

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

WI7142LG-N

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- People Required: 2
- **Assembly Surface:** Use a clean, soft, or carpeted surface to prevent damage to upholstery;
- **Tools Required:** L-Key (included). Phillips screwdriver may be required.
- **Handling:** Avoid dragging to prevent fabric tearing or frame damage.
- **Maintenance:** Check and tighten all hardware every 6-8 weeks.

PRE-ASSEMBLY NOTES

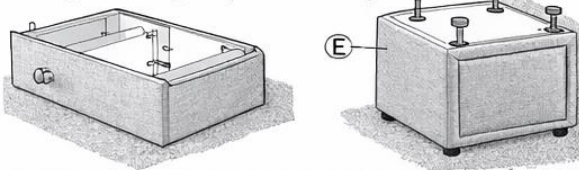
- Inspect all parts before assembly.
- Do **not** fully tighten hardware until all components are aligned.
- If **drawers** are pre-installed, remove them before attaching legs/base.

STEP 1: PREPARE THE UNIT

1. Place nightstand body (A) upside down on a protected surface.
2. Ensure fabric upholstery is not compressed or damaged during setup.

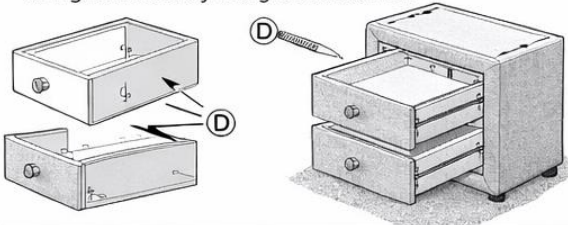
STEP 2: ATTACH LEGS / BASE (IF APPLICABLE)

1. Align each leg (E) with the pre-drilled holes on the bottom panel.
2. Insert bolts through the leg into the frame.
3. Tighten using the provided L-Key.



STEP 3: ATTACH LEGS / BASE (IF APPLICABLE)

1. Insert knob screws from inside the drawer front panel.
2. Attach knobs (D) on the exterior.
3. Tighten securely using a screwdriver.



PARTS CHECKLIST

(A) Nightstand Body (Pre-assembled frame with upholstery) - 1 pc

(B) Upper Drawer - 1 pc

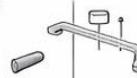
(C) Lower Drawer - 1 pc



(D) Drawer Knobs - 2 pcs (pre-installed or separate)



(E) Legs / Base Supports (if applicable) - 4 pcs



(F) Hardware Pack:

- Bolts
- Washers
- L-Key



FINAL CHECKS



- Confirm all screws and bolts are tightened securely.
- Open and close drawers to ensure proper alignment.
- Verify the unit sits evenly on the floor.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Clean with a soft, dry cloth.
- Avoid harsh chemicals to protect fabric upholstery.
- Keep away from excessive moisture or direct sunlight.

FINAL POSITIONING

- Carefully turn the nightstand upright with assistance.
- Place in desired location.
- Ensure the unit is level and stable.

If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact the supplier for assistance. See - .
