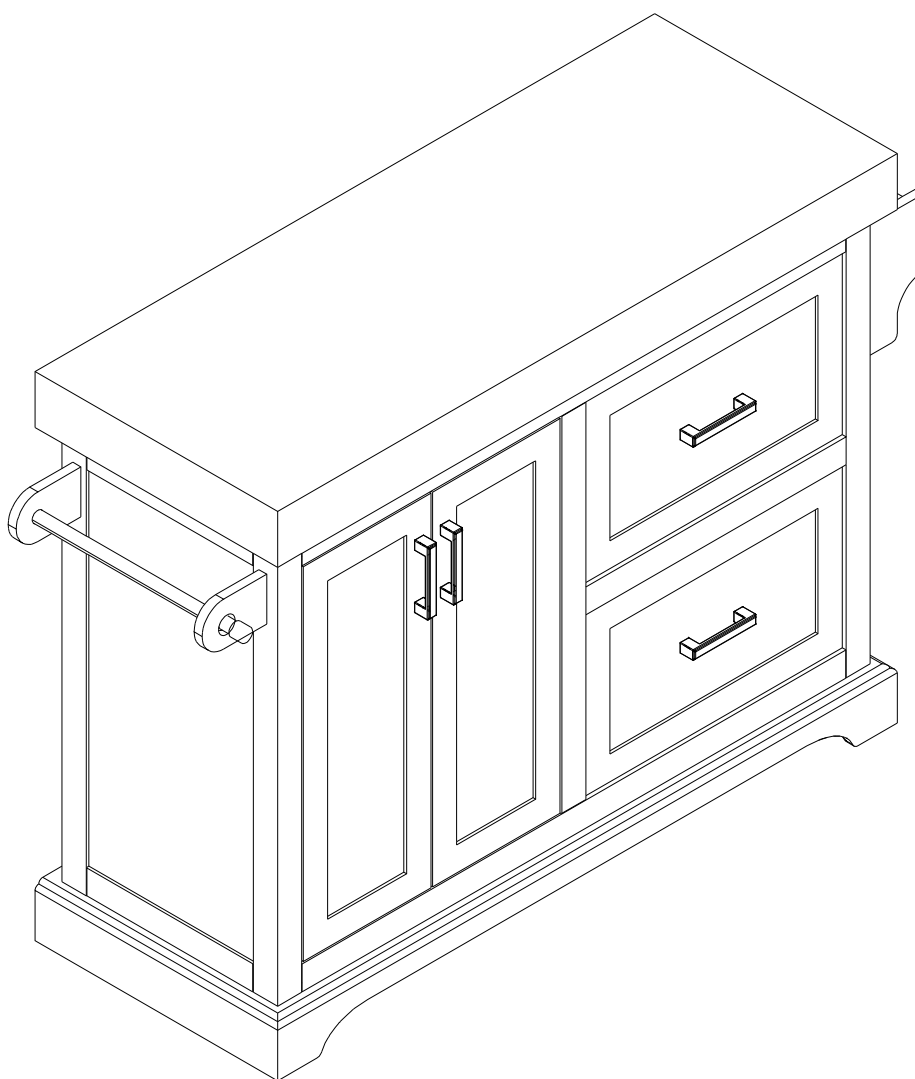

## Recommendations Before Beginning Assembly

Read instructions, cover to cover

Have 2-4 adults on hand for assembly depending on product size

Do not assemble directly on flooring or carpet

Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (example:packing foam)

Save all packaging until finished

## 3. Assembly Notice:

If you encounter any problems during assembly and find that you cannot continue, rest assured we will help you solve the situation as soon

- as possible. Simply keep all of the parts of the products to redina safe place and contact us immediately so we may assist you further.
- Once you have opened your package, remove all inner hardware packages and take the parts out. One by one, Place the parts out neatly infront of you, then refer to the instructions to ensure no parts are missing.If any pieces are found missing, please carefully look in the box first, as the hardware packaging might have torn making the hardware spill in the box. Some key parts of your product maybe stored and hidden inside of other parts. Please open any zippered or hook & loop storage
- Compartments to remove all parts. (example:cushions and legs being stored in the underside of a sofa)  
**IMPORTANT:** When setting up your product, **DO NOT INSTALL THES CREWS ALL THE WAY IN THE BEGINNING.** Place each acrew into their proper hole and use your hand to twist the screw halfway. Twist all the screws in halfway to ensure the holes will match up properly and the product is level on the ground. When everything seems fitted, then tighten thes crews.

When you have completed assembly, we suggest you have more than one person to assist you with lifting and placing the product.

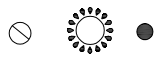
## Care & Maintenance



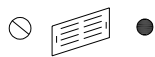
Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface

Do not place furniture under direct sunlight



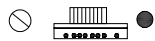
Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents

Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth

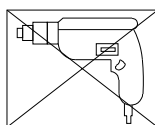

# HINGE ADJUSTMENTS

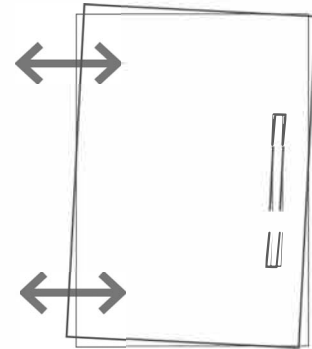


## ① Sideways / Tilt adjustment

Turn the screw

**clockwise** to move the door further away from the side of the cabinet

**anticlockwise** to move the door closer to the side of the cabinet

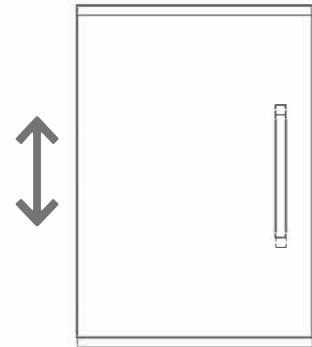


## ② ④ Height adjustment

While supporting the weight of the door, turn the screws

**clockwise** to move the door up

**anticlockwise** to move the door down



## ③ Forward and back adjustment

If the gap between the back of the door and the cabinet is too small, and the door may not close fully. Turn the screw

**clockwise** to decrease the gap between the door and the cabinet

**anticlockwise** to increase the gap between the door and the cabinet
