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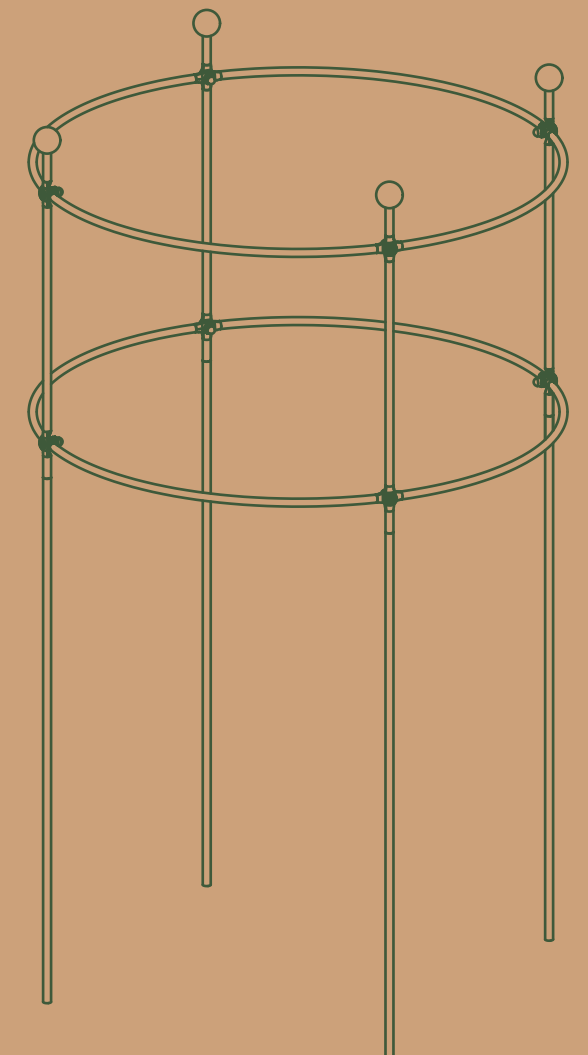

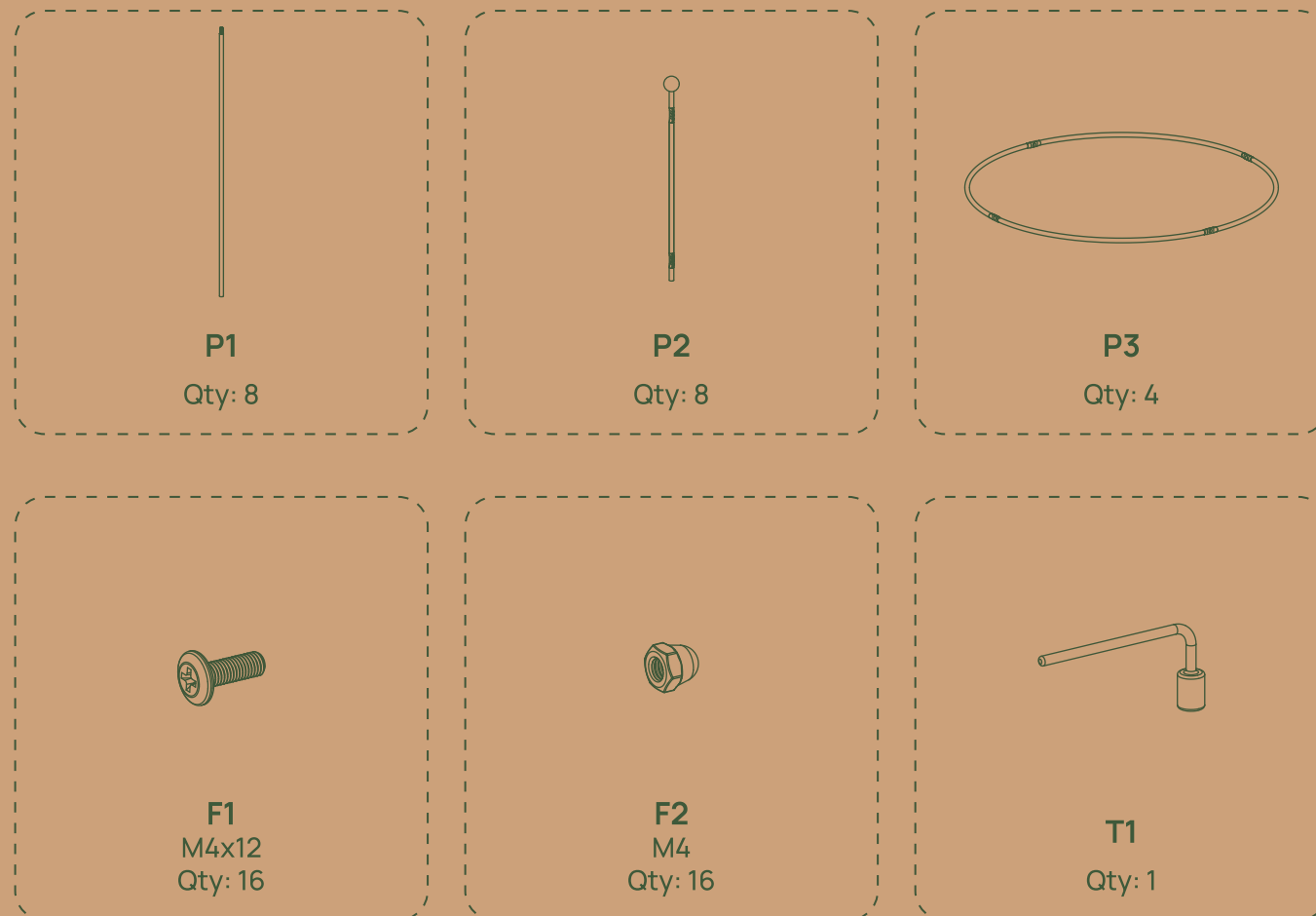

## Installation Instructions

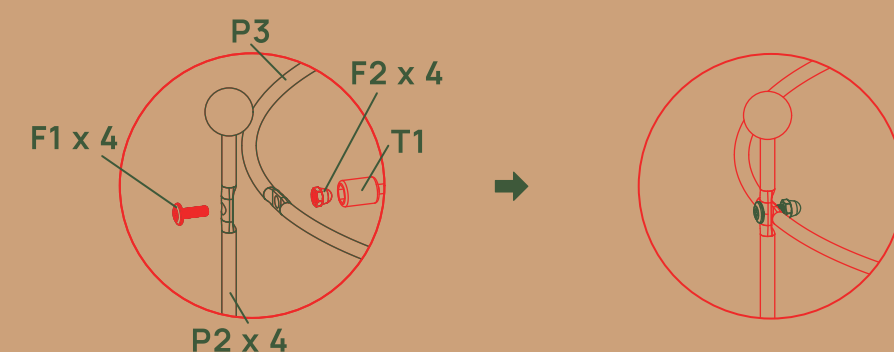
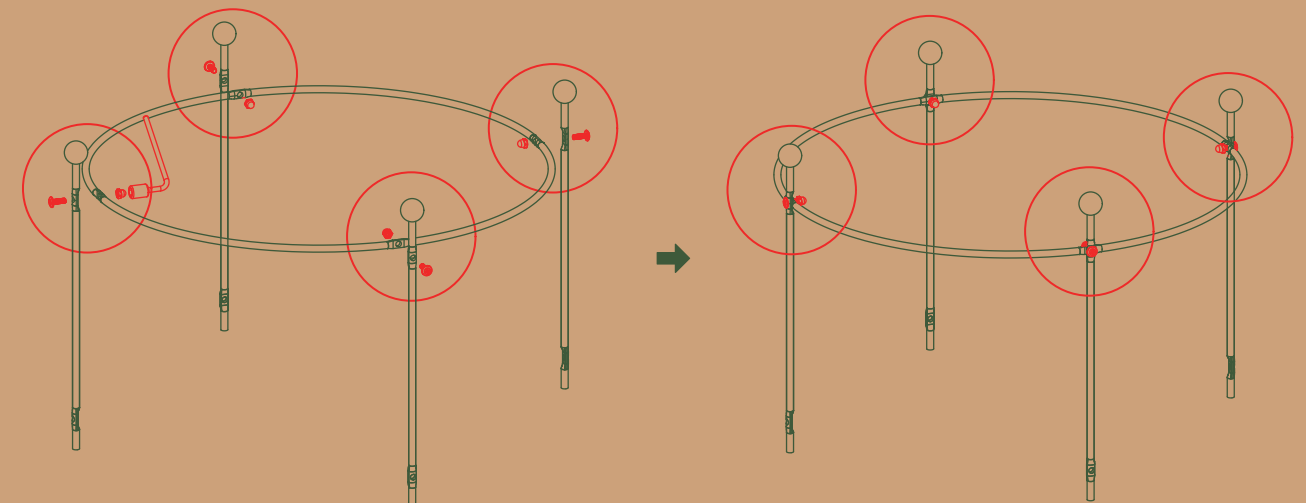
### 1 Assemble the Support Rings

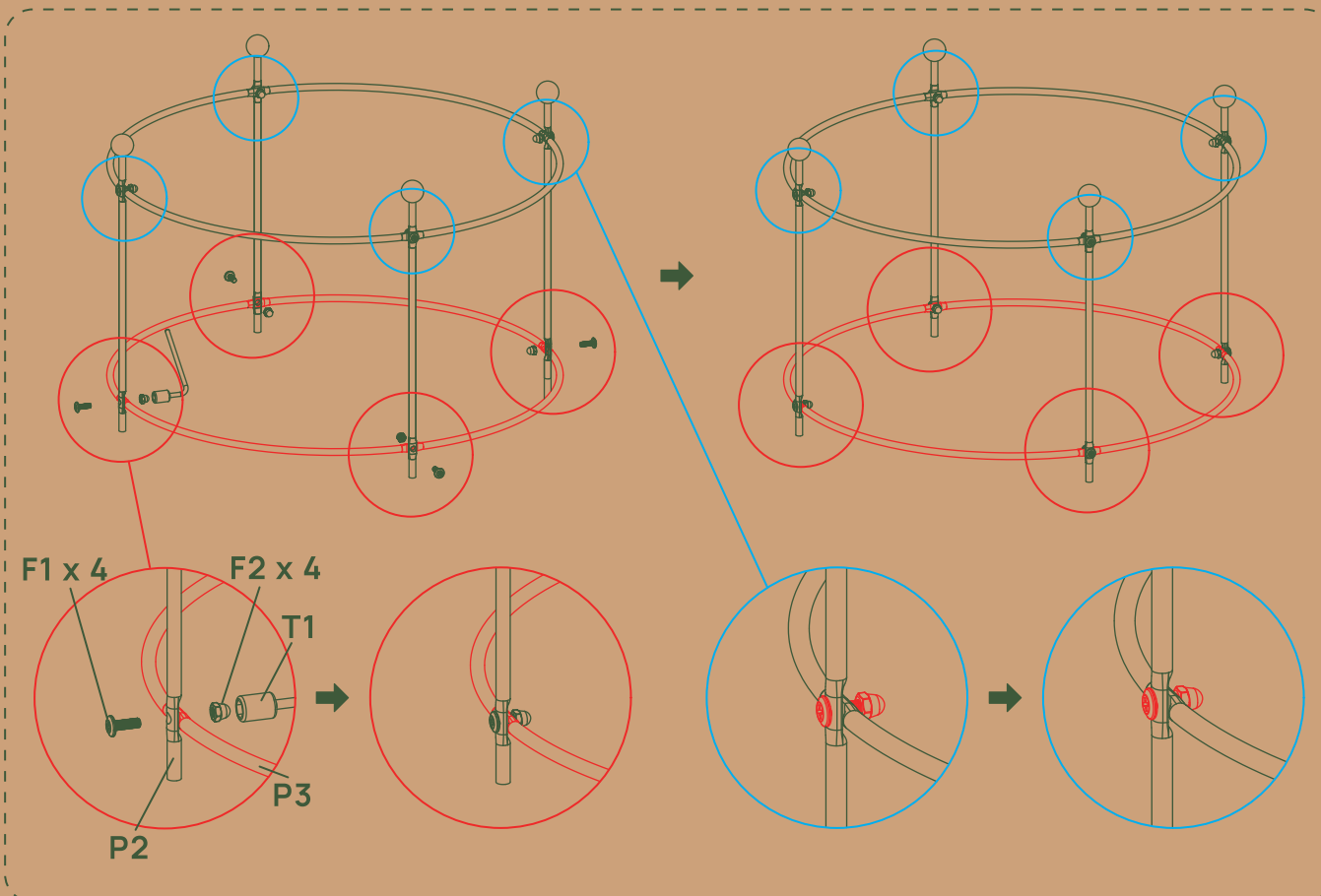
Use F1 screws and F2 Nuts to attach the P3 rings to the P2 Vertical Support Rods as shown in the diagram.

#### ⚠ Important:

When installing the first ring, do not fully tighten the screws, tighten each screw about 3-4 turns only.

After the second (bottom) ring is installed and all parts are properly aligned, use T1 and a screwdriver to fully tighten all screws.





## Important

For your safety, please ensure the product is securely fastened. In windy areas, be sure to anchor your Flower Supports firmly to the ground.

## Maintenance and Care

- Clean with a soft cloth , use mild soap and water if needed.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- Avoid prolonged contact with standing water or constantly wet soil.
- If the surface coating is scratched, touch up promptly with rust-resistant outdoor metal paint.
- Periodically check and retighten fasteners as needed.

Exclusions: Damage caused by misuse, improper installation, or modifications is not covered.

### 2 Attach the Ground Stakes

Thread the P1 ground stakes onto the P2 vertical support rods, one by one, and tighten securely, then place it into the soil.

**Note:** Make sure all rods are evenly tightened and standing straight.
