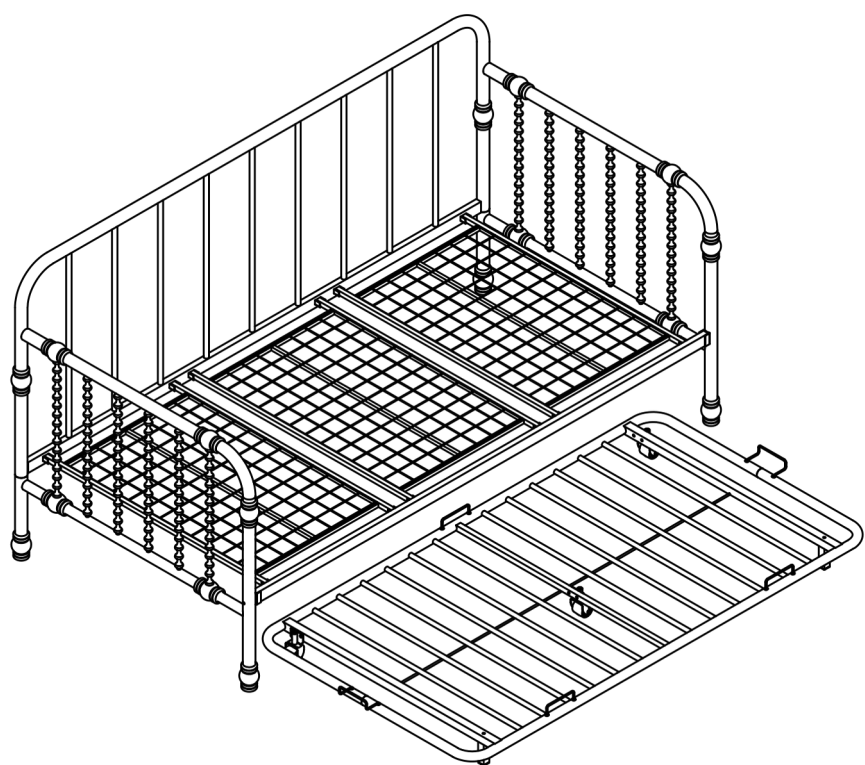

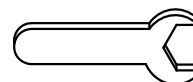

PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

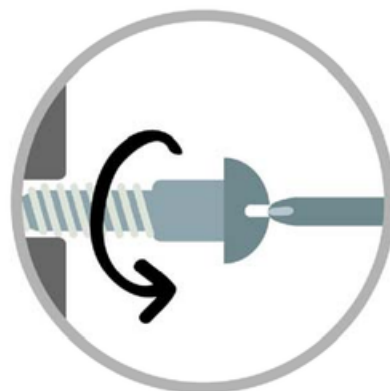
ASSEMBLY AND CARE ADVICE

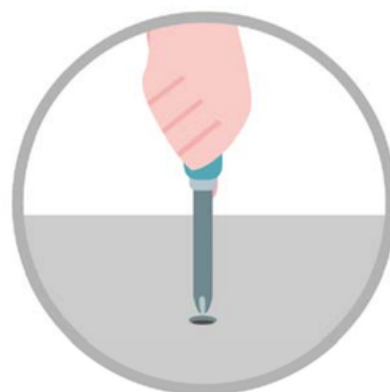
Position each part correctly
and insert screws or bolts into
their respective holes.



Turn clockwise to tighten and
only tighten when step is
completed or when instructed
to do so.



Use the appropriate hand tools
or power tools for assembly.
Select steps, such as tightening
screws and/or bolts, may require
hand tools to avoid causing
damage during assembly.



Save the instructions and store
any supplied tools for later
maintenance.

After two weeks, check and
tighten any loose hardware and
repeat again every six months
thereafter.

Part (#1) x 1pc
Part (#2) x 2pcs



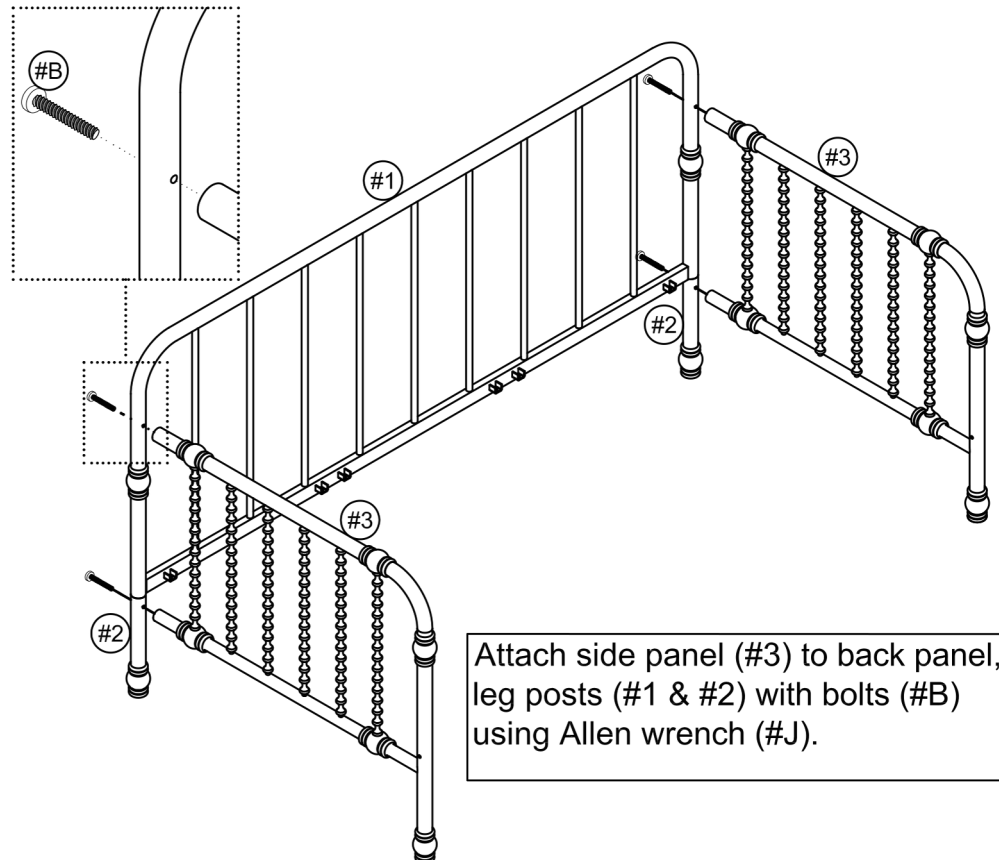
Note:
Keep bolts loose during initial assembly. Tighten bolts only after all parts are assembled for best alignment.

Insert leg posts (#2) into back panel (#1).

Attach side panel (#3) to back panel, leg posts (#1 & #2) with bolts (#B) using Allen wrench (#J).

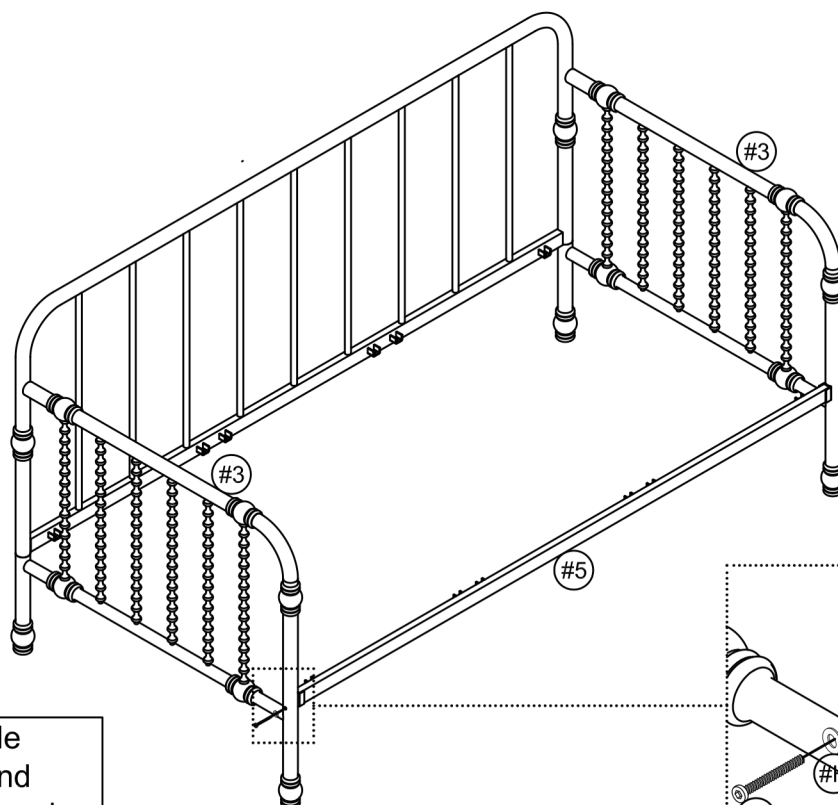

Attach front brace (#5) to side panels (#3) with bolts (#A) and washers (#H) using Allen wrench (#K).

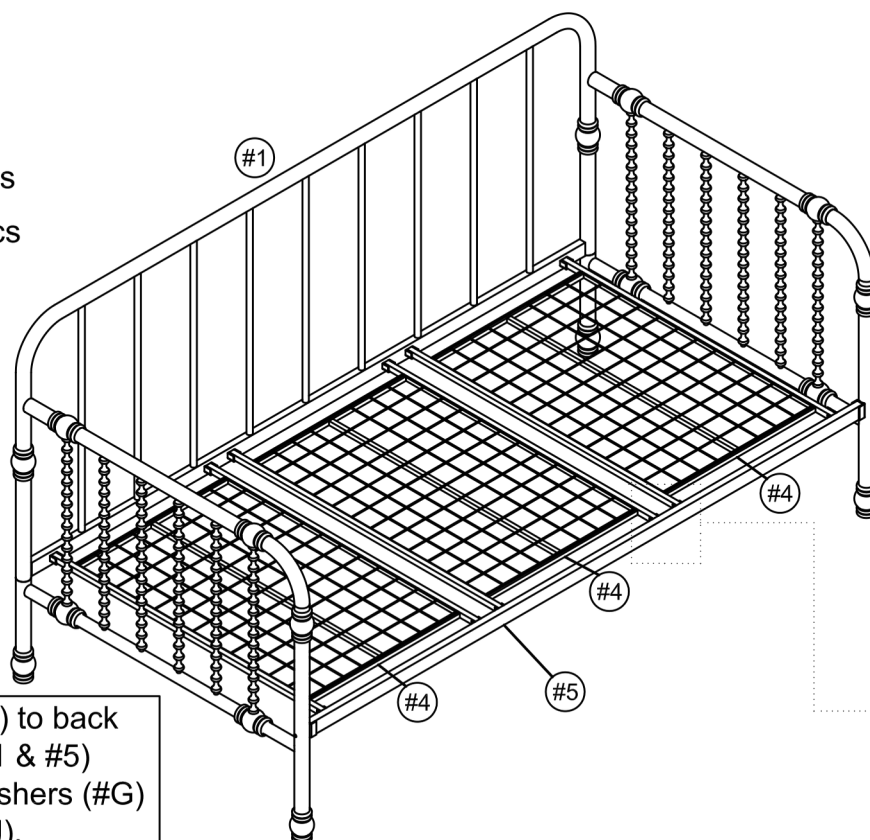

WARNINGS:

- Use only mattress which is 74"-75" long and 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ "-38 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.
- Do not allow horseplay or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.
- Periodically check and ensure that all the components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- Do not substitute parts, contact the store for replacement parts.
- Maximum total weight is not to exceed 400 lbs.
