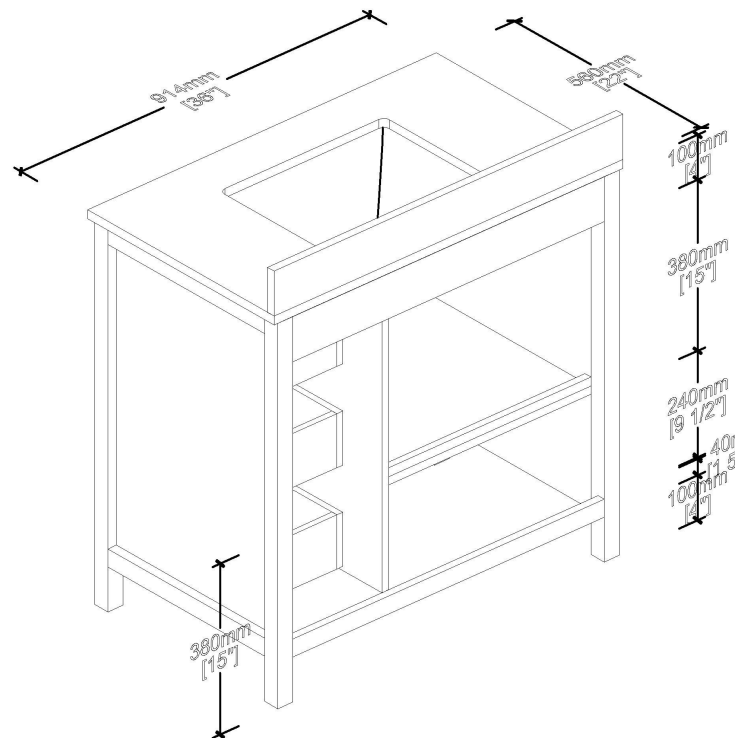




PRE-ASSEMBLY

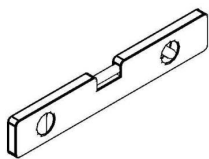
To ensure your installation goes smoothly, please read the following instructions carefully before your installation.

- 1. Removing your old vanity (if applicable). Turn off the electricity and water supply before you start. Then disconnect all lines to the sink and disconnect appliances.
- 2. Evening out walls and floor Flat, level surfaces are important. Unevenness can cause your vanity to become misaligned resulting in twisting of the cabinet. Repair any uneven areas by reducing high spots or shimming low spots.
- 3. Check all parts and review all tools (not included) make sure you have all prepared before your installation.

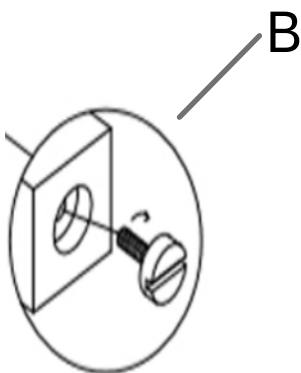
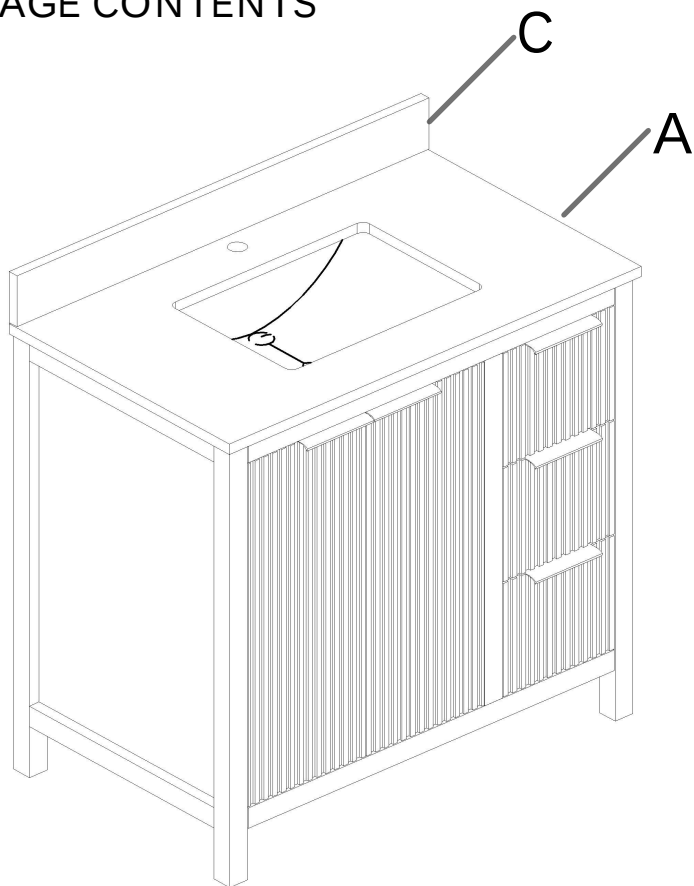

ASSEMBLY

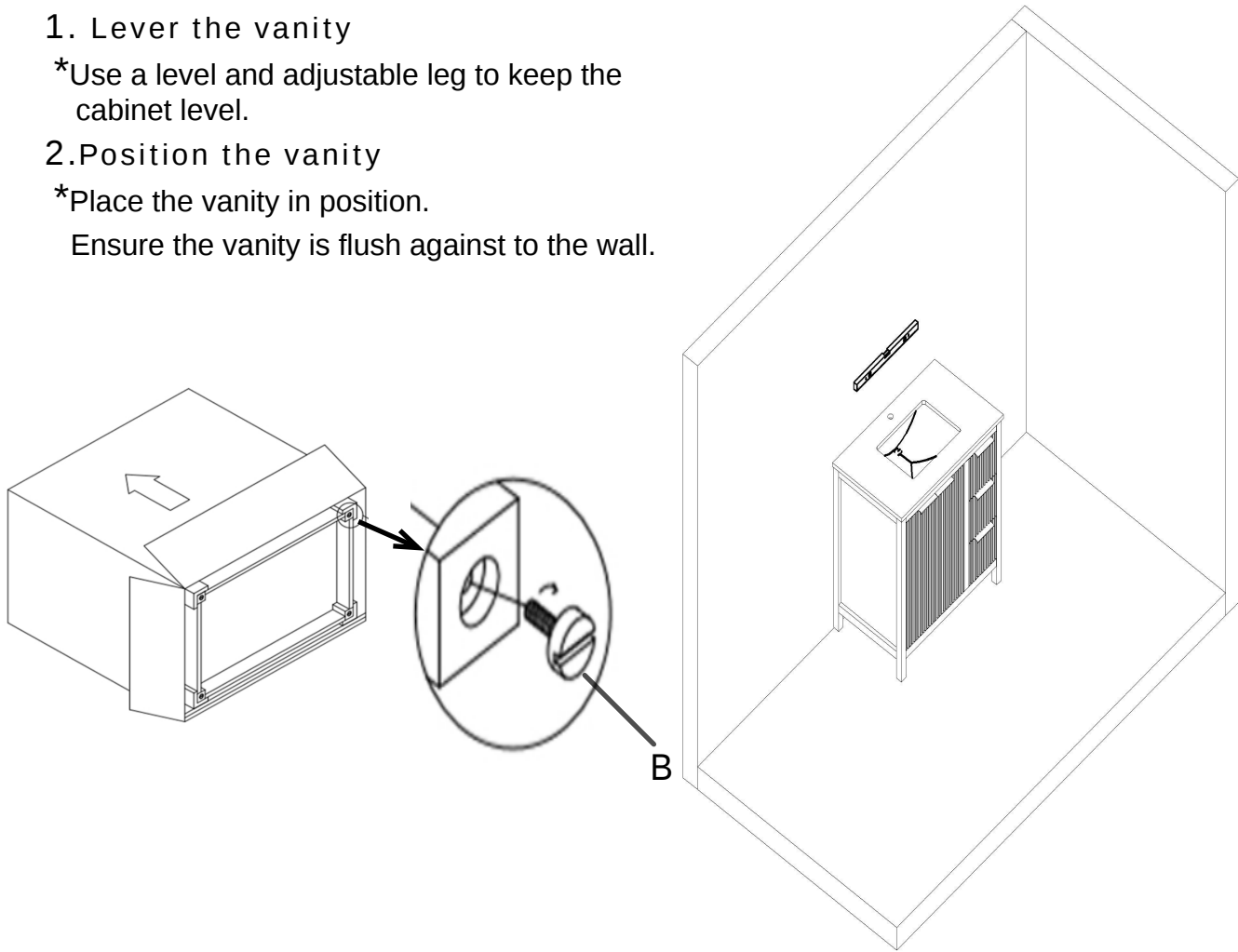
1. Lever the vanity

*Use a level and adjustable leg to keep the cabinet level.

2. Position the vanity

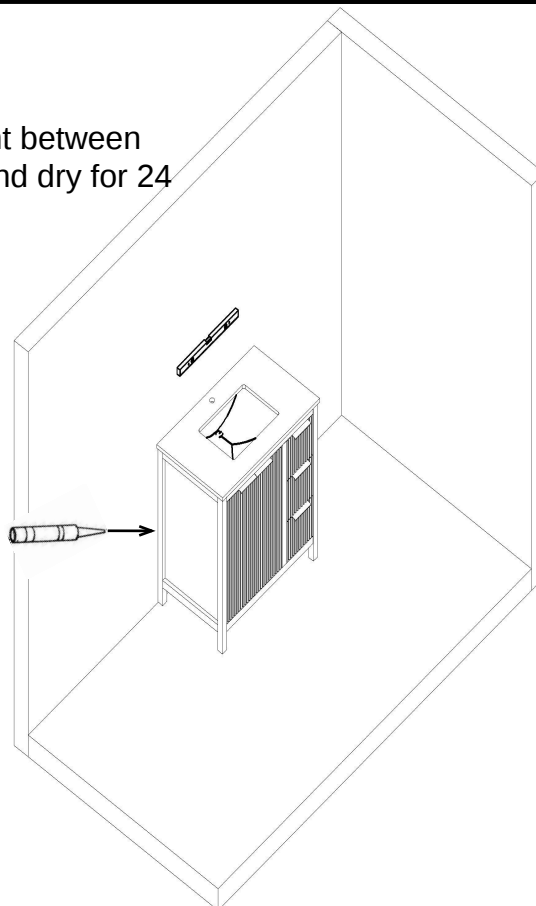
*Place the vanity in position.

Ensure the vanity is flush against to the wall.



3. Seal the vanity

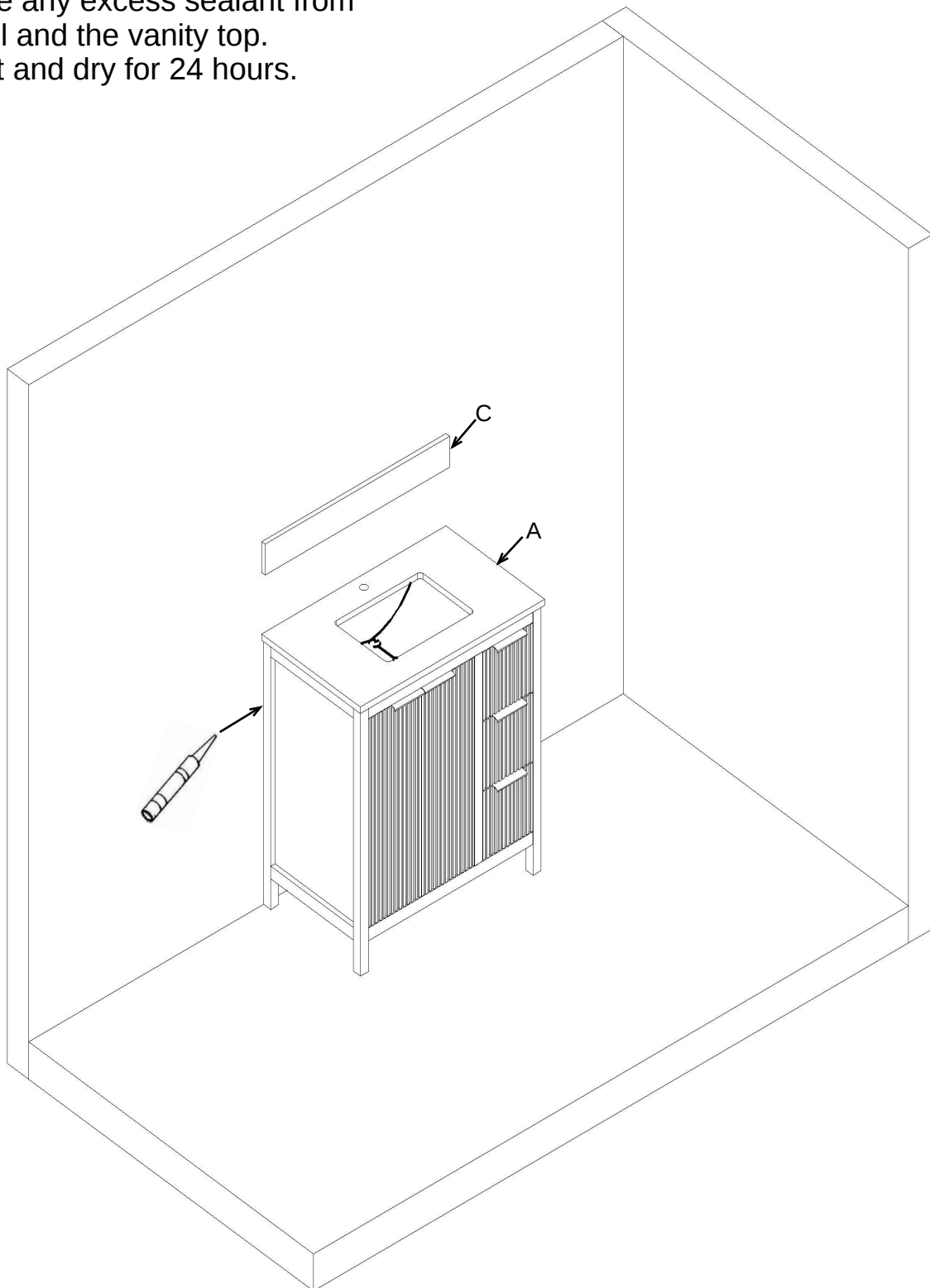
*Apply sanitary silicone sealant between vanity and the wall. Let it sit and dry for 24 hours.



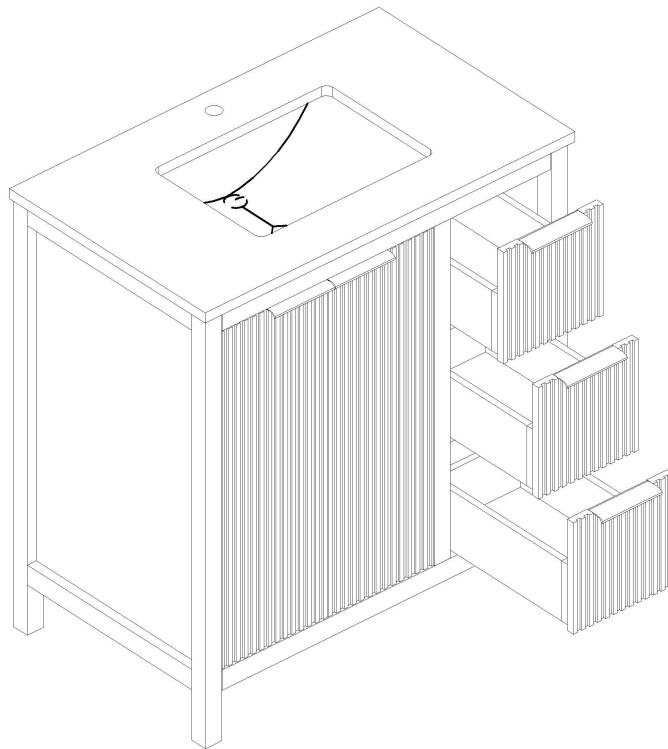
4. Install the backsplash

Apply backsplash sealant:

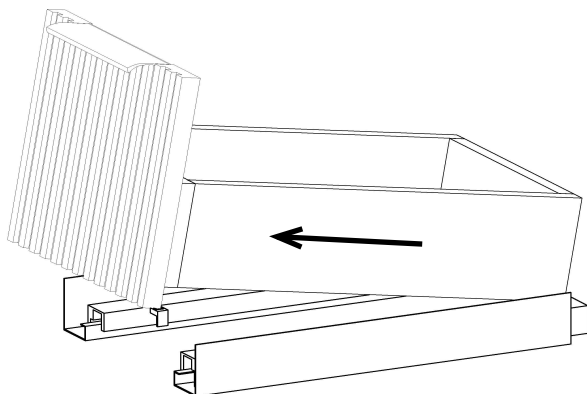
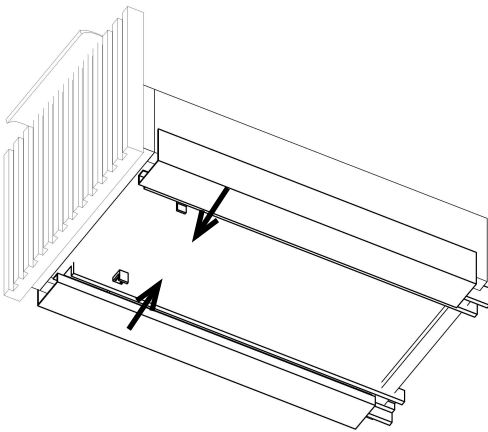
- *Clear backsplash of all debris before applying clear silicon sealant.
- *Ensure to apply the sealant on the roughedge and smooth face is facing the front.
- *Set unpolished bottom edge of backsplash on the vanity countertop.
- *press gently against wall and down on the top.
- *Remove any excess sealant from the wall and the vanity top.
- *Let it sit and dry for 24 hours.
