CARE GUIDE

Thank you for purchasing this product.

The sofa is often the central point of the room and in order to maximise the life span of your sofa and keep it looking its best we recommend you follow the set of guidelines below.

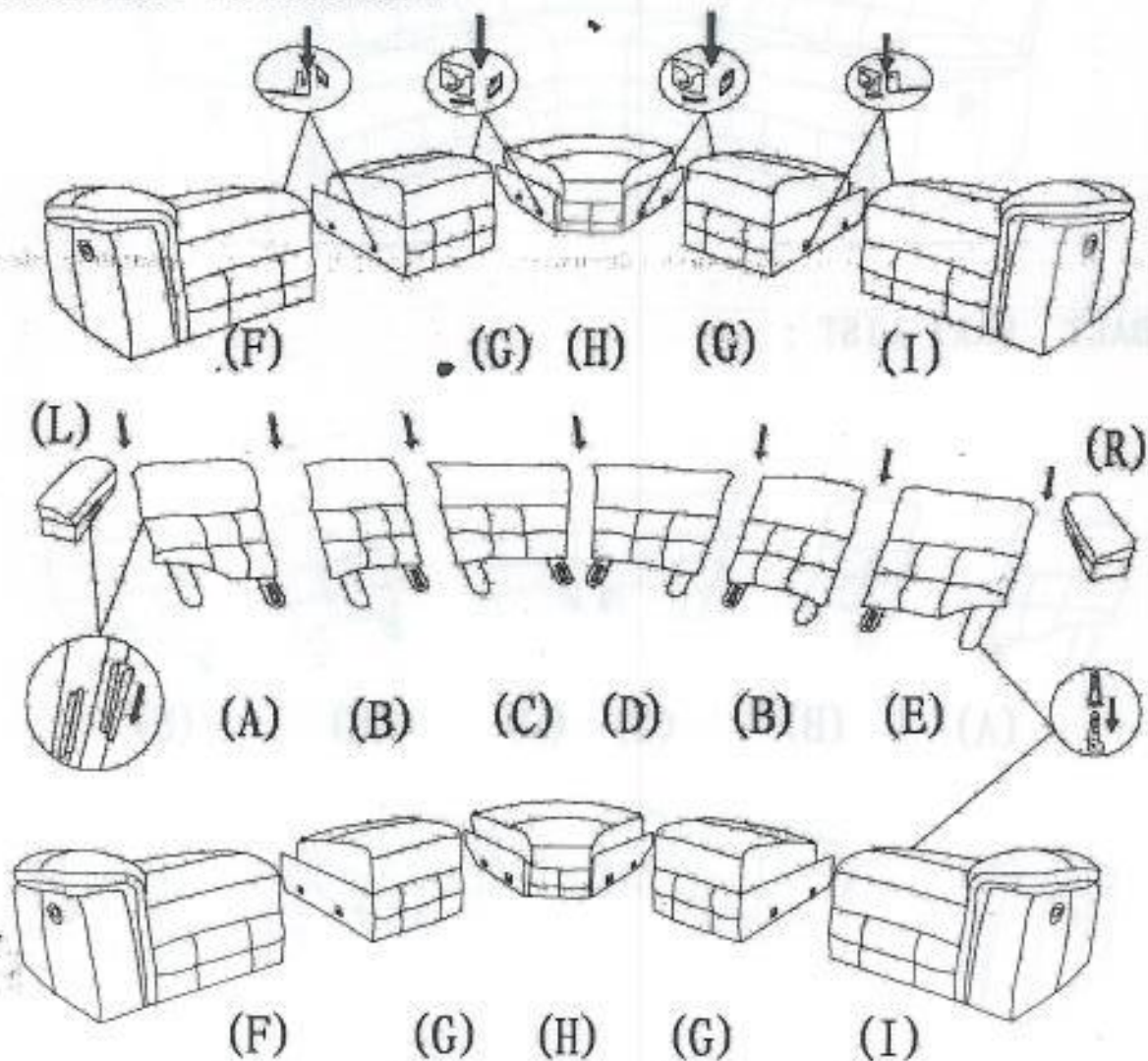
Please keep this Care Guide in a safe place as you may need to refer to it at a later date.

- Avoid sitting on the arms of sofas and chairs as the upholstery will become stretched and distorted.
- Dust will cause wear on a fabric. We recommend vacuuming your sofa suite at least once a week taking care to remember to include the hard to reach places such as all gaps between seats and arms, and under and behind cushions.
- Cushion interiors will lose up to 25% of their volume in the first six months. Maintain the shape by shaking daily. Cushions should also be rotated weekly to ensure even wear on seats and back covers.
- Direct sunlight will always cause covers to fade and will weaken the fibers over a period of time. Try to keep the sofa out of direct light and if not possible close curtains and blinds. Also keep away from high temperature and any heat source as this too will cause material quality to deteriorate.
- Unless you have a loose cover suit, all covers are designed to be cleaned whilst on the upholstery frame. We recommend that a professional cleaning company be used to clean your sofa. This should be cleaned every 12-18 months.
- Sofas should be kept in rooms with dry air and good ventilation and avoid positioning too close to walls.
- Solvents will weaken and slowly decompose fibers. Only use leather cleaning products and before use always test on an isolated area of the sofa and check for any adverse effects over a period of at least fourteen days.
- Oily based substances (food), Solvents (cleaning products), Acidic & Alkaline materials (sweat, oils and soaps) all will react and weaken fibers resulting in the thinning and cracking of fabrics. Avoid prolonged direct skin contact, spillages and eating on the sofa suite.
- Your sofas are not suitable for Pet use. They will scratch and can introduce foreign contaminants that will have adverse effects on the sofa.
- Repetitive rubbing will eventually wear down fabric (buckles and rivets) and take care with certain clothe materials.
- If you need to store your sofa the best position is in its natural sitting position and avoid any heavy pressing. Loosely cover the whole sofa and keep in a dry and ventilated environment.
