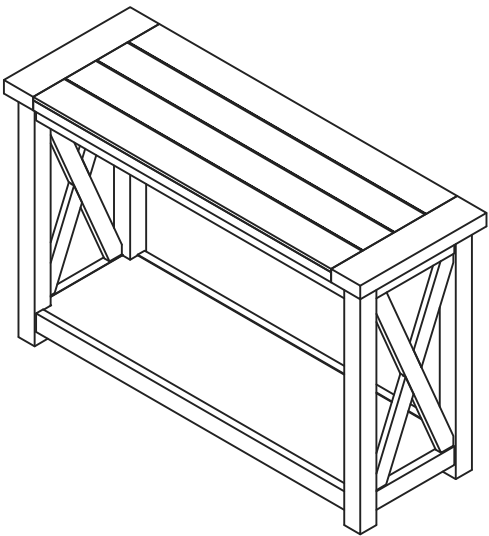


Console Table

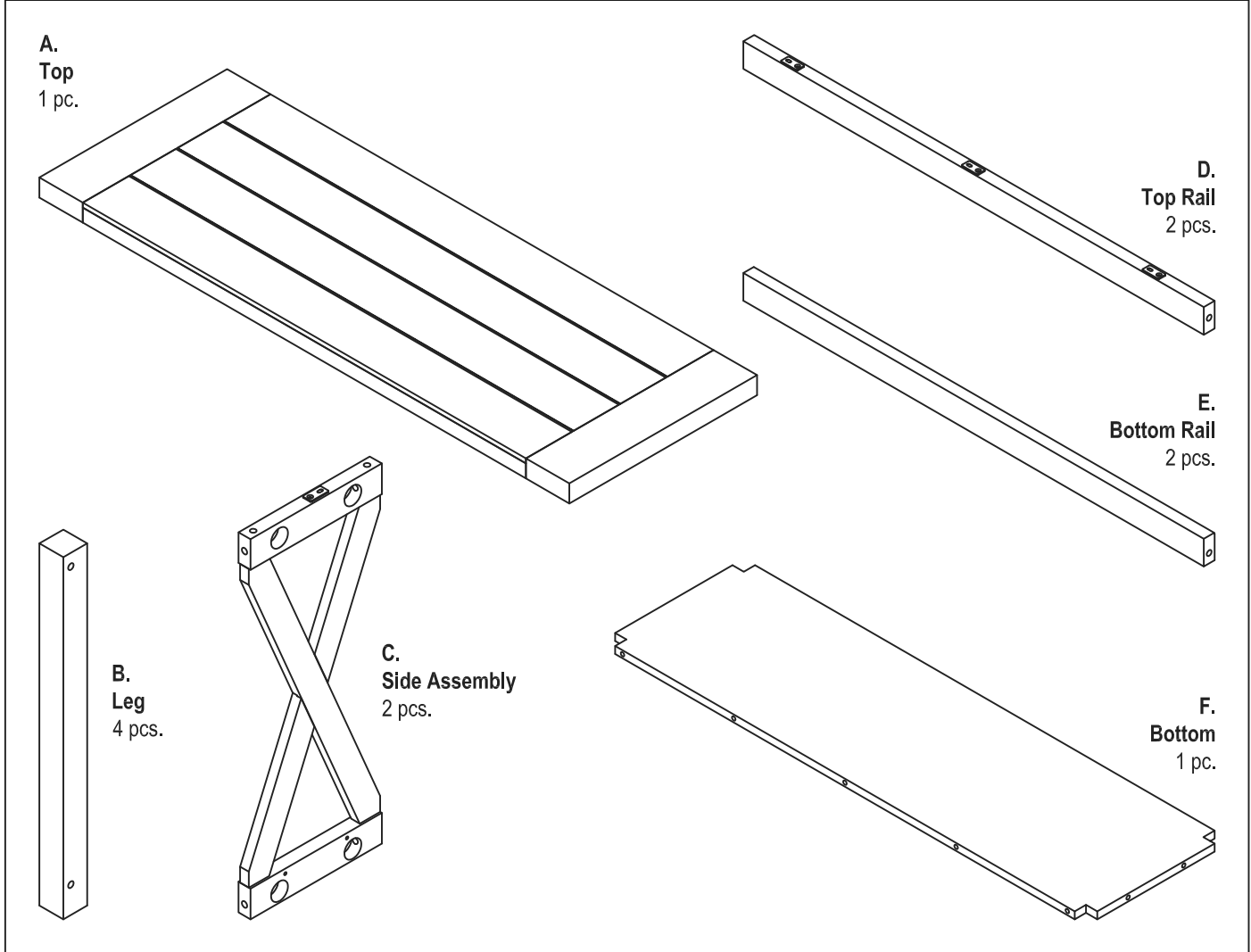
IMPORTANT NOTE

Assembly Instructions 2/4

IMPORTANT

- * You should keep Wrench in a safe place as you may need to tighten up the Nuts in the future.
- * Do not tighten up all the screws until each part is properly assembled.
- * Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.
- * After assembly, item must be level to work properly.
Use the included adjustable levelers to level.

STEP 1

Insert Cam Lock Screws into the pre-drilled holes of Side Assemblies (C) and Bottom Rails (E).

Insert Bolts into the pre-drilled holes of Legs (B).

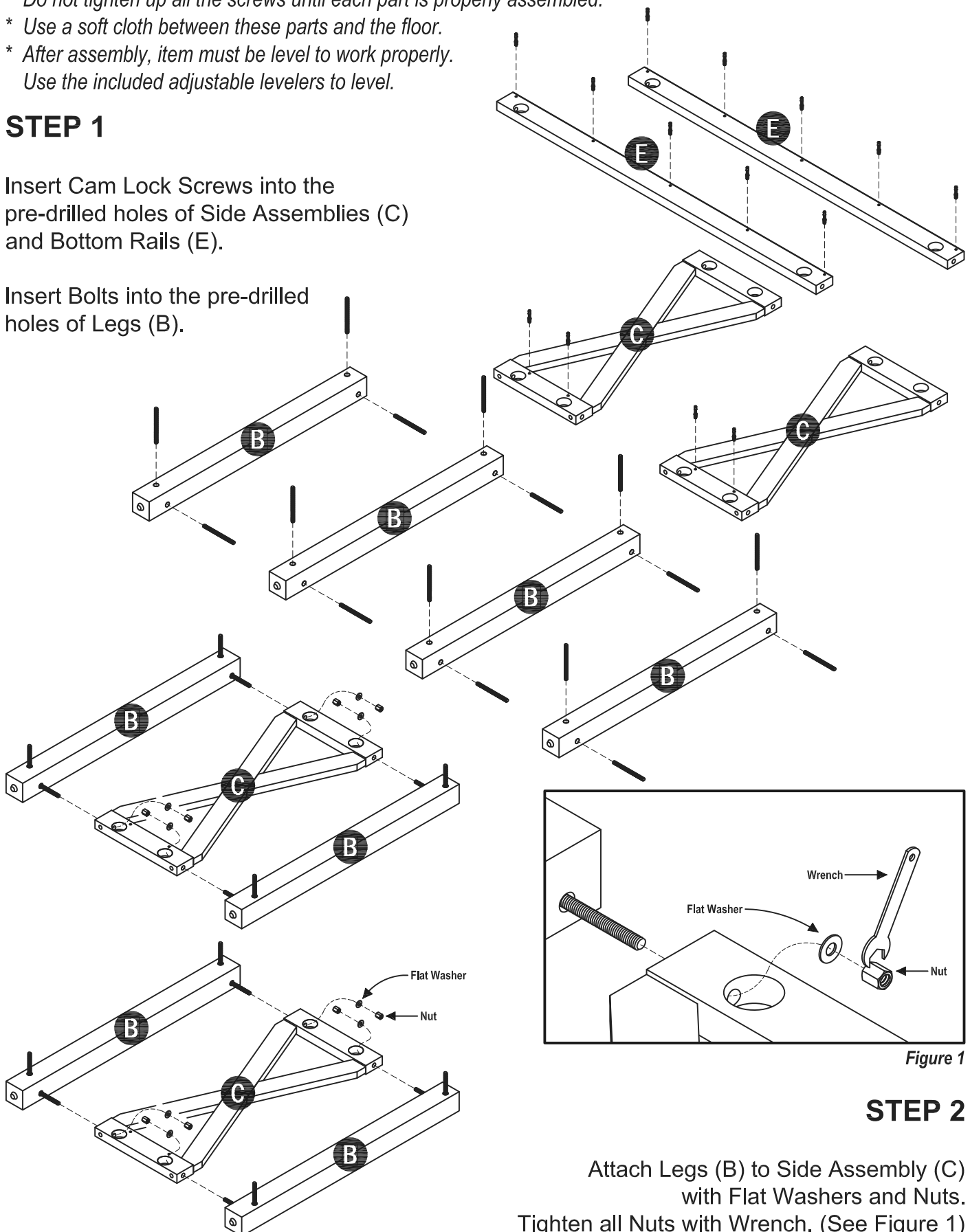

STEP 2

Attach Legs (B) to Side Assembly (C) with Flat Washers and Nuts. Tighten all Nuts with Wrench. (See Figure 1)

STEP 3

Attach Bottom Rails (E) to Bottom (F) with Cam Locks.
(See Figure 2)

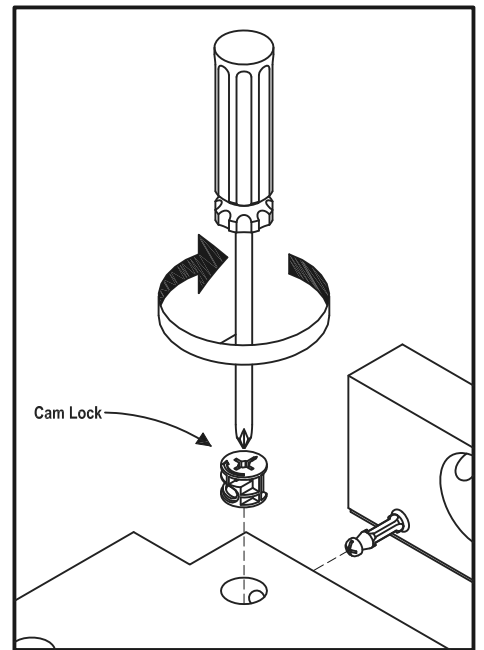
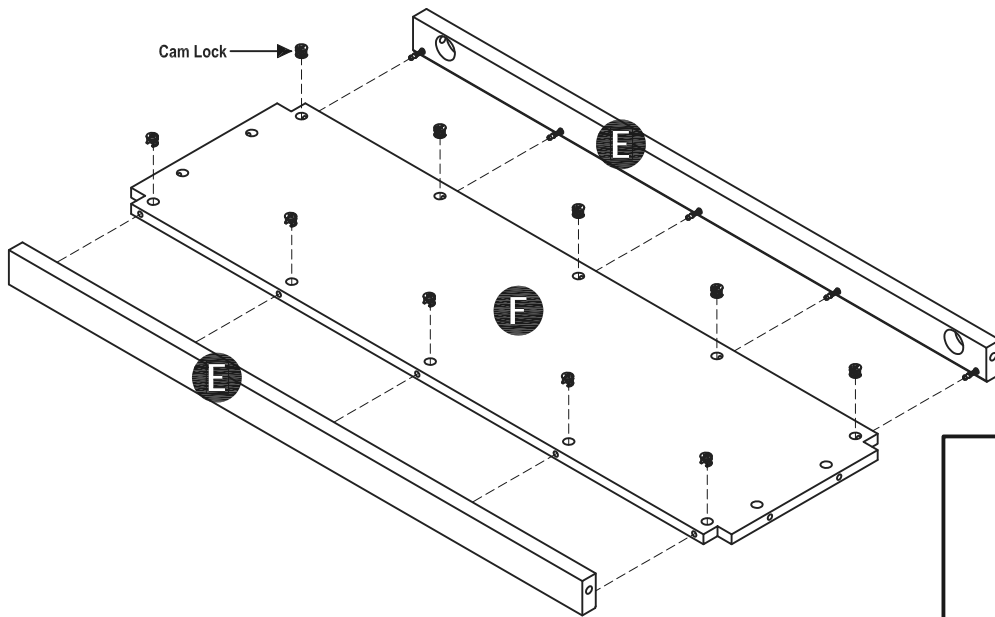
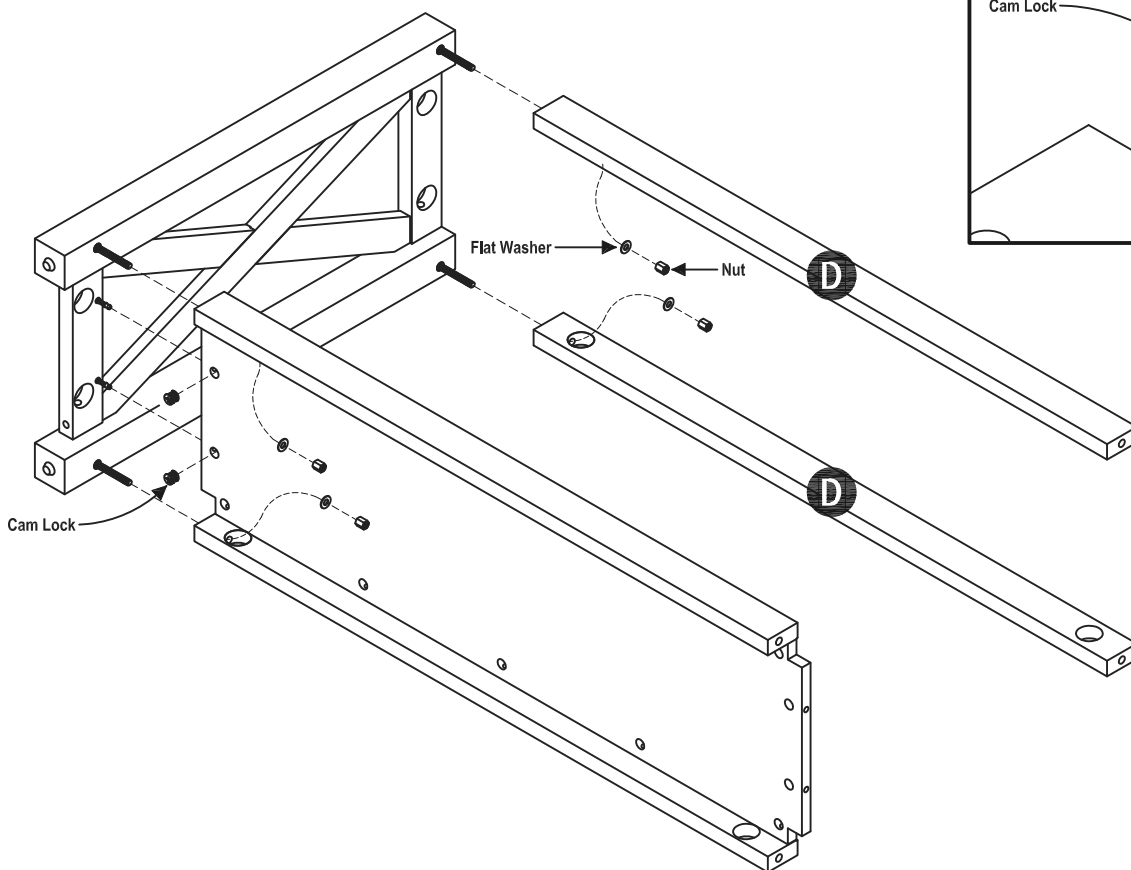

STEP 4

Attach Top Rails (D) and unit from Step 3 to side unit with Flat Washers, Nuts and Cam Locks.
Tighten all Nuts with Wrench.

STEP 5

Attach side unit to unit from Step 4 with Flat Washers, Nuts and Cam Locks. Tighten all Nuts with Wrench.

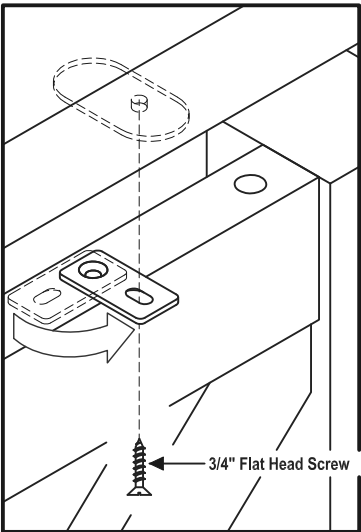

STEP 6

Rotate metal tabs on the unit out and attach Top (A) to unit with 3/4" Flat Head Screws. (See Figure 3)

To level the unit, adjust the adjustable levelers on the bottom of the legs. (See Figure 4)

Note: Unit must be level to work properly.



VERY IMPORTANT !!

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

NEVER

USE GLASS CLEANERS ON FINISHED FURNITURE. AMMONIA WILL CHEMICALLY ATTACK THE FINISH.

NEVER

ALLOW LIQUIDS OF ANY KIND TO REMAIN ON THE FURNITURE. ABSORPTION CAUSES PART TO WARP AND SPLIT AND FINISHES TO DELAMINATE.

DO NOT WRITE DIRECTLY ON SURFACE.



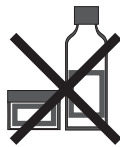
PREVENT MARKING

DO NOT PLACE IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT.



PREVENT FADING

DO NOT USE COMMERCIAL WAXES AND POLISHES.



PREVENT YELLOWING

DO NOT PLACE HOT OBJECTS ON SURFACE.



PREVENT FINISH DAMAGE

DO NOT USE RUBBER BASED PLACE MATS.



PREVENT DISCOLORING

TO CLEAN

USE A SOFT CLOTH MOISTENED IN LUKEWARM SOAP AND WATER, THEN BUFF WITH A DRY CLEAN CLOTH.
