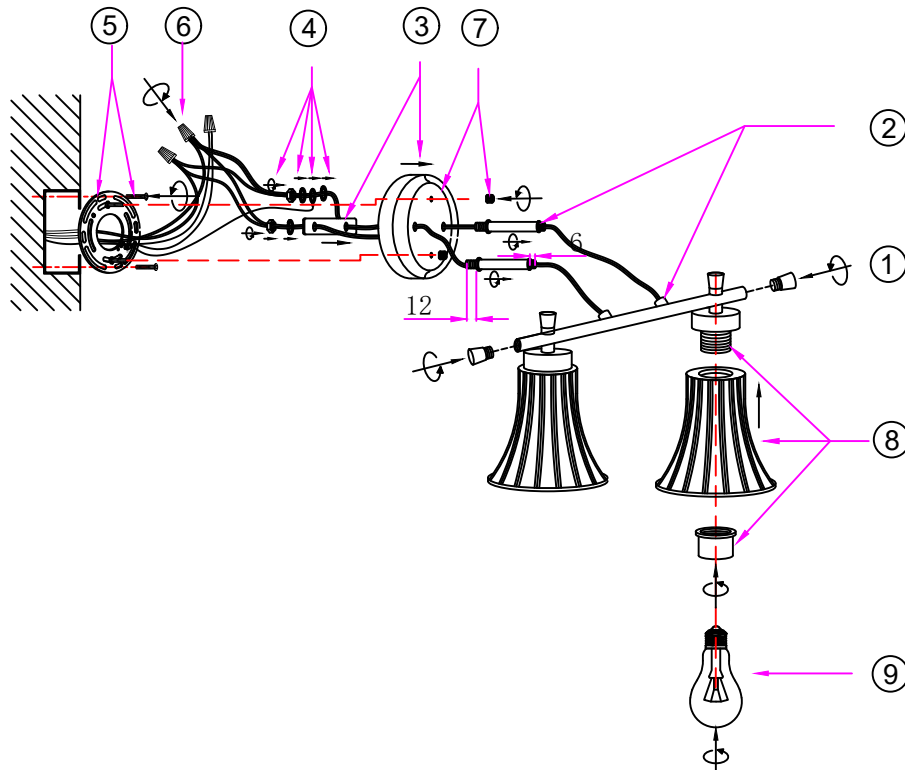


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Screw the decorative end caps onto both ends of the metal tube.
 2. Thread the power cord through the threaded nipple, and tighten the short end (6mm) to the lamp frame.
 3. Pass the cord through the wall bracket and reinforcement plate. Slide both onto the two threaded nipples.
 4. Thread the cord through a threaded washer, ground wire, and add another washer. Secure with a nut.
 5. Mount the clamping mounting plate to the junction box using screws.
 6. Wiring Connections
 - Use wire connectors to connect the black (hot) wire to the black wire, the white (neutral) wire to the white wire, and the ground wire to the grounding terminal.
 - Ensure no exposed conductors remain outside wire connectors or outside the junction box.
 7. Secure the wall bracket to the mounting plate using decorative nuts.
 8. Place the glass shade over the socket, align it, and secure with the retaining ring.
 9. Install light bulbs into sockets (bulbs not included). Do not exceed maximum wattage.
 10. Restore power and test operation.
- Installation is complete.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
