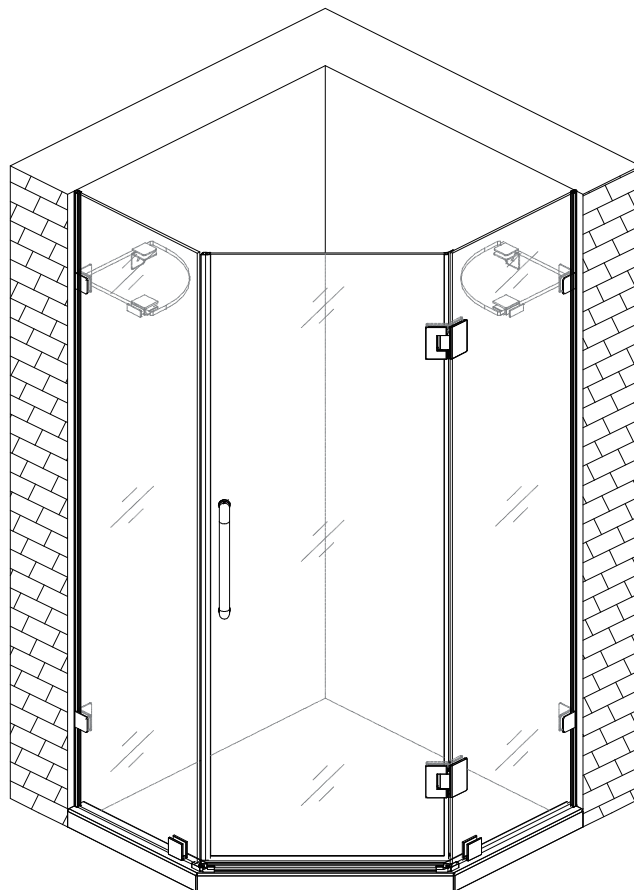

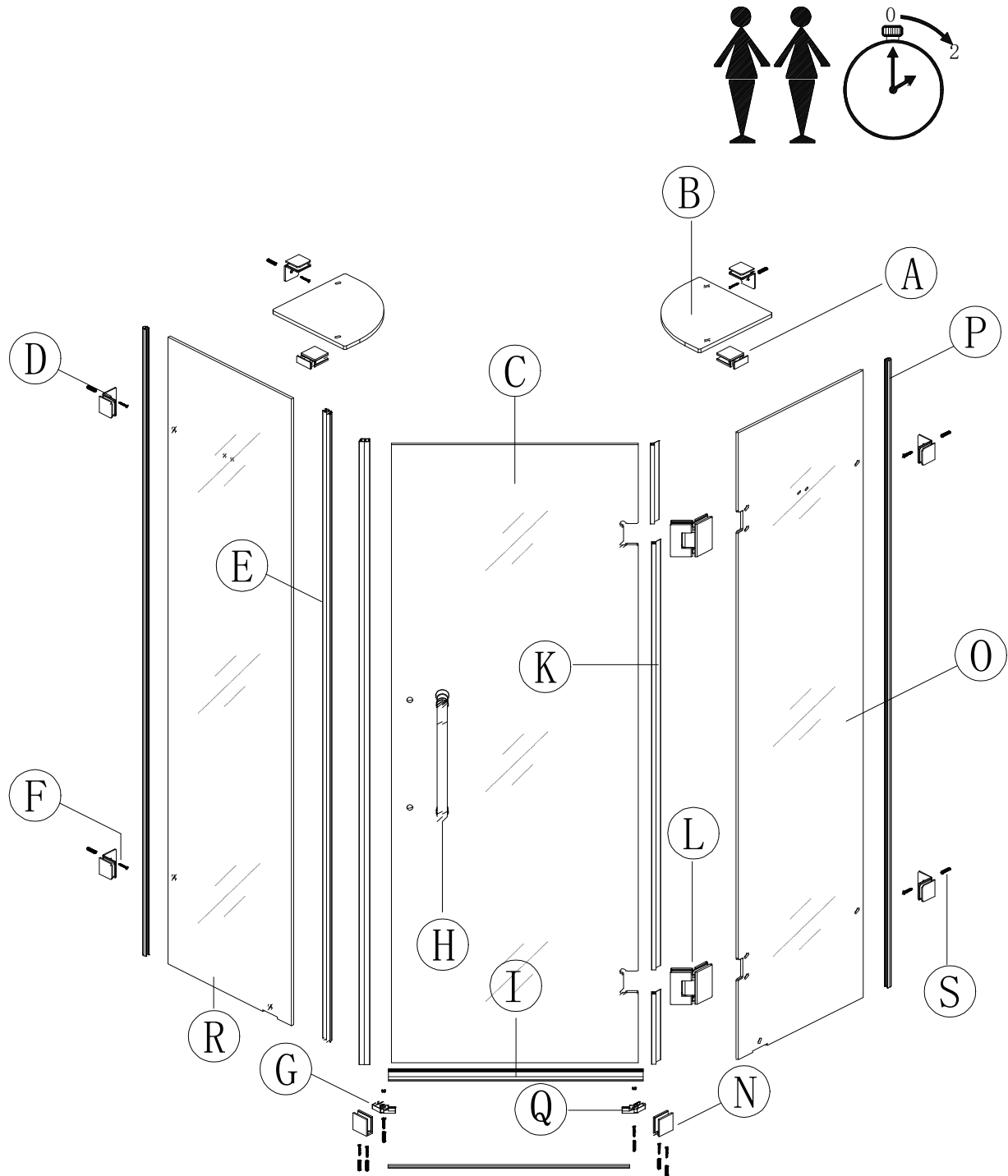

General Information

Please inspect the product immediately upon receipt for any transit damage, missing parts, or manufacturing faults. Damage reported at a later time cannot be accepted. Please handle the product with care, avoiding knocks and shocks to all sides and edges of the glass.

Please read these instructions carefully before starting the installation. Special care should be taken when drilling walls to avoid hidden pipes or electrical cables.

Note: This product is heavy and requires two people for installation.











Cleaning and Maintenance

1. For daily cleaning of the shower enclosure, you can use a mild liquid detergent and a soft cloth.
2. If there are stains, gently wipe them with a clean, soft towel or a small amount of neutral soap solution or toothpaste.
3. To enhance the shine of the glass surface, you can polish it using a glass polish.

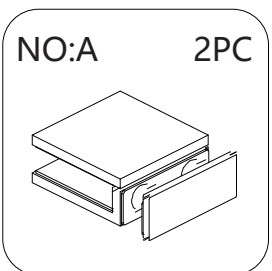
Attention

1. Avoid using acids, alkalis, or sharp tools when cleaning to protect the gloss of the shower tray, glass, and aluminum fittings.
2. Do not use strong detergents containing acetone or ammonia; avoid disinfectants with formic acid and formaldehyde to prevent damage to the product's surface gloss.
3. During showering, avoid contact or impact with hard objects against the glass surface to prevent accidents.
4. Regularly inspect the condition of the shower enclosure and contact the after-sales service department promptly if any abnormalities are detected.

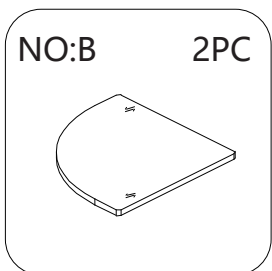

Step 1: Installation components for fixed glass

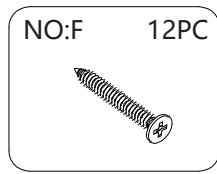
1-1. Install and fix corner bracket for door magnetic fixed glass.

1-2. Install and fix corner bracket for hinge fixed glass.

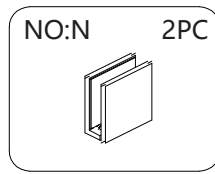
1-3. Install sealing strips on the door magnetic fixed glass and hinge fixed glass.

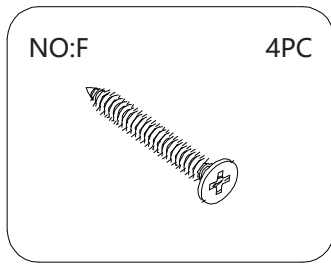


Step 2: Install the ground fixing clip

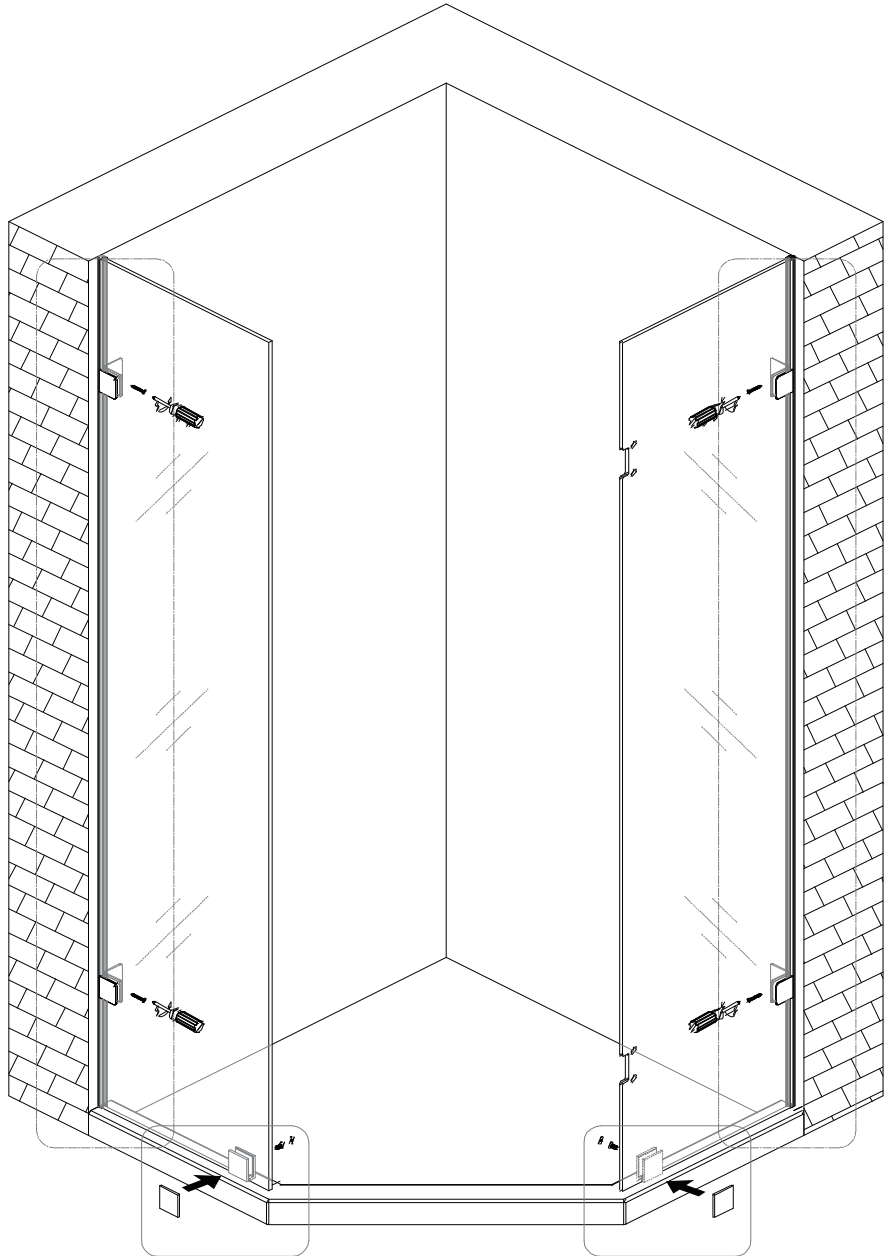
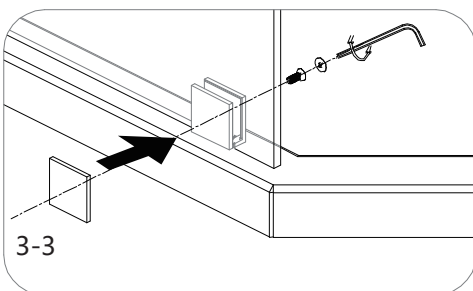
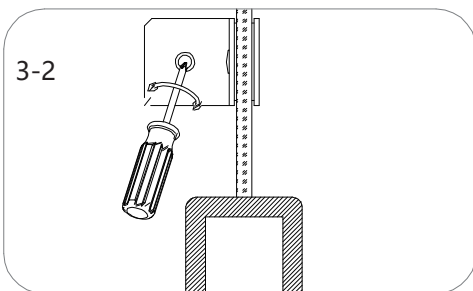
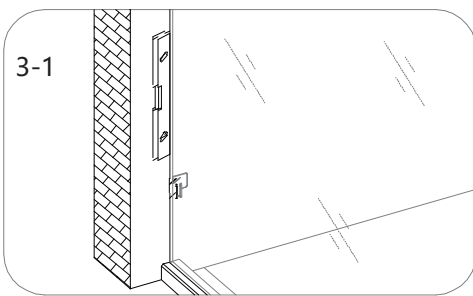
- 2-1. Attach the glass fixing parts to the glass, position them on the floor/base surface, confirm their specific positions, and use a marker pen to mark and position them.
- 2-2. Use a 6mm drill bit to drill holes at the marked points.
- 2-3. Insert the plug into the hole, ensuring that the end face is flush with the floor/base surface.
- 2-4. Reinforce the ground fixing clips with screws.

Step 3: Fixing hinge fixed glass and door magnetic fixed glass to the wall

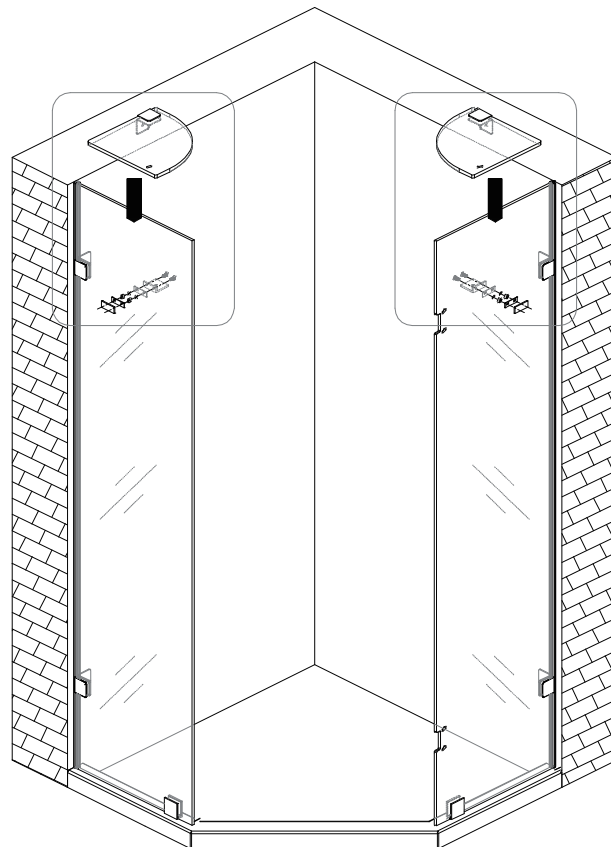
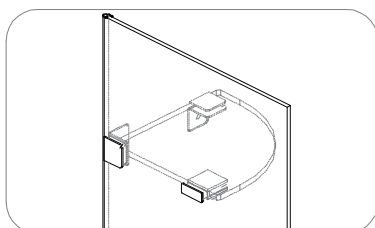
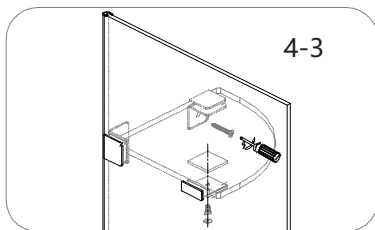
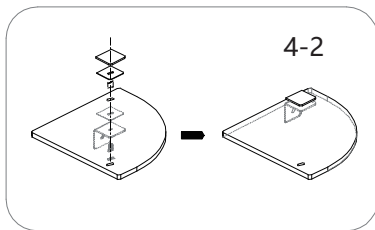
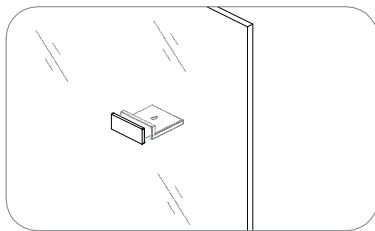
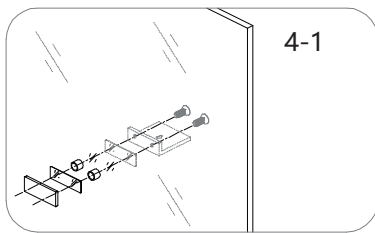
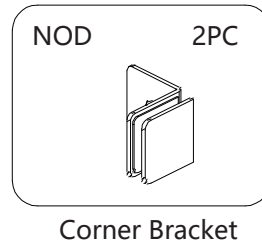
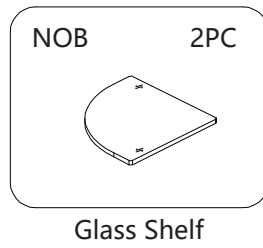
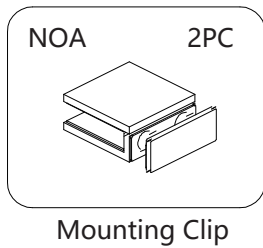
3-1. Position the hinge fixed glass and door magnetic fixed glass on the floor/base, ensuring they are centered, then use a level to adjust their horizontal position.

3-2. Align the lock hole on the corner bracket with the corresponding hole on the wall and secure it with screws.

3-3. Use a hex wrench to tighten the glass fasteners securely.

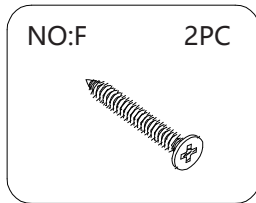


Step 4: Install the glass shelf

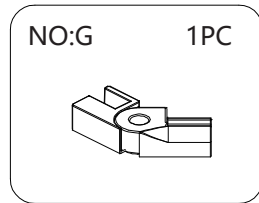
- 4-1. Begin by attaching the glass shelf accessories onto the hinge fixed glass and door magnetic fixed glass.
- 4-2. Assemble the shelf glass accessories and attach the corner brackets to the glass shelf.
- 4-3. Attach the assembled shelf glass to the mounting clips and secure with screws.

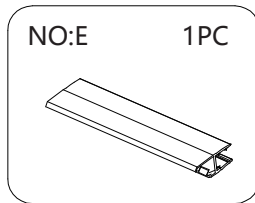


Step 5: Install the water blocking aluminum strip

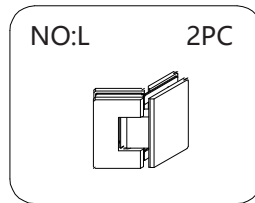
- 5-1. Assemble and adjust the components, then fix them against the glass and hinge to secure the glass.
- 5-2. Use a marker pen to mark and position the locations.
- 5-3. Use a 6mm diameter drill bit to drill holes at the marked points as per the above steps and insert the wall plug. Ensure the end face of the wall plug is flush with the wall.
- 5-4. Use 4*30 self-tapping screws to secure the water blocking aluminum strip in place.

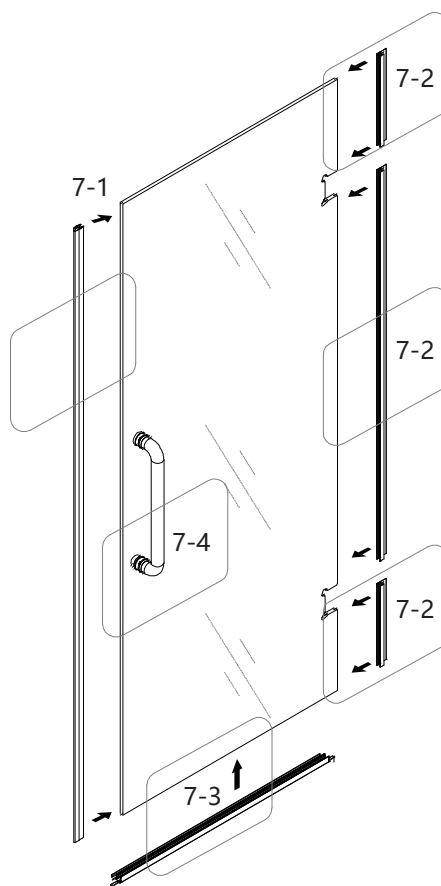
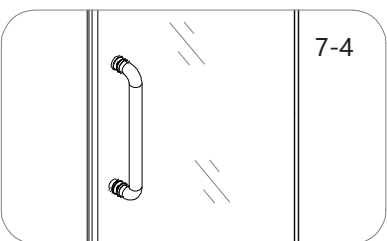
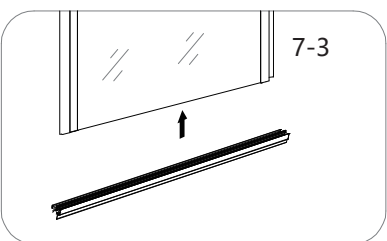
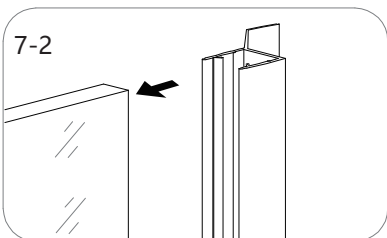
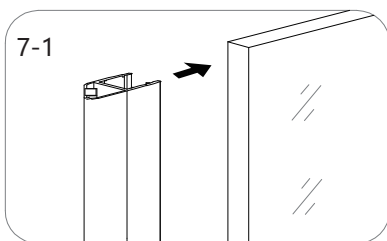
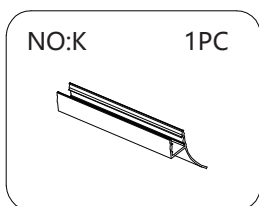
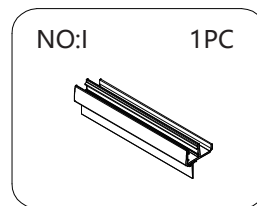
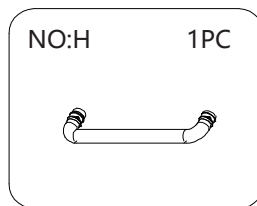
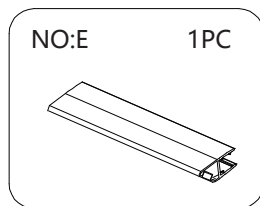
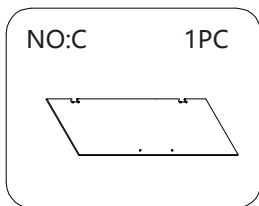
Step 6: Install the hinge and door magnetic strip

- 6-1. Install the two hinges separately on the hinge fixed glass, making sure to pay attention to the orientation of the hinges. Adjust the horizontal position of the hinges to ensure they are level before locking them in place.
- 6-2. Install the door magnet on the large fixed glass, ensuring that the diagonal edge of the door magnet faces inward (towards the interior). Make sure the door magnet is properly aligned for smooth operation.

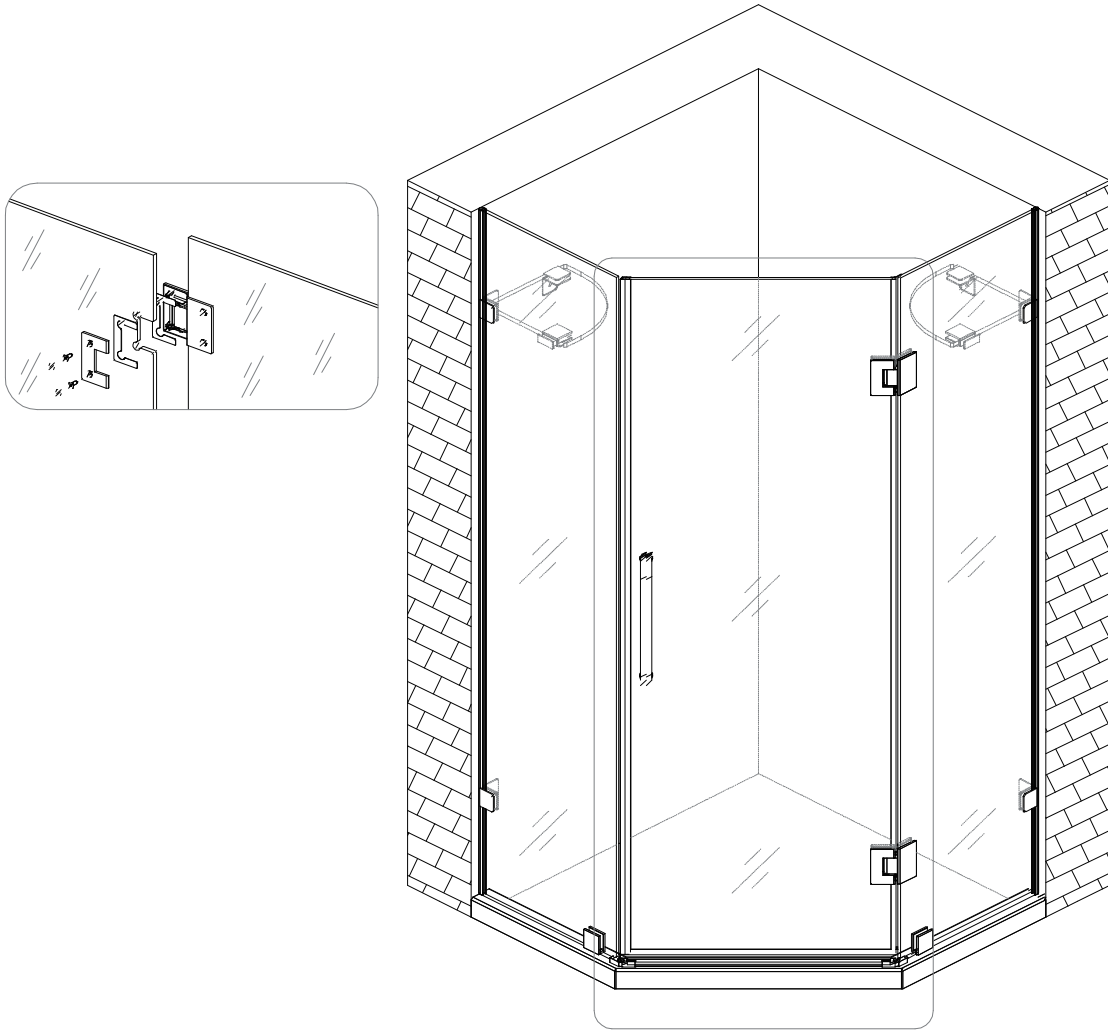


Step 7: Assemble the movable door glass

- 7-1. Install the door magnetic strip, ensuring that the diagonal orientation of the door magnetic strip is correct.
- 7-2. Install the 135-degree soft edge water blocking strip, making sure to align the soft edge in the correct direction.
- 7-3. Install the door glass water guide strip, paying attention to the orientation of the components.
- 7-4. Install the door handle, making sure to orient the inner and outer handles correctly for proper functionality.

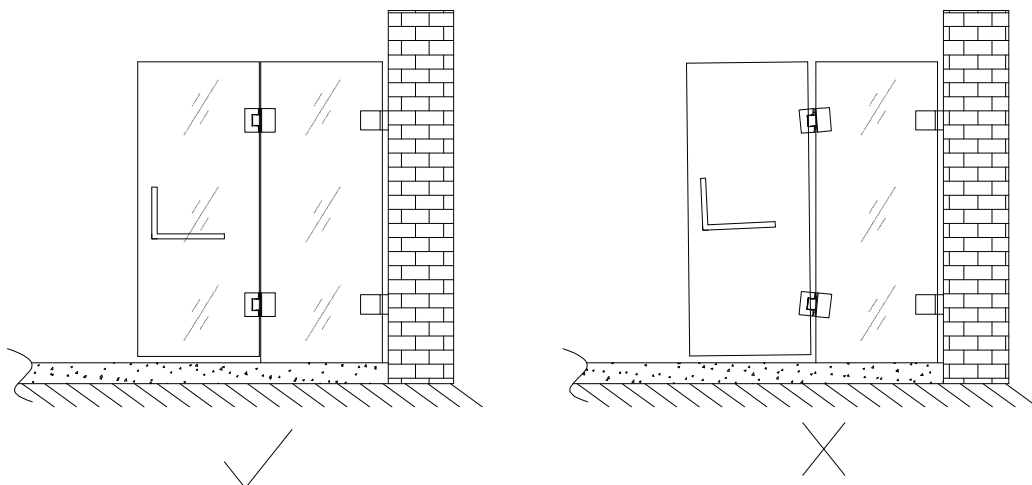

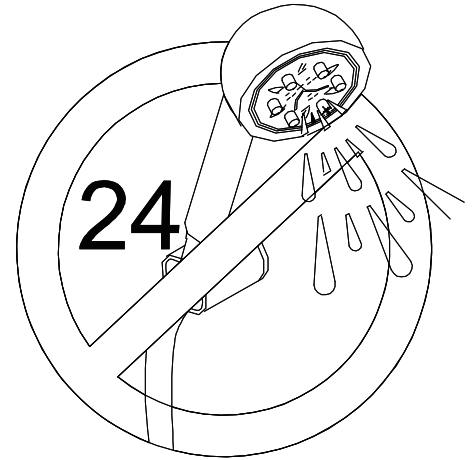
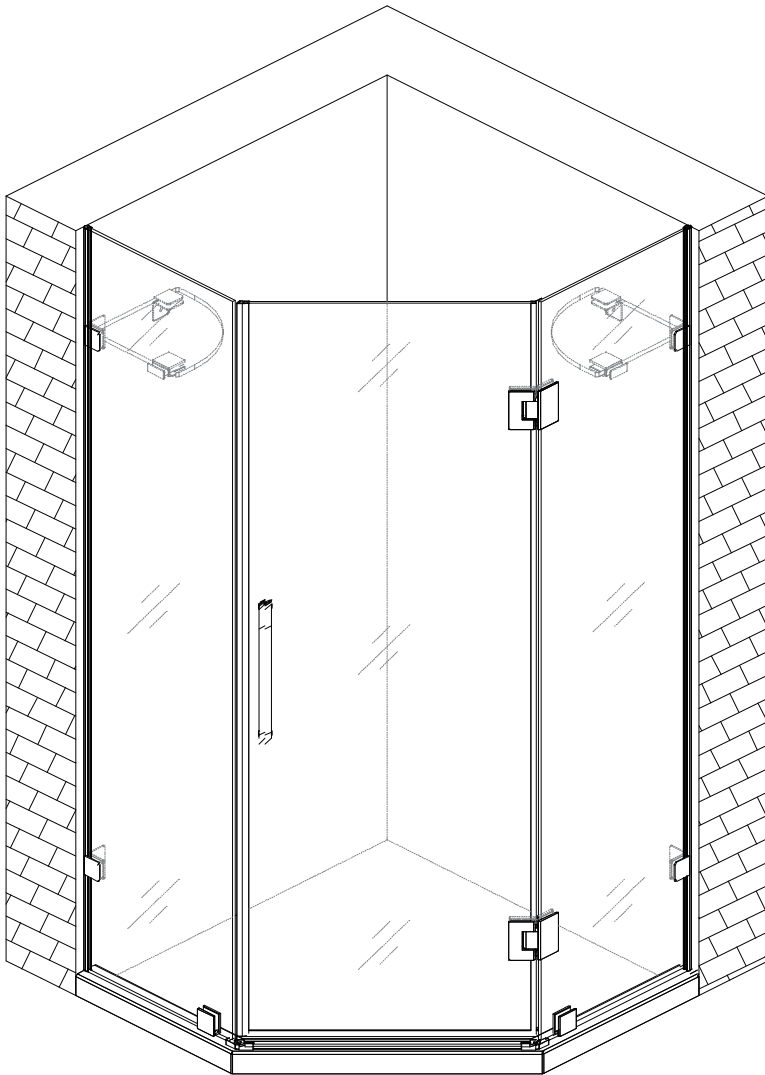
Step 8: Install the door glass

8-1. Carefully install the door glass, ensuring it is aligned vertically.

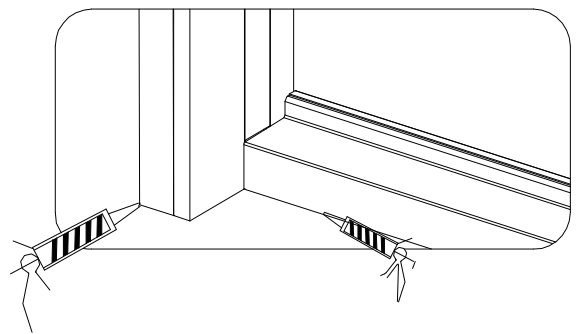

After installation, check for any issues and apply waterproof sealant as needed.



Step 9: Final inspection

- 9-1. Check if the movable door closes properly. If not, verify the vertical installation of the fixed glass and make any necessary adjustments.
- 9-2. Ensure the glass door is level; adjust the lower water-blocking connector if needed. Align it properly to meet standards.
- 9-3. Address any discrepancies in the gap between the glass door and the frame. Adjust the accessories in each part as needed.
- 9-4. If all previous checks are satisfactory, apply glass glue along the top edge of the room for waterproofing. Allow 24 hours for it to set before use.

LIMITED WARRANTY COVERAGE

5-YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

DeerValley products are made with quality materials and excellent craftsmanship to provide customers with a long-lasting product. If any defects in materials or craftsmanship are found under normal use within the 5th year of delivery, DeerValley will provide replacement parts at no charge or, at its option, replace any product or part of the product deemed defective under normal installation, use, service, and maintenance. This warranty applies only to the original purchaser. Proof of purchase will be required to process any claims. **SCRATCHES ARE NOT COVERED UNDER WARRANTY.**

The manufacturer warrants that this product will be free from manufacturing defects for the duration of the above-mentioned warranty period. Please retain a copy of the original invoice as proof of purchase.

DeerValley will, at its option, (1) repair or replace the defective part(s) or product(s) at no charge; (2) issue a refund for the original purchase price of the product(s) (valid within 30 days from the date of delivery); or (3) issue a credit to be applied toward the purchase of a new DeerValley product. Shipping/delivery charges may apply and are at DeerValley's sole discretion.

DeerValley recommends that installations be performed by a licensed, professional plumber. DeerValley will not be held responsible for any damage or product failure resulting from improper installation, misuse, or failure to hire a licensed professional. Additionally, DeerValley is not responsible for any removal or installation costs.

This limited warranty does not cover goods that have been subjected to accidents, negligence, improper installation, product abuse, product misuse, or the use of cleaners containing abrasives, alcohol, or other organic solvents. Such exclusions apply regardless of whether the actions were performed by a contractor, service company, or the purchaser.

DeerValley's responsibility under this limited warranty is limited solely to the replacement of parts and does not cover any other costs. DeerValley will not be responsible for labor charges or any damage incurred during installation, repair, or replacement, nor for any indirect, incidental, or consequential damages, losses, injuries, or costs of any kind related to this product. RESPONSIBILITIES OF OTHERS
