

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING! SHUT POWER OFF AT FUSE OR CIRCUIT BREAKER.

MOUNTING THE FIXTURE (Fig. 1)

1. Shut off power at the fuse box or circuit breaker box and remove the old fixture including the mounting hardware.
2. Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts in a clean area. Take care not to misplace any small parts necessary for installation.
3. Attach mounting plate (A) to junction box (not included) using mounting screws (B) (Size: #8-32N*L0.5"). The side of the mounting plate marked "GND" must face out.

CONNECTING THE WIRES (Fig. 2)

4. Connect the electrical wires as shown in figure 2, making sure that all wire connectors are secured. If your junction box has a ground wire (green or bare copper), connect fixture's ground wire to it. Otherwise, connect fixture's ground wire directly to mounting plate (A) using green screw provided.
5. Tuck wire connectors neatly inside the junction box.

COMPLETING THE INSTALLATION (Fig. 1)

6. Place fixture body (D) onto mounting plate (A) followed by plastic washer (E) and secure with screws (C).
7. To prevent moisture from entering outlet box and causing a short, use clear caulking (i.e. Indoor/Outdoor Silicone Sealant) to outline the outside of fixture back-plate where it meets the wall leaving a space at bottom to allow moisture a means to escape (Fig.3).
8. Install (1) one candelabra base bulbs (G) up to 60 watts each or CFL or LED equivalent (not included) in accordance with the fixture specification—**DO NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM WATTAGE RATING! (NE PAS DEPASSER LA PUISSANCE NOMINALE MAXIMALE!)**
9. Place glass shade (H) over socket (F) and twist until secured on socket cup.

Your installation is now complete. Return power to the junction box and test the fixture.

Note: Illustration (Fig. 1) on this manual is for installation purposes only. It may or may not be identical to the fixture purchased.

- Mounting Screw *2




