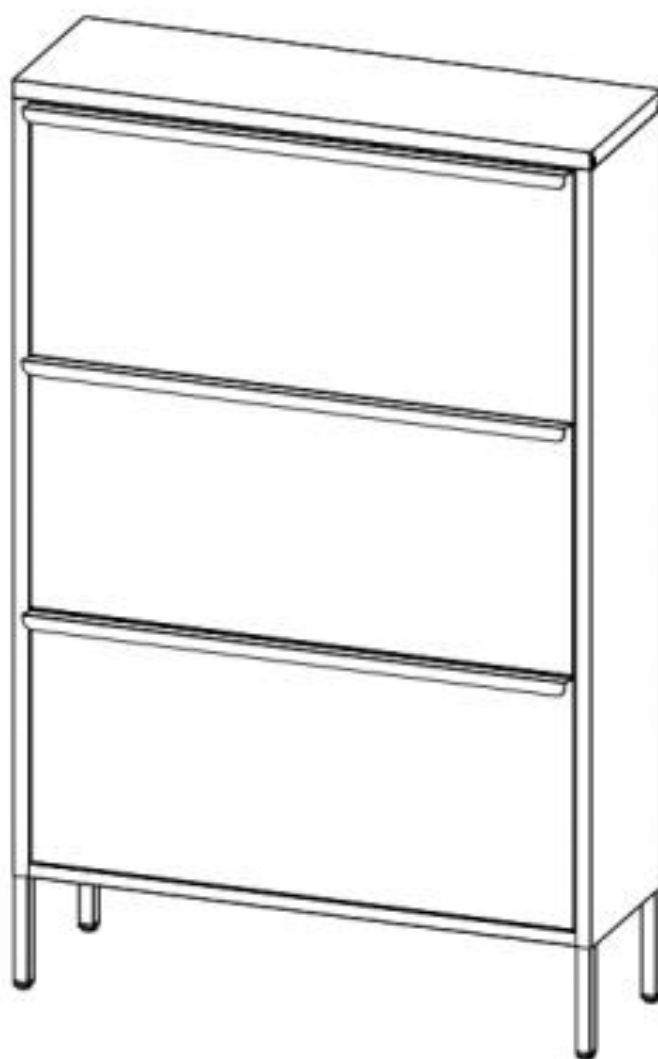


Shoe Cabinet

Assembly Guide



IMPORTANT: please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

CARE ADVICE**



NO POWER TOOLS

- Check you have all the components and tools listed
- Remove all fittings from their bags and separate into groups
- We do not recommend use of power tools - this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers and Allen keys
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could cause choking if swallowed
- Make sure you have enough space to lay out the parts before starting
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (same room) as possible
- Do not over tighten the nuts to avoid damage to the threads
- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent. Do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners
- From time to time, check there are no loose screws in this unit
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre

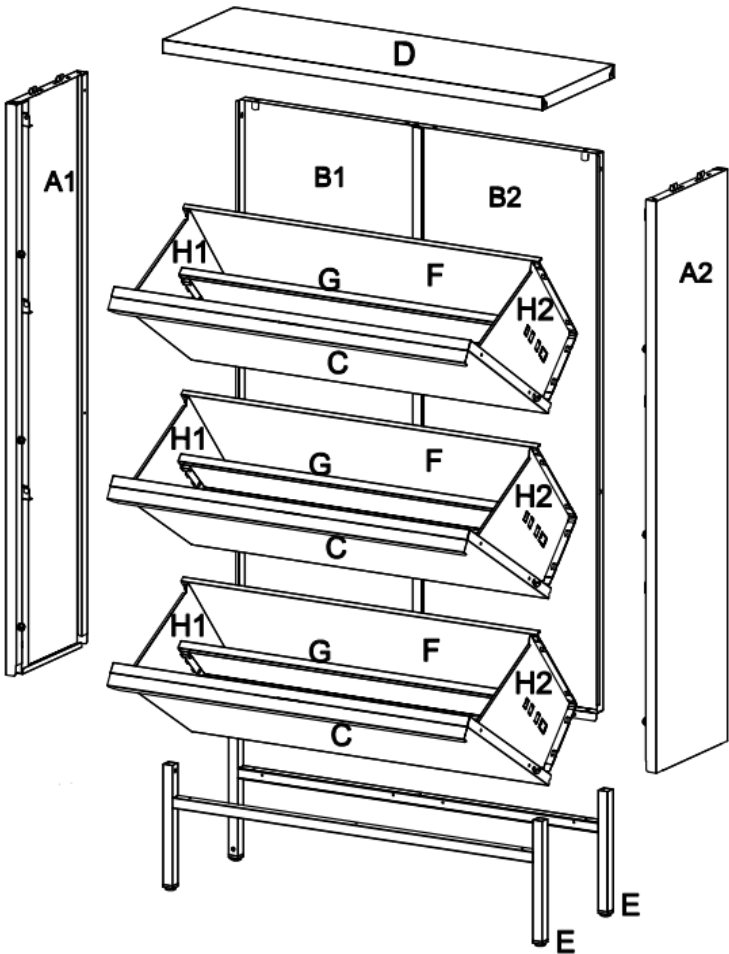

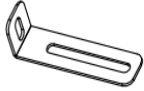

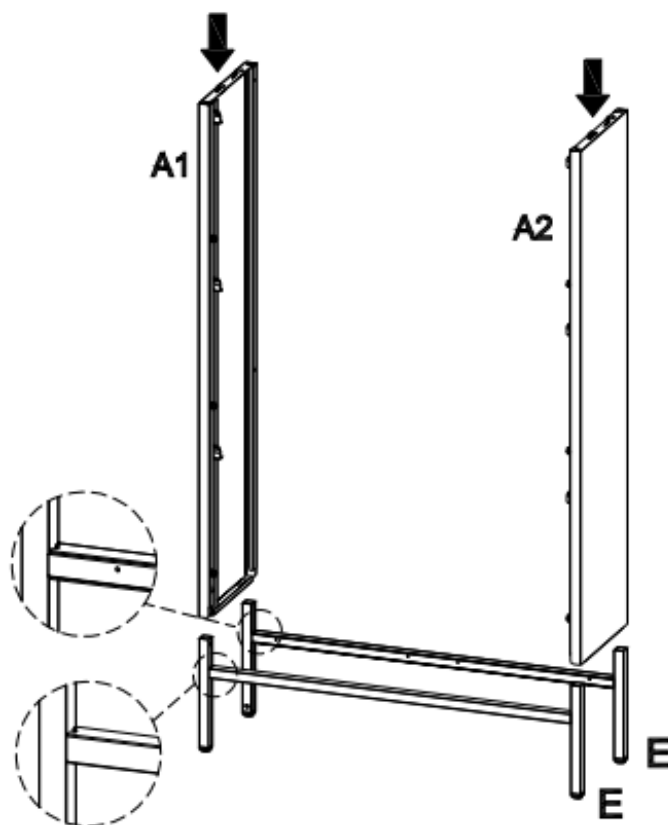

- Work on a flat, clean surface to prevent scratches or uneven assembly.
- Insert and align all fixings first, then tighten them evenly.
- Do not over-tighten, as this may damage parts.
- Lift and position the tabletop with two people to avoid damage.
- Attach rods to the tabletop using the stopper end only to prevent damage.

STEP 1

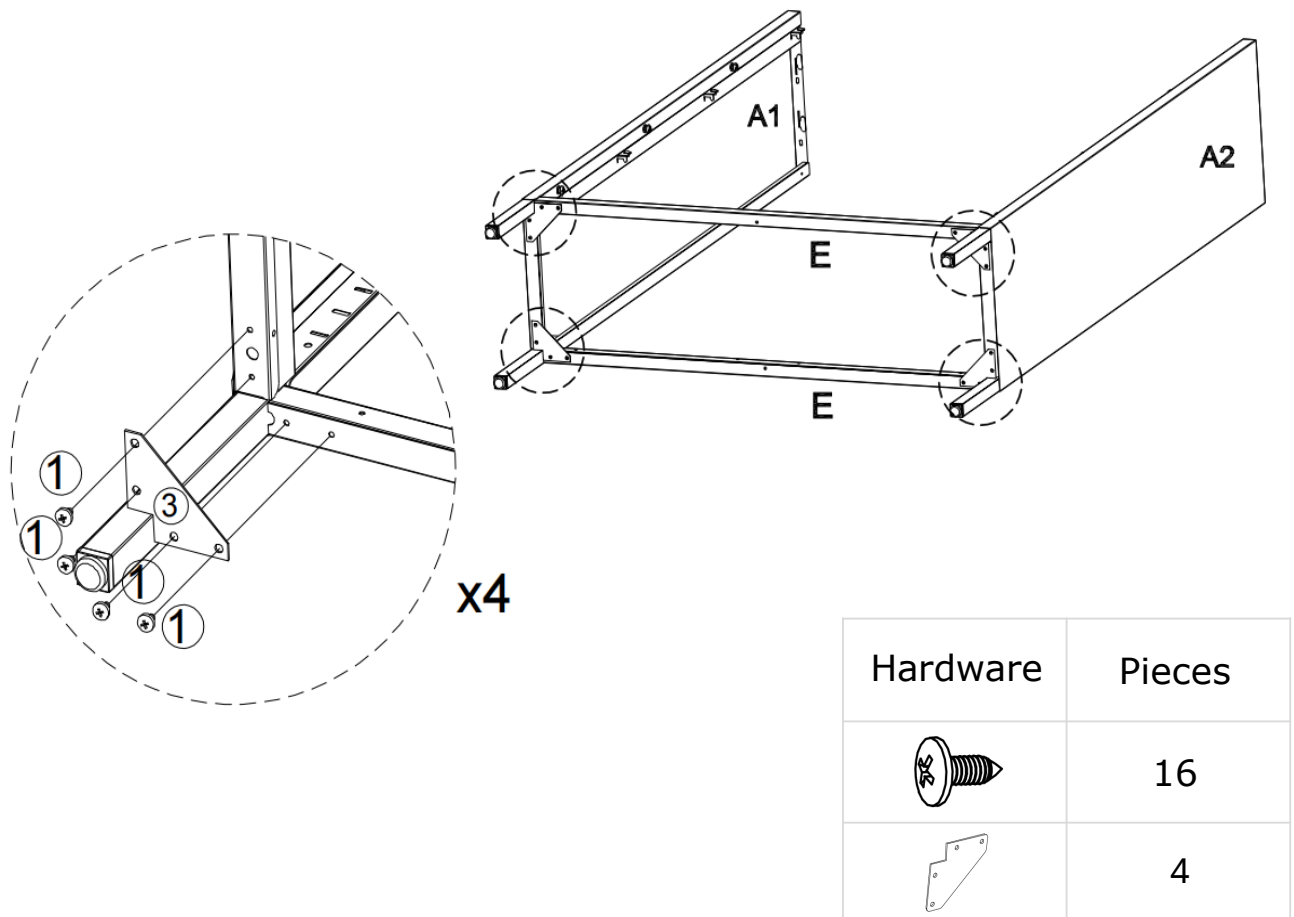
Insert the side panel (A1& A2) into the leg tube (E)

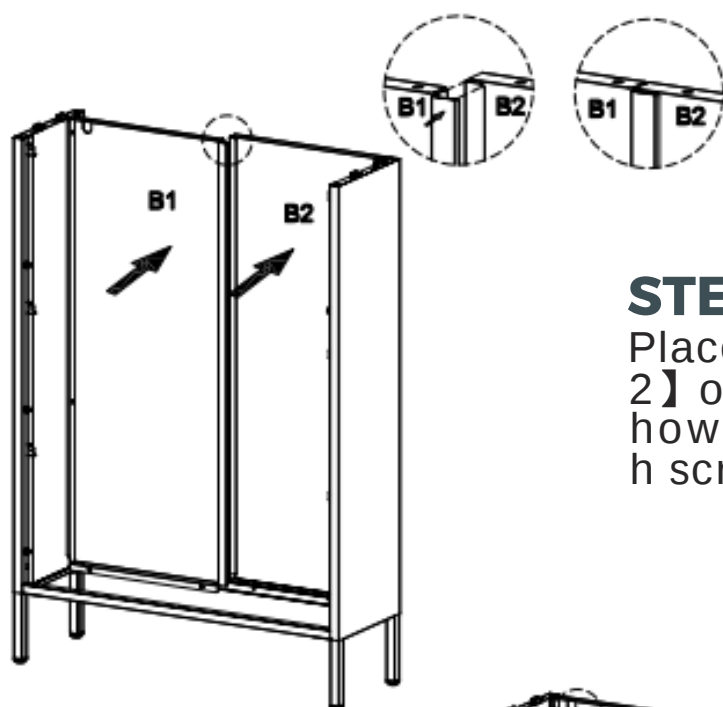


STEP 2

Fix the fixing plate **【3】** at the bottom four corners with screws **【1】**

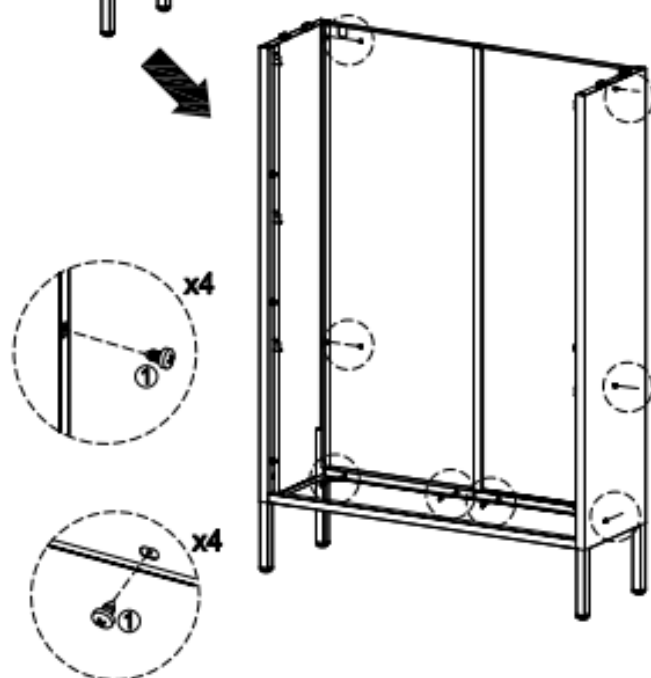
Insert and align all fixings first, then tighten them evenly.





STEP 3

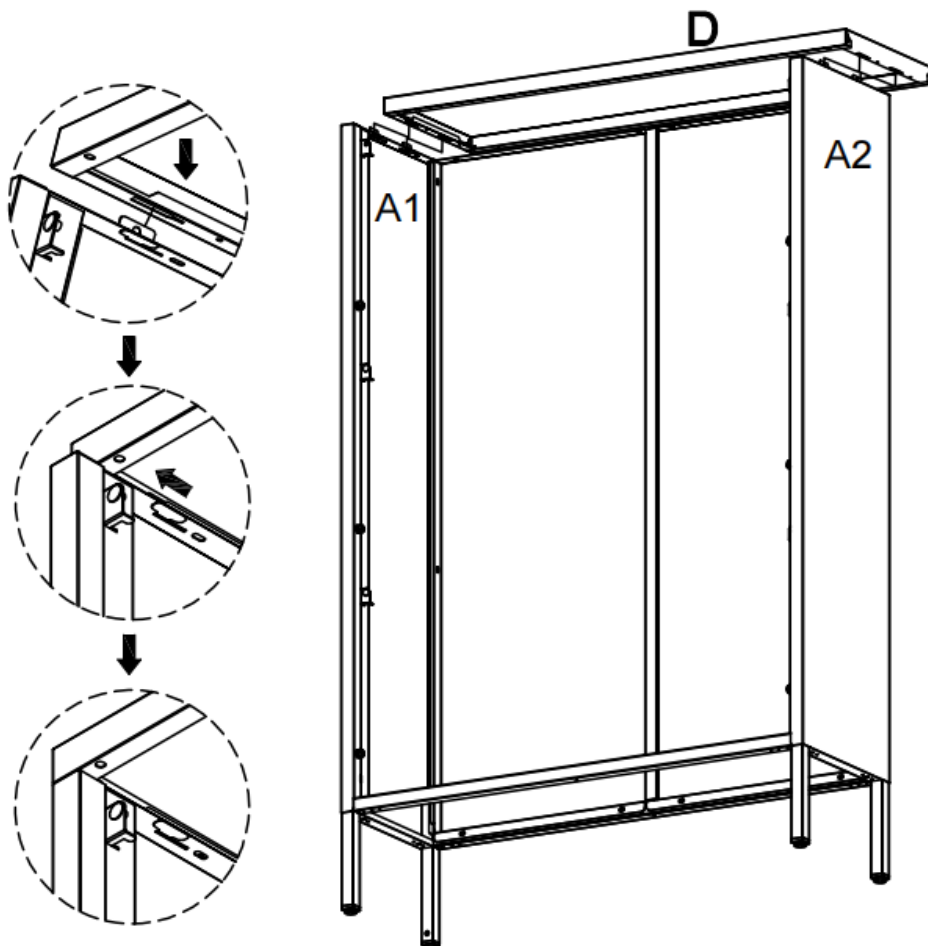
Place the back panel 【B1&B2】 on the leg tube 【E】 as shown in the picture. Fix with screws 【1】

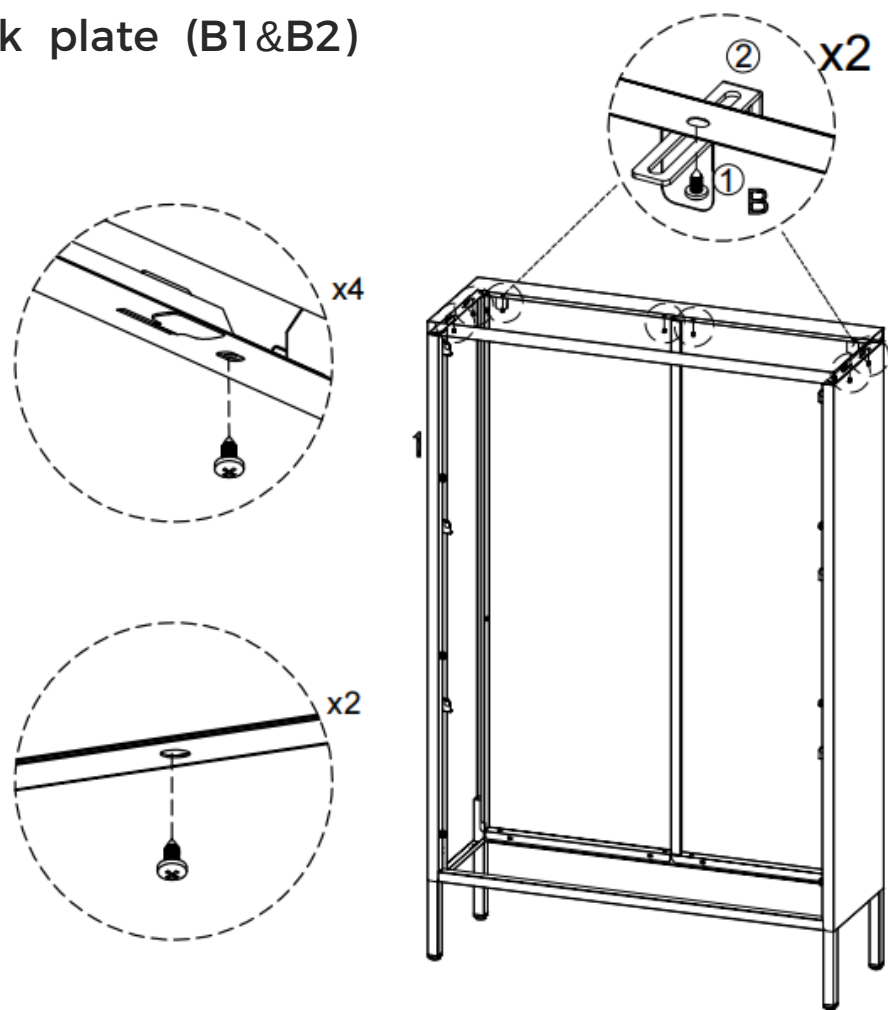
STEP 4

Place the top plate 【D】 above the two side plates 【A1&A2】 , aligning the protrusions on the side plates with the grooves on both sides of the top plate 【D】 . Slide the top plate 【D】 from back to front until aligned.



STEP 5

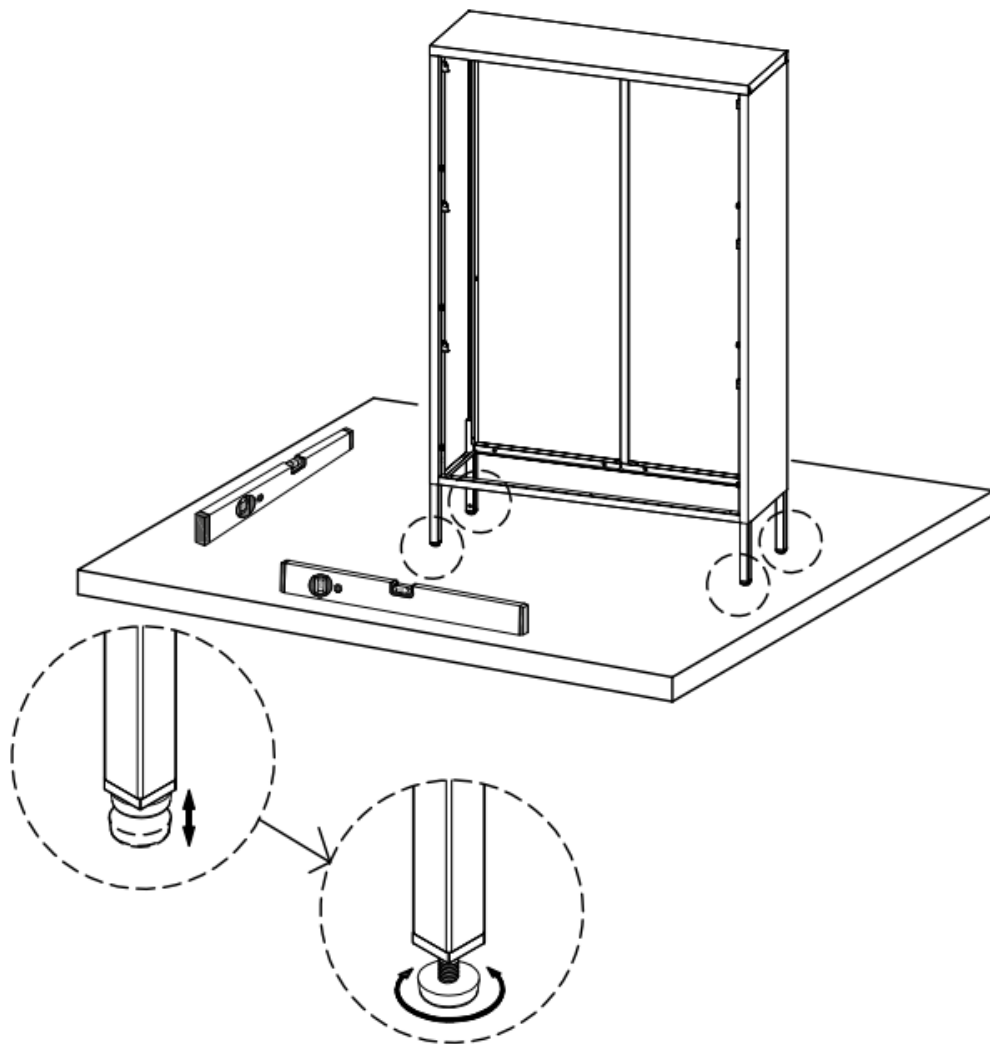
Fix the top plate(D) with screws (1) and fix the anti-tipping device (2) above the back plate (B1&B2)

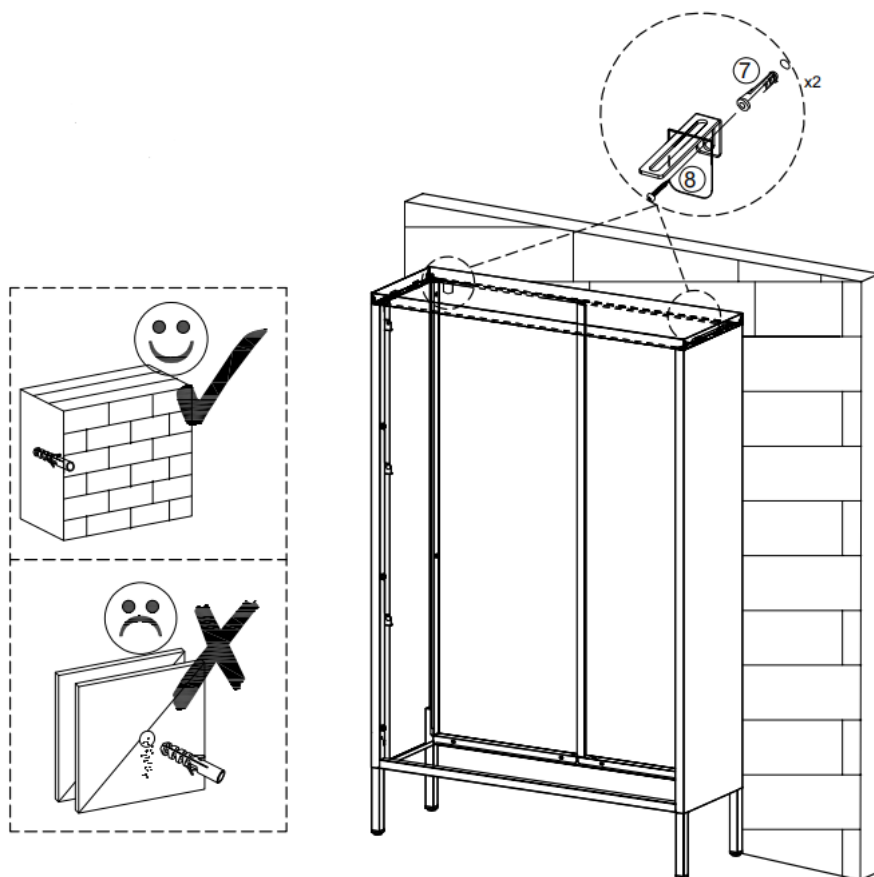
STEP 6

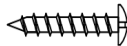
Before installing the drawer, please adjust the feet to ensure it is upright on a level surface.



STEP 7

Before installing the drawer, please use expansion tube (4) and expansion screw (5) fix the cabinet to the wall.

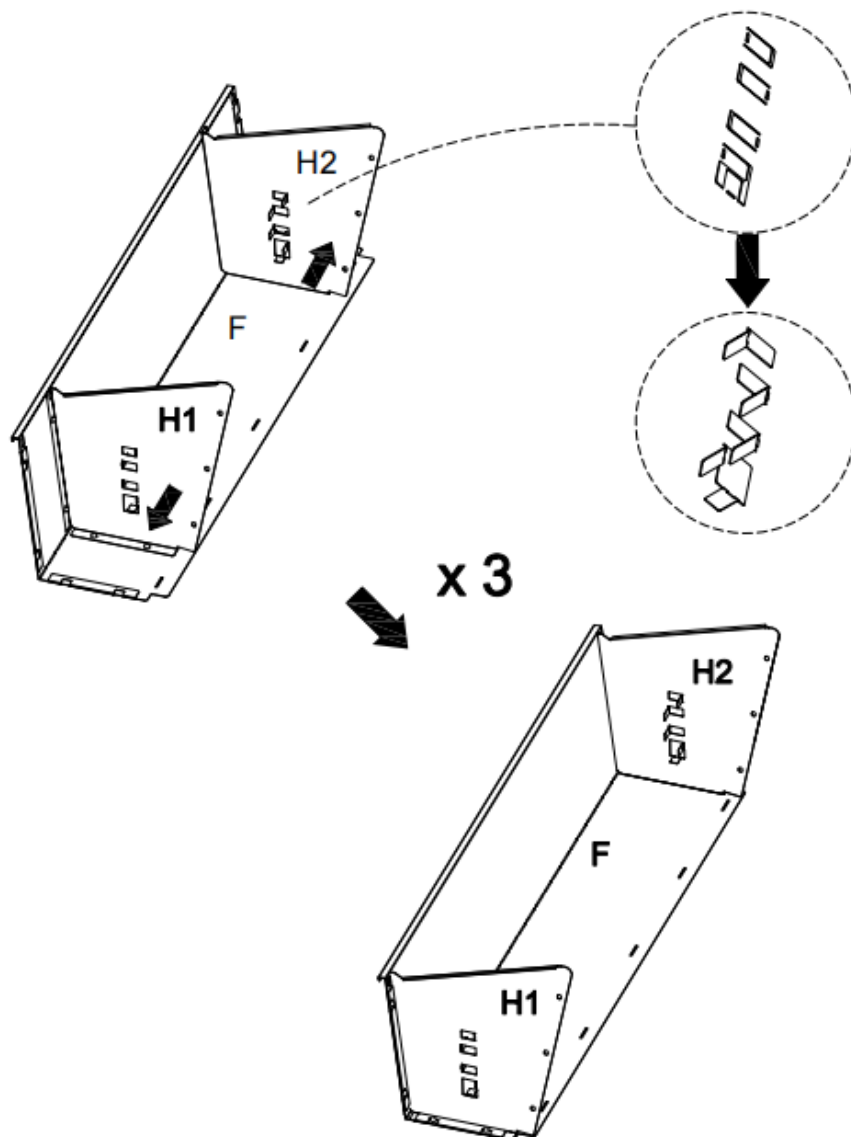

STEP 8

Insert the side panel of the drawer (H1&H2) into the groove on the side of the drawer bottom plate (F). Unfold the iron pieces with notches on the side panel (H1&H2).

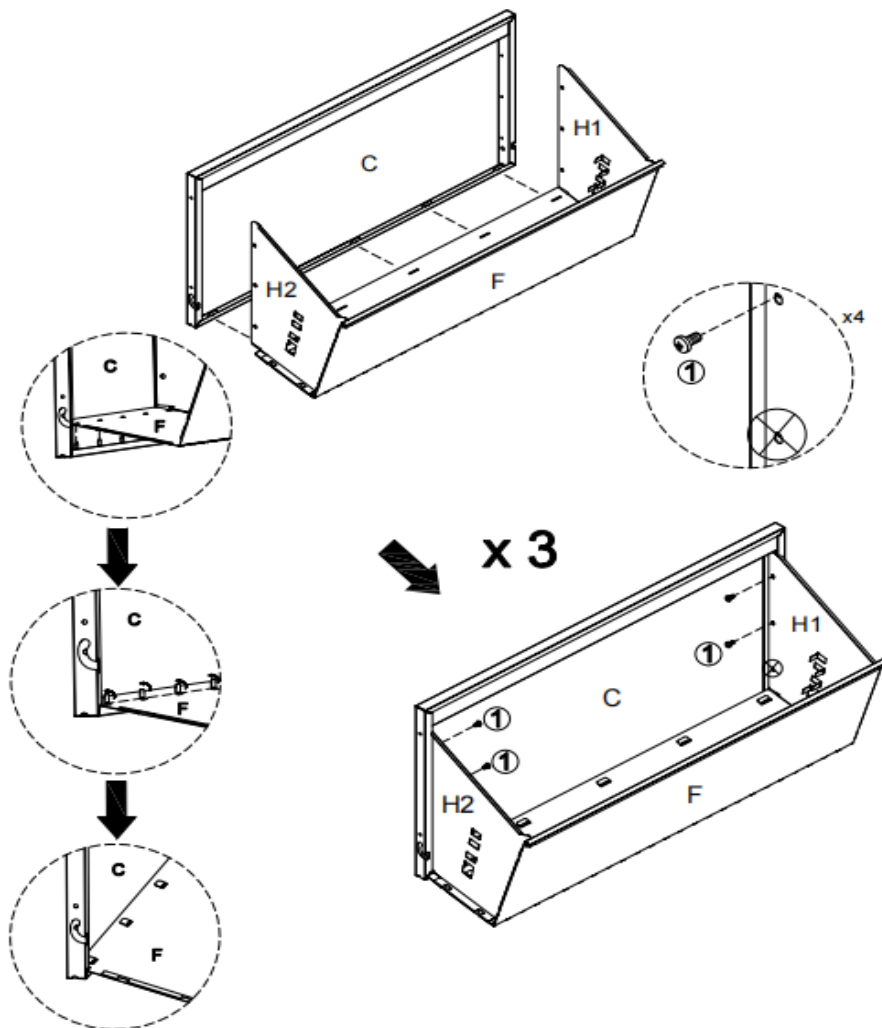
Repeat this step 3 times.



STEP 9

Insert the protrusion inside the drawer panel (C) into the opening of the bottom (F), and fold the iron sheet towards the drawer panel (C) direction. Then fix with screws (1)

Repeat this step 3 times.

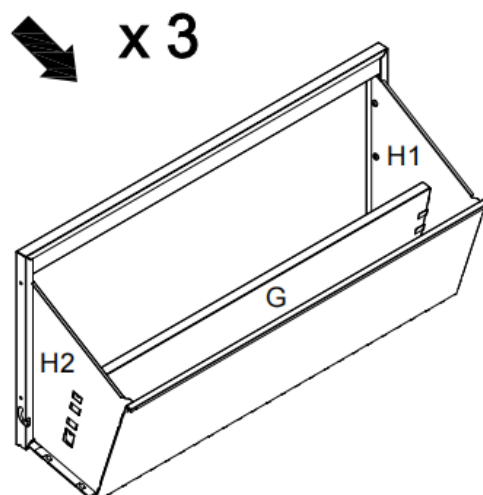
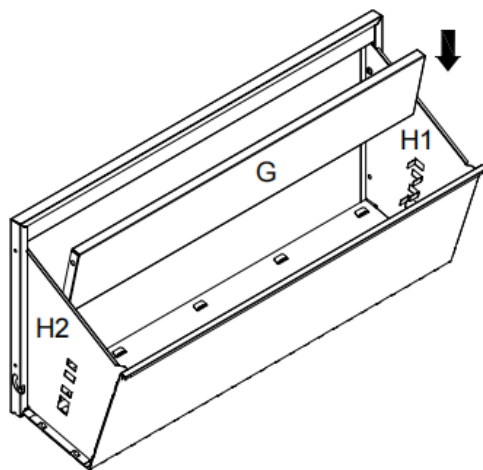
There are three screw holes on each side, don't fix the screw hole at bottom. Need screw it in the last step.

STEP 10

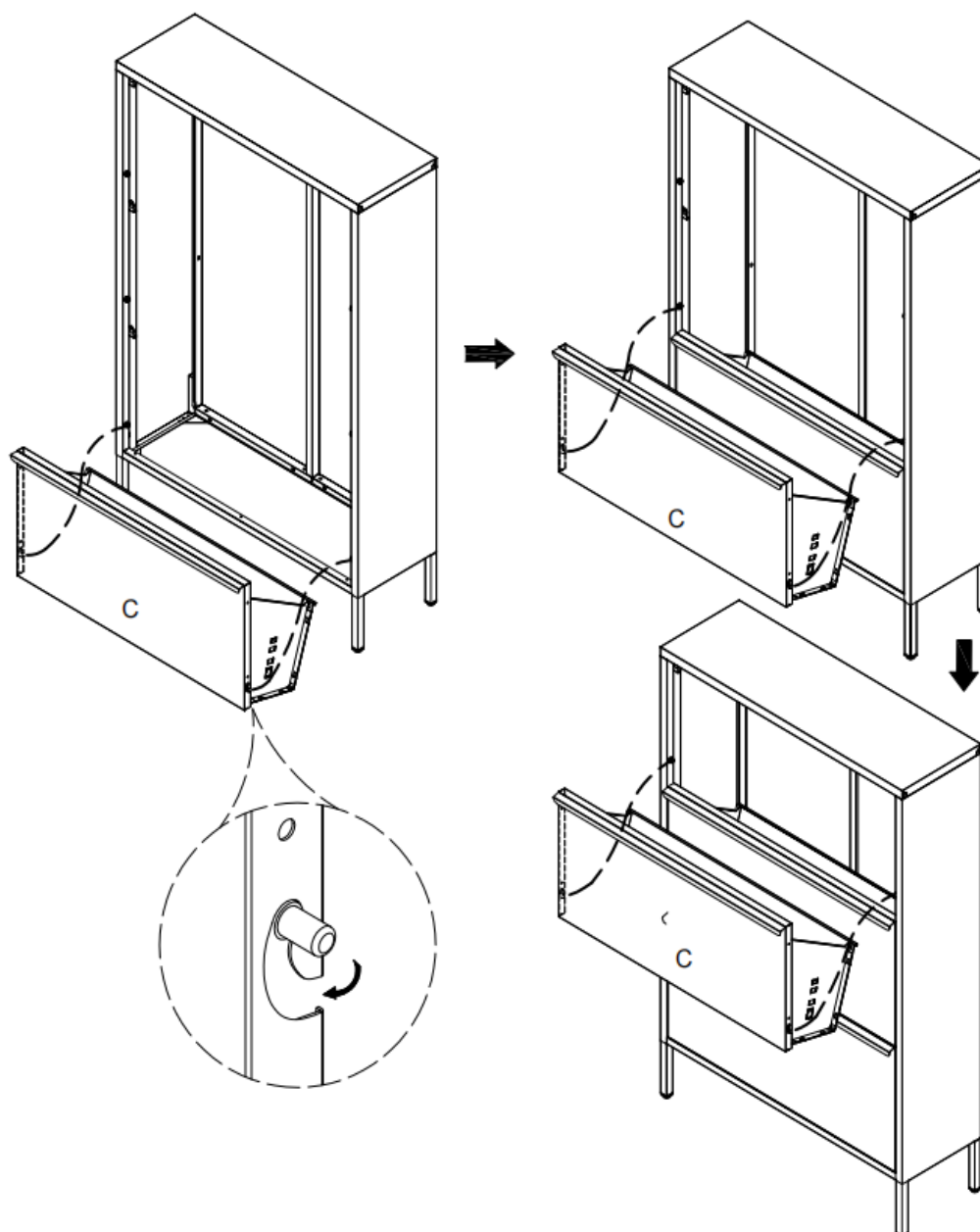
Attach the drawer shelves (G) into the drawer, make sure all iron pieces alignment.

Repeat this step 3 times.



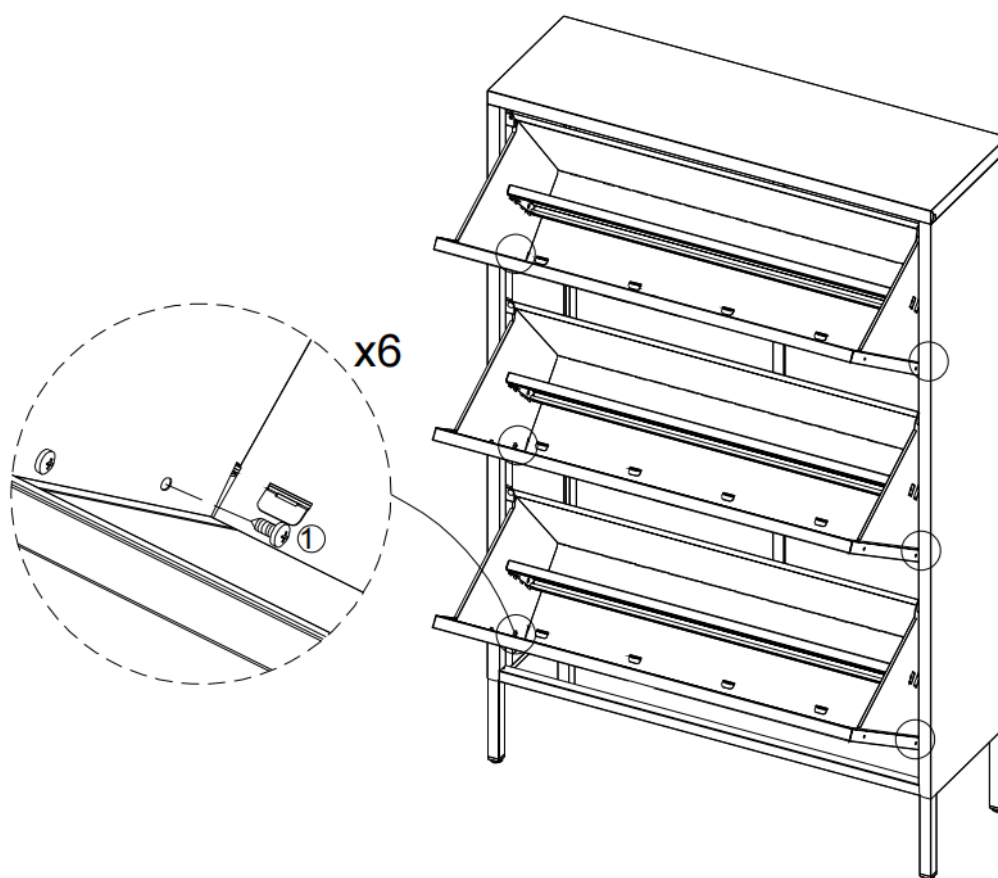
STEP 1 1

Hang the drawer onto the pivot on the side panel.
Repeat this step 3 times.



STEP 1 2

Fix drawers with screws (1).
