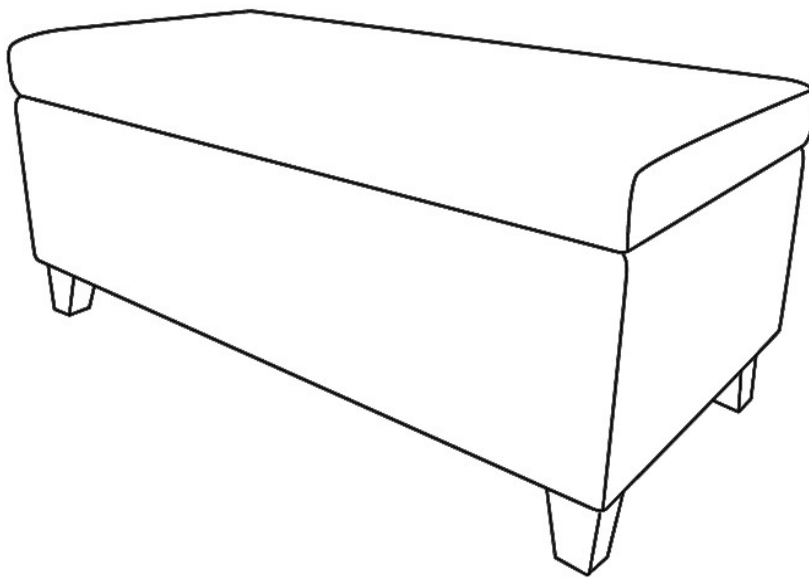


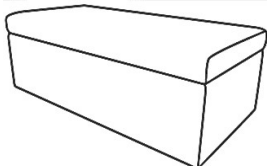

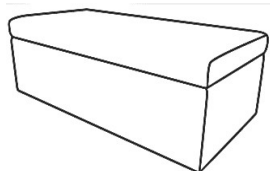

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



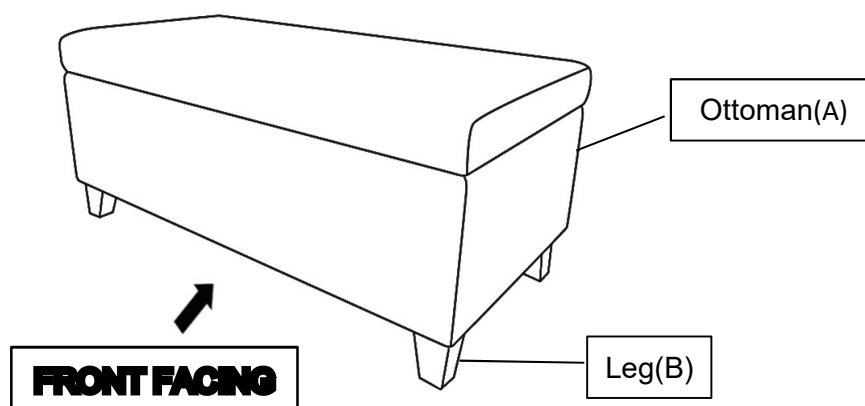
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-

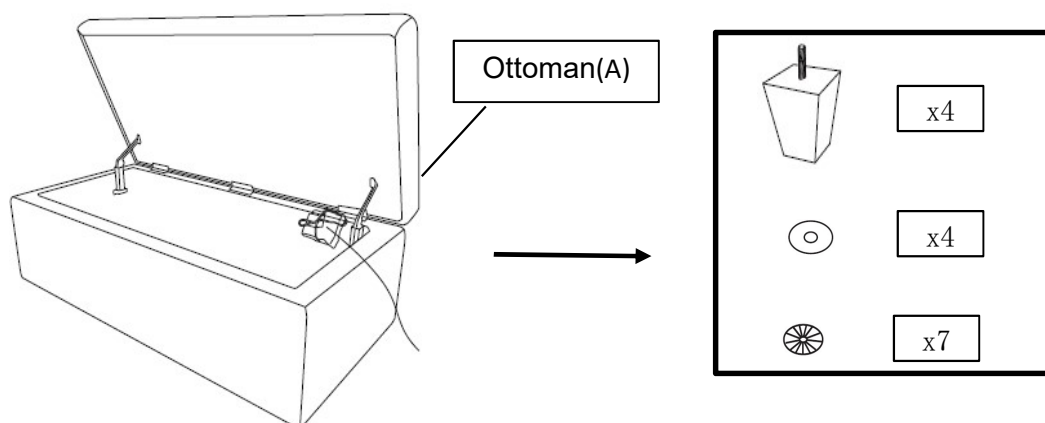
Assembly Steps

Overview

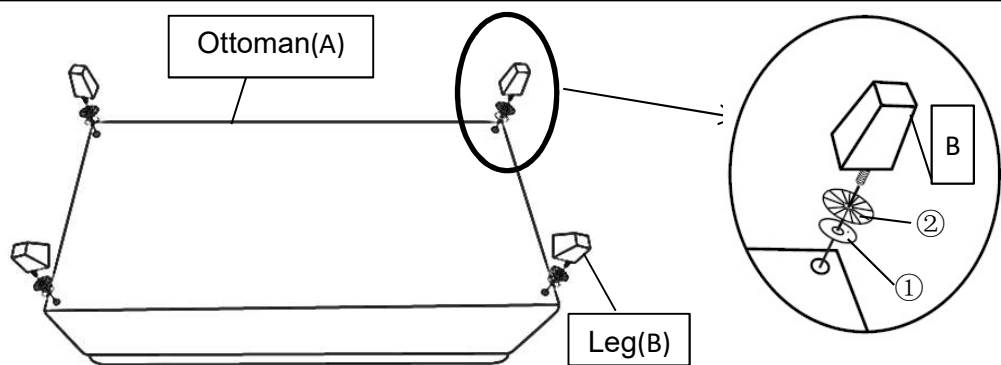


This Ottoman has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Ottoman parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

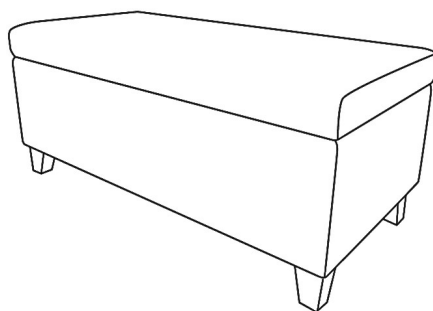
Step 1



Position the Ottoman(A) on its side on a clean, non-marring surface. Open the Ottoman(A) and remove the four Legs(B) and Hardware package. Then Close the pouch before assembling.

Step 2

With Assistance from your adult partner, position the Ottoman(A) facedown on a clean, non-marring surface, as shown. Install the Leg(B) onto the the bottom of the Ottoman(A) by putting a Plastic Washer(②)(optional but improves security and tightness), a Rubber Washer(①) onto the threaded stem. Insert the threaded stem into the threaded hole at each corner of the bottom of the Ottoman(A). Tighten the leg by turning clockwise. Repeat the same steps to install the remaining 3 legs.

Step 3

Your Ottoman is ready for use.
Your Ottoman can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Care & Maintenance



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only .



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only .



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth .
