SAFETY GUIDE

When using any electrical appliance, including this infrared heater, basic safety precautions must be followed to reduce the risk of fire, shock, or injury. Please read all instructions before using this appliance:

- This heater becomes extremely hot when in use. To minimize risk of burns or injury, do not touch any part of the heater when in use. Allow enough time for product to cool down completely before handling. If applicable, use handles when transporting this product. Keep all combustible items, such as furniture, pillows, bedding, or paper, at least 3 feet away from all sides of the heater.
- Be extremely cautious of surroundings when heater is in use. No children or pets should be close to the product when it is on.
- Ensure heater is unplugged after each use.
- Do not operate this heater if it malfunctions, has been dropped, or any cords or plugs are damaged. Discard heater or send the product to an authorized service facility for inspection and/or repair.
- Do not run the cord under any carpeting, rugs, furniture, or appliances. Ensure the cord is neatly placed away from areas that are high-traffic and may be tripped over.
- Connect to properly grounded outlets only.
- To disconnect the heater, turn the switch to the "OFF" position. Then, remove the plug from the outlet. Allow the product to cool down completely.
- Do not insert any foreign objects into the ventilation system. This may result in a fire, shock, or damage to the heater.
- For fire prevention, do not block any air intakes or exhausts with any items, including newspapers, cloths, or curtains. Do not use this appliance on top of soft surfaces, such as a bed or clothes.

Do not move, reroute, or wrap cord when heater is in use.

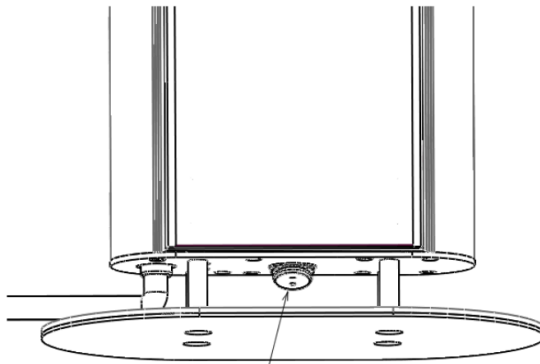
CARE AND MAINTENANCE

OPERATION INSTRUCTION

Use the heater according to the following steps:

Open the package and remove all parts and materials. Ensure all pieces are present and working. Check the heater body, heater stand, wire cables, and plug for any damage. If damage is present, please contact our customer support and do not continue assembly.

If any parts or hardware pieces are missing or damaged, please contact customer service at support@eastoak.com. In your email, include your shipping address and product purchased. We will send you replacement parts for free.

Place the product on the ground vertically. Connect the plug to a socket for electrical power. Make sure the socket and plug is not wet.

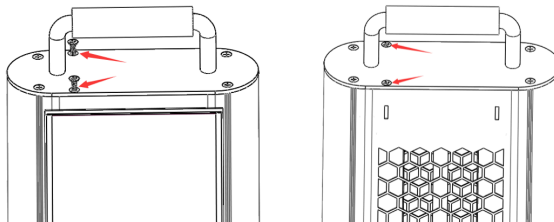
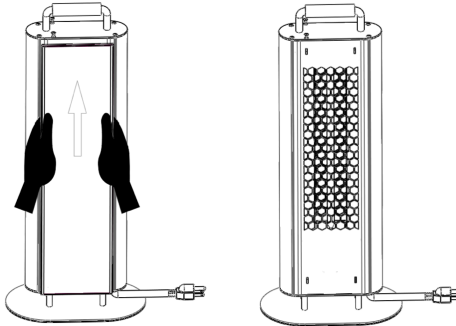
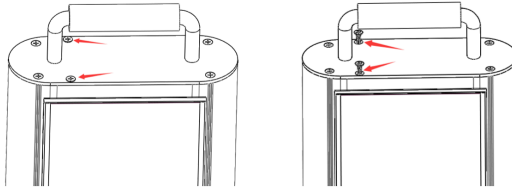
Turn the switch to the “ON” position. The heater should begin heating up.

If the glass baffle must be removed, turn off the heater and allow it to cool.

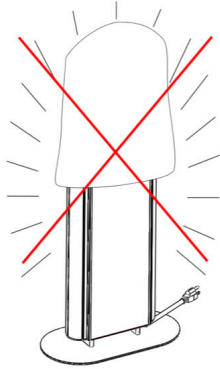
- Unscrew the two screws on the upper cover plate by about 10 mm.
- Hold the glass frame with both hands. To remove the plate, lift up and pull out.
- Tighten the two screws to secure the plate.

Unscrew the two screws on the left side by approximately 10 mm. Do not unscrew all the way.

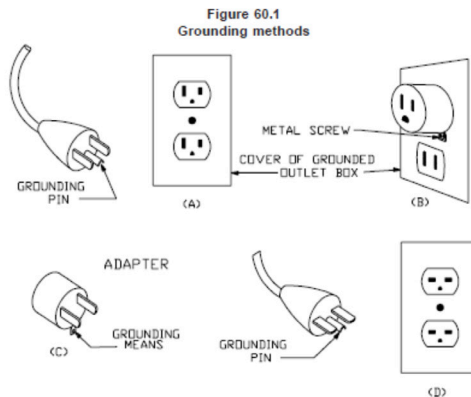
If the glass baffle needs to be installed, reverse steps 4a - 4c.
Do not move or cover the appliance when it is in use.



- Inspect the mount and all mounting pieces, such as dowels and screws. Make sure they are secured tightly to lengthen the product's lifespan.
- Do not add excessive weight to the appliance.
- Adjust your heater to your desired angle. Then, fasten all screws tightly. Regularly check your screws and tighten if needed.
- Plug your heater to a power source, then turn the switch to the "ON" position. Assess the product for at least 15 minutes to ensure there are no problems.

GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

This heater is compatible with 120 volt sockets. The plug (A) is shown Figure 60.1. An adapter (C) is available to adapt three-blade plugs to two-slot sockets. The green grounding extension must be connected to a permanent round, such as an outlet box. The adapter should not be used if a three-slot socket is available.
