

Project: Macrame Keychain

Estimated time to complete: 1-2 Hours

Difficulty Level: Easy



What you need

- Macrame Cord (3mm) - 78 ft (26 yd)
- Keychain Ring
- Measuring Tape
- Scissors

Knots Used

- Double Half Hitch Knot **(4B)**

Instructions

Step 1 – Measure and cut:

- 4pcs of cord each measuring 5 ft



Step 2 - Attach the macrame string to the lanyard keychain

- Add the lanyard clip to the ring. Attach four 5' lengths of 3mm cotton macrame string to the ring using a lark's head knot. This will give you 8 strings that are 2 1/2' long



Step 3 - Begin Knotting

- Starting on the left, tie 2 square knots, then skip two strings and tie 1 square knot on the second row.



- Use the first string on the left side as your working cord and tie double half hitch knots at a diagonal down the left side
- Repeat the same with the right side.



- Once both sides are knotted, continue tying double half hitch knots from the right side all the way across diagonally to the left side.



- Now pick up the working cord from the left side and tie double half hitch knots the rest of the way diagonally down the right side so that they criss cross each other.



- Tie 3 more sets of 2 square knots bordered by double half hitch knots.

NOTE: You can add more sets if you want to make it longer, but you will have to cut your lengths of macrame string longer.

Step 4 - Cut and comb the fringe

- Cut the strings at the bottom to the length you want and comb it out.

Step 5 - Celebrate!!
