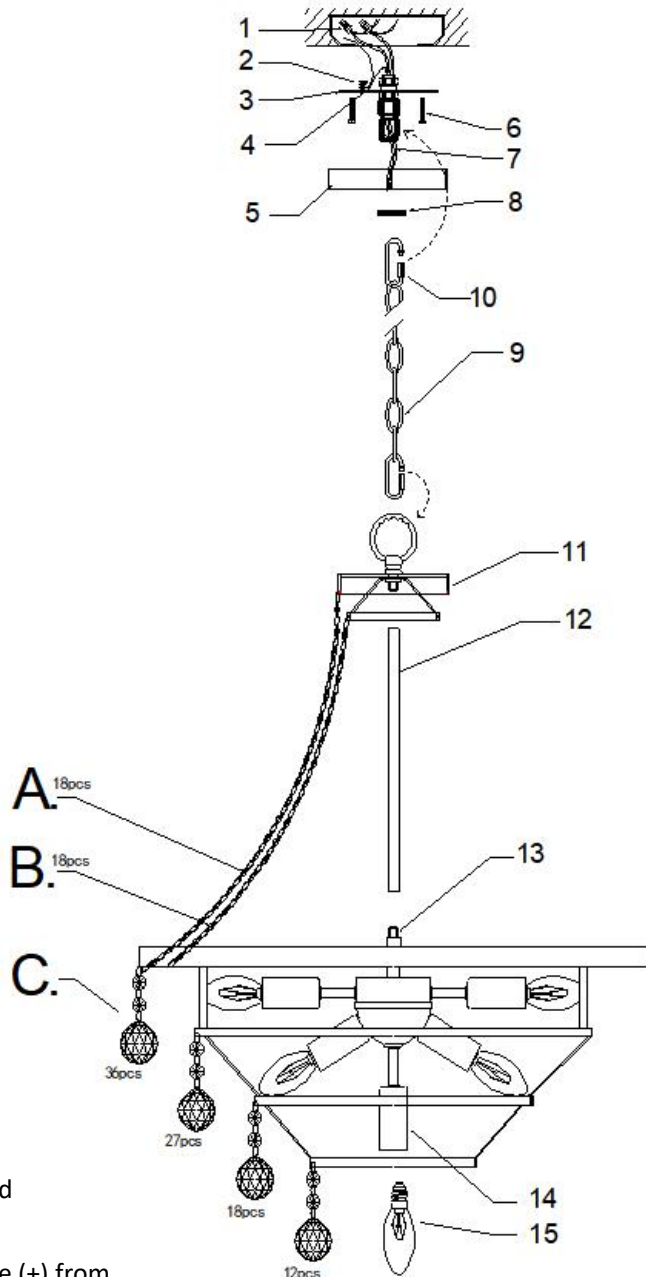

### Installation Instructions

- ① Pass the light wire (7) and ground wire (4) through the hanging pole (12), metal ring (11), and hanging chain (9), then tighten on to the threading tube (13).
- ② Secure the mounting plate onto the junction box using the screws (6).
- ③ Pass the light wire (7), ground wire (4), collar ring + loop through the canopy (5), then pass the light wire (7) and ground wire (4) to the threading tube of mounting plate (3) and connect the hanging chain (9) and the collar ring + loop using quick link (10).
- ④ Connect the light positive wire (7) to the positive wire (+) from ceiling using the wire cap (1). Similarly, connect the light negative wire to the negative wire (-) from ceiling using the wire cap (1). Ensure no bare wires are exposed to prevent electrical leakage. Attach the ground wires to the mounting plate using the green screw (2).
- ⑤ Cover the junction box with the canopy (5) and secure the canopy with the collar loop. Install the light bulbs onto the light sockets.
- ⑥ Finally, hang decorative strands A, B, and C onto the light fixture according to the markings:
  - A. 22 octagonal beads for one strand, total of 18 strands
  - B. 21 octagonal beads for one strand, total of 18 strands
  - C. 2 octagonal beads and 1 crystal ball for one strand, total of 94 strands (including 1 spare strand)
