(3) on the threaded stem. Then insert the threaded stem into the threaded mounting position at the corner of the sofa. Tighten by turning the Leg clockwise.

Repeat the same step to install the remaining three Legs.

Note: The use of Gaskets are OPTIONAL and are especially useful to help alleviate slight wobbles. Some Legs may need more than one whilst some legs may not need any.

Please keep the Allen key, as you may need it to tighten the Bolts again if the product were to loosen during use.

Step 5



Your sofa is ready for use.
This sofa can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Care & Maintenance



- Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.
