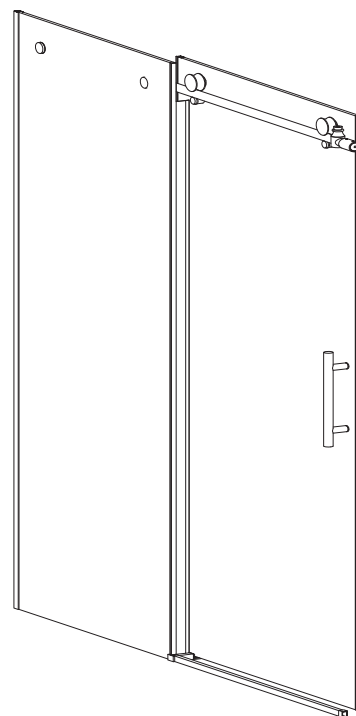

"FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1.Can I combine 2 shower screens together?
No. There are rails around each piece of glass and the rails can not be connected.
- 2.Are handles interchangeable between models?
No. Handles are specific for each shower model.
- 3.Do the shower sets need to be installed on the floor or a shower base?
All shower sets can be installed on either a tile floor or shower base.
- 4.For the sliding doors, do both doors slide or is one panel stationary?
Most sliding door sets will have 1 stationary panel and 1 sliding door.
- 5.Do you make custom shower doors.
No. All shower doors in stock are size specific
- 6.What can I do if the structural rail or threshold is cut too short?
If this were to happen, you can contact BCANHOME Product Support at ysd-wf-after-sale@outlook, one of our knowledgeable reps would be happy to assist you in getting replacement parts.When contacting, please have your original purchase order number and BCANHOME model at the ready.
- 7.Why do I see a greenish hue in my shower glass?
The slight greenish hue is due to the iron content in the glass.When looking directly at the glass it would appear clear.When looking through the glass at an angle, you may see the hue imore pronounce as the glass is thicker.

- Installation Requirements
BCANHOME strongly recommends that all shower door products be installed by a fully licensed and insured professional installer with experience in bathroom, shower, and bathtub door installations. Improper installation or installation by an inexperienced installer may result in glass breakage, which could cause serious personal injury or death. Installation must strictly follow the provided installation manual without modification. Any deviation from the installation instructions will void this Limited Warranty.
- Warranty Coverage
Under normal residential use, BCANHOME warrants the following:
 - Seal strips, bumper strips, and hardware components – One (1) year limited warranty from the date of purchase.
 - Glass components – One (1) year limited warranty from the date of purchase.

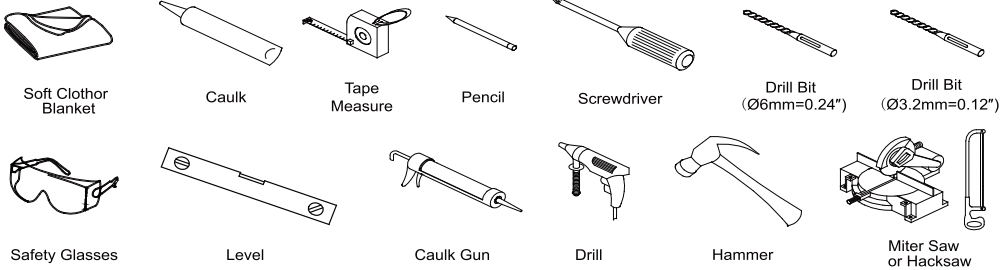
8.What anchors are needed to install the shower set?

All BCANHOME shower door set will have all necessary hardware for proper installation.The anchors included in the set are used for installation. We do recommend that studs be behind the tile wall prior to installation of any shower door set.

9.Where can I get replacement parts?

10.How are the shower doors adjustable, example 60"" set fitsbetween 56""-60""? BCANHOME shower door sets are designed to fit a range of wall-to-wall widths depending on the shower door size. If the structural rail is longer than the wall-to-wall opening, the rail would need to be cut shorter than the actual wall-to-wall opening so it can be installed properly. The glass panels cannot be cut as the glass is tempered."

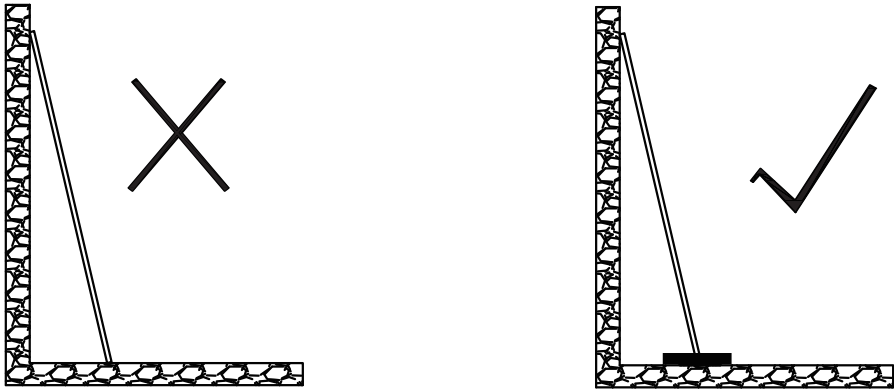
Before You Start

- ☐ Read Thoroughly: Carefully read all instructions and maintenance information. Failure to do so may result in injury or product failure.

- ☐ Professional installation: We strongly recommend installation by a licensed, insured contractor. Two-person assistance is required.
- ☐ Inspect Components: After unpacking, check the Shower Door Components Detail Sheet to ensure all parts are included. Inspect for shipping damage, defects, or missing parts, and contact customer support if needed. Double-check the glass doors for breakage-especially at the corners and edges. Do not install if the glass is damaged.

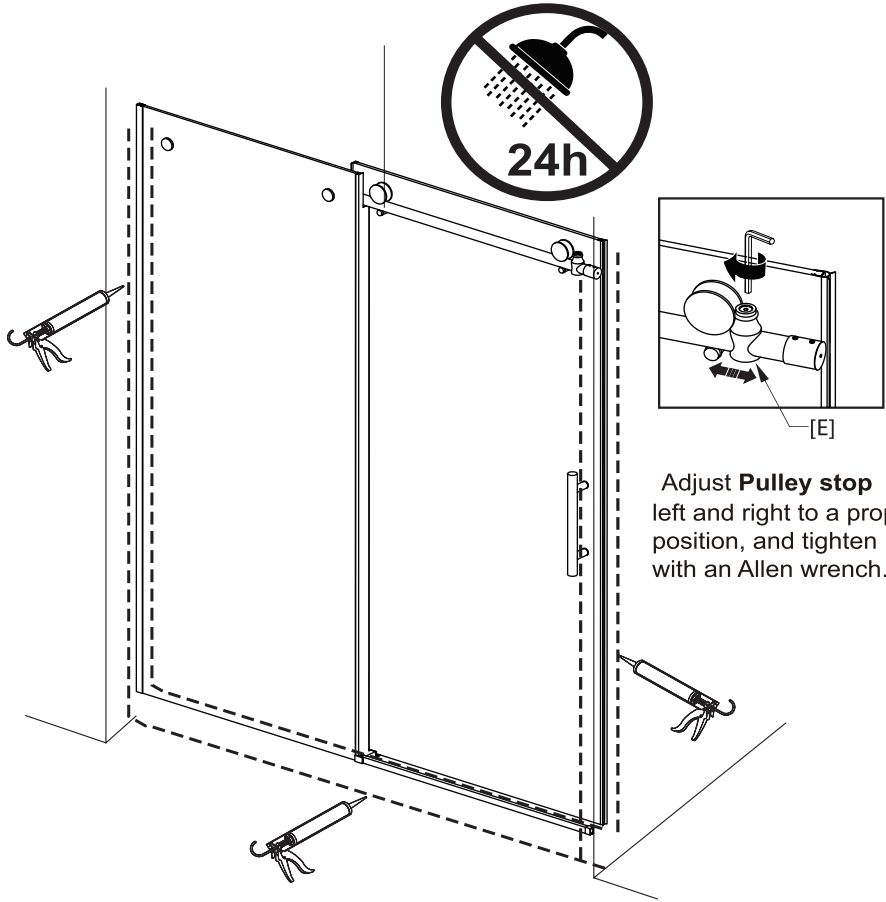


WARNING

When placing the tempered glass upright, ensure a soft material is underneath and avoid impact to the corners or edges to prevent shattering.



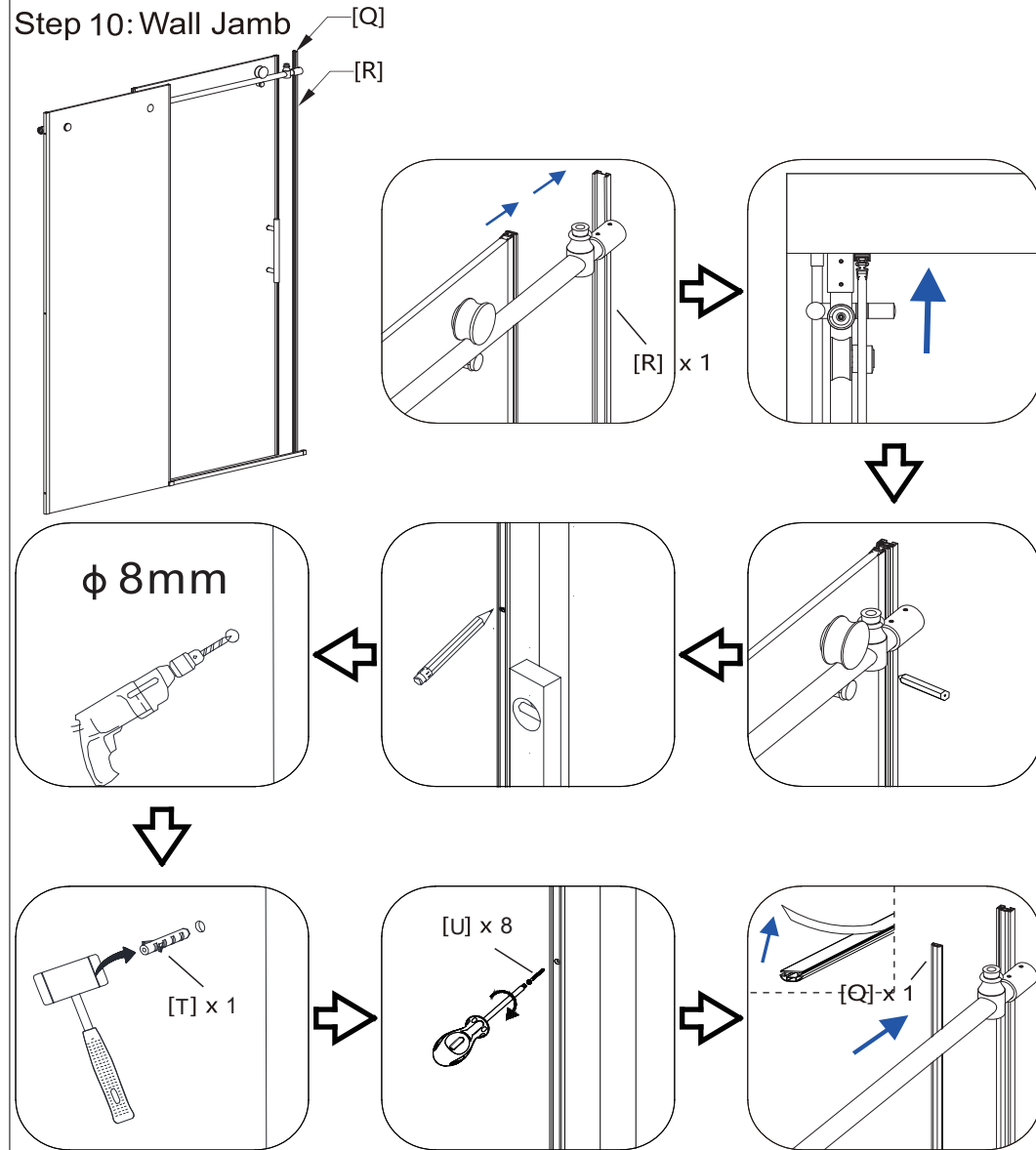
Step 11 : Door Seal



Apply silicone sealant to the seams between the fixed glass and the shower base/floor, and between the wall and the glass (as indicated by the dotted line).

MUST ALLOW SILICONE TO DRY FOR 24 HOURS BEFORE USING THE SHOWER DOOR

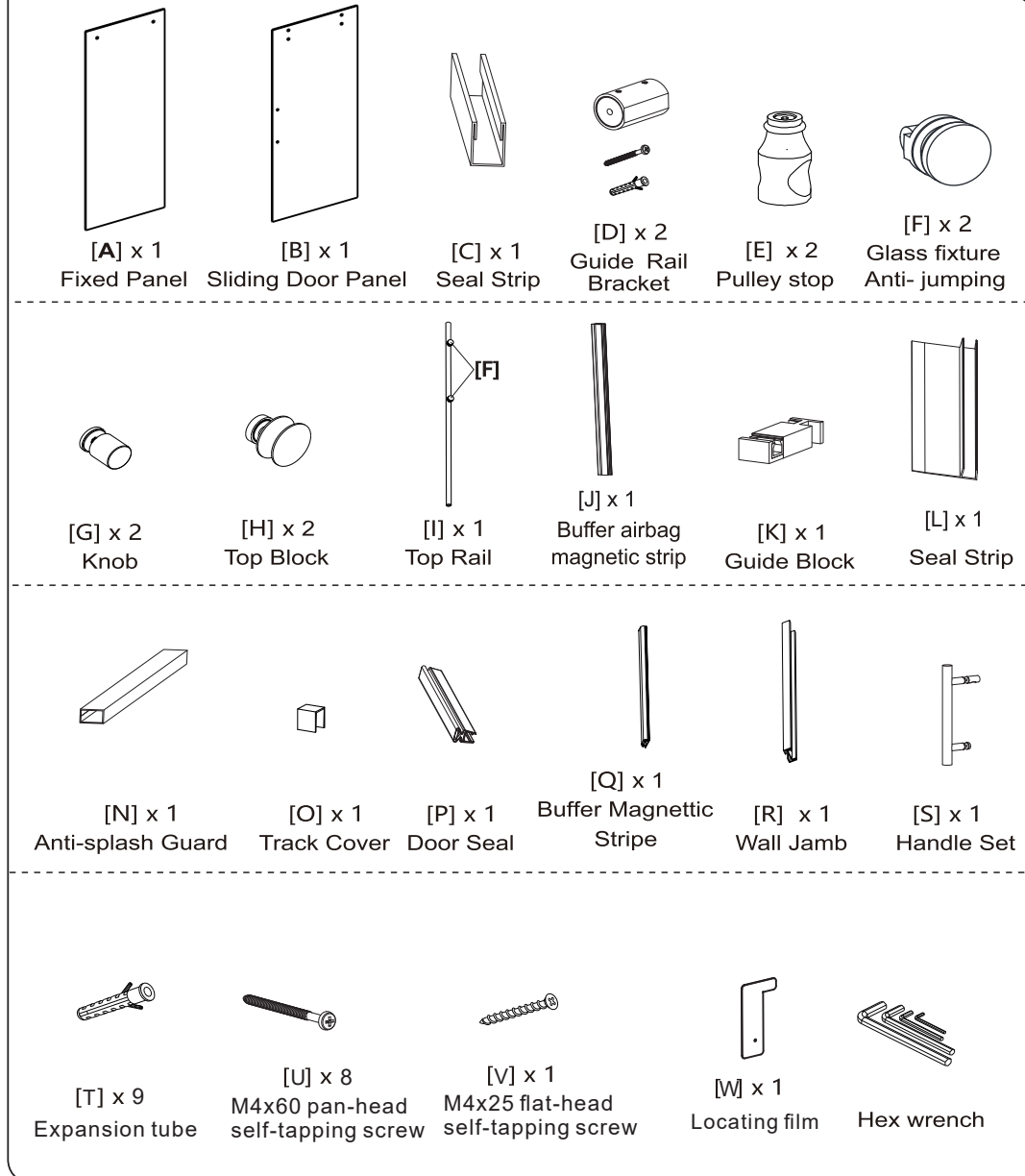
Step 10: Wall Jamb

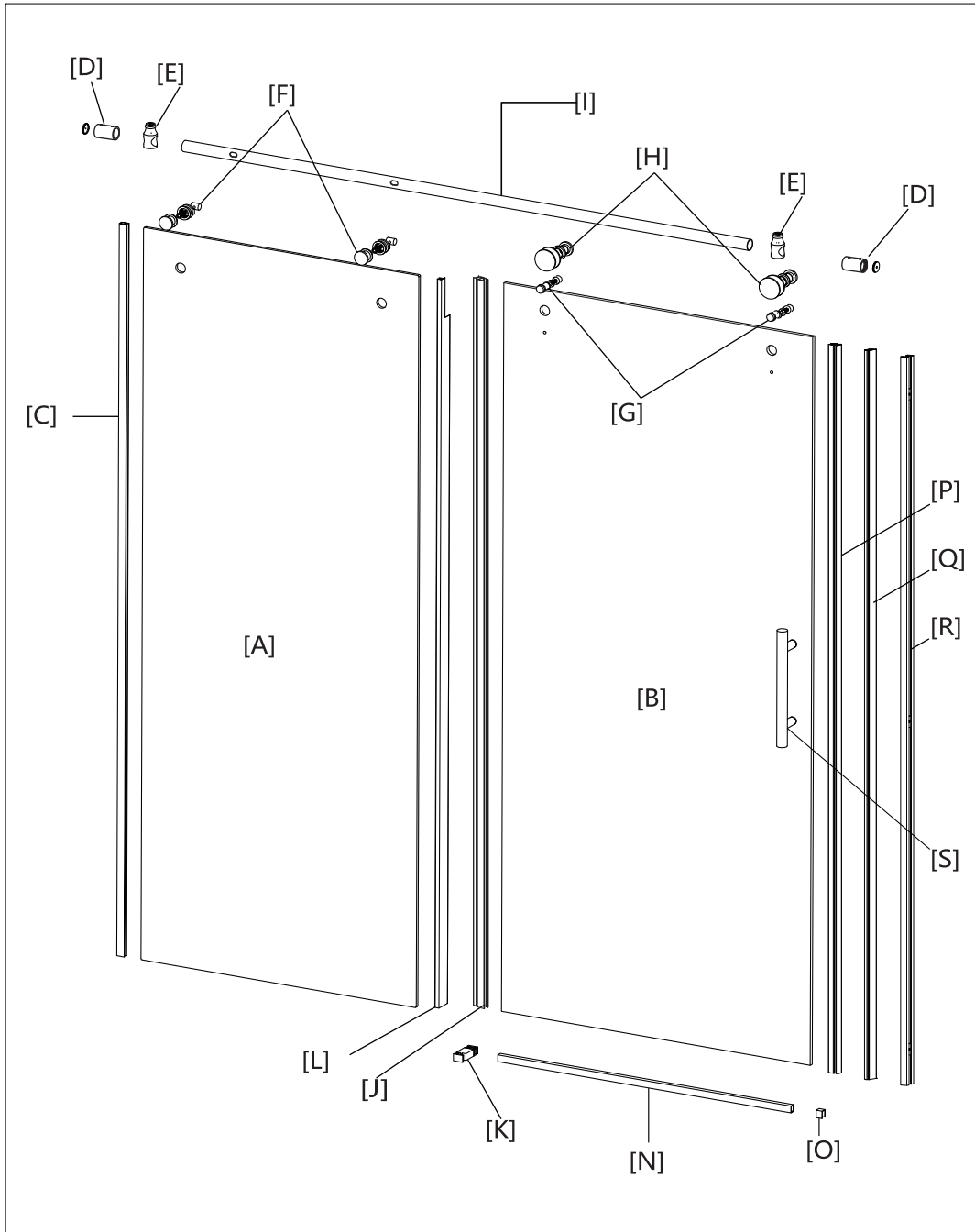


- ① Use the door panel to press the **Buffer magnetic strip [Q]** and the **Wall Jamb [R]** against the wall. Mark the positions with a pen.
- ② Then install the **Buffer magnetic strip [Q]** and the **Wall Jamb [R]**.

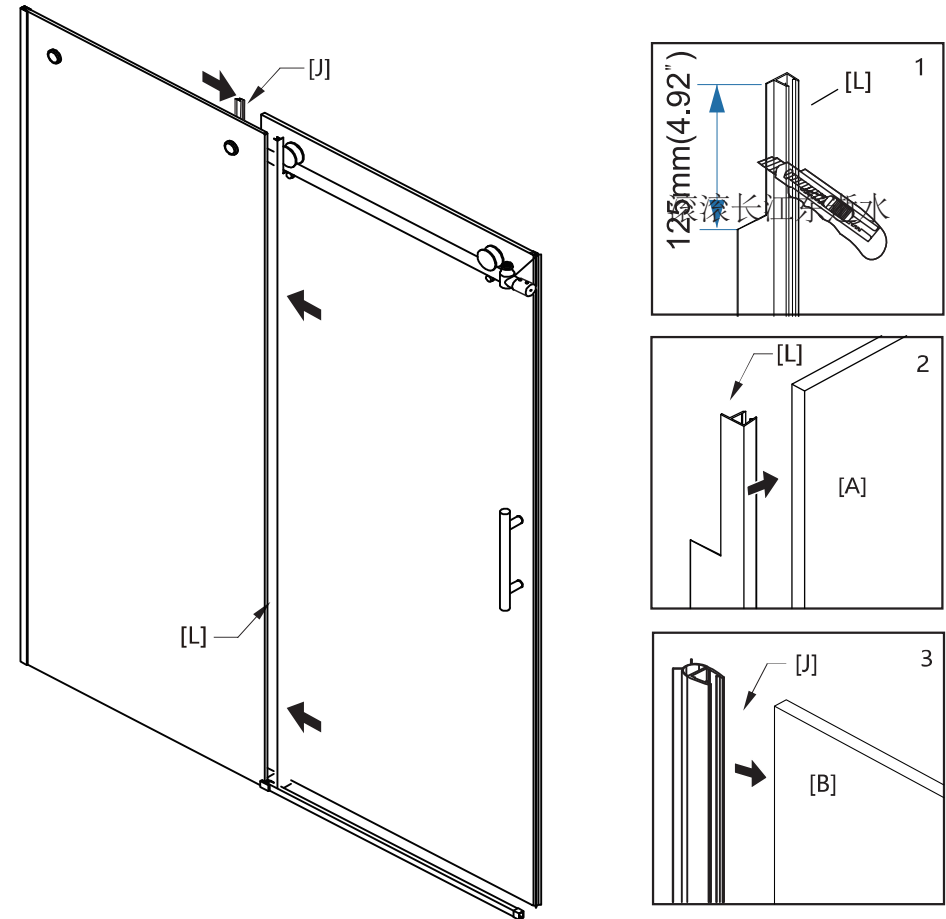

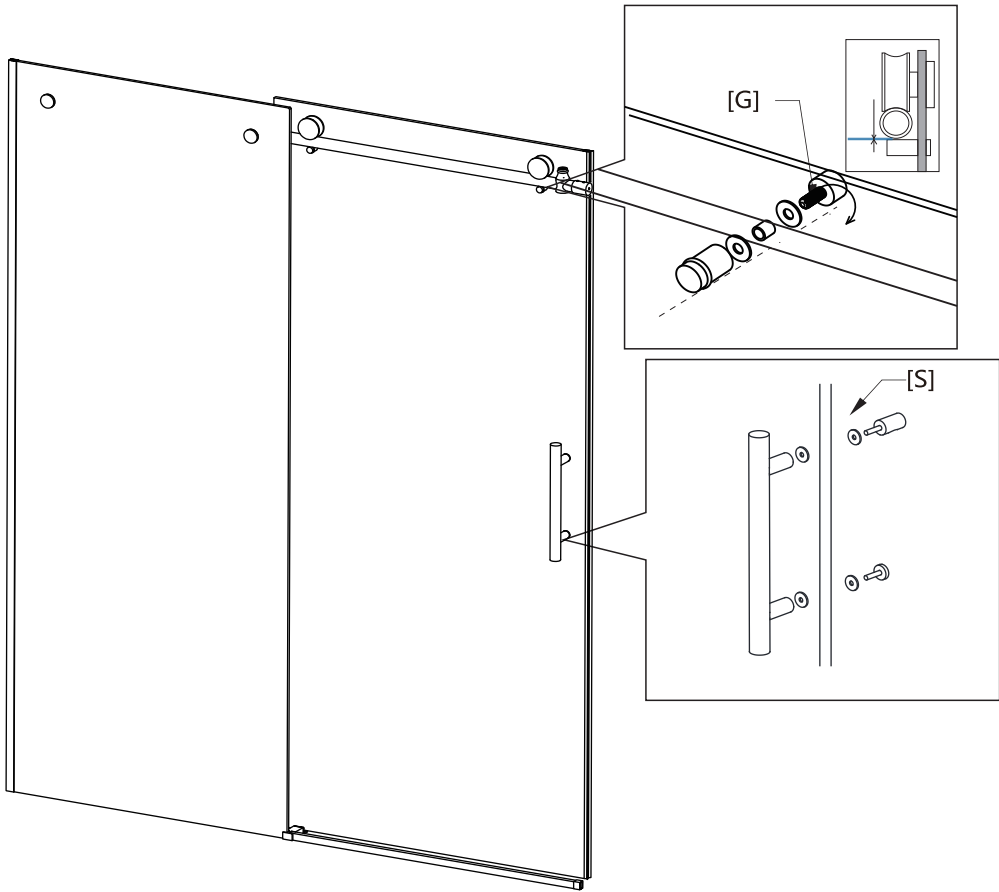


Step 9: Adjusting Seal Strip



- ① Trim the flapper on **Seal Strip [L]** where it interferes with the upper guide rail, as shown in the image.
- ② Install **Seal Strip [L]** on **Sliding Door Fixed Panel [A]**.
Install **Buffer Airbag Magnetic Strip [J]** on **Sliding Door Panel [B]**.

Step 8: Adjusting Konb & Handle Set

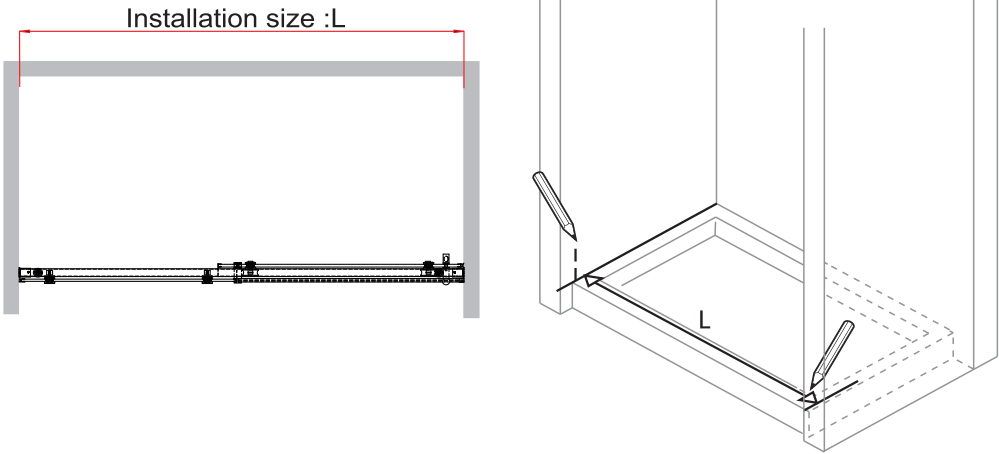


Anjust the eccentric pieces of the **Anti-jumping Knobs [G]** to make **Anti-jumping Knobs [G]** get stuck the Rollers.
Mount the **Handle [S]** on the **Sliding Door Panel [B]**, and lock it with a hexagon wrench.

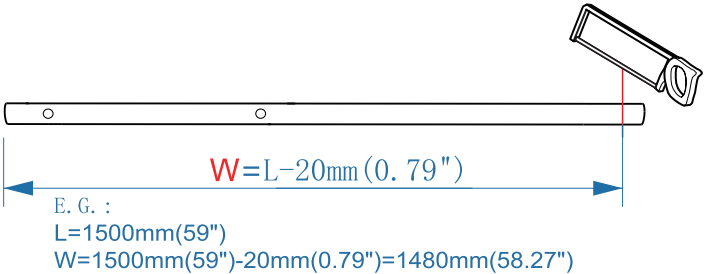
Step 1: Measure and Trim to Fit

NOTE: Designed for a standard 60-inch opening, this shower door can be trimmed by up to 4 inches to fit spaces from 56 to 60 inches wide. If your opening is exactly 60 inches, no trimming needed.

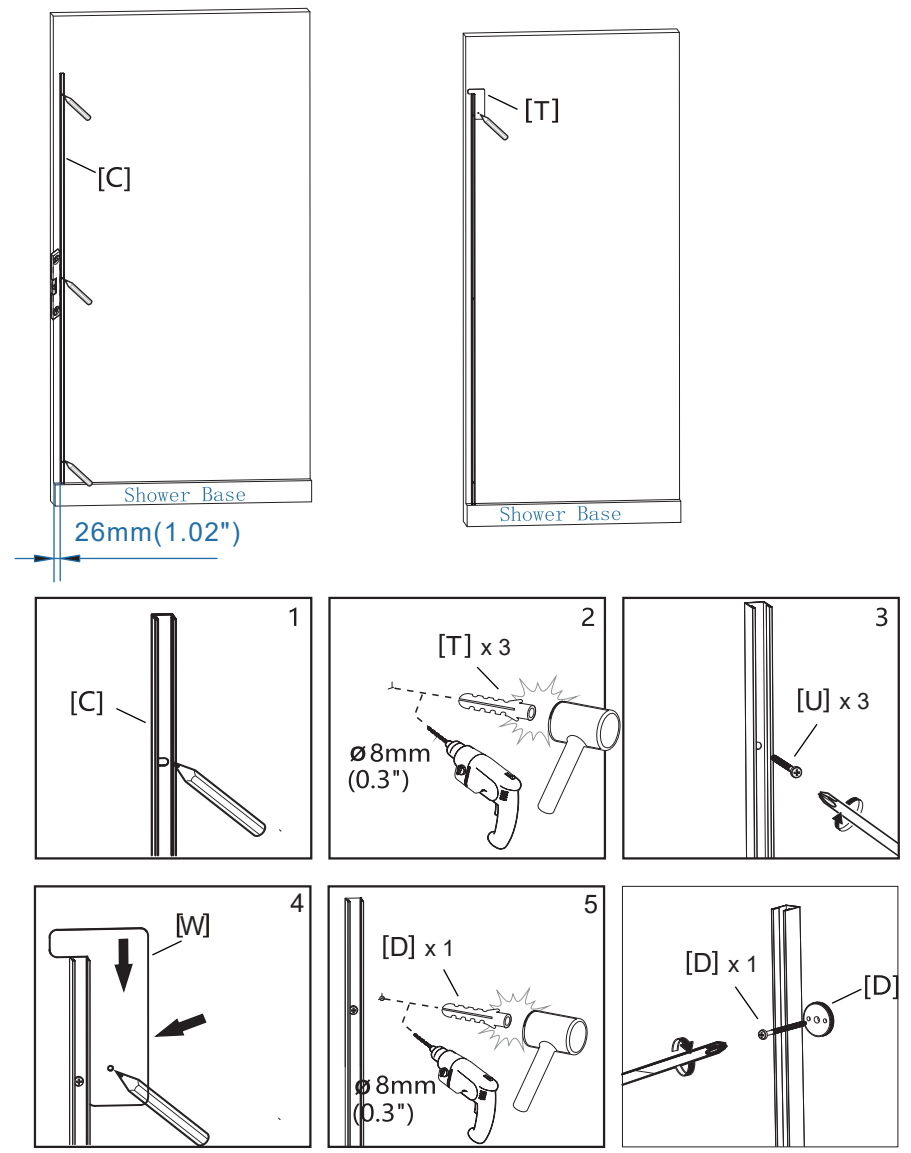

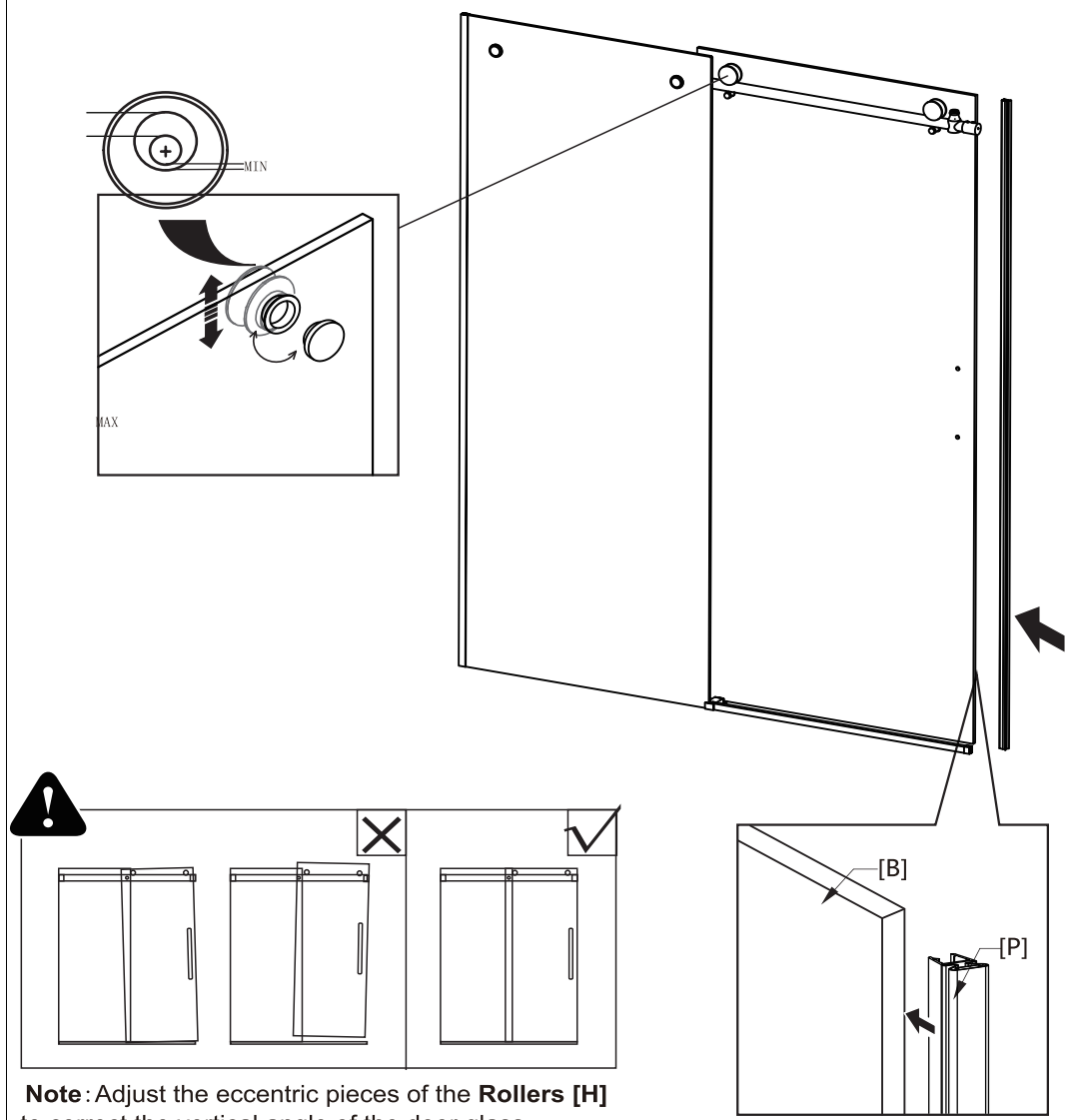
- ①. Measure the width of the shower opening with a tape measure and record it as installation size **L**.
- ②. Cut the **Top Rail [I]** to length **W**: Installation size **L** -20mm(0.79")

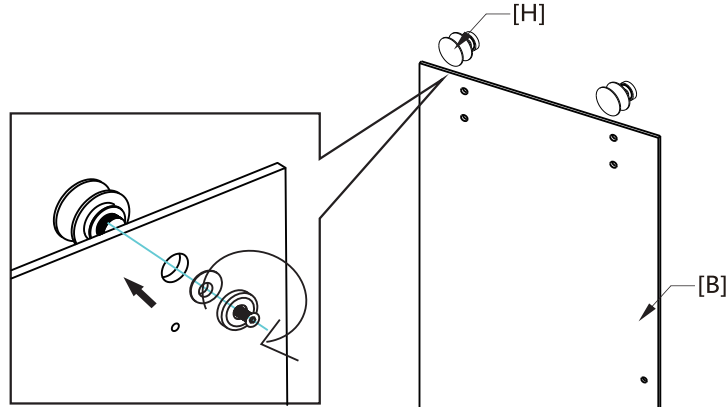
Step 7: Adjusting Glass fixture & Door Seal



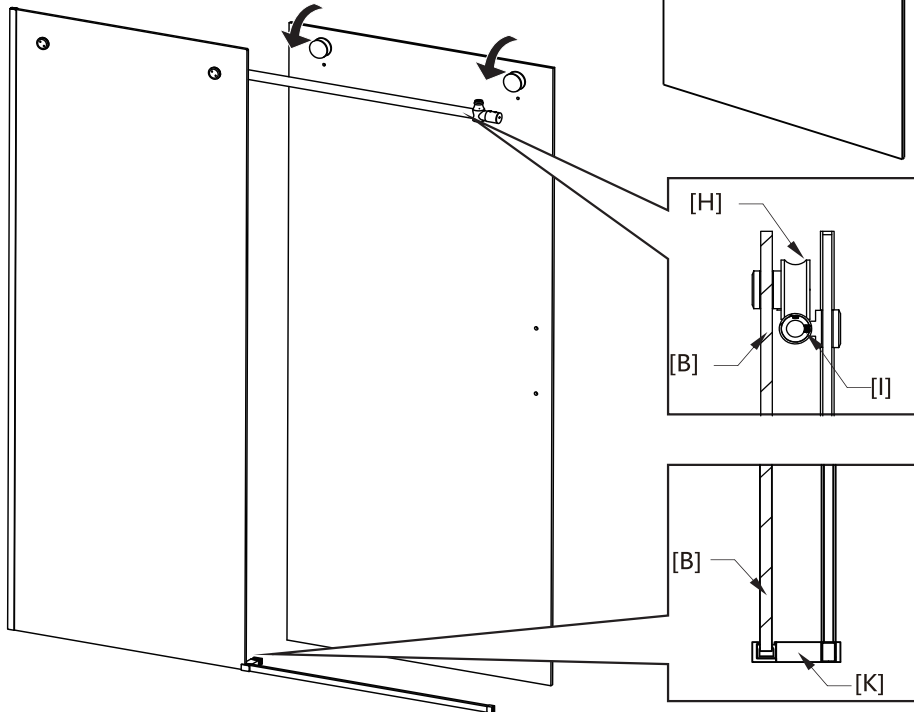
Note: Adjust the eccentric pieces of the **Rollers [H]** to correct the vertical angle of the door glass, ensuring the **Door Seal [P]** is parallel to the wall.

Install the **Door Seal [P]** on the side of **Sliding Door Panel [B]** facing the wall.

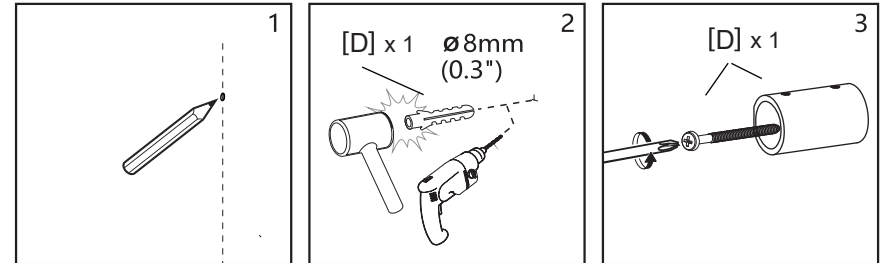
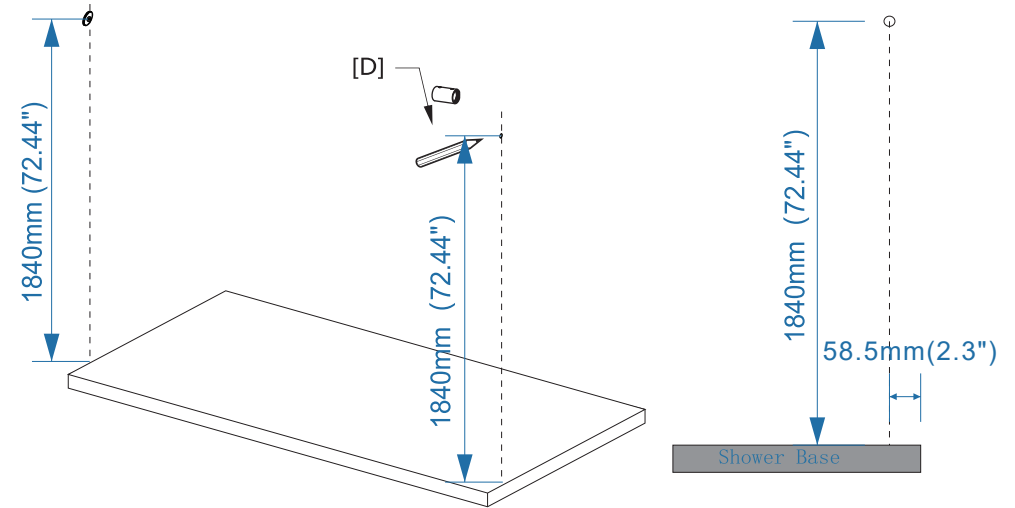
Step 6: Install the Sliding Glass Panel



Install the **Rollers [H]** on the **Sliding Door Panel [B]** according to your installation direction, and then hang the door panel on the **Top Rail [I]**.

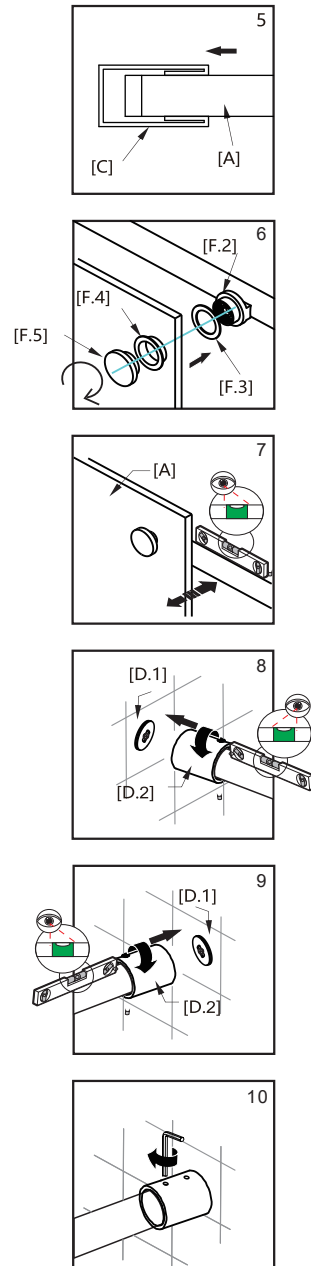
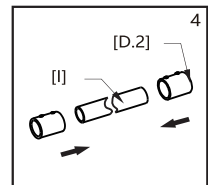
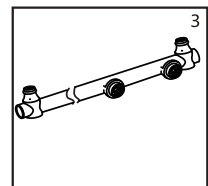
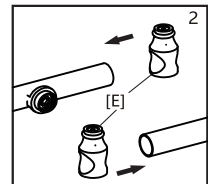
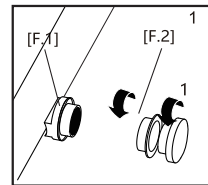
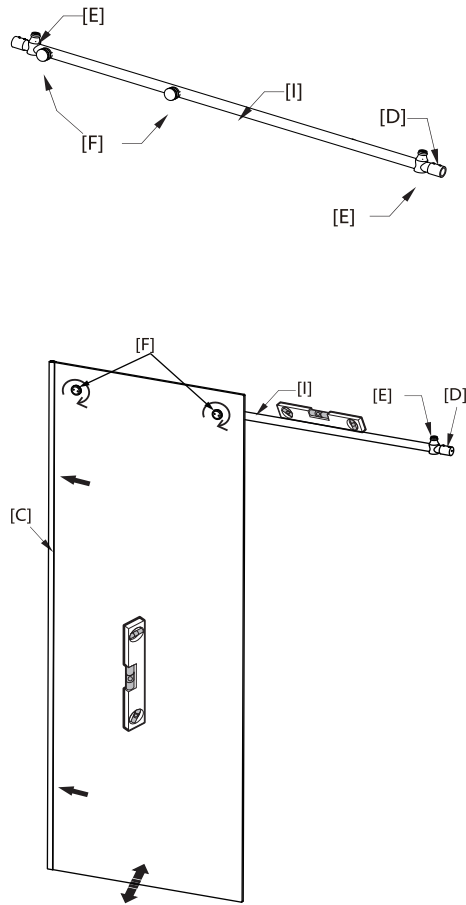


Step 3: Wall Hole Marking & Drilling



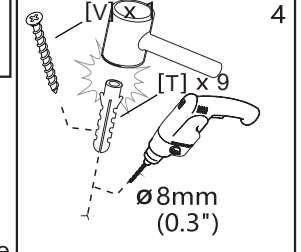
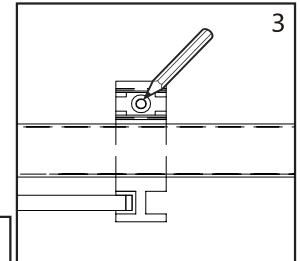
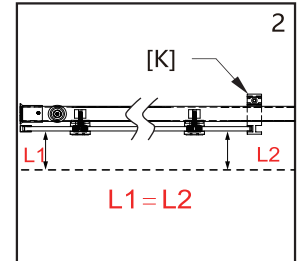
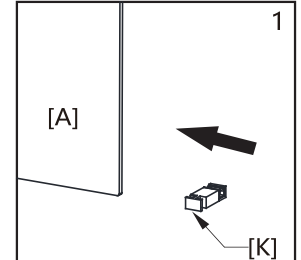
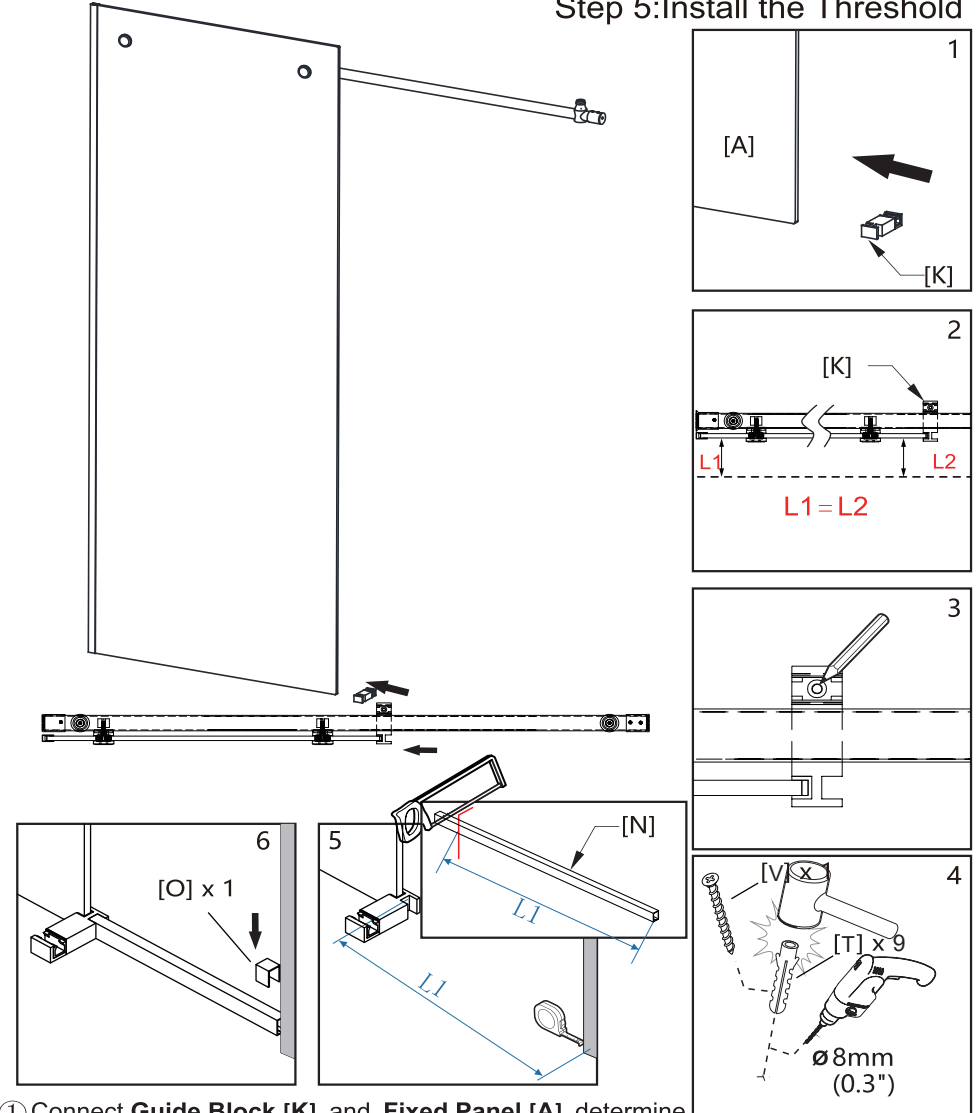
- ① Place the Measuring Tool vertically against the wall on the floor. Use a pencil to mark the hole position through the tool onto the wall. Repeat this for both left and right side walls to ensure symmetry. If a shower base is installed, keep 58.5mm (2.3") from the base edge.
- ② Drill holes with a $\phi 8$ mm (0.3") bit and insert the expansion sleeves on both sides of the wall.
- ③ Fasten the **Guide Rail Bracket [D]** using the provided screws.
- ④ Fix the **Bracket Base [D.1]** to the wall on both sides. Then remove the **Bracket Cover [D.2]** from the base.

Step 4: Install the Fixed Glass Panel



- ① Insert **Fixed Panel [A]** into **Seal Strip [C]**.
- ② Install the remaining **Glass fixure [F]** in sequence according to step 2.
- ③ Adjust **Fixed Panel [A]** until the level bubble is centered, ensuring the glass is perfectly perpendicular to the ground.
- ④ Tighten the screws on the **Guide Rail Bracket [D]** with hexagon wrench to the rail to the wall.

Step 5: Install the Threshold



- ① Connect **Guide Block [K]** and **Fixed Panel [A]**, determine the position, and ensure that dimension L1 and dimension L2 are equal.
- ② Record the position with a pen at the opening.
- ③ Take away **Guide Block [K]**, drill holes with a drill with a diameter of 8mm, and fix them with an expansion screw tube.
- ④ Measure **Guide Block [K]** to the wall (L1). Cut **Anti-splash Guard [N]** to length L1 if needed.
- ⑤ Apply silicone sealant to the bottom of **Anti-splash Guard [N]** and place it next to the **Guide Block [K]**. Apply silicone sealant to the bottom of **Track Cover [O]** and place it next to the **Anti-splash Guard [N]**.
