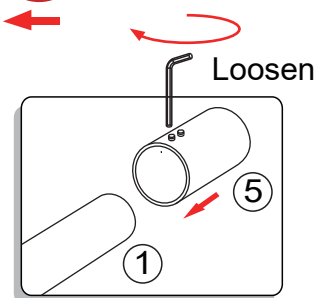
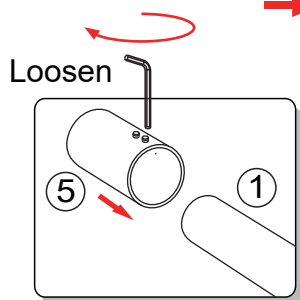
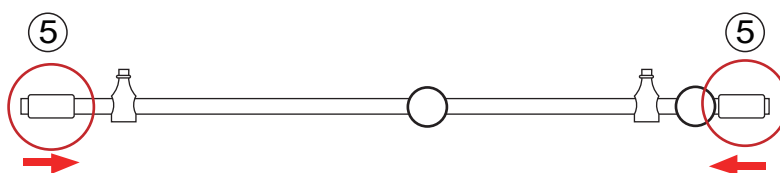
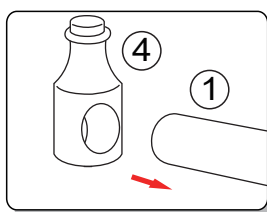
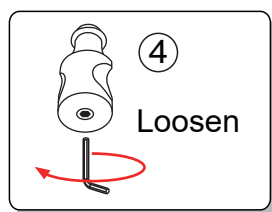
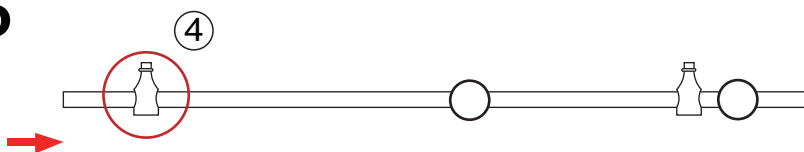
Place the Measuring Tool(#22) vertically against the wall on the base, Mark the drill points at the specified mounting height according to the holes in the Measuring Tool(#22),drill holes for the Guide Rail Brackets (#6) in the determined position, insert the wall anchors (#8) for the Guide Rail Bracket.

This step uses an Ø 5/16" drill bit to drill holes in the wall.

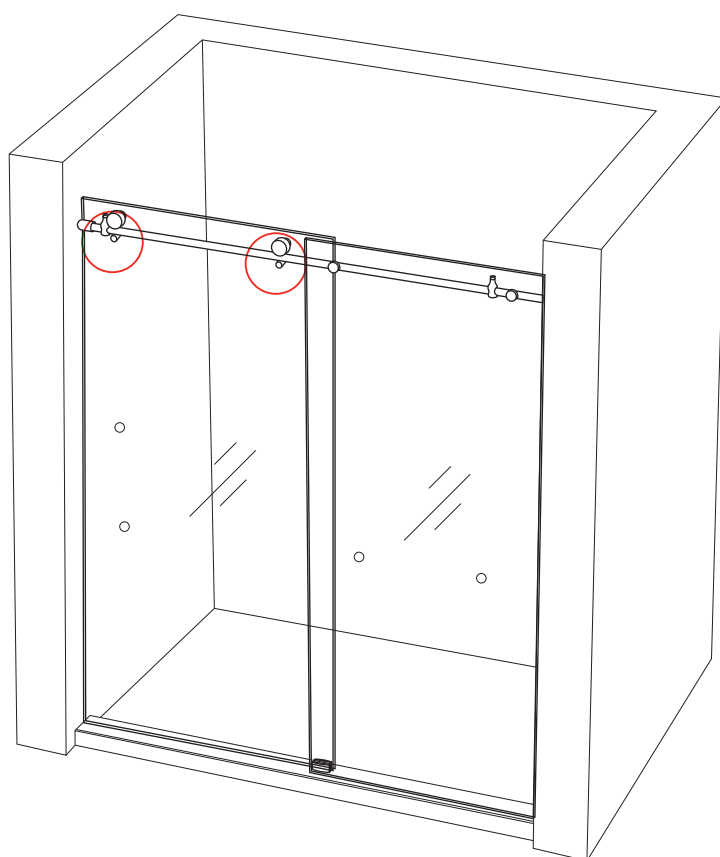
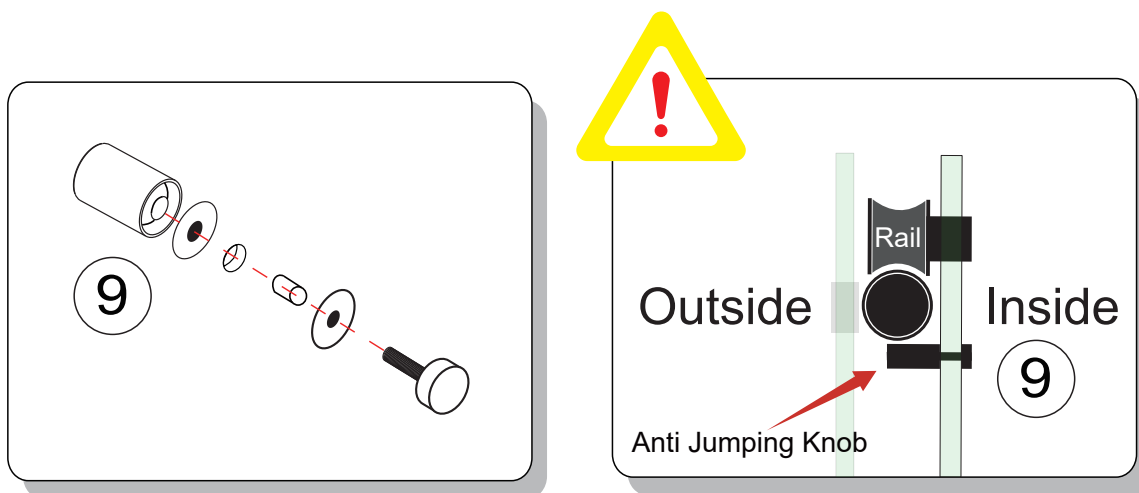


After hang the Sliding Glass (13) to the Upper Guide Rail (1), Slide the Guide Block (21) to the bottom of the Sliding Glass, mark down the predrilled position of the Guide Block, set the Sliding Glass aside. Now drill the holes on the base, then put the wall anchors (20) into the holes and secure the Guide Block to the base with Screws M4X25 (19). Please use an Ø1/4" drill bit to drill holes.



Hang the Glass Door (7) onto the Upper Guide Rail (5), and seat the bottom into the slot of the Guide Block (11). Be careful that the glass door should not touch the metal part of the guide block.

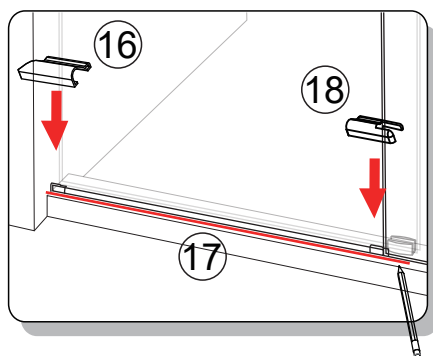
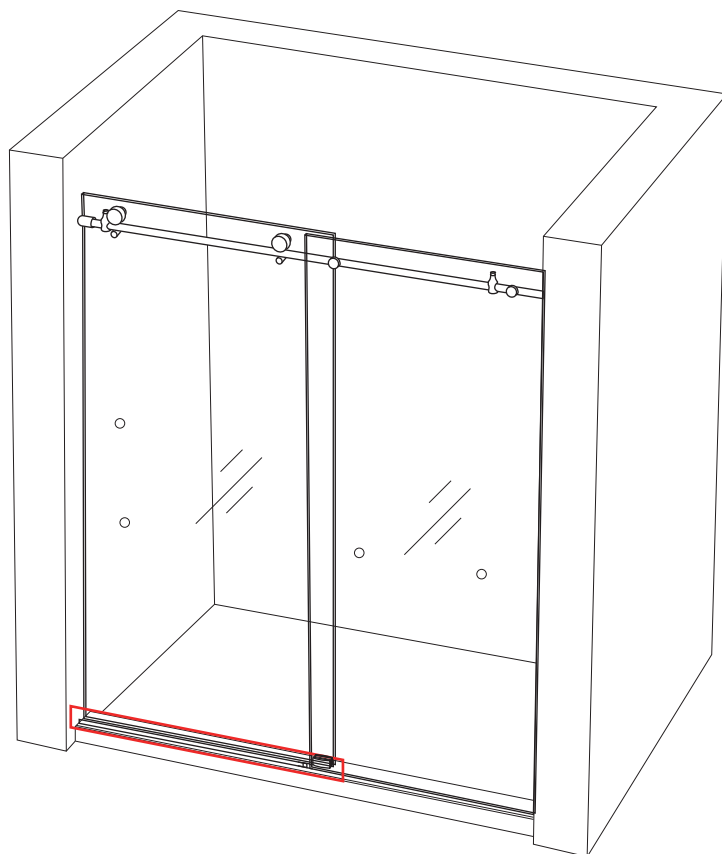

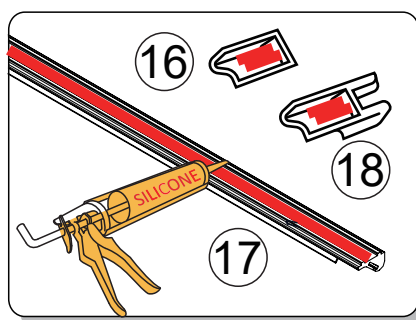
10. Install the Anti jumping knob (9) to the Sliding Glass Door (10). Make sure that the clear gasket will be between the glass and the metal parts of the Anti jumping knob (9). The distance between the Anti jumping knob (9) and the Upper Guide Rail (1) should be less than 1mm to prevent the glass from falling off.

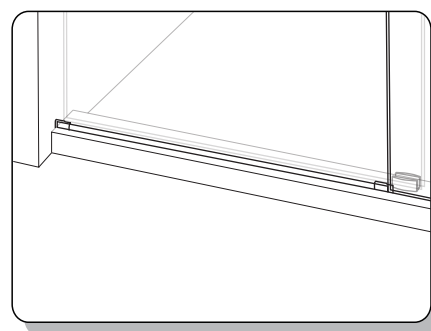
Pre-Install the Anti-Splash Threshold (17) and Covers (16) (18) in front of the Sliding Door (10), put the Anti-splash Threshold Cover (18) with slot corresponds to the end of the Stationary Glass (13). And mark down the appropriate position, then put silicone sealant to the bottom of the Anti-splash threshold and Covers, secure it to the floor.



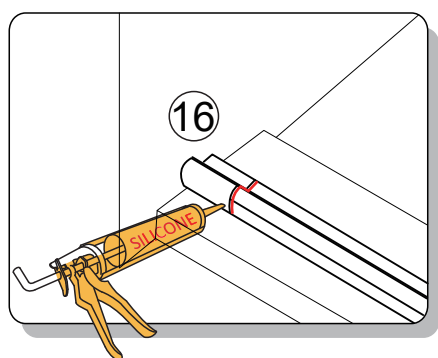

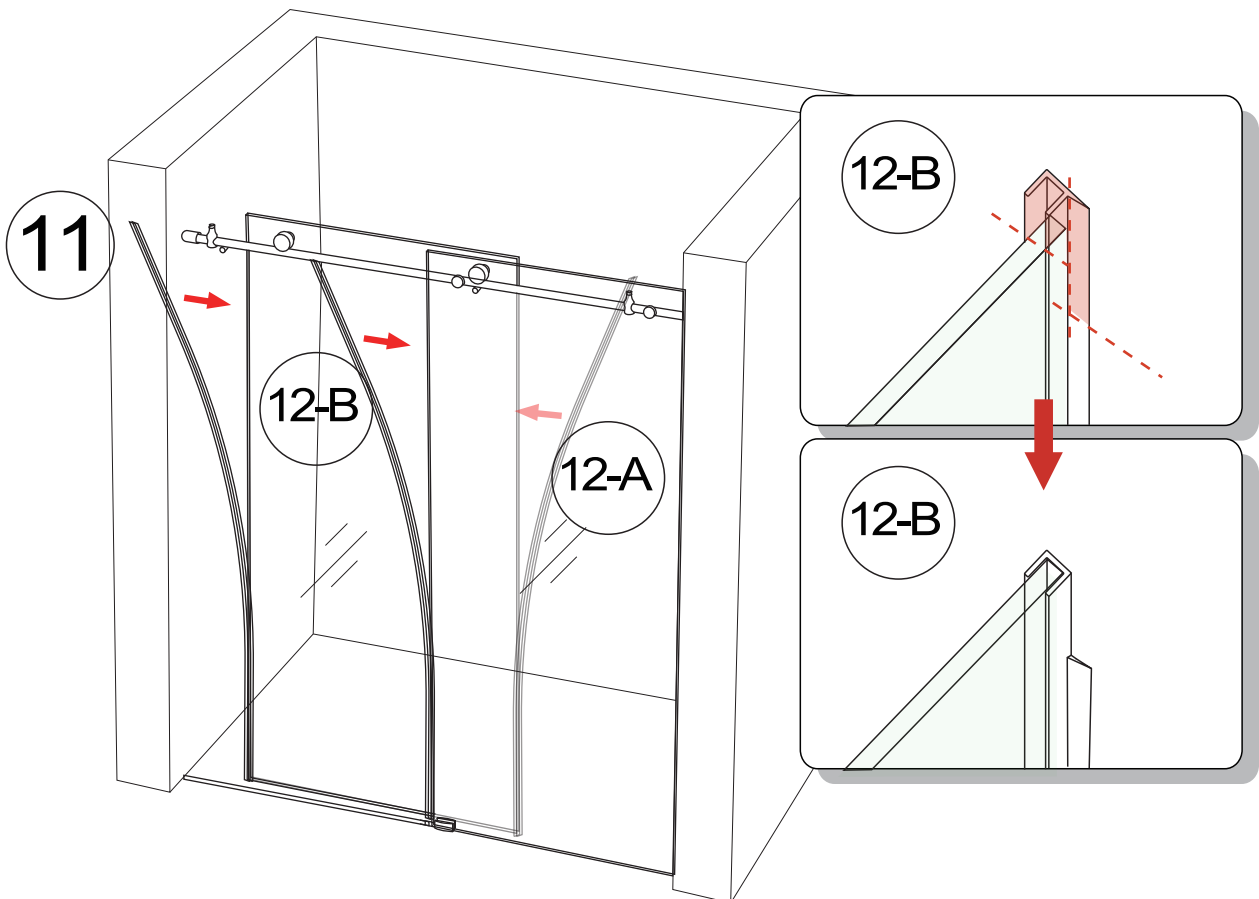
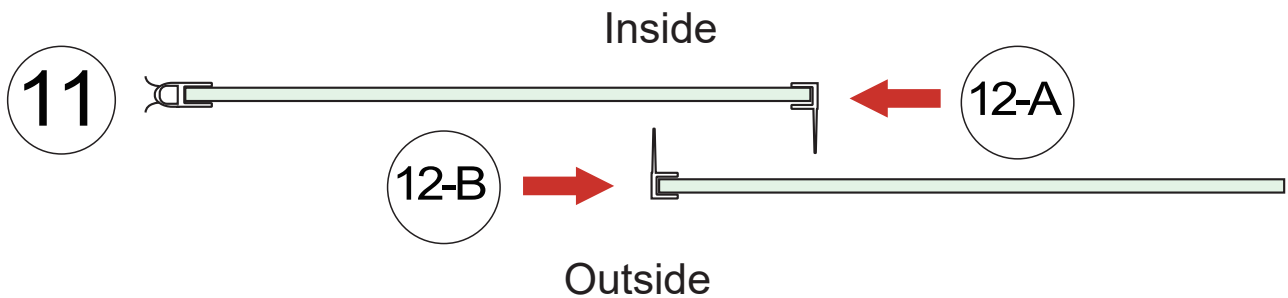
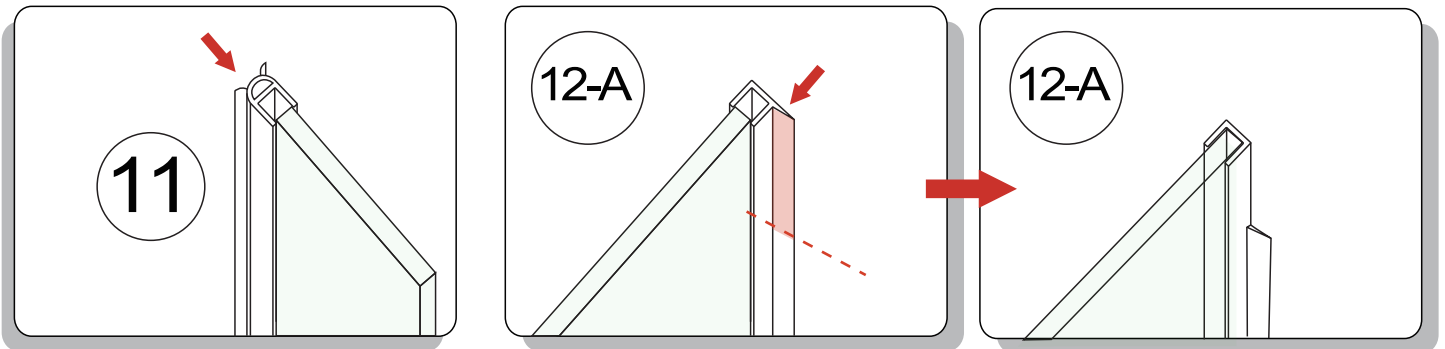


5. Seat the U Cover snugly (18) against the Stationary Glass (13), then seal and waterproof.

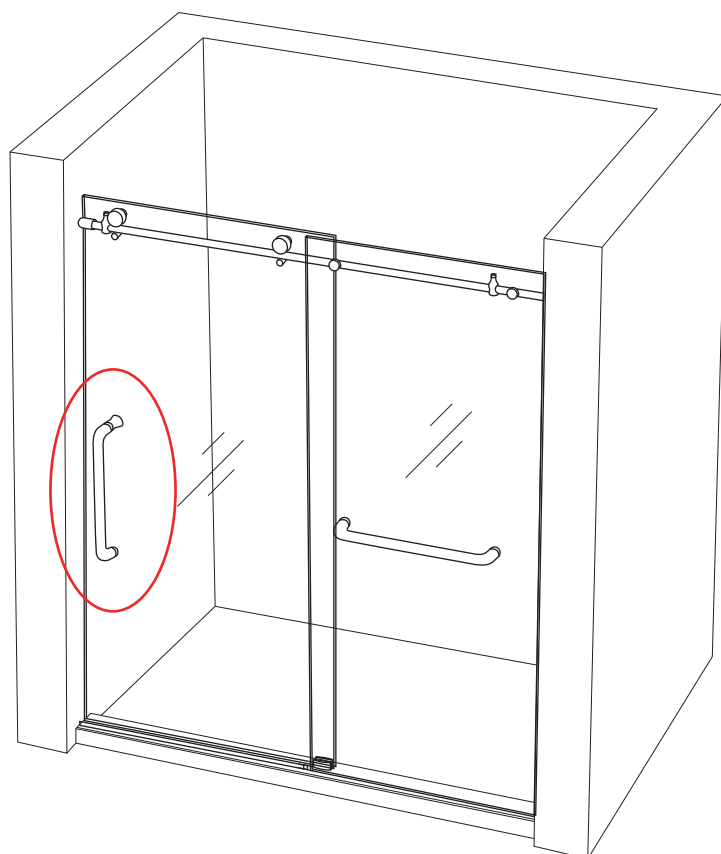
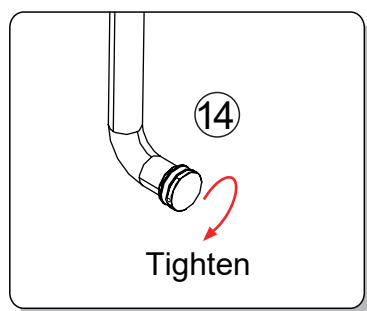
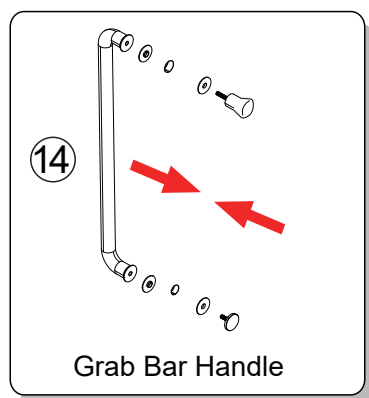
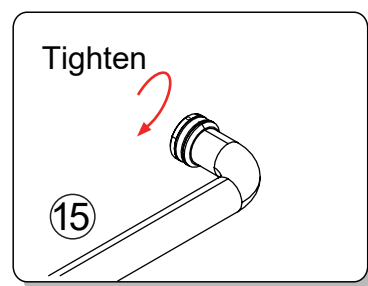
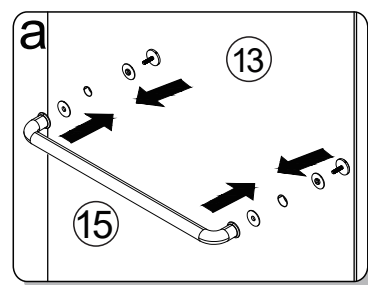
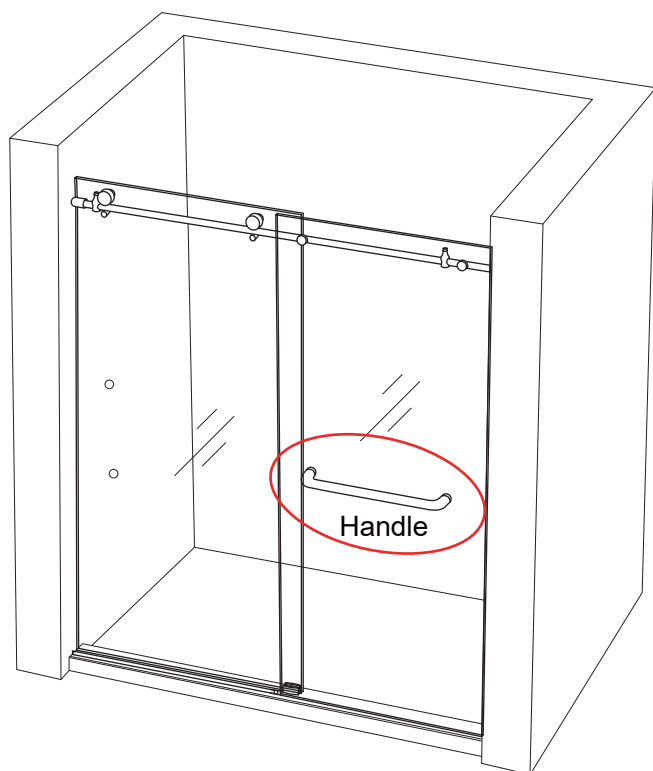

Seat the Anti-Water H Strip (11) to the Glass Door (10), and Seat the 2 pieces Anti-Water F Strips (12) with an extended side to the middle glass, cut the extended side that interferes with the Upper Guide Rail (1).

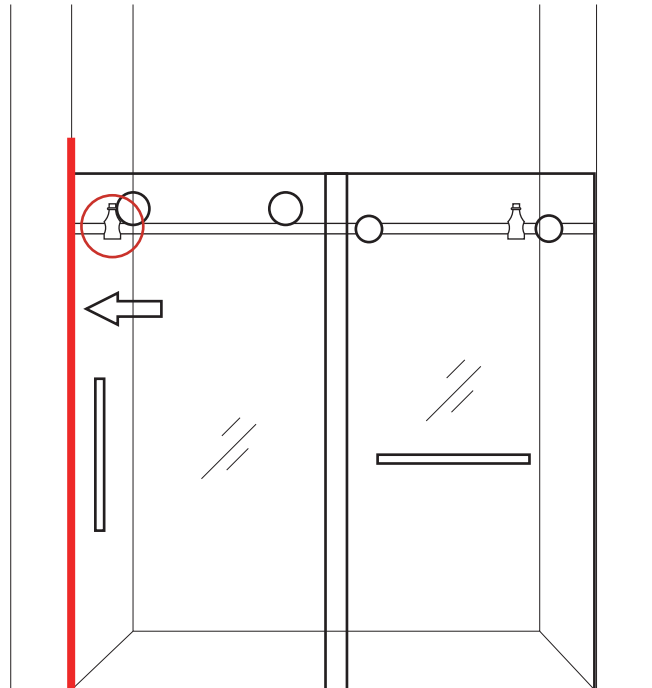
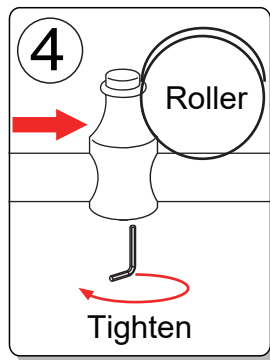
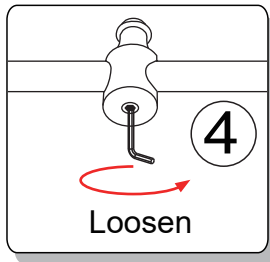

Slide the sliding glass snugly against the wall, fasten the Left Stopper (4) close to the left roller.

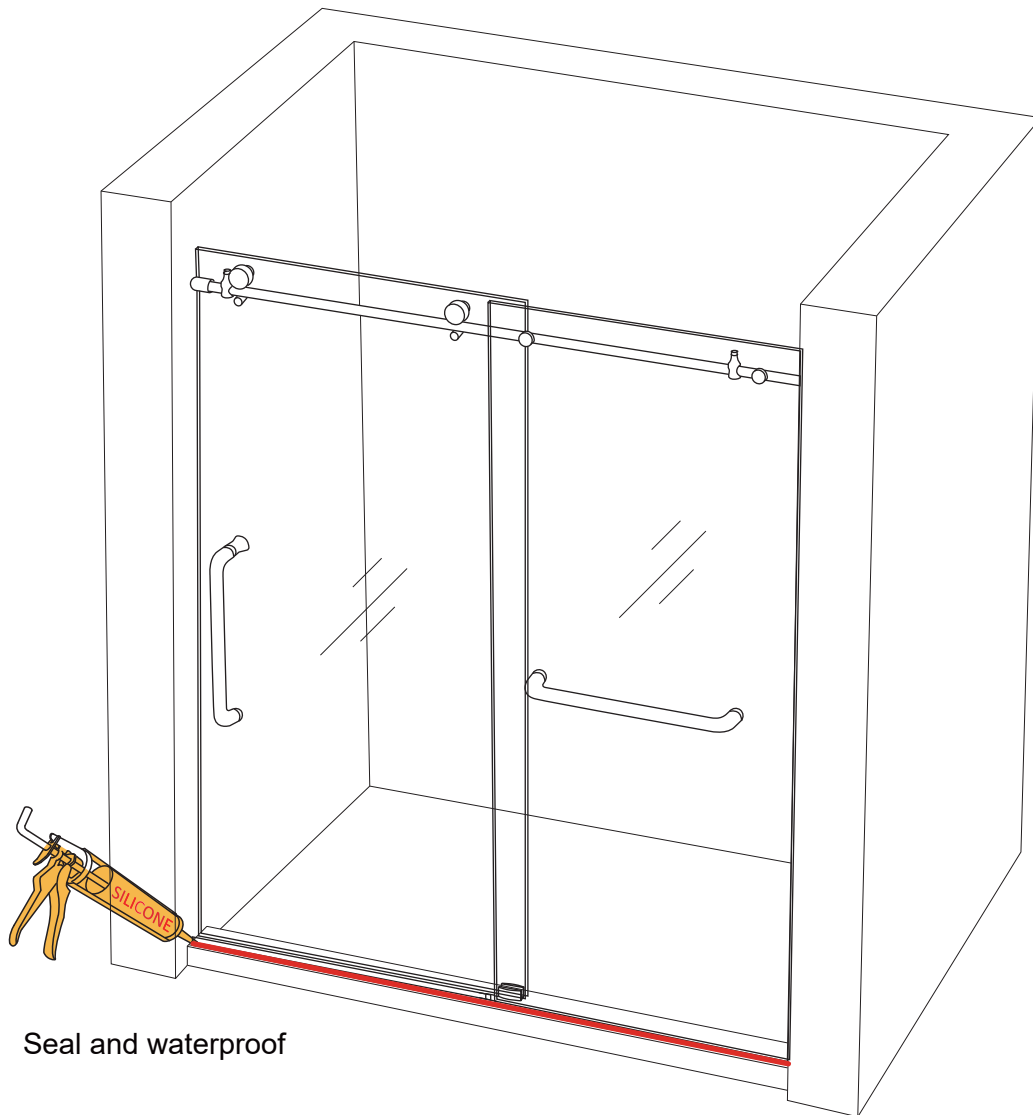


Full open the sliding glass, keep appropriate gap between the door and handle, fasten the Right Stopper (4) close to the Right roller.

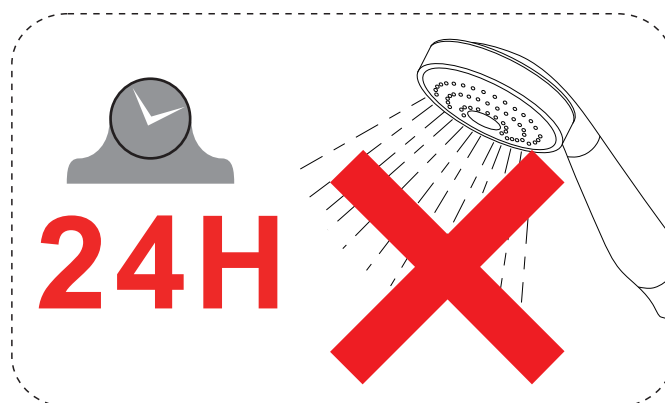


Min. 1 inch gap between handle and glass.

Seal and waterproof



Do not use the shower enclosure for at least 24 hours in order to allow the silicone sealant to cure fully.

CARE & MAINTENANCE



The golden rules for care

NOTE: Use warm soapy water and a soft damp cloth to keep the glass clean. Wipe dry with a clean cloth. Glass cleaner can be used if required. Scourers, abrasives and chemical cleaners can damage the glass and pattern, and should not be used.

In hard water areas, insoluble lime salts may be deposited on the glass. If this is allowed to build up it becomes increasingly difficult to remove and looks unsightly. Regular cleaning will minimize this effect.

- ☒ Do not attempt to cut the glass.
 - ☒ Do not strike the glass with hard or pointed items.
 - ☒ Regularly check moving parts such as rollers and hinges to ensure they are secure and adjusted correctly. Tighten and adjust where required. Also check all sealed joints to ensure seal has not deteriorated. Re-seal if required.
