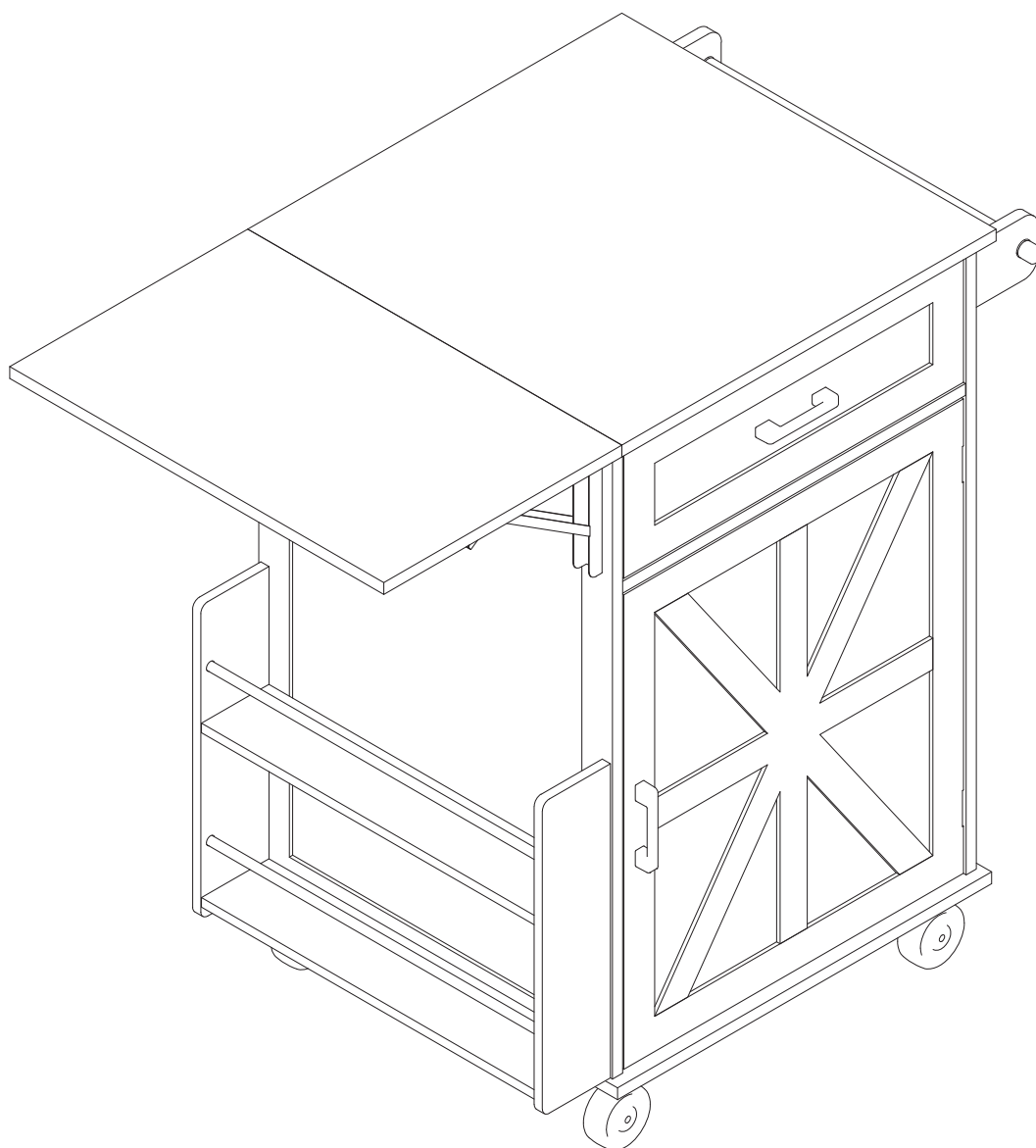

Recommendations Before Beginning Assembly

Read instructions, cover to cover

Have 2-4 adults on hand for assembly depending on product size

Do not assemble directly on floating or carpet

Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (example:packing foam)

Save all packaging until finished

3. Assembly Notice:

If you encounter any problems during assembly and find that you cannot continue, rest assured we will help you solve the situation as soon

- as possible. Simply keep all of the parts of the products to redina safe place and contact us immediately so we may assist you further.
- Once you have opened your package, remove all inner hardware packages and take the parts out. One by one, Place the parts out neatly infront of you, then refer to the instructions to ensure no parts are missing.If any pieces are found missing, please carefully look in the box first, as the hardware packaging might have torn making the hardware spill in the box. Some key parts of your product maybe stored and hidden inside of other parts. Please open any zippered or hook & loop storage
- Compartments to remove all parts. (example:cushions and legs being stored in the underside of a sofa)
IMPORTANT: When setting up your product, **DO NOT INSTALL THES CREWS ALL THE WAY IN THE BEGINNING.** Place each acrew into their proper hole and use your hand to twist the screw halfway. Twist all the screws in halfway to ensure the holes will match up properly and the product is level on the ground. When everything seems fitted, then tighten thes crews.

Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth

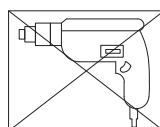

How To SEPARATE BALL BEARING SLIDE.

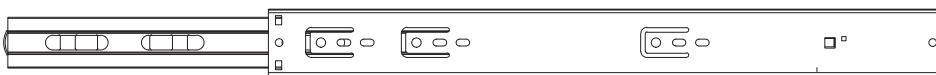
- 1) Pull toward arrow to open the slide until its stops and then flip it over.
