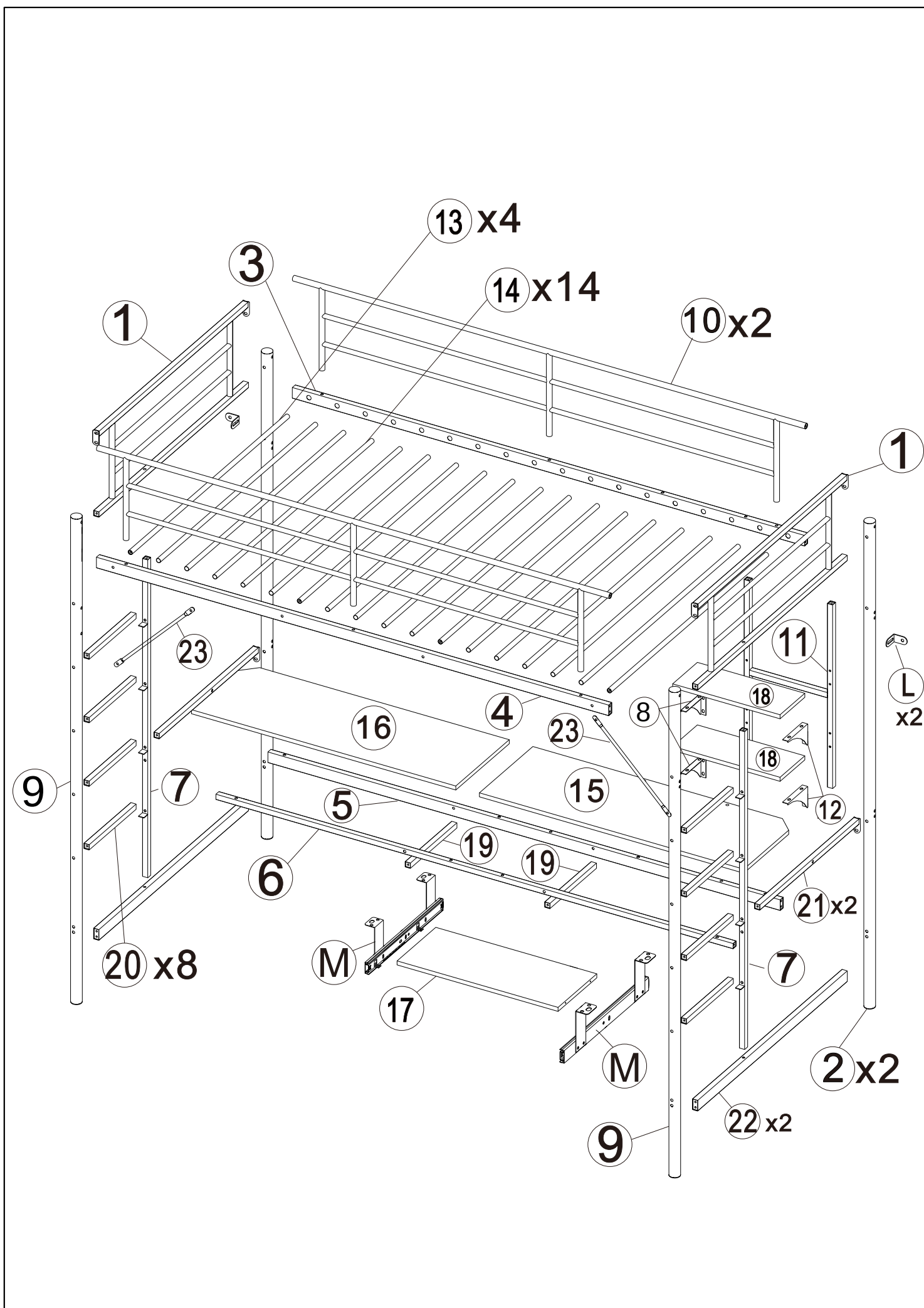
Notes

- Make sure to start on the correct instruction page for the bed configuration you are assembling.
- Unpack parts and hardware carefully to prevent scratching of lacquered components.
- Please assemble the product according to the steps on the diagram strictly.
- Do not fully tighten the screws until all pieces are situated in place.
- For continued use, it's suggested you regularly check the tightness of bolts and connections to ensure safety.
- Do not assemble and disassemble the product repeatedly to avoid damaged.
- To avoid confusion keep all parts and hardware together with the boxes that they came in; some bed configurations require multiple boxes.

SAFETY WARNING:

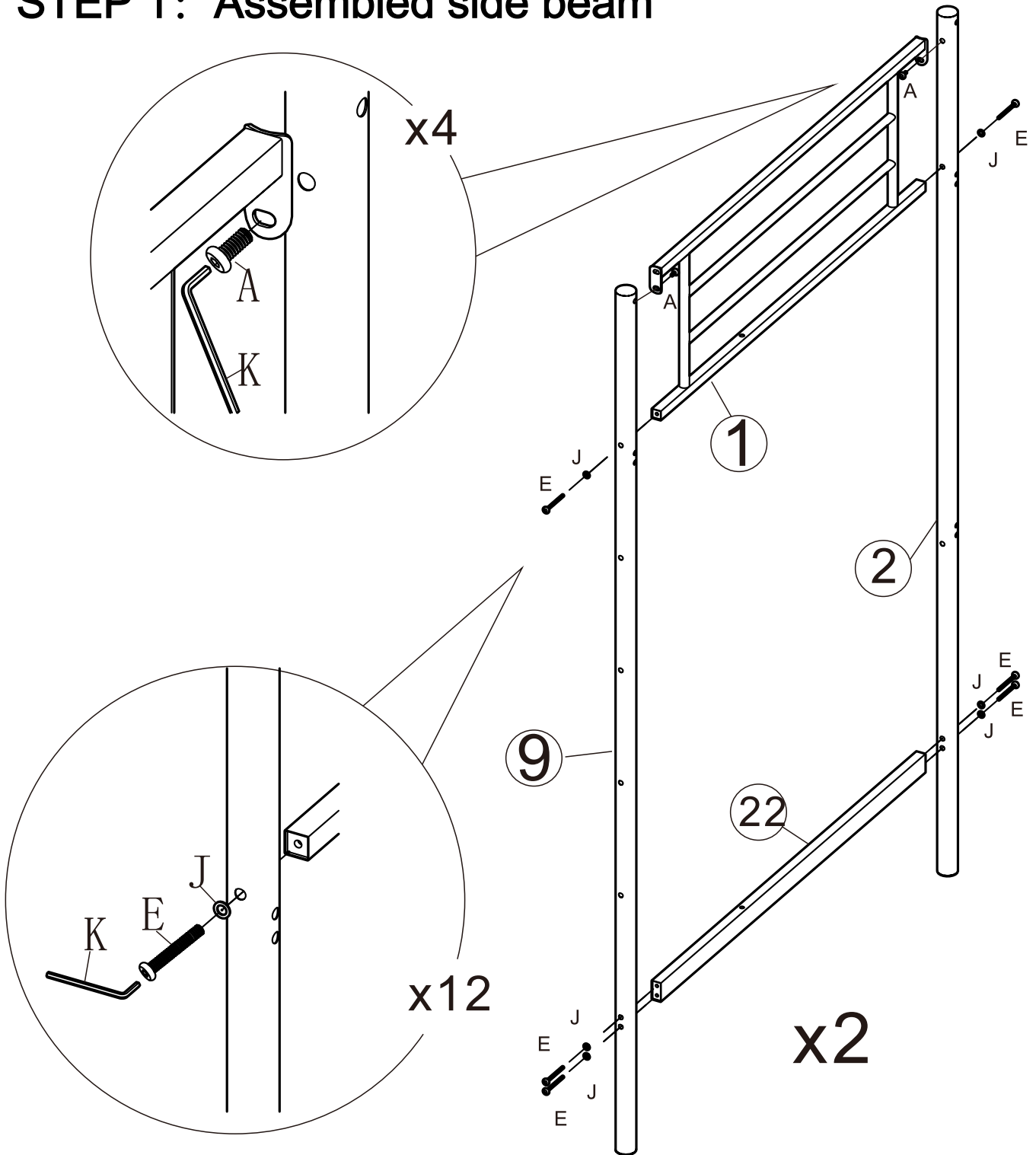
1. Follow the information on the warnings appearing on the upper bunk end structure and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from bed.
2. Always use the recommended size mattress or mat tress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
3. Surface of mattress must be at least 5 in. (127 mm) below the upper edge of guardrails.
4. Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
5. Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, ladder, and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
6. Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.
7. Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.
8. Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
9. Use of a night light may provide added safety precau tion for a child using the upper bunk.
10. Always use guardrails on both long sides of the upper bunk. If the bunk bed will be placed next to the wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and wall.
11. The use of water or sleep flotation mattresses is prohibited.
12. Keep these instructions for future reference.

STEP 1: Assembled side beam

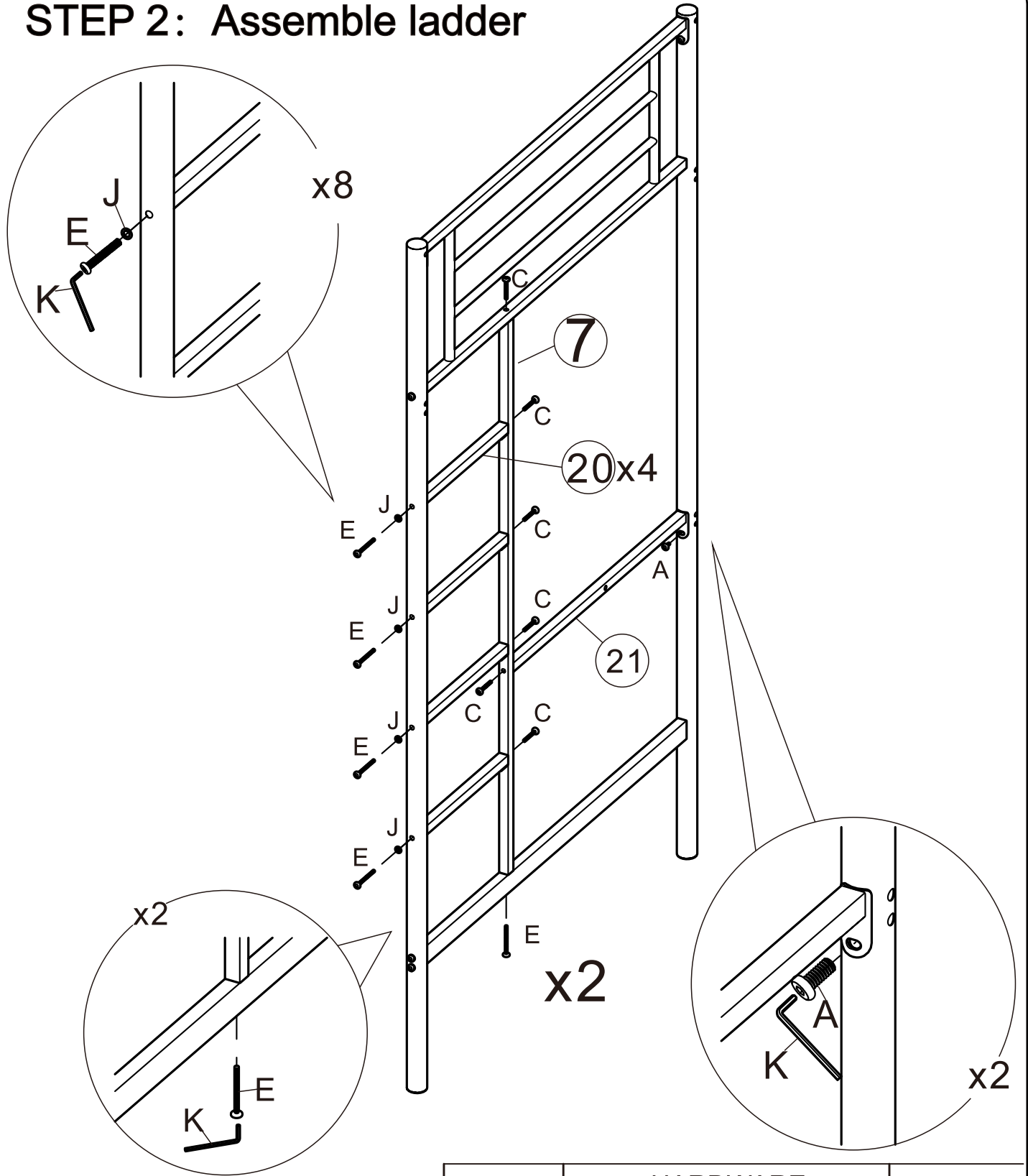


Pass A, E, and J through
(9)(2) Lock (1) (22)

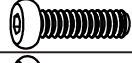

STEP 2: Assemble ladder

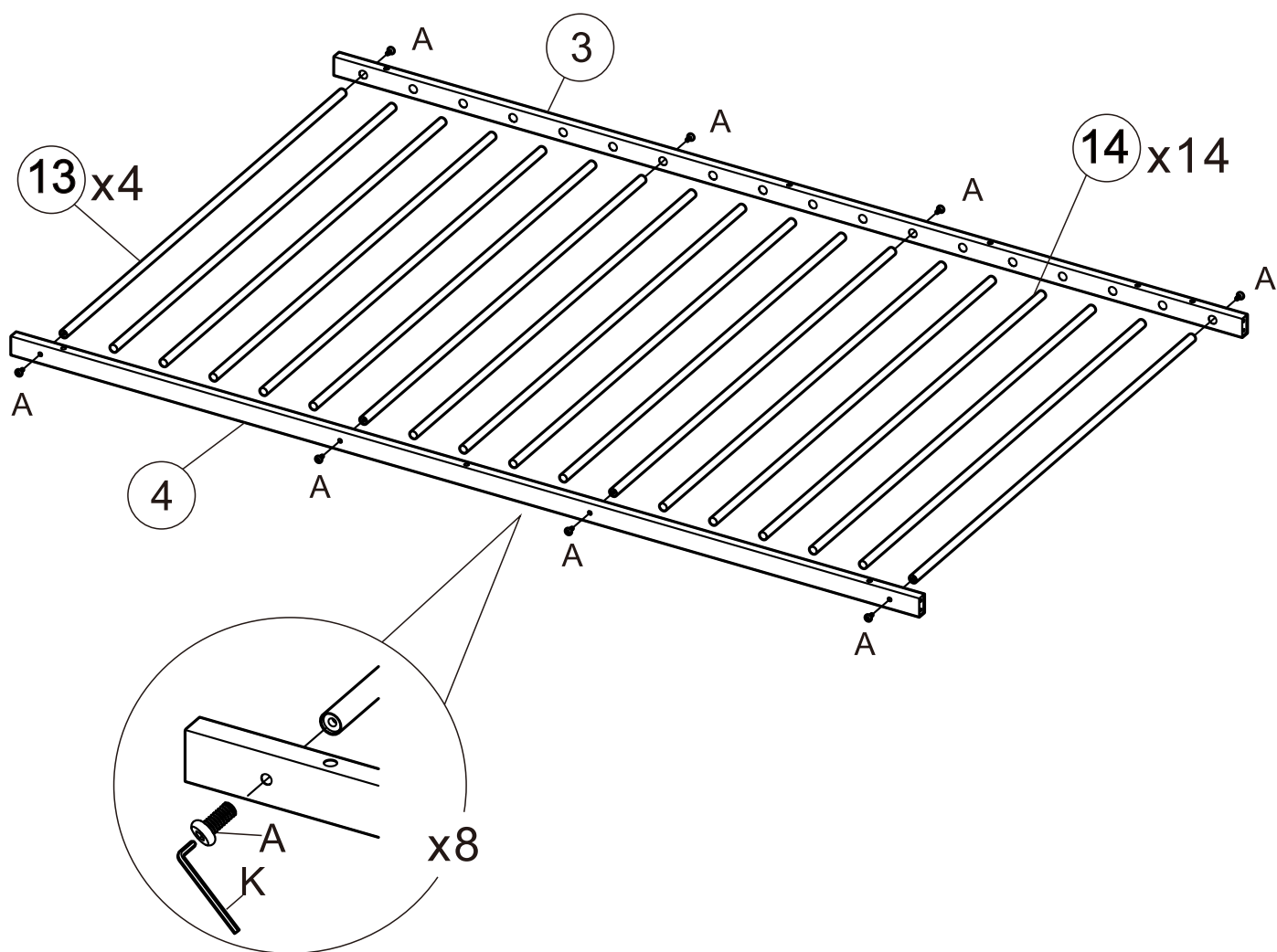


C, E, and J through (1) (9) (22) Lock (7)(20) and place A and C pass (10) (7) Lock up (21)

STEP 3: Assemble the bed support tube

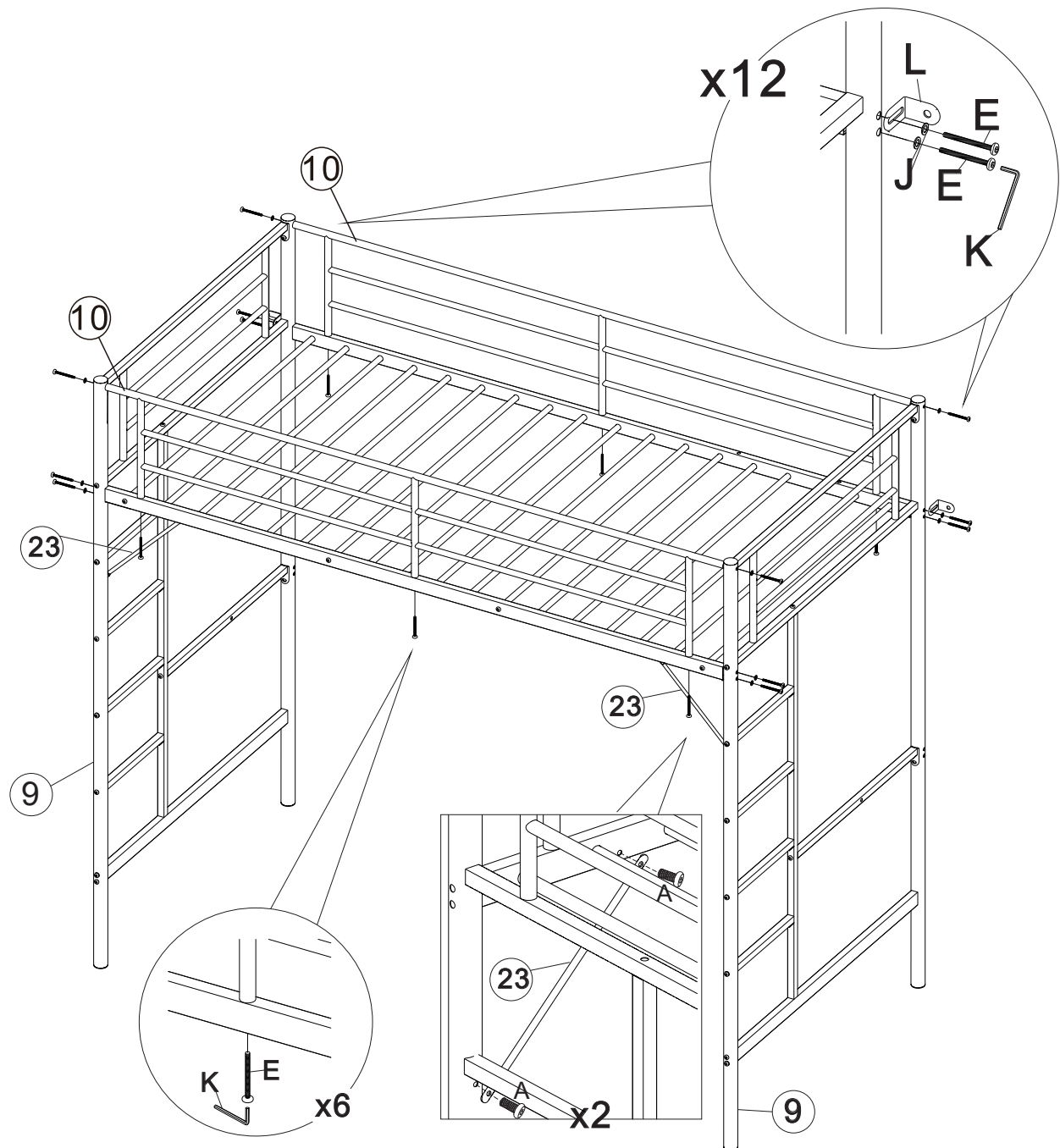


- ①I'm going to pass A (3) (4) Lock (13)

STEP 4: Assemble the bed and guardrail

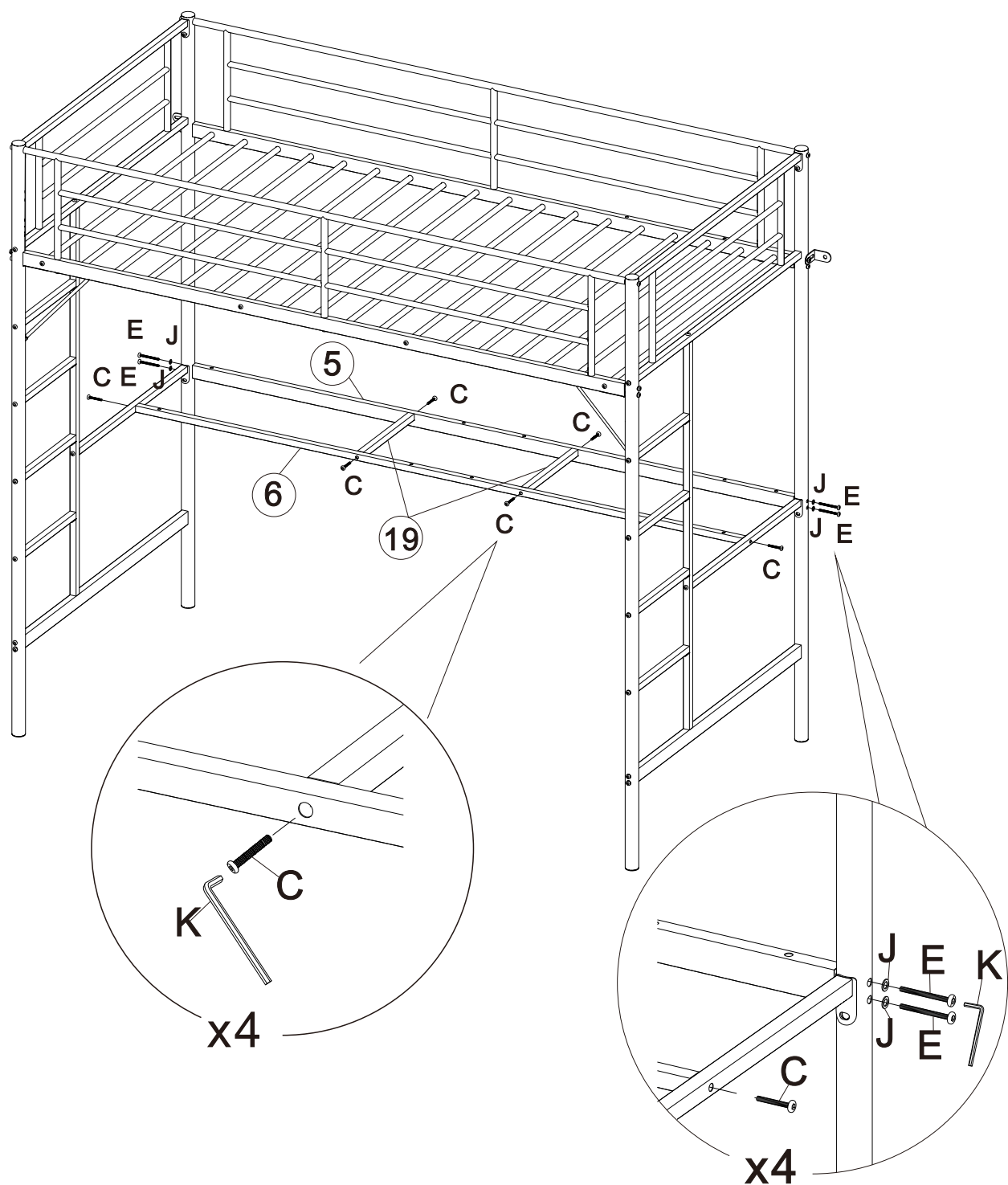


- ① Assemble the bed and guardrail to lock the bed by E and J through (L) and the side side of the bed
- ② and A through (23) to strengthen the side and the bed, and then E and J through the side and the bed lock (10)

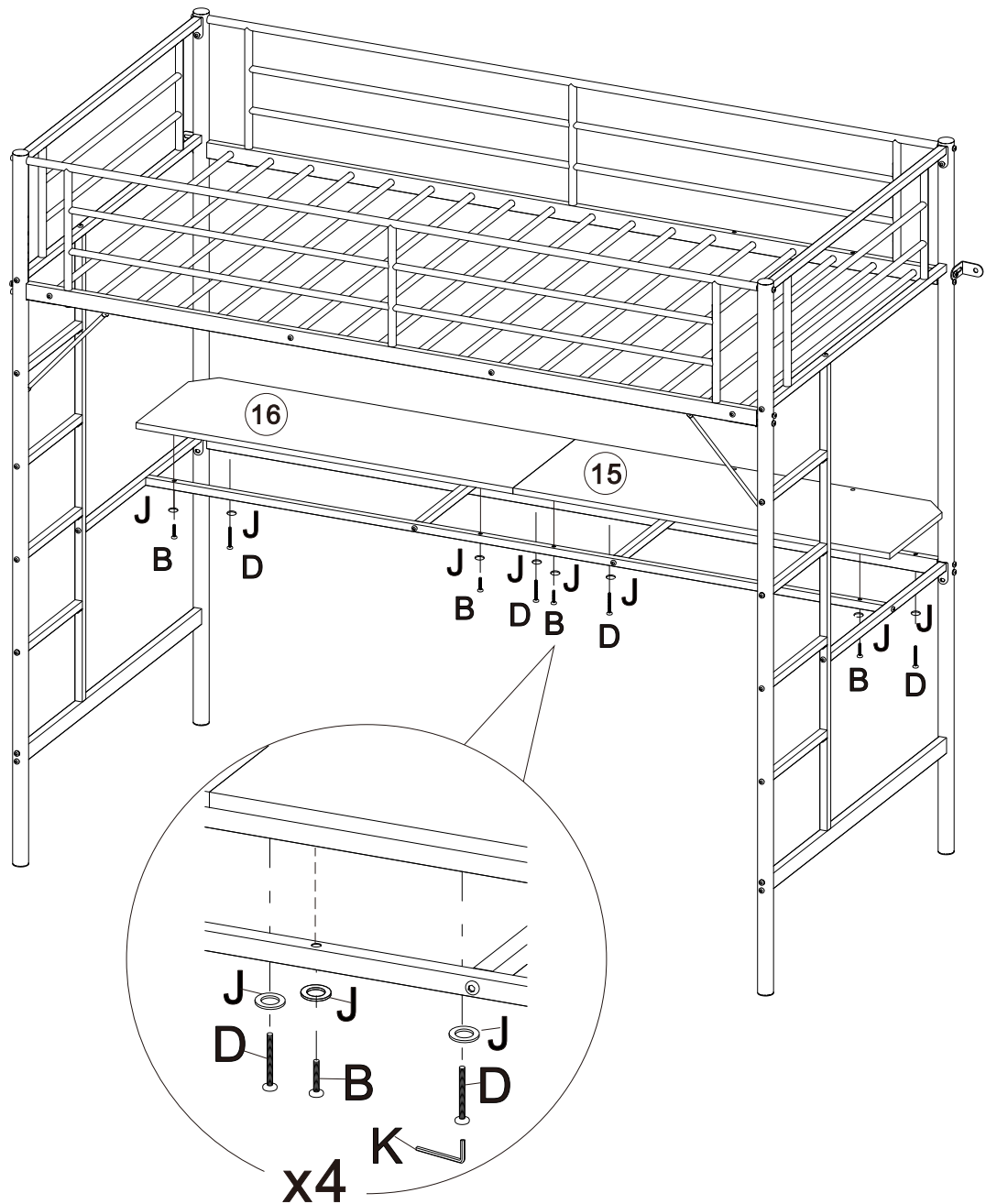


Lock C, E, J through the side square (5) (6) (19)

STEP 7: Assembly shelf

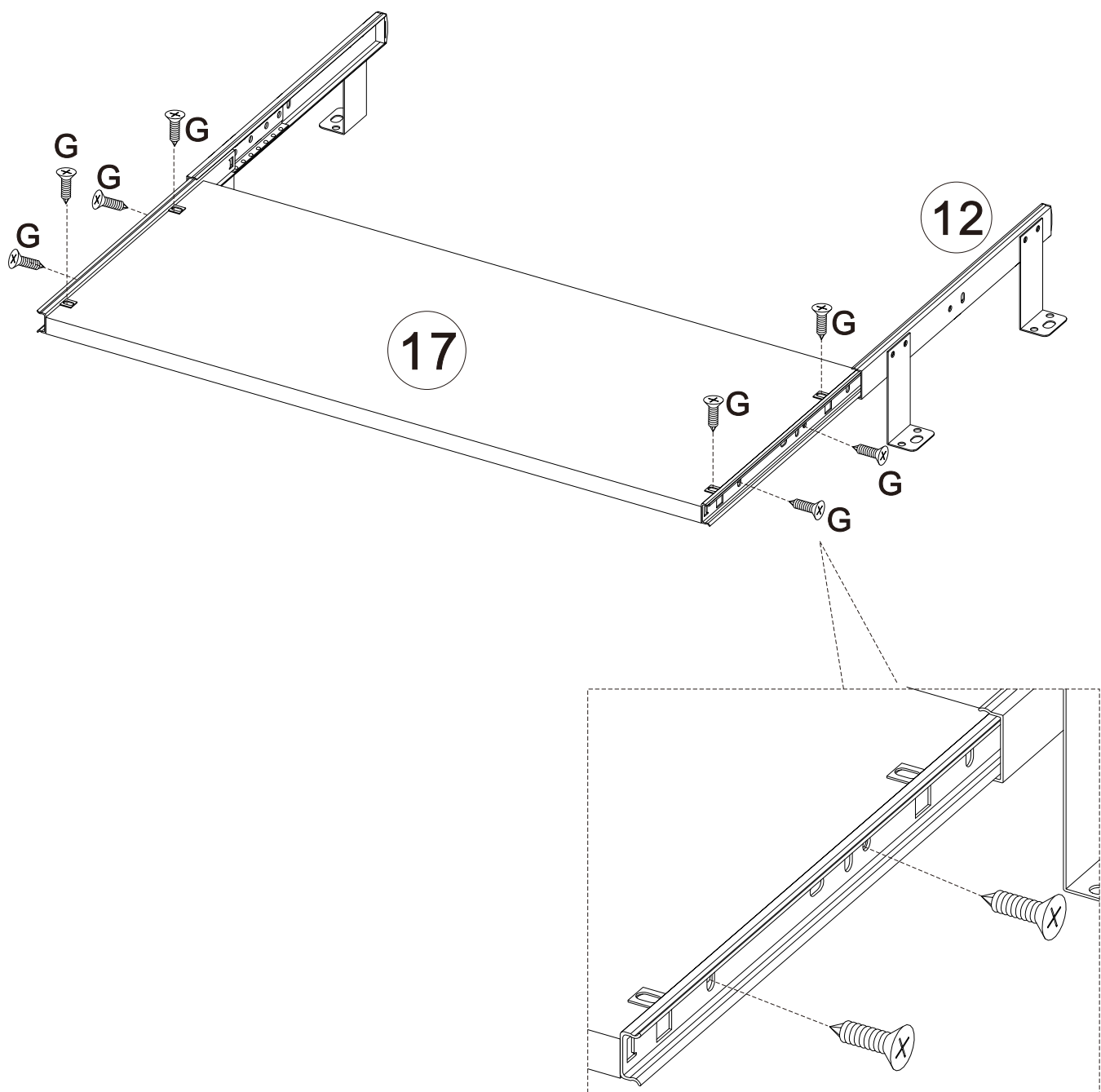


- ① Put A through (11) to lock (8) and (12)

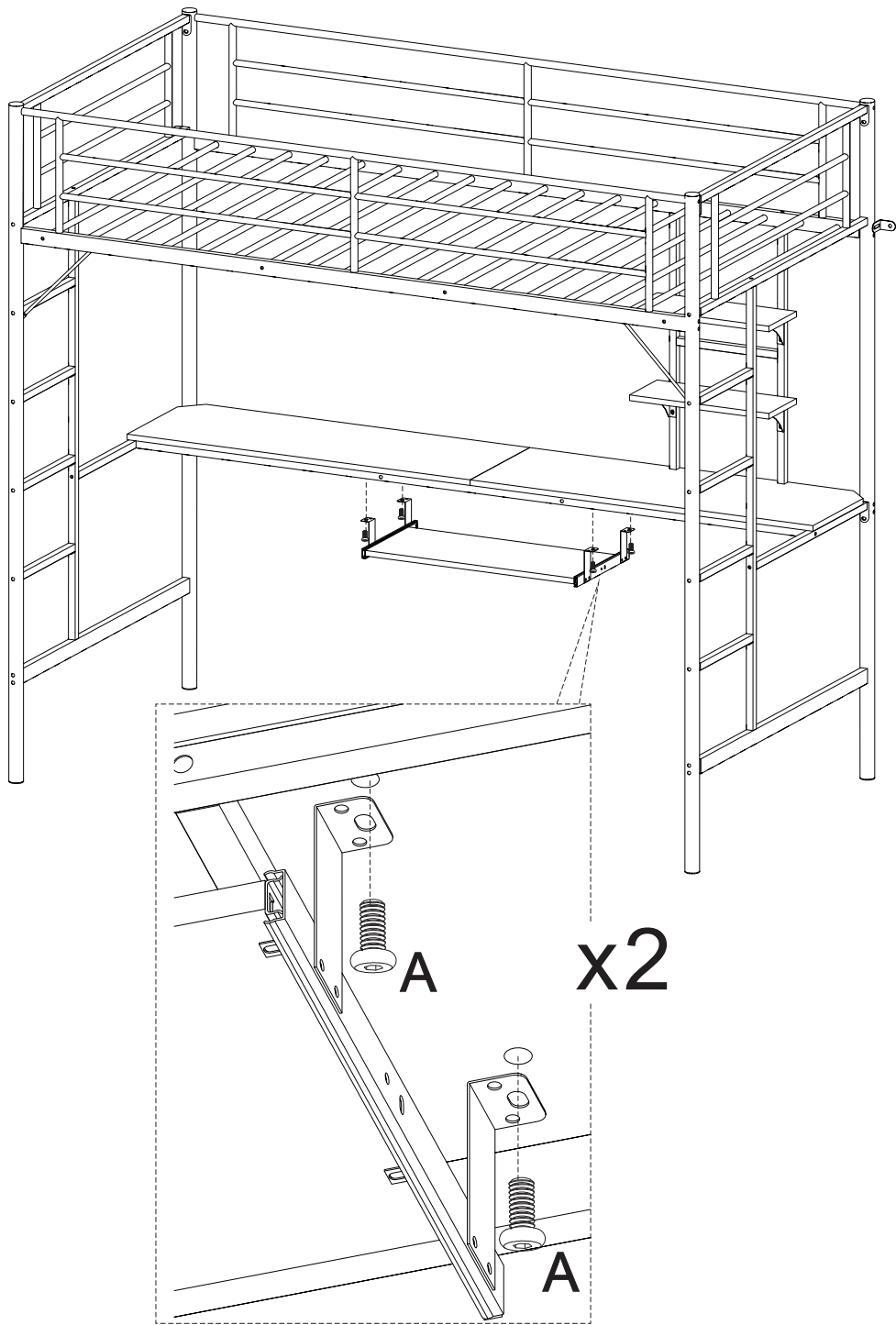
