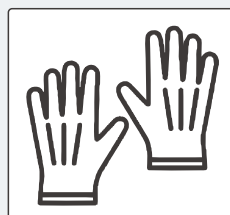

Important:

In each of the previous steps, tighten all screws to approximately 70% to stabilise the overall frame during assembly. Do not fully tighten any screws until the final step is completed.

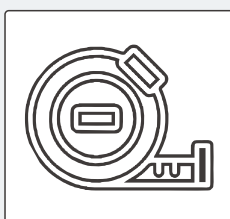

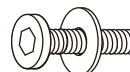
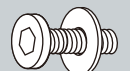
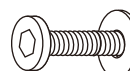
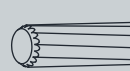
Headboard Section Installation

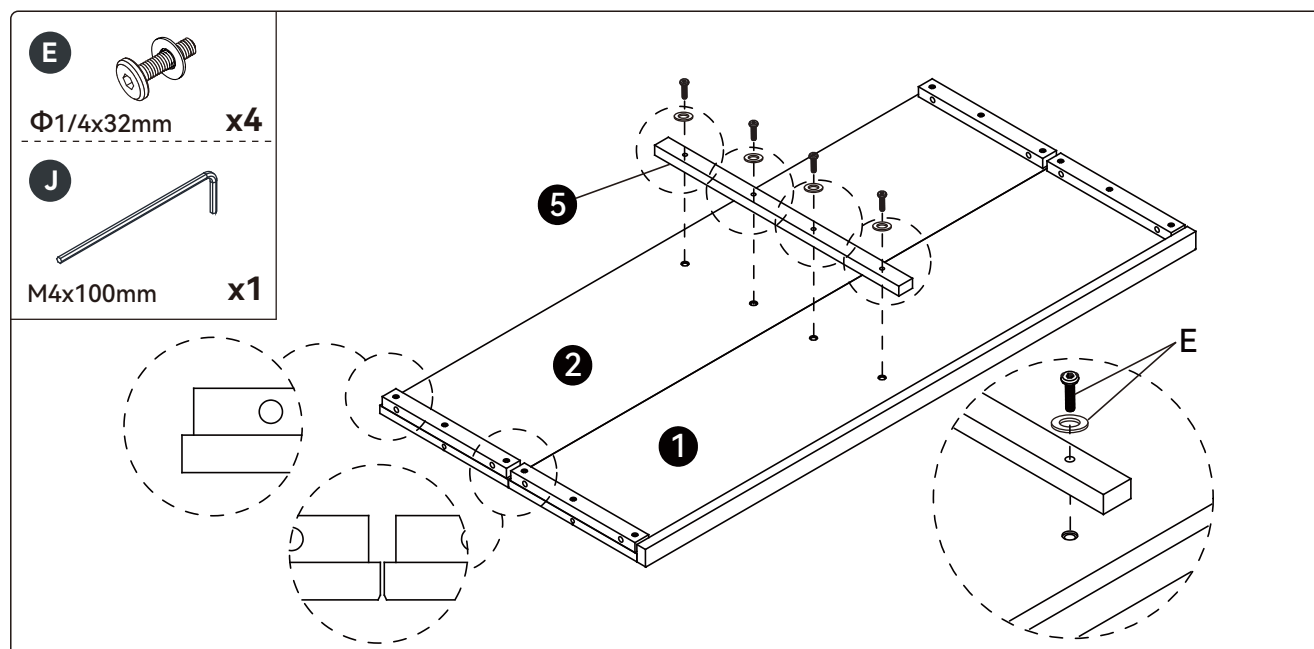

Step 1

Headboard Section

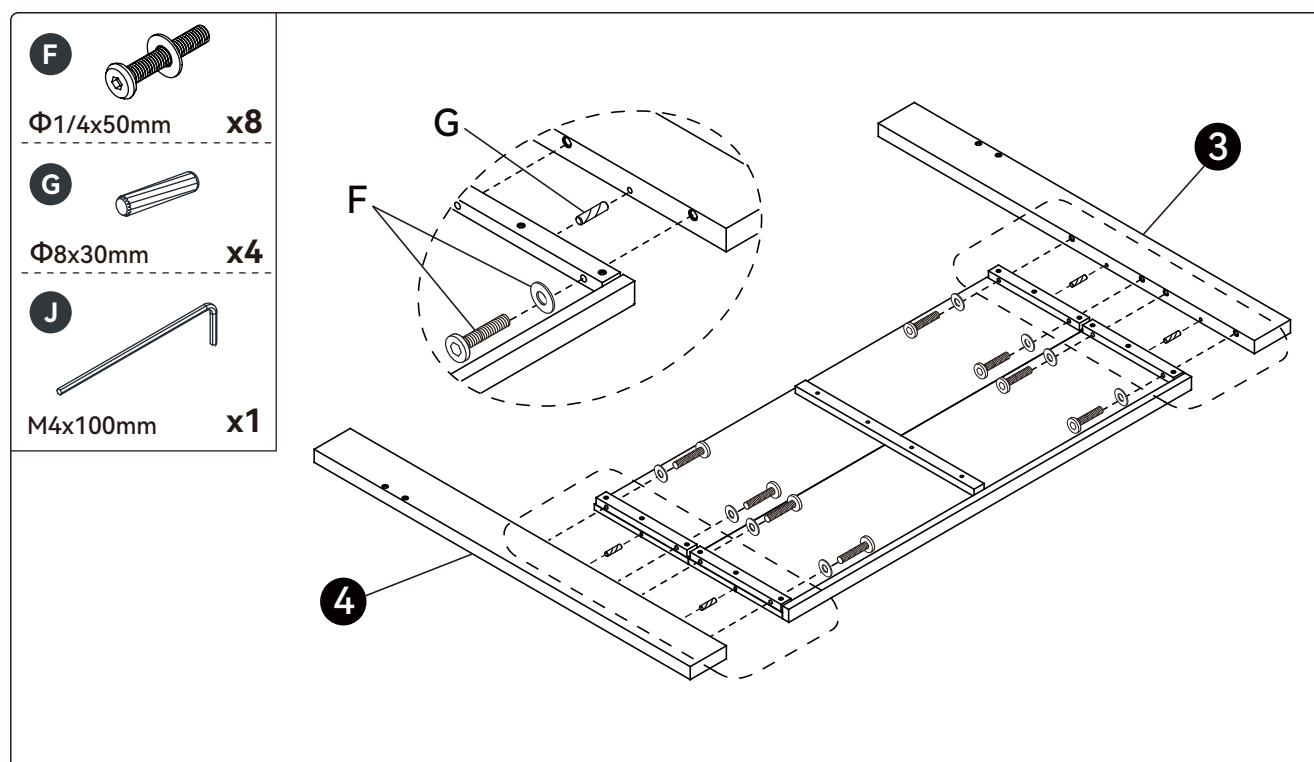


Attach headboard parts (1&2) with headboard support bar (5), using bolts (E).

Note:
The headboard part (2), the side with out edged cut is the bottom side.

Step 2

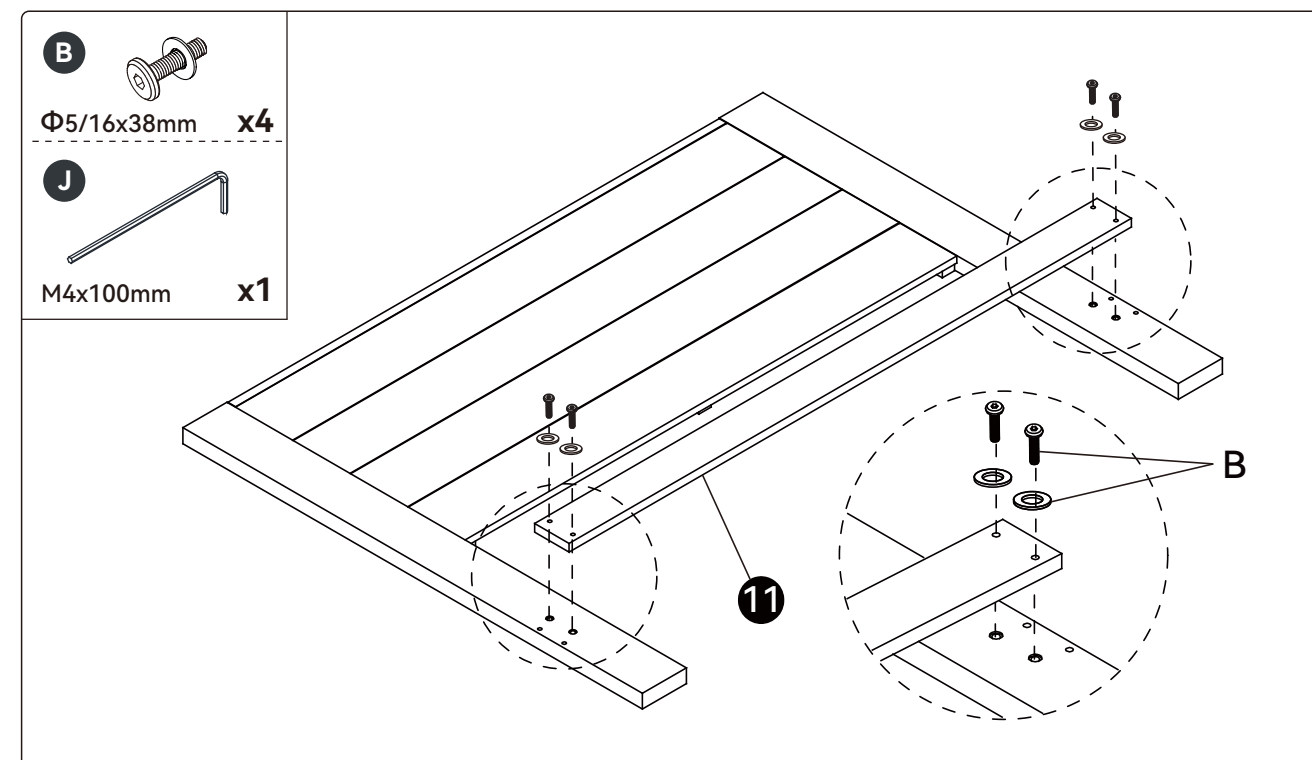
Headboard Section



Assemble the headboard from Step 1 with headboard legs (3&4), using wood dowels (G) to fix the position and then tighten with bolts (F) as illustration.

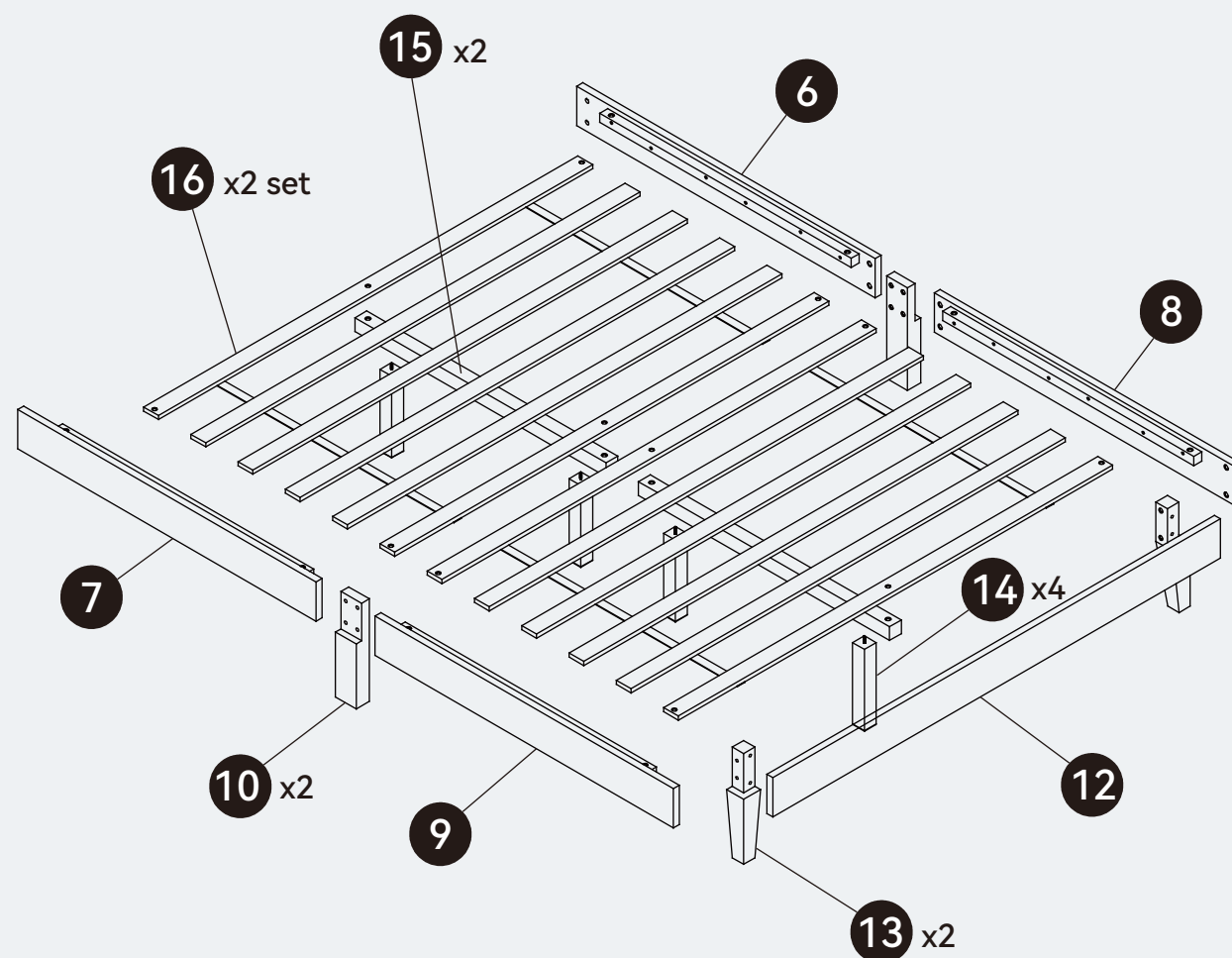
Step 3

Headboard Section



Assemble the headboard part bottom (11), onto the bottom of front of headboard from Step 2 as illustration.

Frame Parts Section Installation



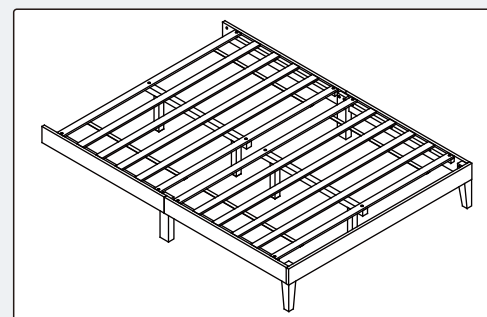
The frame parts section assembly requires a total of labeled panels shown in the diagram. Please locate all of them and prepare them for use.

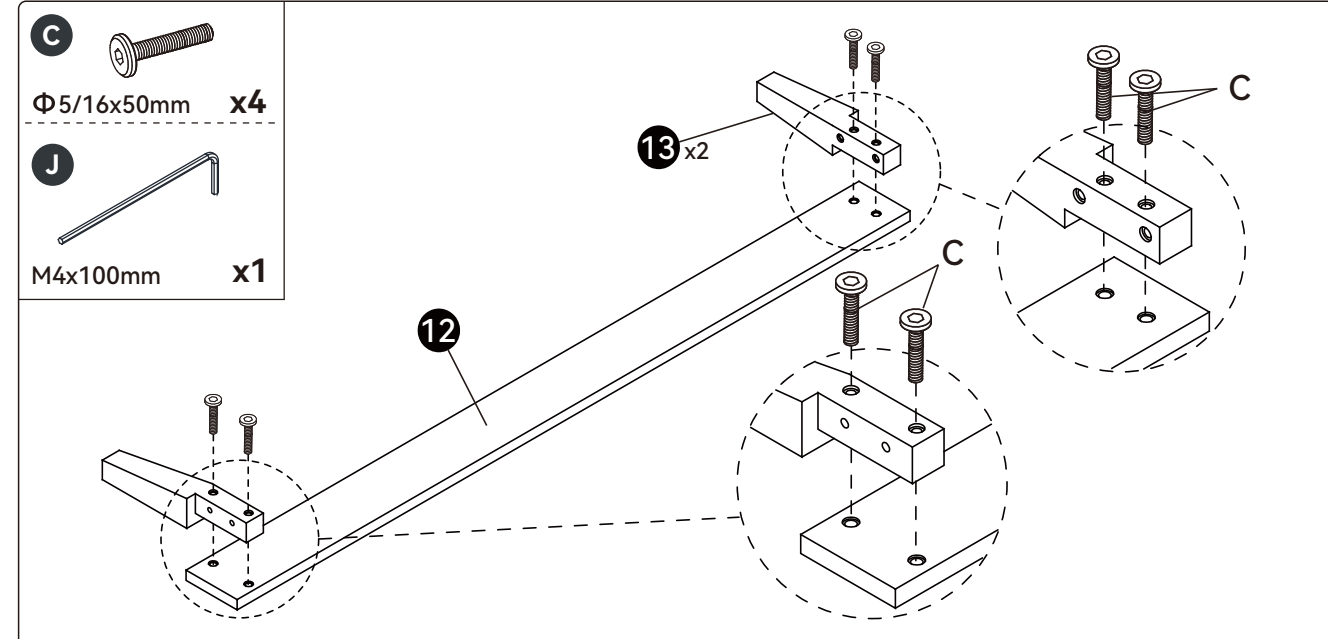

Step 4

Frame Parts Section



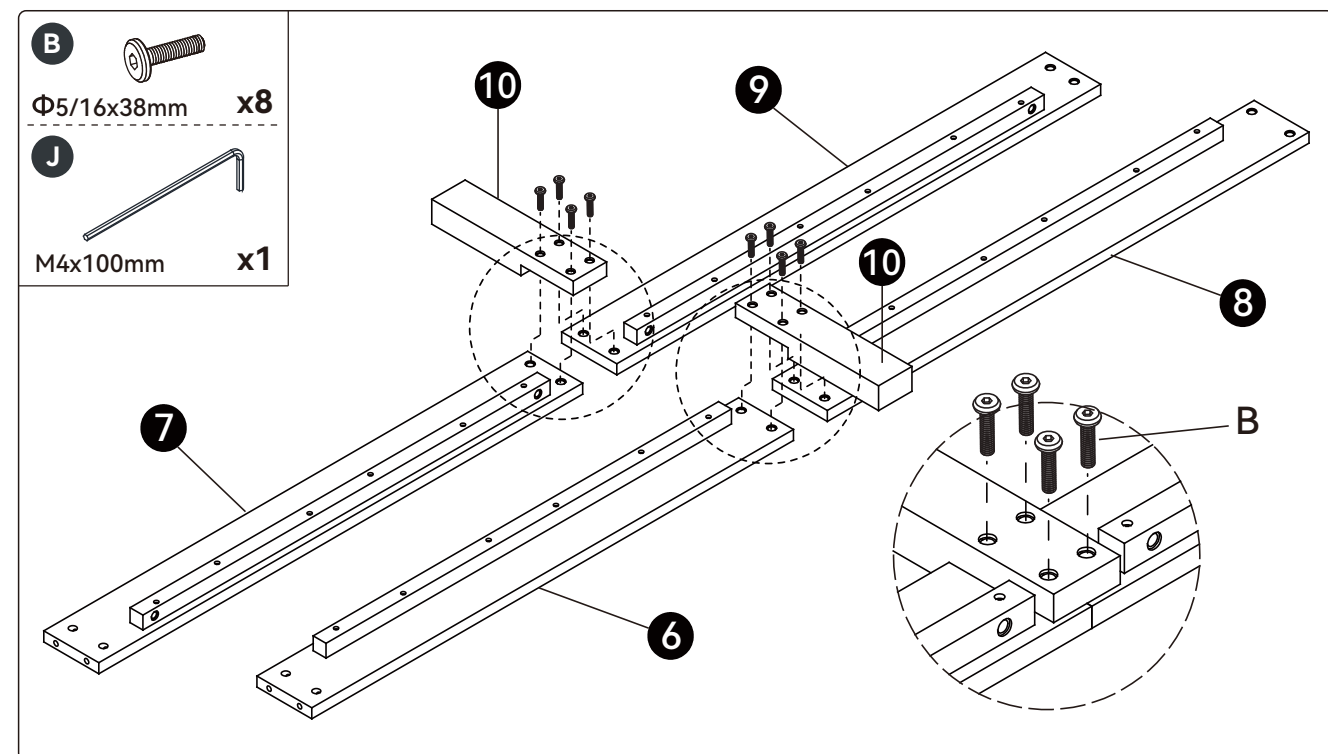
Assemble the footboard legs (13) onto footboard (12), using bolts (C).

Note:

The cut edged should be outwards.

Step 5

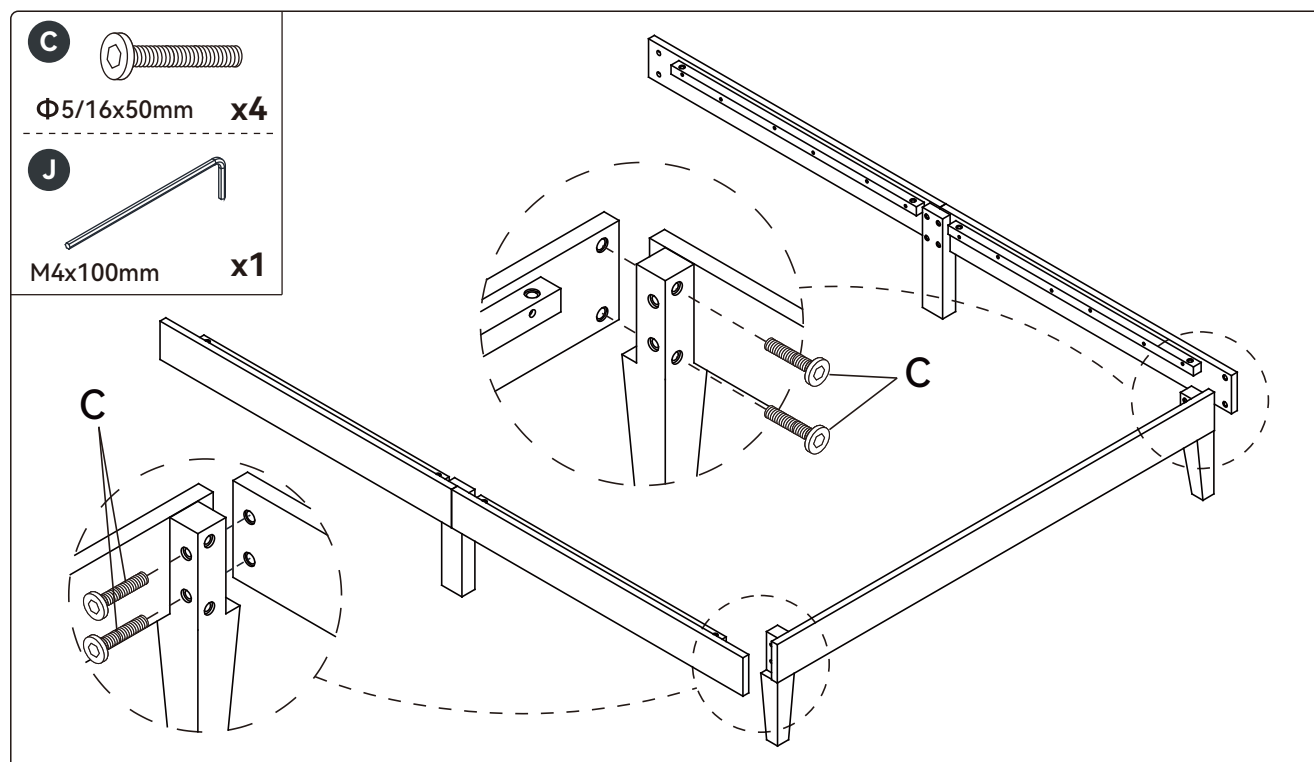
Frame Parts Section



Assemble the side rail legs (10) with siderails (6, 7, 8, 9) using bolts (B).

Step 6

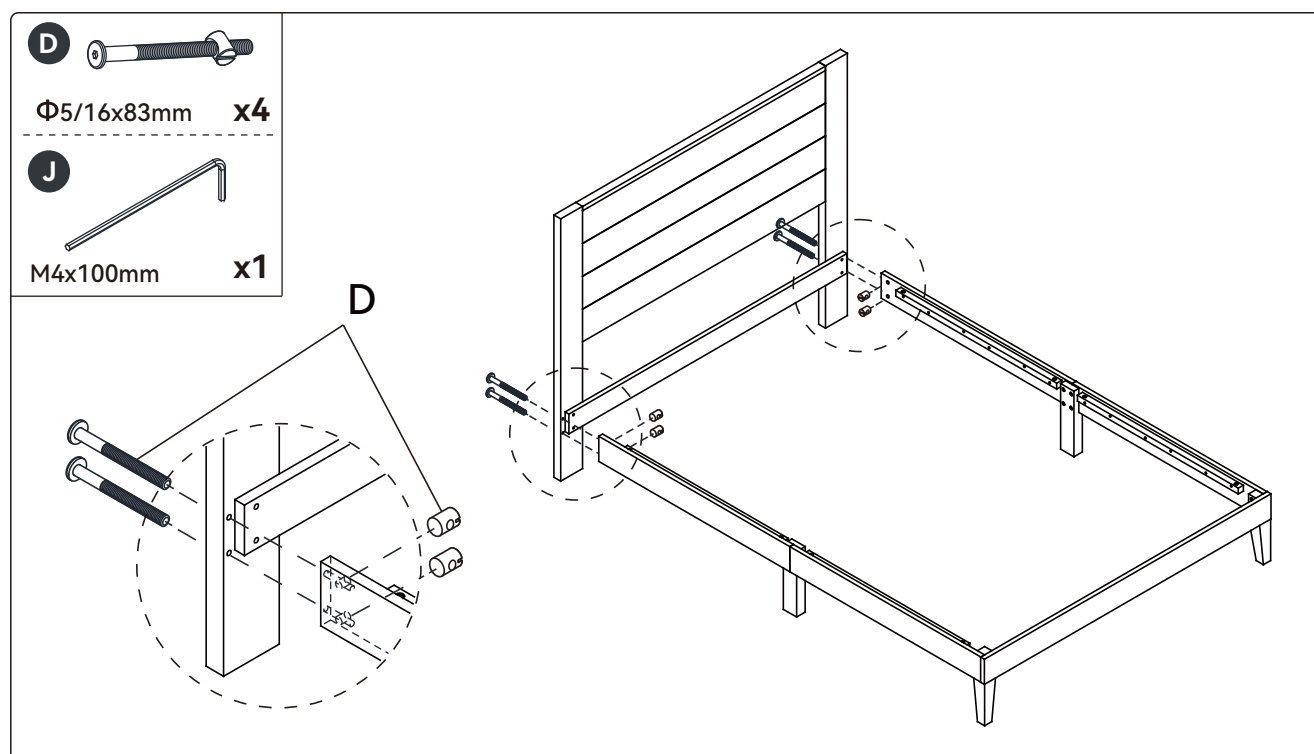
Frame Parts Section



Assemble the footboard with legs from Step 4 and siderails from Step 5, using bolts (C) as illustration.

Step 7

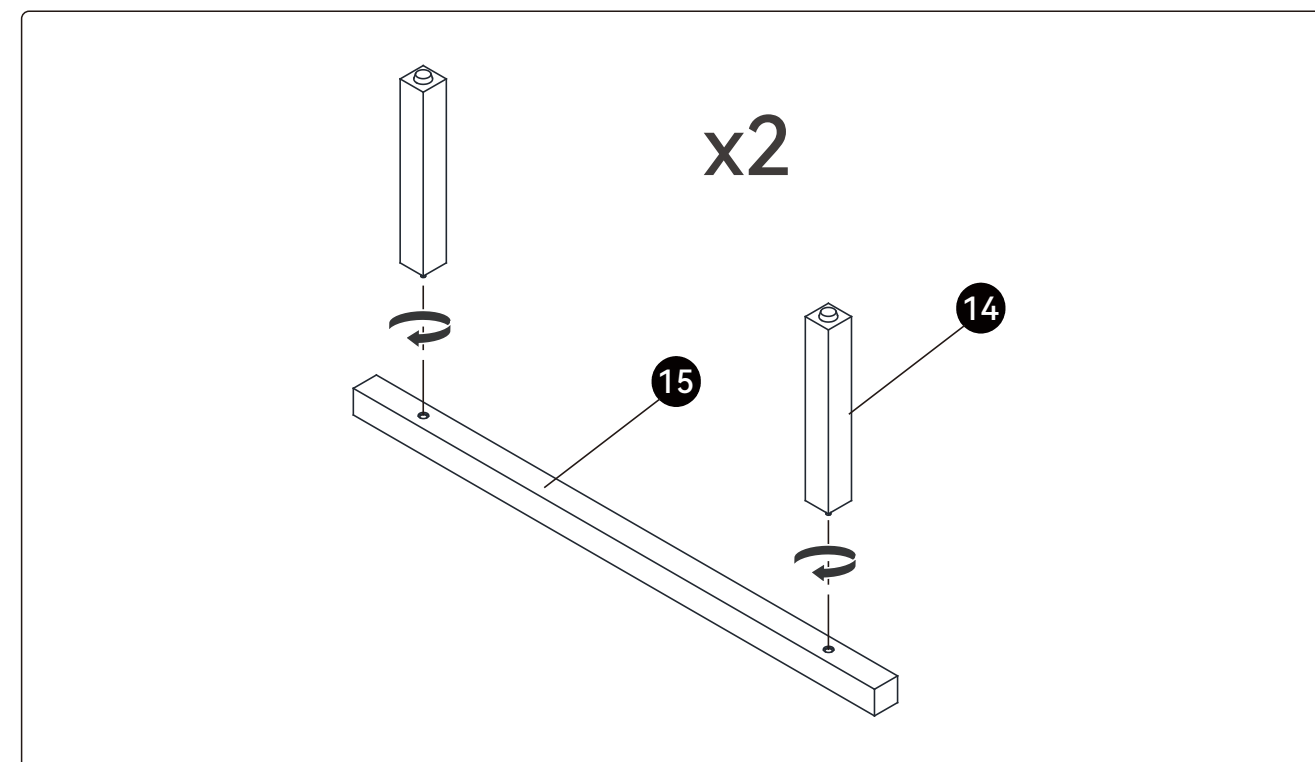
Frame Parts Section



Assemble the footboard with siderails from Step 6 with the headboard from Step 3, using barrel nuts (D) as illustration.

Step 8

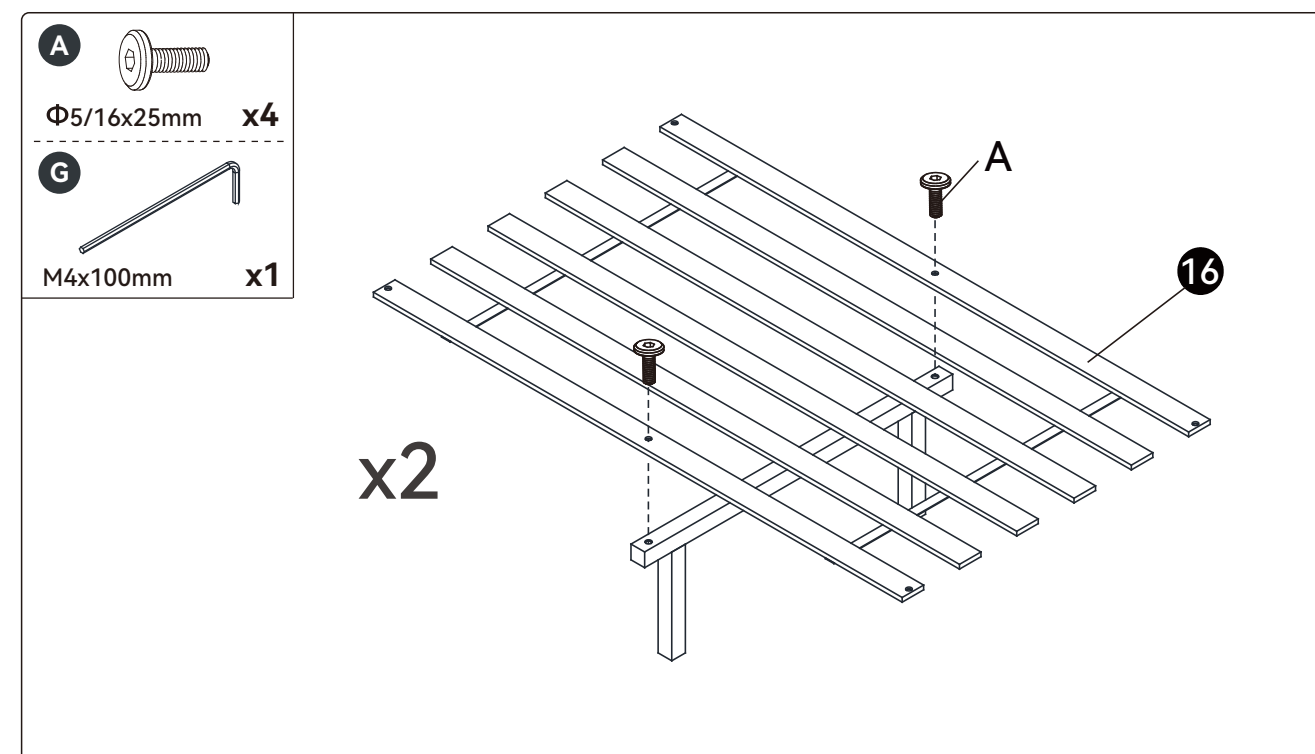
Frame Parts Section



Twist the middle legs(14) clockwise into supporting rails(15), repeat the step twice to finish.

Step 9

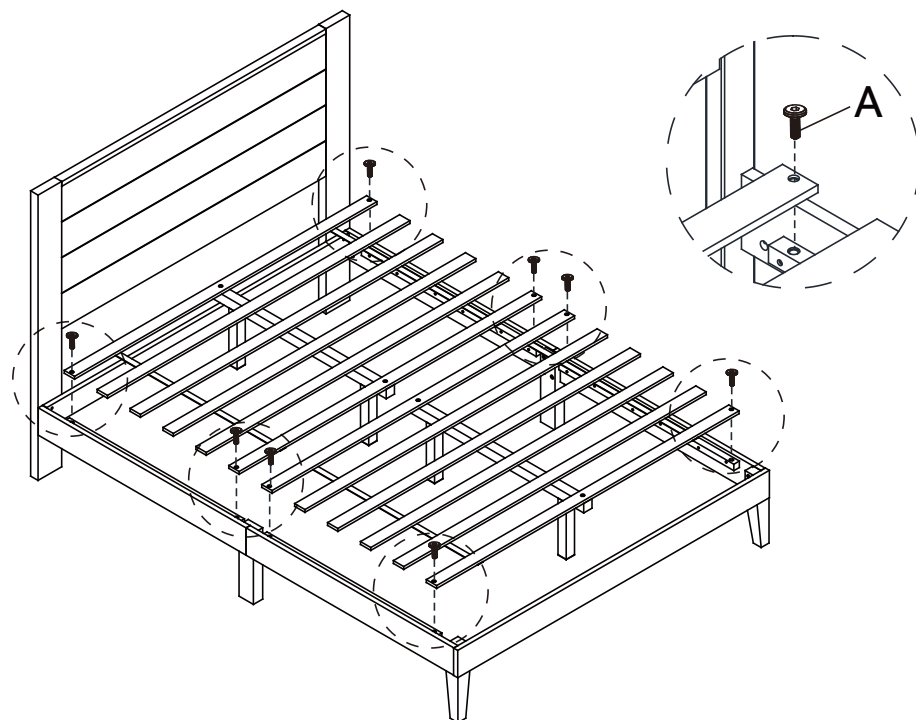
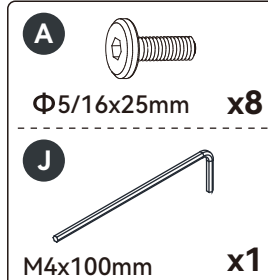
Frame Parts Section



Align the center slats assembly(from Step 8) to the holes along the slat kit(16) using the bolts (A) to tighten. Repeat the step twice.

Step 10

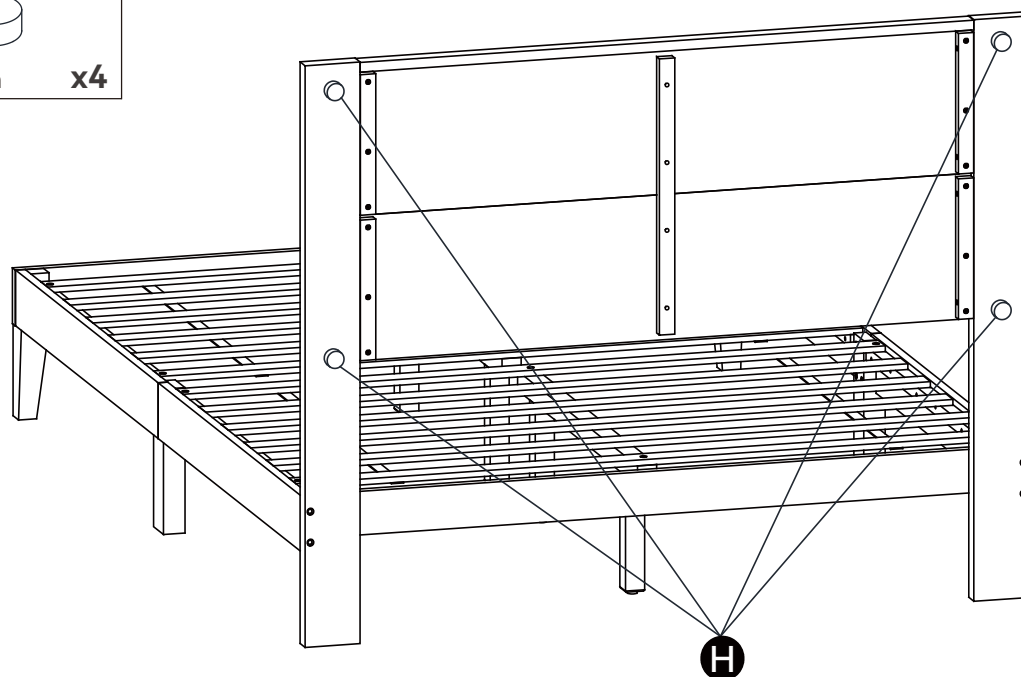
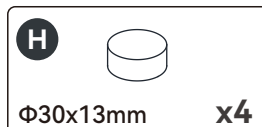
Frame Parts Section



Place the slat kit onto the side rails, then insert the bolts (A) into each end. Secure using the Allen Wrench (J).

Step 11

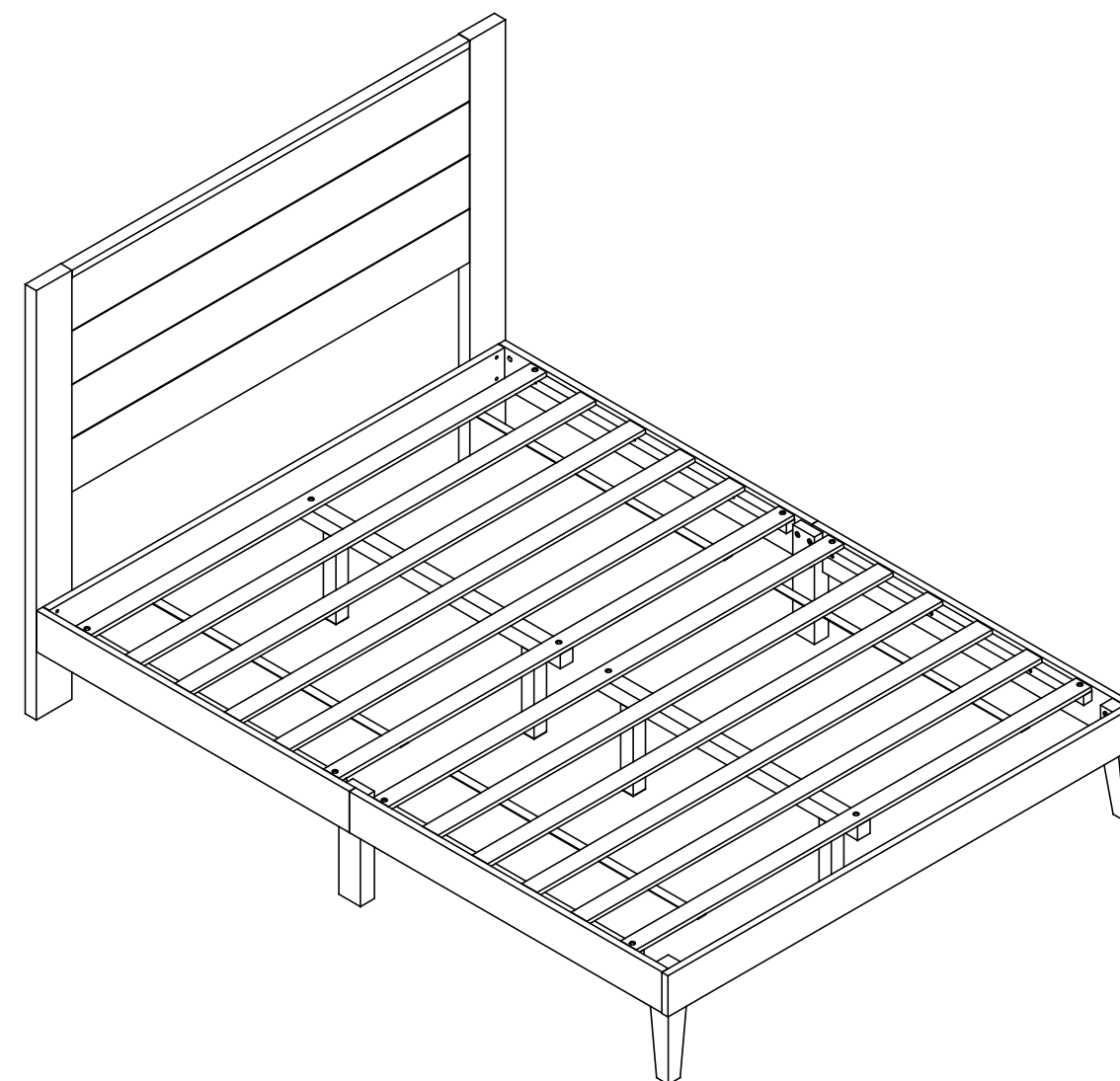
Frame Parts Section



Attach the silent pad (H) as illustration to provide the cushion.
