What you need to know about cracks and splits in wooden bench

This is the time of year when we sell a lot of wooden bench.

It's also the time when we get lots of customers asking why they're seeing cracks and splits in their new wooden bench.

The good news is that you have nothing to worry about.

Let us explain why.

Why you don't have to worry about cracks and splits

Cracks and splits occur naturally in wood – they're part of the maturing process. Temperature and humidity levels go up and down and cracking and splitting are a natural, normal reaction to this.

When you buy a piece of wooden bench, the wood needs a little time to adjust to its new surroundings. Cracks and splits, if they appear, are just a sign that your furniture is bedding in. The important thing to know and remember is that these cracks and splits have no impact on the strength and durability of your wooden bench. They don't affect the quality of the furniture or how long you can enjoy it for.

When to check about cracks and splits in wooden garden furniture

Of course, there are rare occasions when you should do something about cracks and splits in your wooden bench.

How do you know if you should be concerned? If you can fit one US dollar coin inside the crack or split, take a picture and contact us, and we'll sort it out for you.
