Care & Maintenance



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.

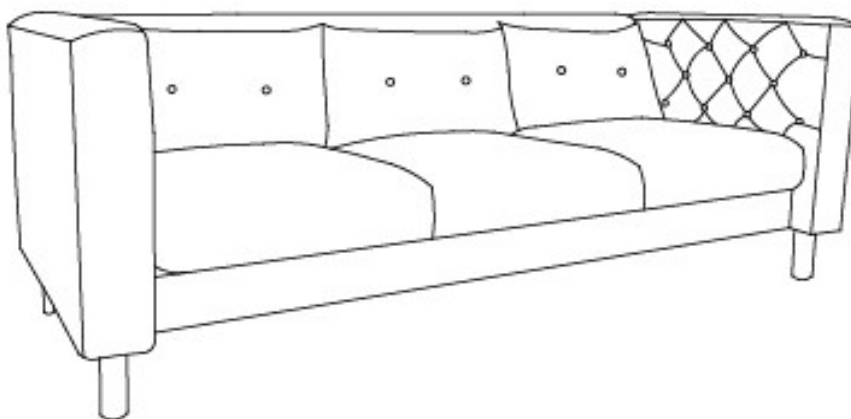


- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.

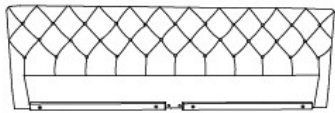


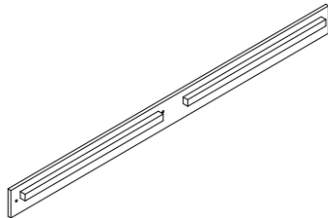
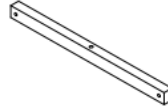
- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

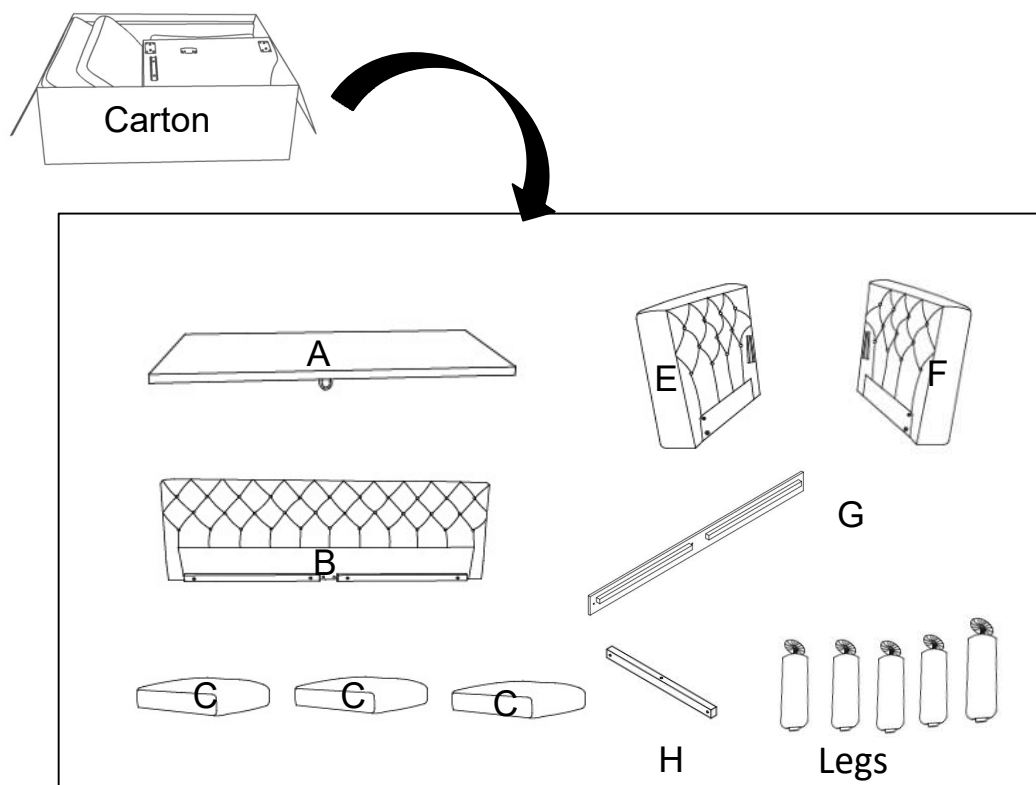

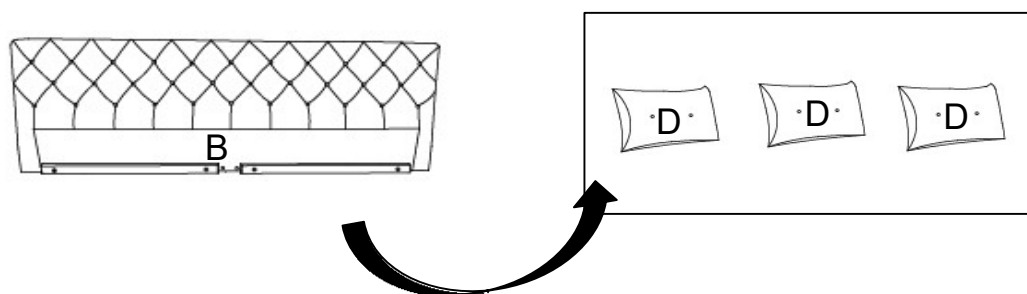
THIS SOFA HAS MULTIPLE PARTS AND MAY REQUIRE UP TO 30 MINUTES TO ASSEMBLE. TO GIVE YOU AN OVERVIEW OF THE SOFA PARTS, THE ABOVE PICTURE IS TO HELP YOU PUT THE VARIOUS PARTS INTO PERSPECTIVE. PLEASE READ THROUGH THE INSTRUCTIONS BELOW TO FAMILIARISE YOURSELF WITH THE PARTS AND STEPS BEFORE ASSEMBLY.

Step 1



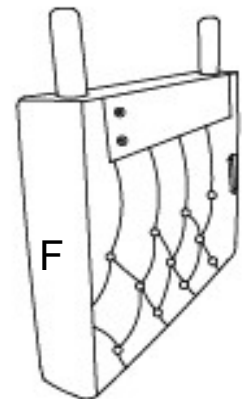
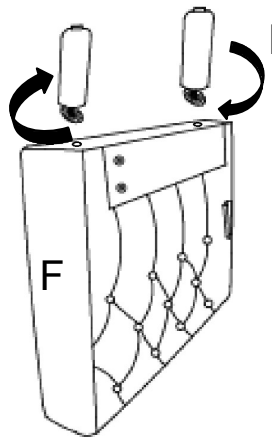
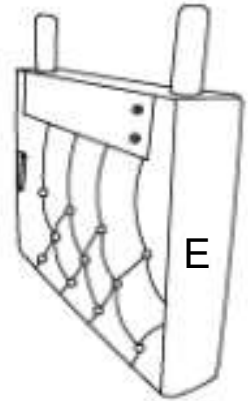
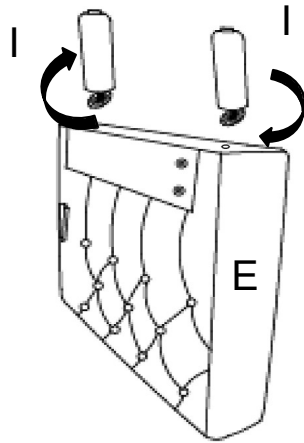
Remove the seat panel (A), backrest (B), seat cushion (C), left arm (E), right arm (F), front seat board (G), crosspiece (H), and legs from the carton and place them on a clean, level surface that will not scratch or damage the parts.

Step 2



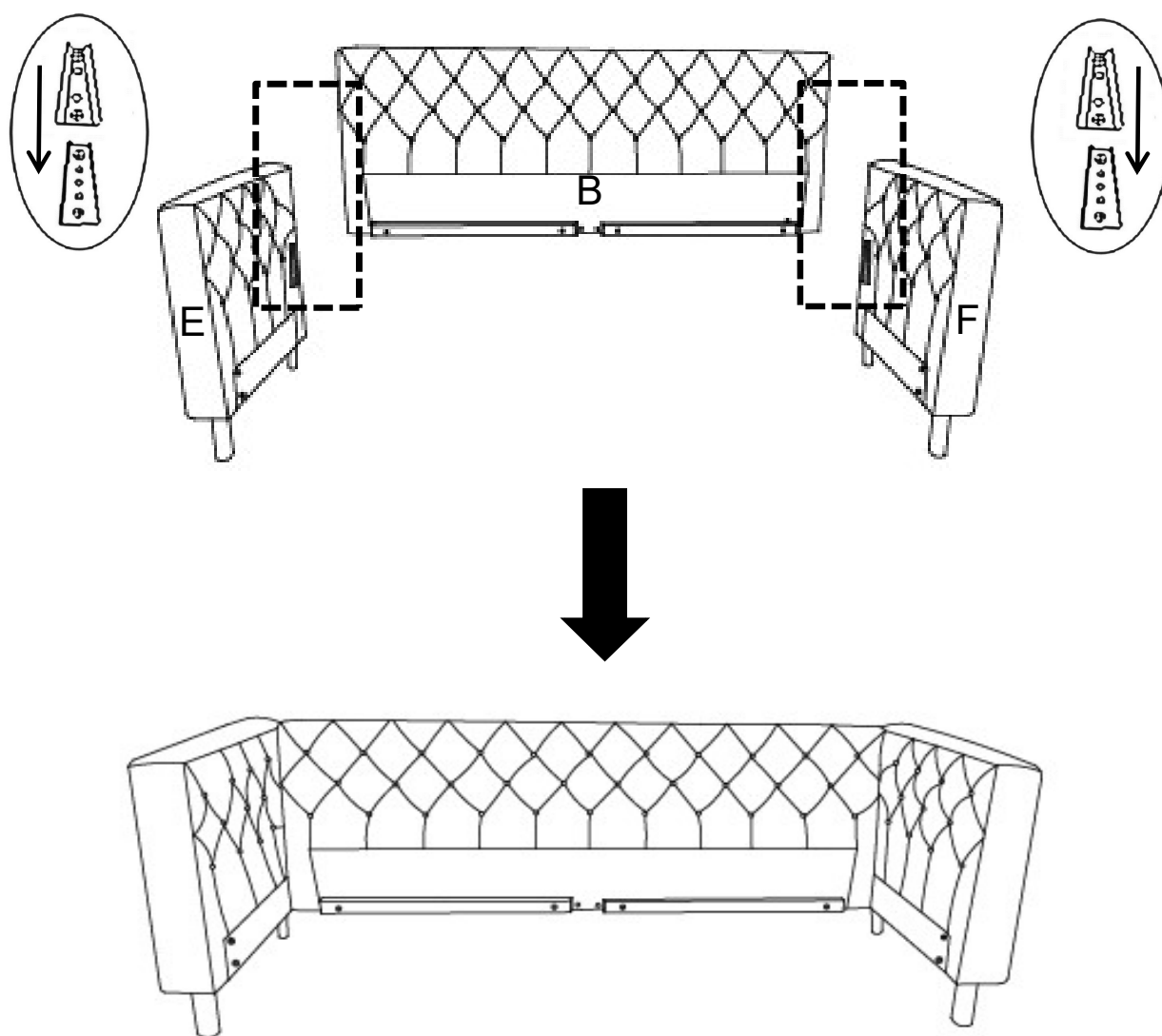
Take out the back cushion (D) from the bottom of the backrest (B).

Step 3



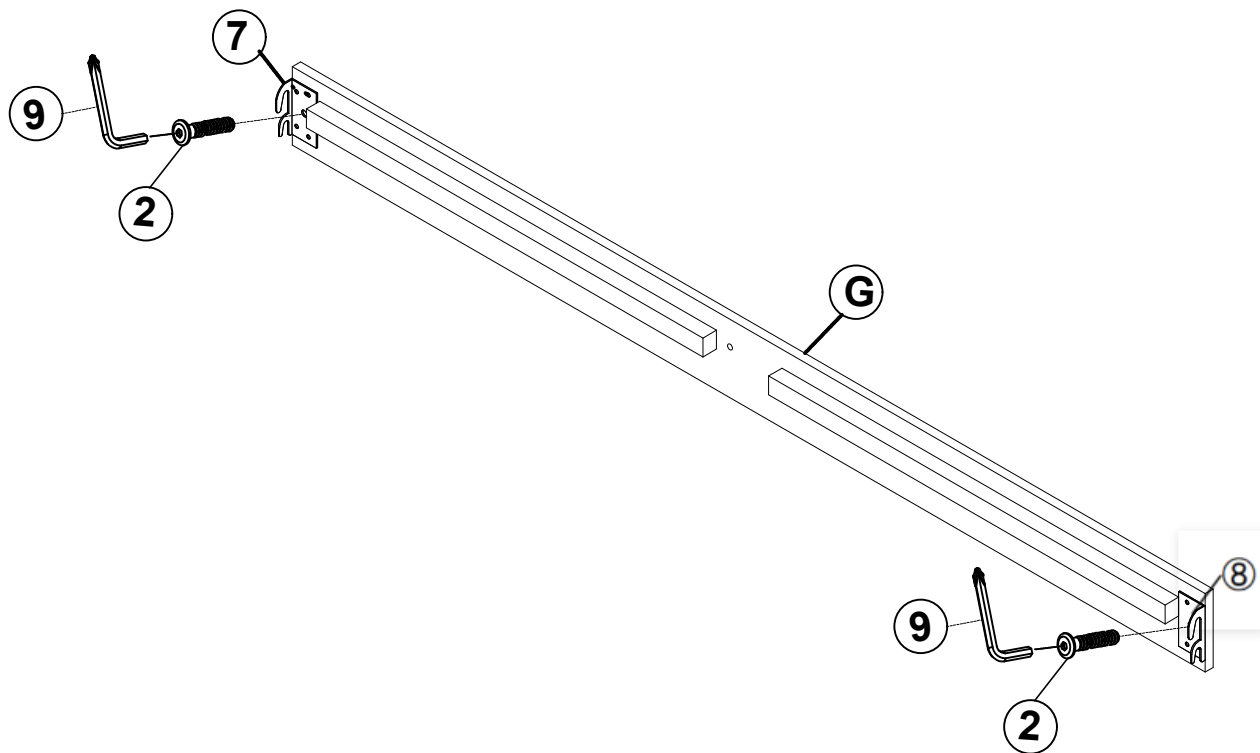
Install the Legs (l) onto the bottom of the Left Arm (E) and Right Arm(F). Tighten the legs by turning them clockwise by hand. Pay attention to the orientation and shape of the legs, and ensure they are installed in the correct positions. Note: The use of Plastic Gaskets is optional and is particularly helpful in reducing slight wobbling. Some legs may require more than one gasket, while others may not require any gaskets at all.

Step 4



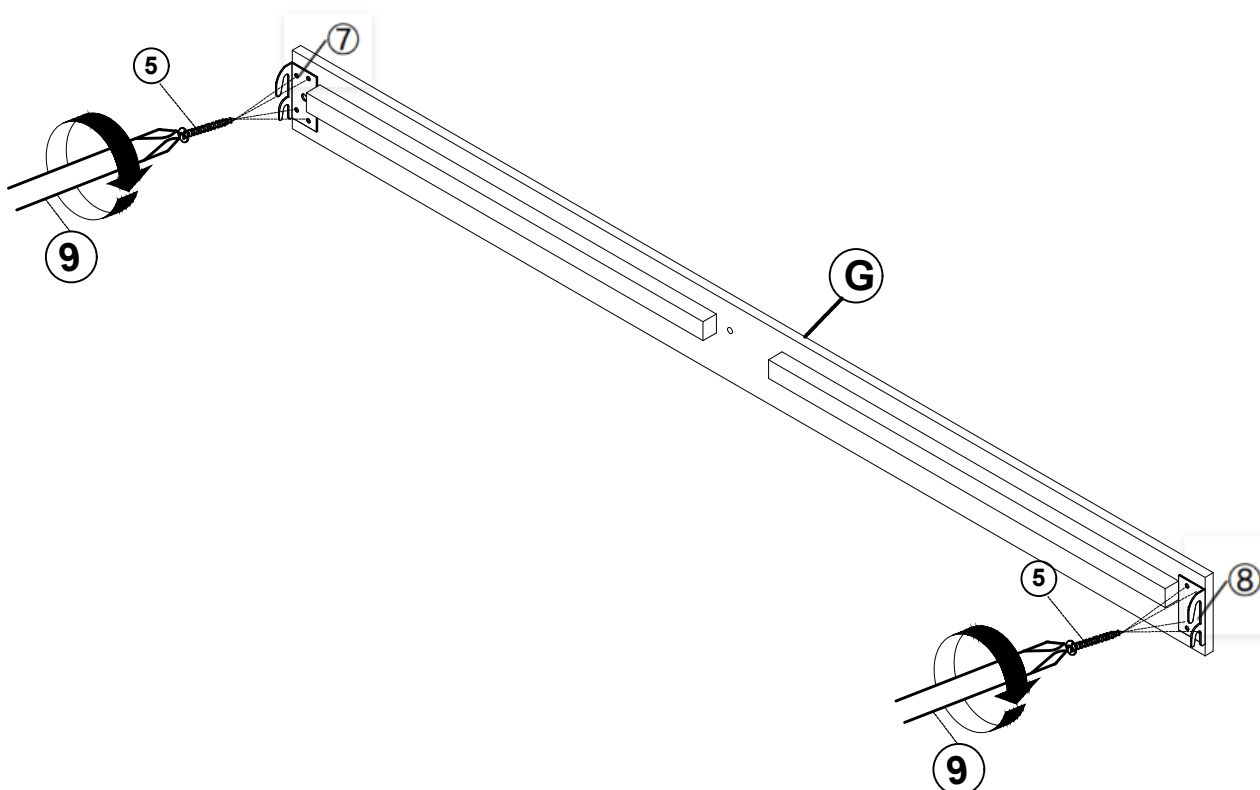
With assistance from your adult partner, hold up the backrest(B). Align the mounting brackets on both sides of the backrest(B) with those on the Left arm(E) and right arm(F). Then slide backrest(B) downward by hand to make sure it locks into place as pictured.

Step 5



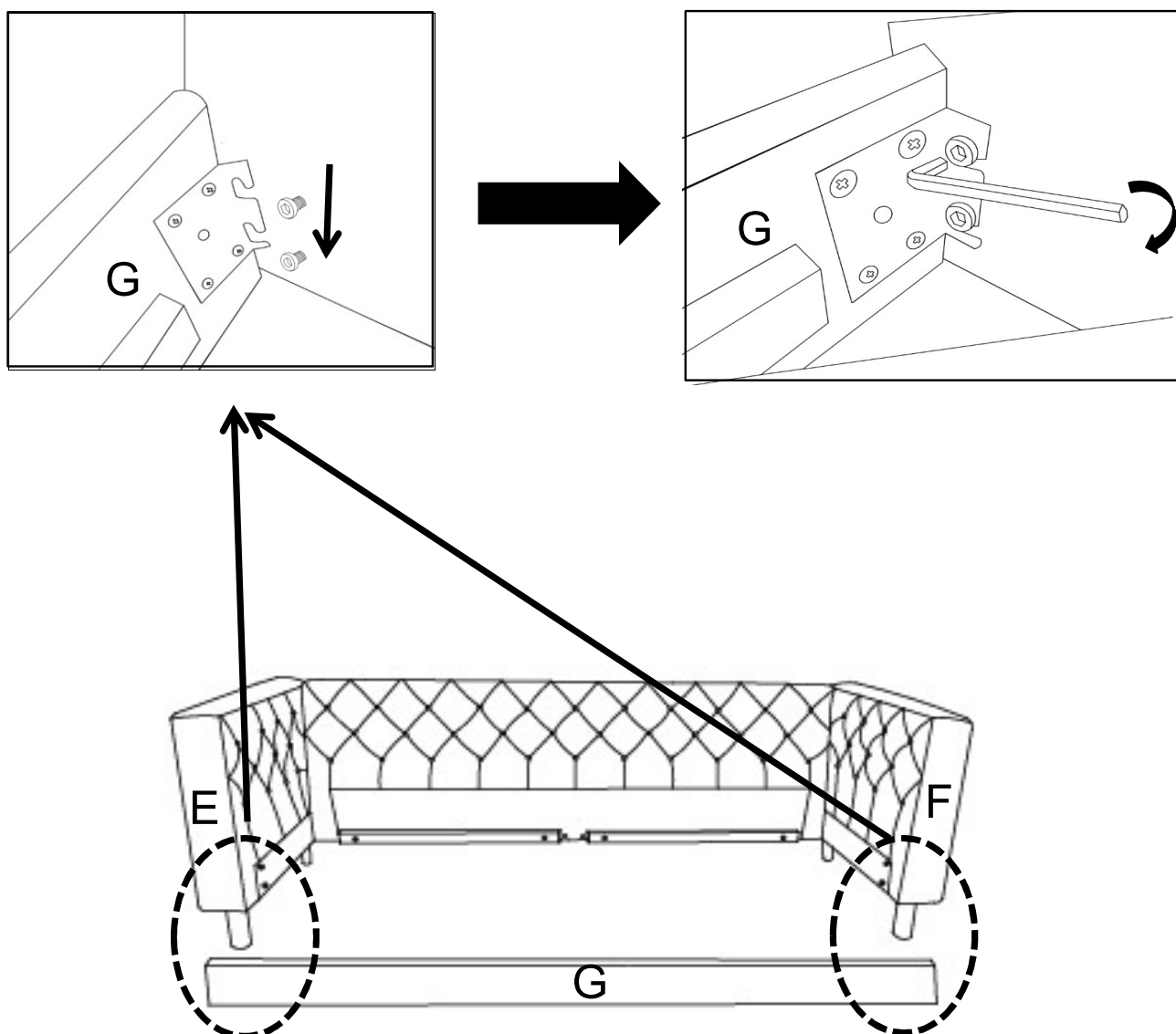
Position components (7) and (8) correctly on part (G). Secure them using bolts (2) togetherwith locking connectors (9), and tighten firmly as shown in the illustration.

Step 6



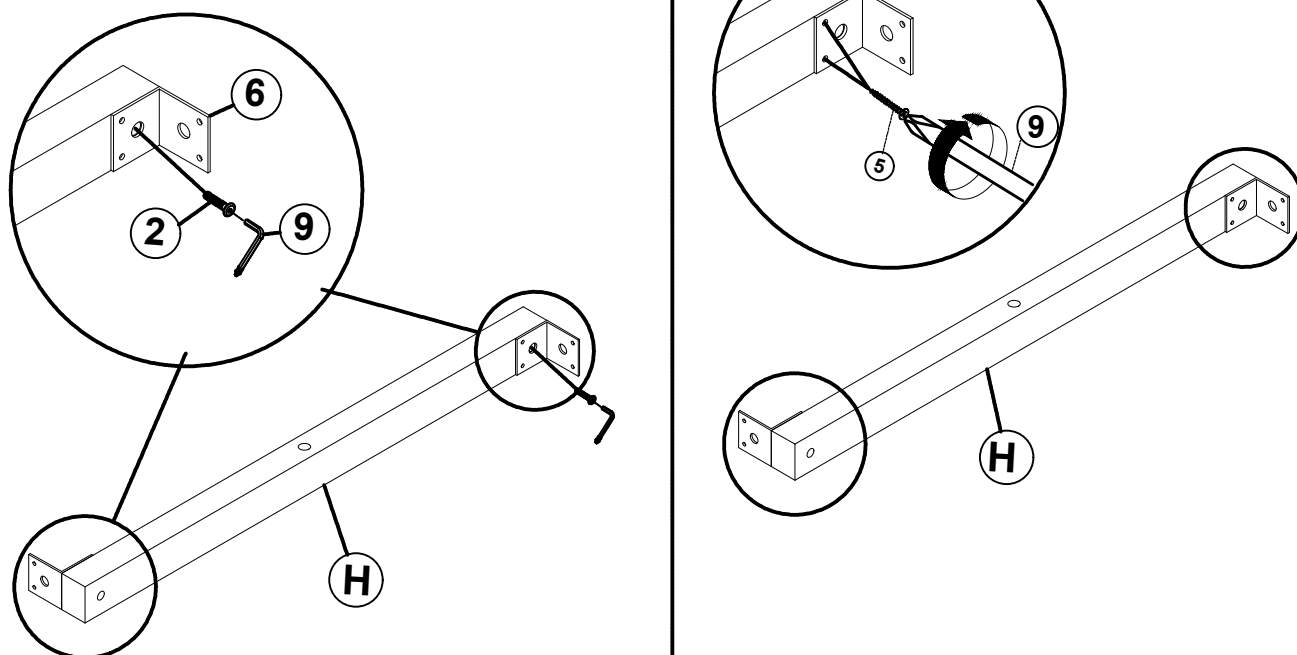
Use screw (5) and locking connector (9) to further secure and reinforce components (7) and (8) as shown in the illustration.

Step 7



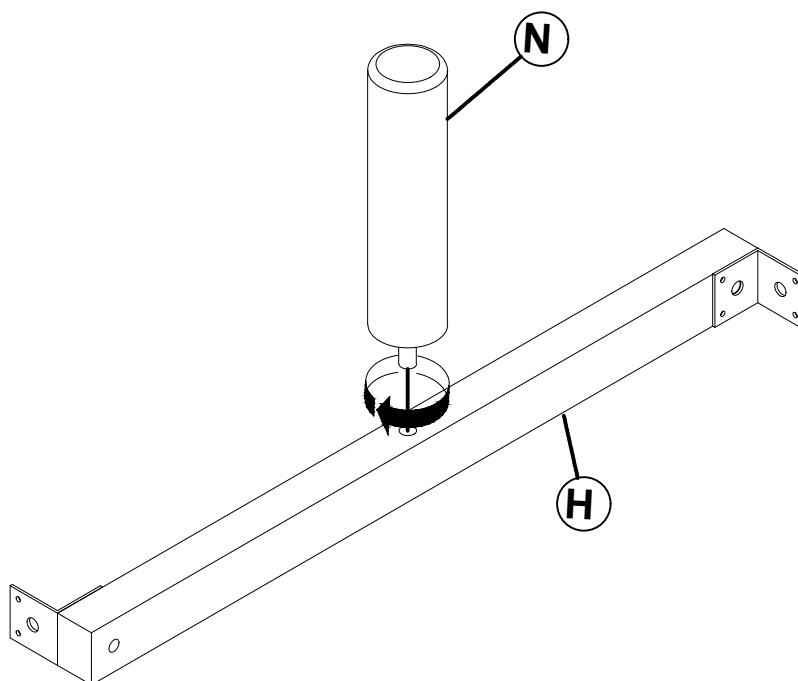
Lift the front seat board (G) and align it with the left arm and right arm. Position the metal brackets of the front seat board (G) correctly onto the left arm and right arm. Then secure them using bolt (1) and tighten firmly with allen wrench (9) as shown in the illustration.

Step 8



Position component (6) correctly on part (H). Secure it using bolt (2) together with locking connector(9), and tighten firmly. Then, use screw (5) to further fasten and reinforce component (6). Repeat this procedure at both locations as shown in the illustration.

Step 9



Install the Leg (N) onto the bottom of the Crosspiece (H).

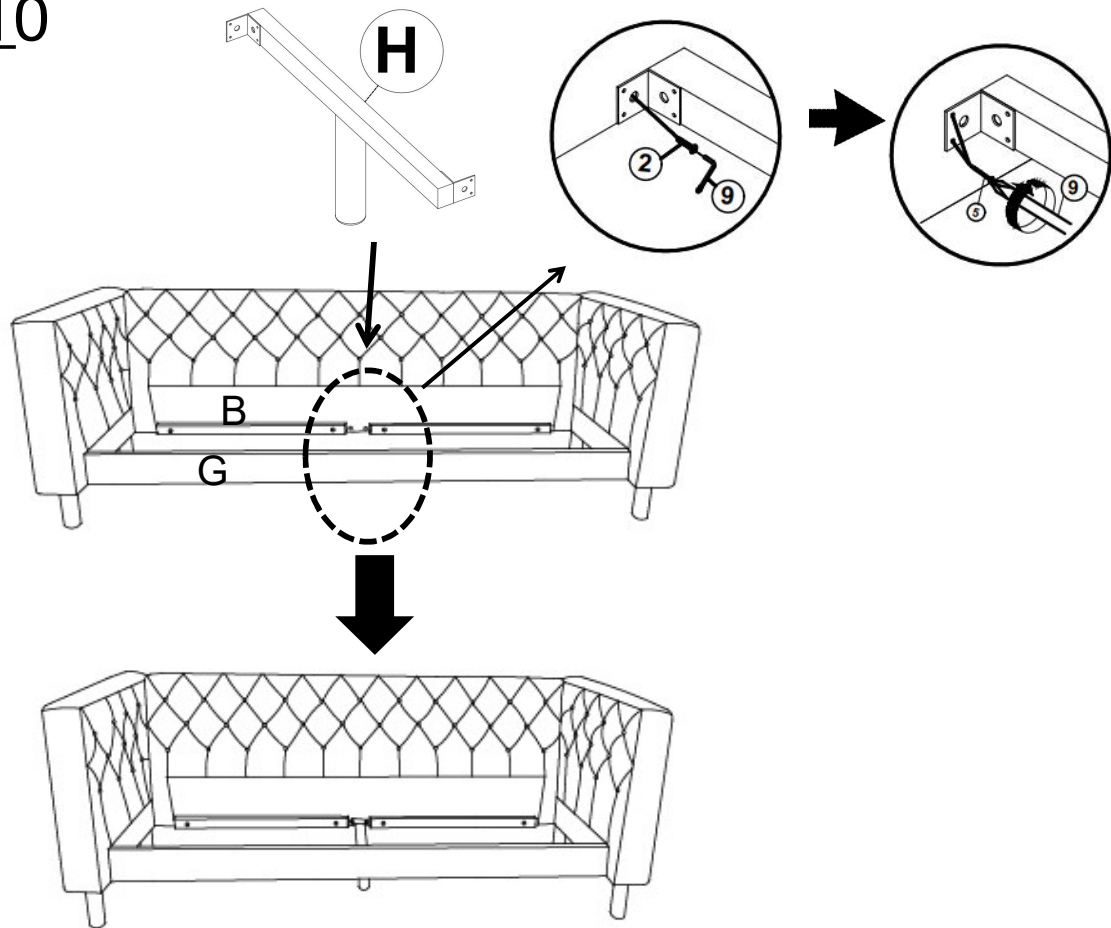
Tighten the leg by turning it clockwise by hand.

Pay attention to the orientation and shape of the leg, and ensure it is installed in the correct position.

Note: The use of plastic gaskets is optional and is particularly helpful in reducing slight wobbling.

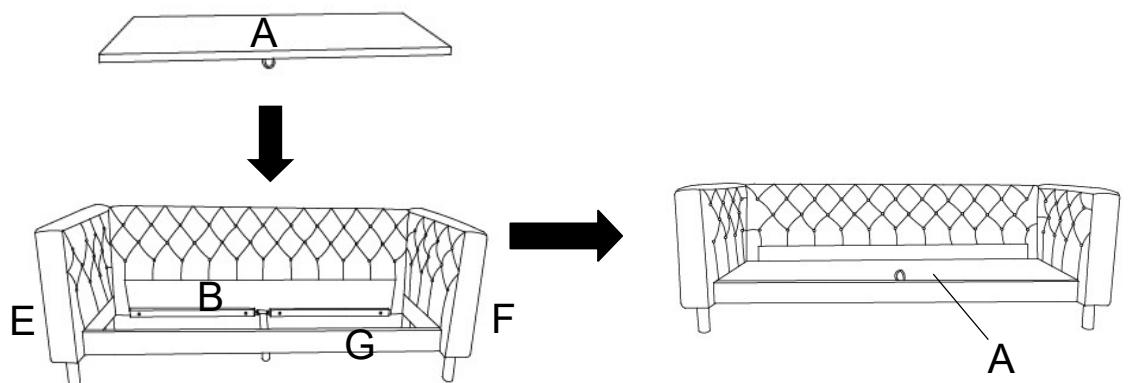
Some legs may require more than one gasket, while others may not require any gaskets at all.

Step 10



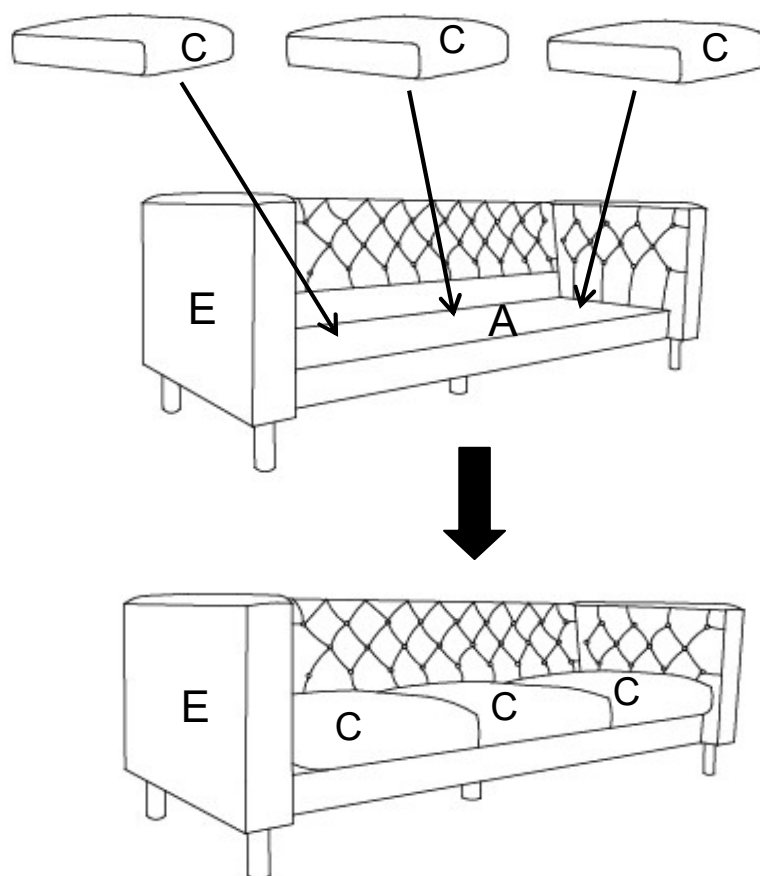
Place the Crosspiece (H) between the backrest (B) and the front seatboard (G), align the mounting holes, then secure it using Bolt (2). After that, use screw (5) to further reinforce the connection as shown in the illustration

Step 11



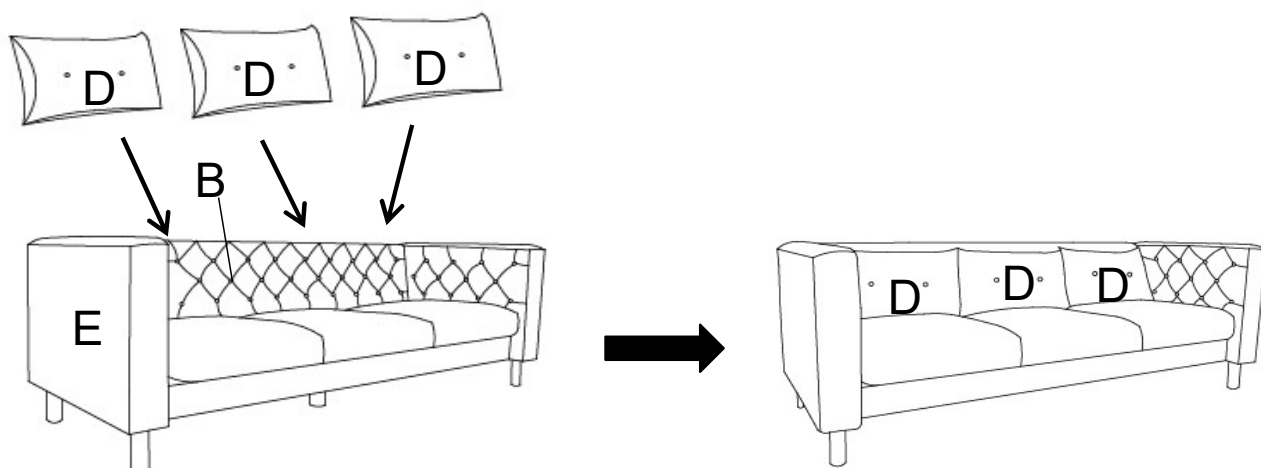
Hold up the seat panel (A) and align it to the SOFA

Step12



Put the seat cushions(C) on the seat panel(A).

Step 13



Place back cushion(D) on the backrest(B).

Your SOFA is ready for use.

This SOFA can only be used on a flat, level surface.
