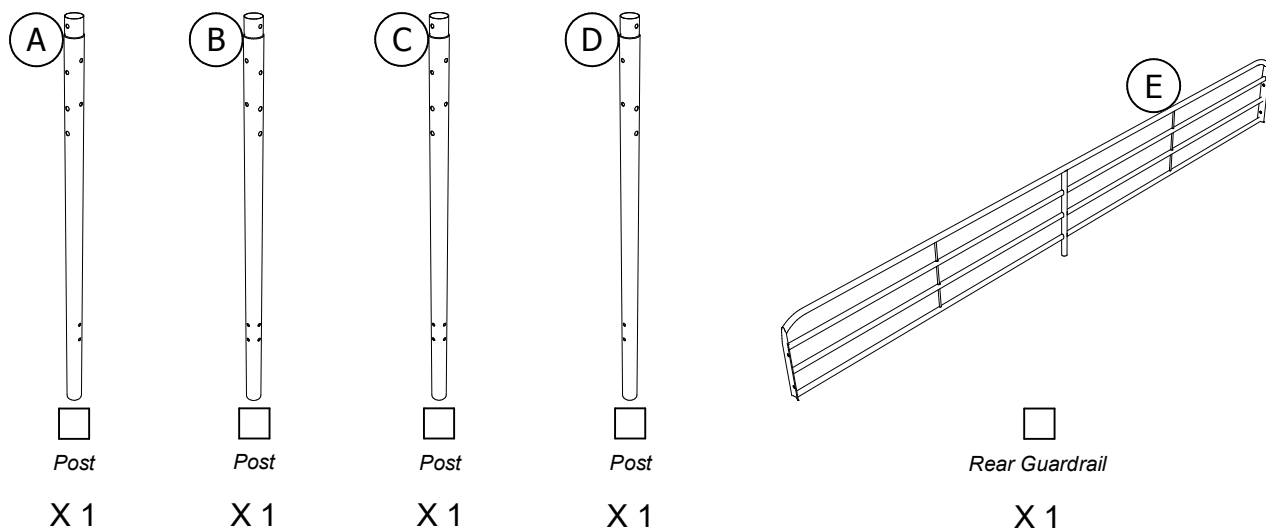
Read Before Beginning Assembly

- Call our Customer Care phone number if you need assistance.
- Work in a spacious area and near where the unit will be used, preferably on a carpet, or use a piece of the cardboard packaging to protect your floor and product.
- Recommended # of people needed for assembly: **2** (however it is always better to have an extra hand). Estimated assembly time is **1h30min**.
- Make sure all parts are included. Most parts are labeled or stamped on the raw edge.
- Read each step carefully. It is very important that each step of the instructions is performed in the correct order. If these steps are not followed in sequence, assembly difficulties will occur.

Caution

- This product is designed for home use and not intended for commercial use.
- This product contains small components. Please ensure that they are kept away from small children.
- Do not use power tools to assemble your furniture. Power tools may strip or damage the parts.
- A power tool and drill bit will be required to secure the bunk to the wall.
- You will need a phillips headed screwdriver to assemble this product.





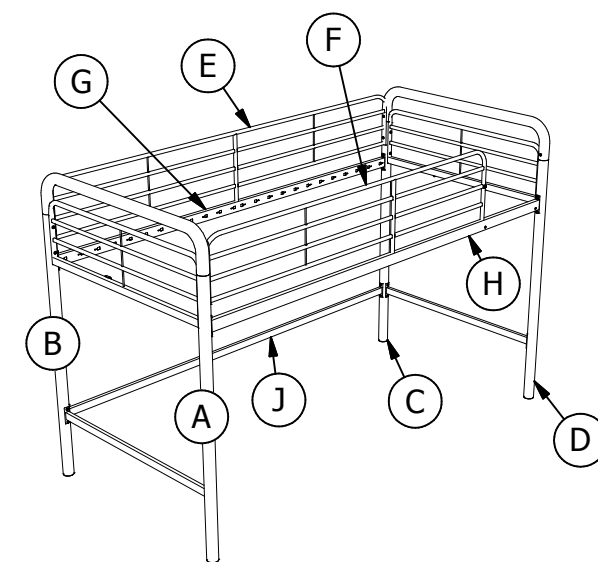
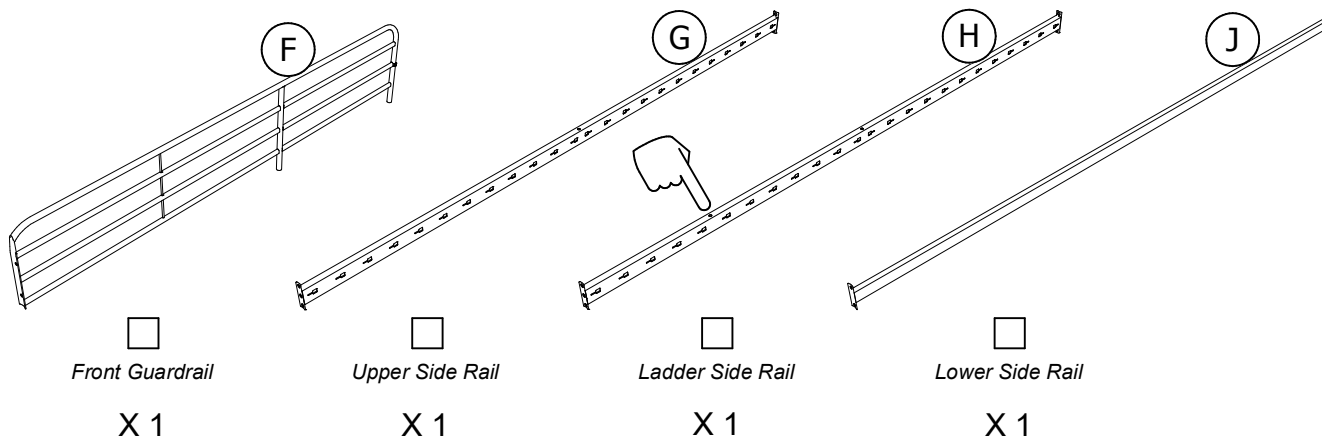

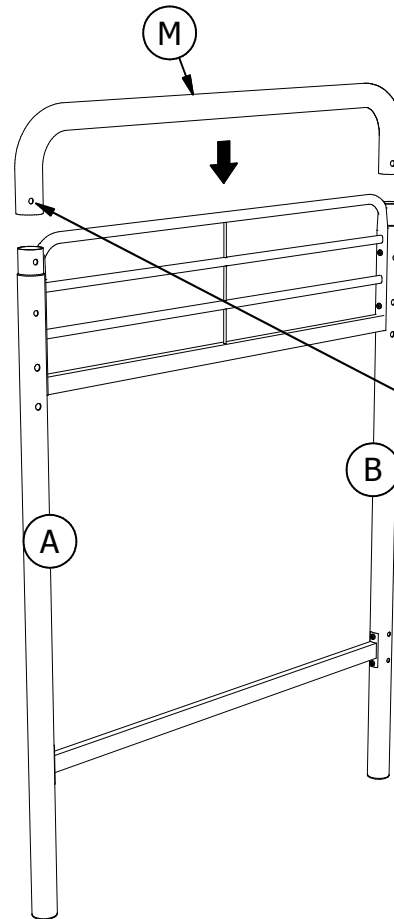
1.1 Attach (I) & (T) to (A) & (B) with BOLTS 3 as shown.

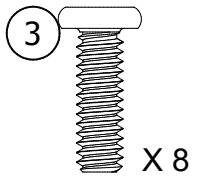

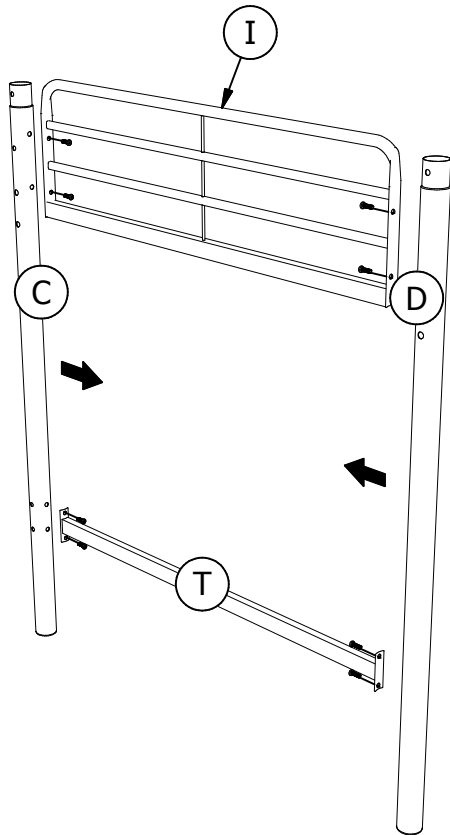

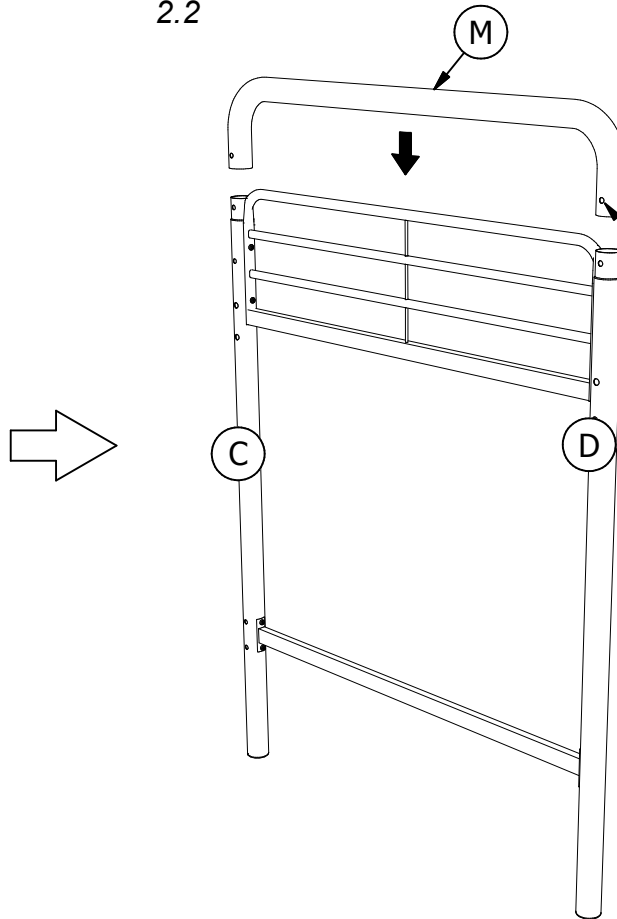
2.1 Attach (I) & (T) to (C) & (D) with BOLTS 3.

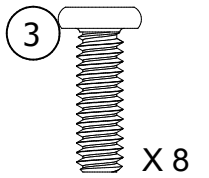

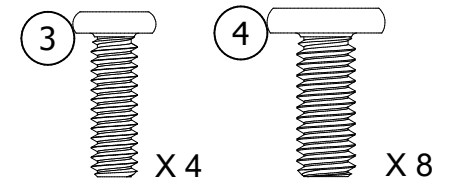
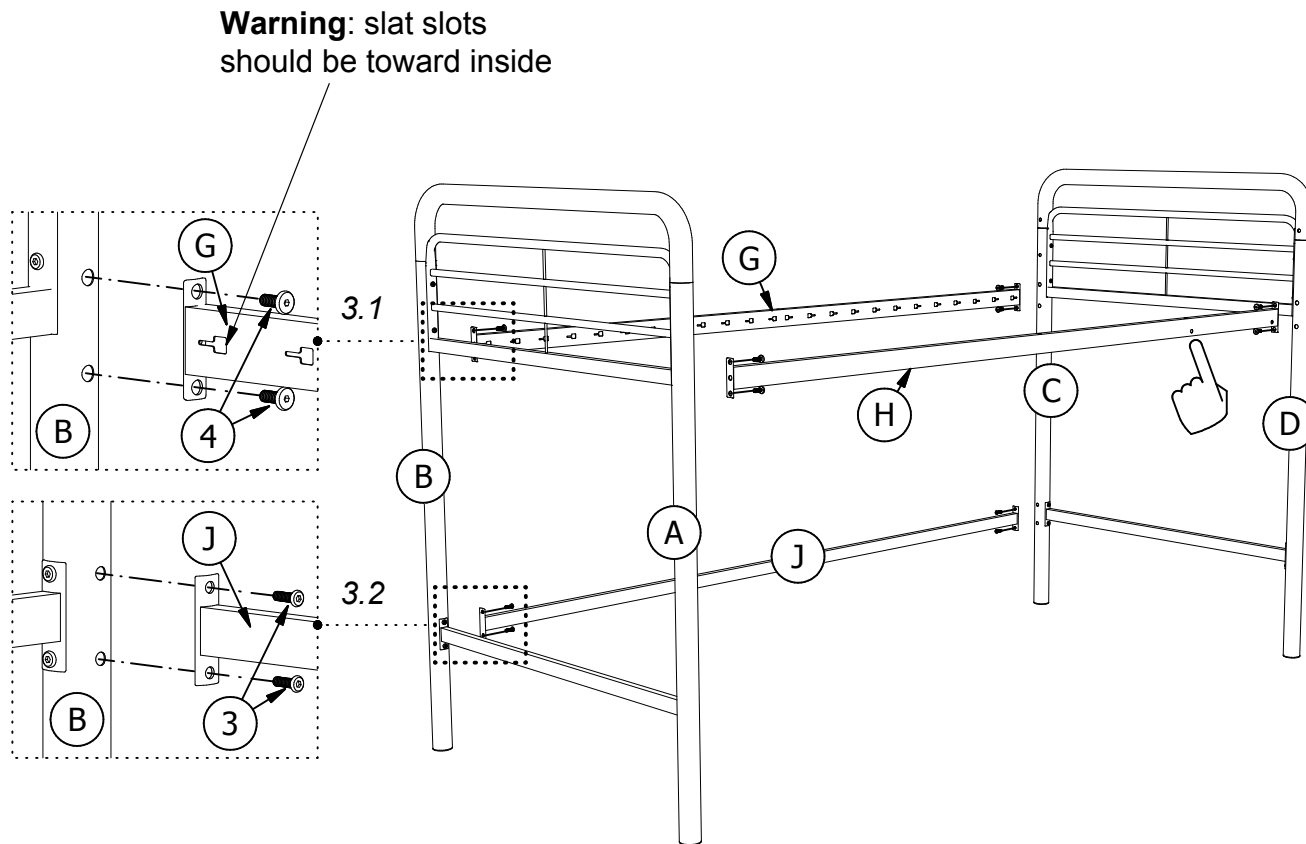

3.2 Then attach (J) to (B) & (C) with BOLTS 3 as shown.

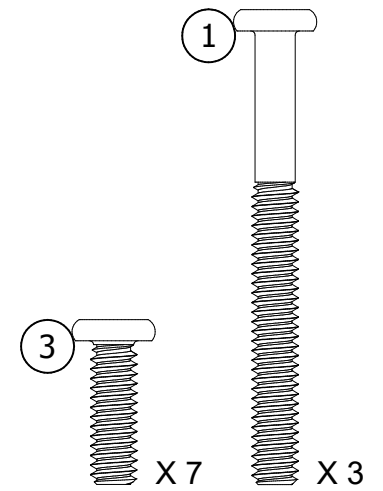
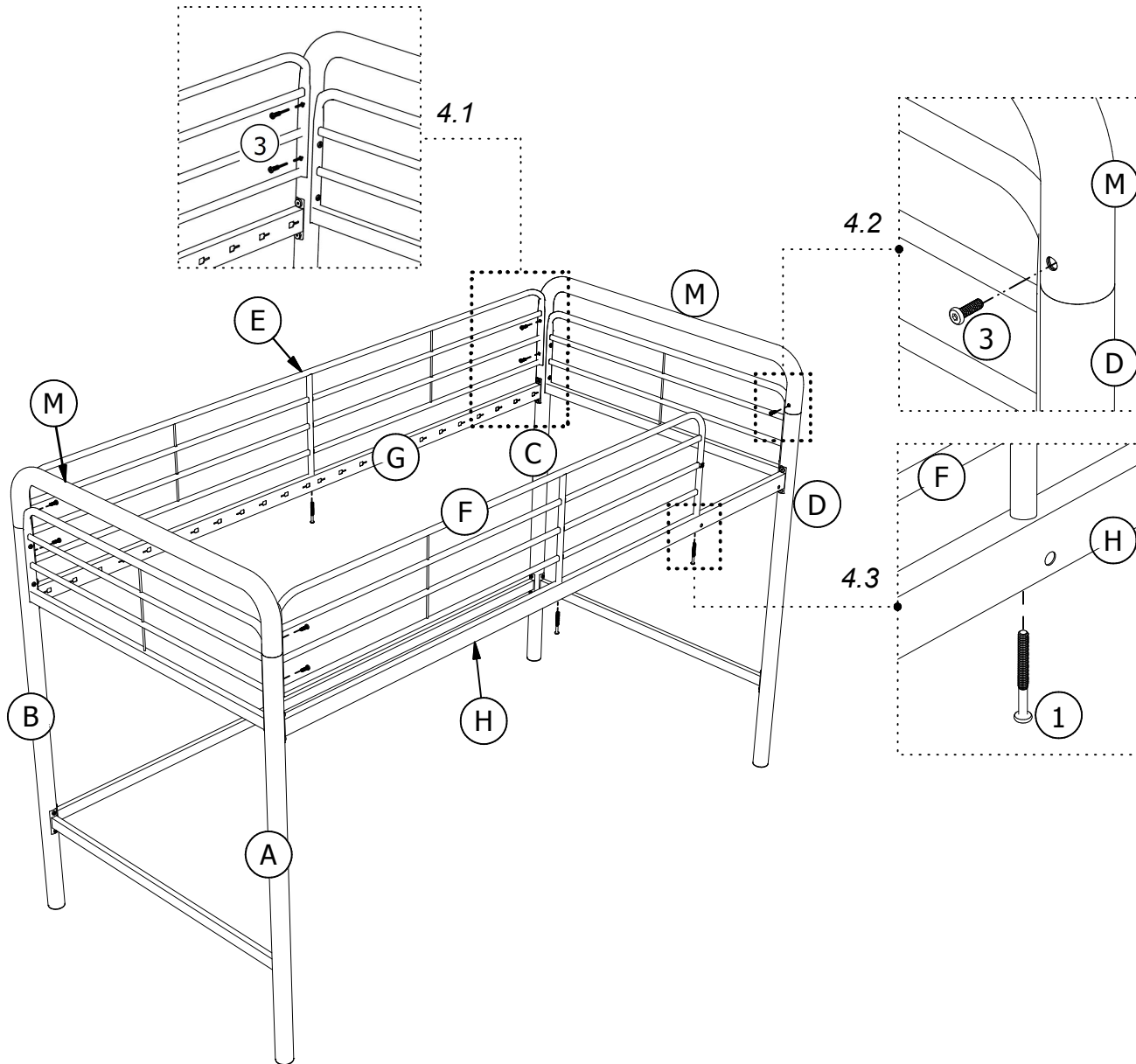


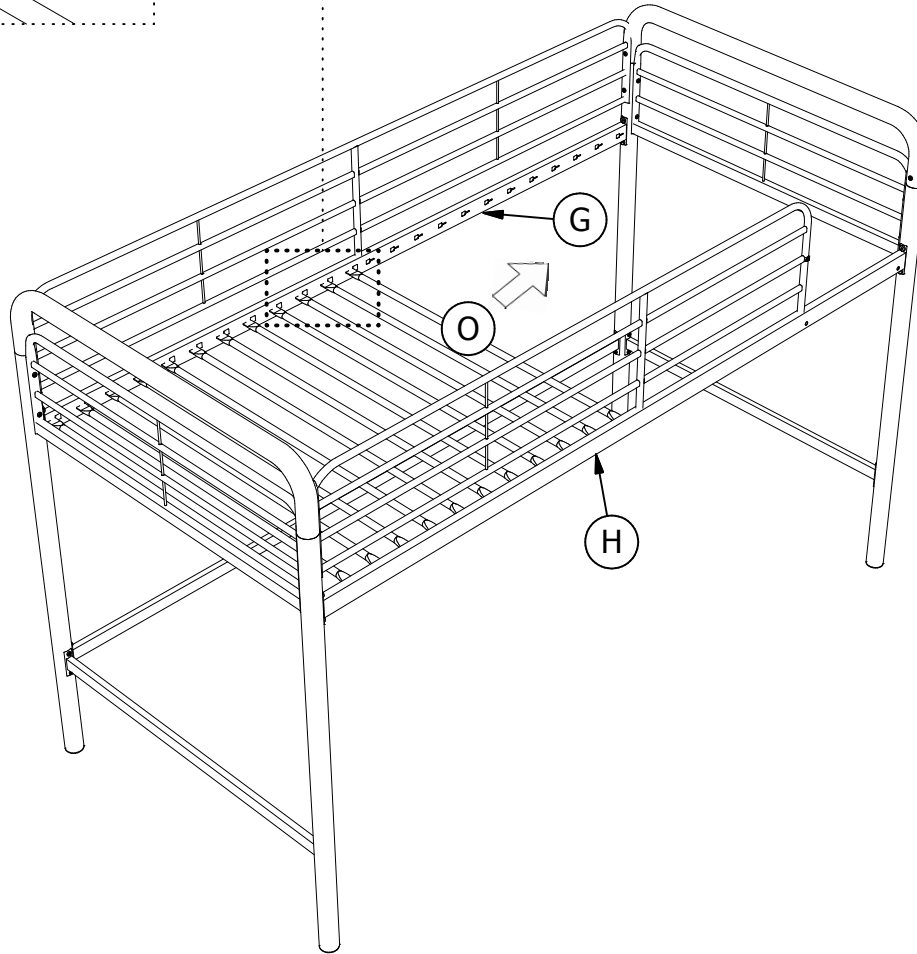
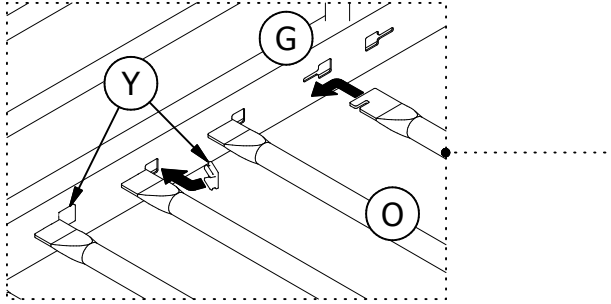

4.1 Attach (E) to (B/M) and (C/M) with BOLTS 3; (F) to (A/M) with BOLTS 3

4.2 Fix (M) to (D) with BOLT 3;

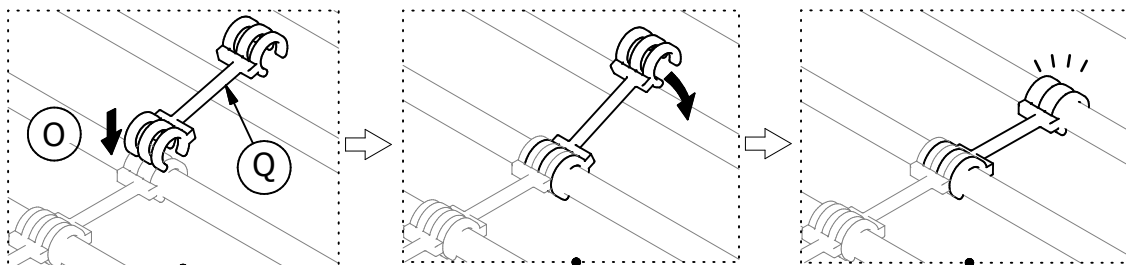
4.3 Then attach (E) & (F) to (G) & (H) with BOLTS 1 as shown.

Insert (O) into (G) & (H), then lock (O) in place with (Y) as shown.

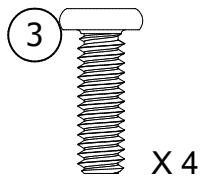
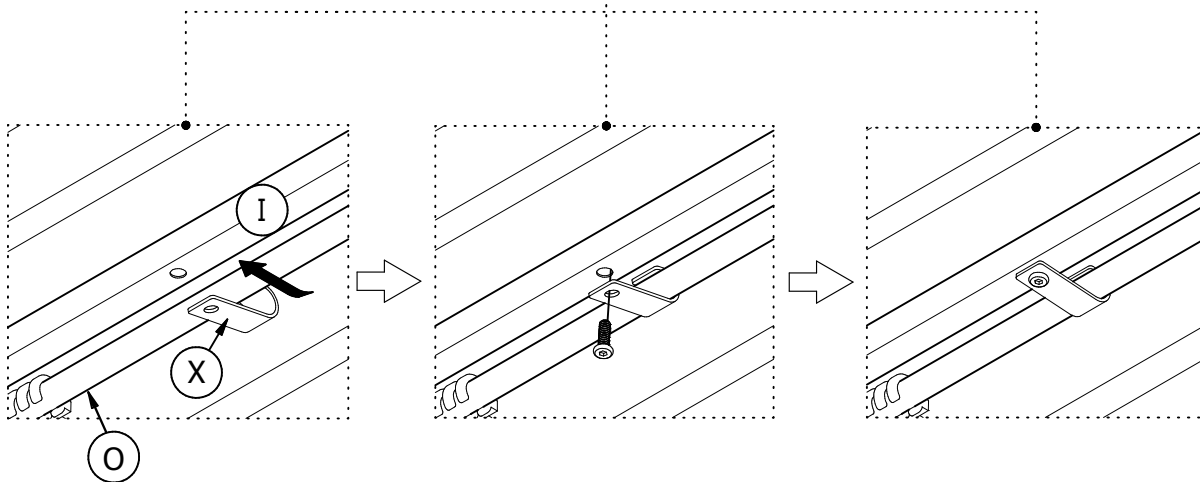
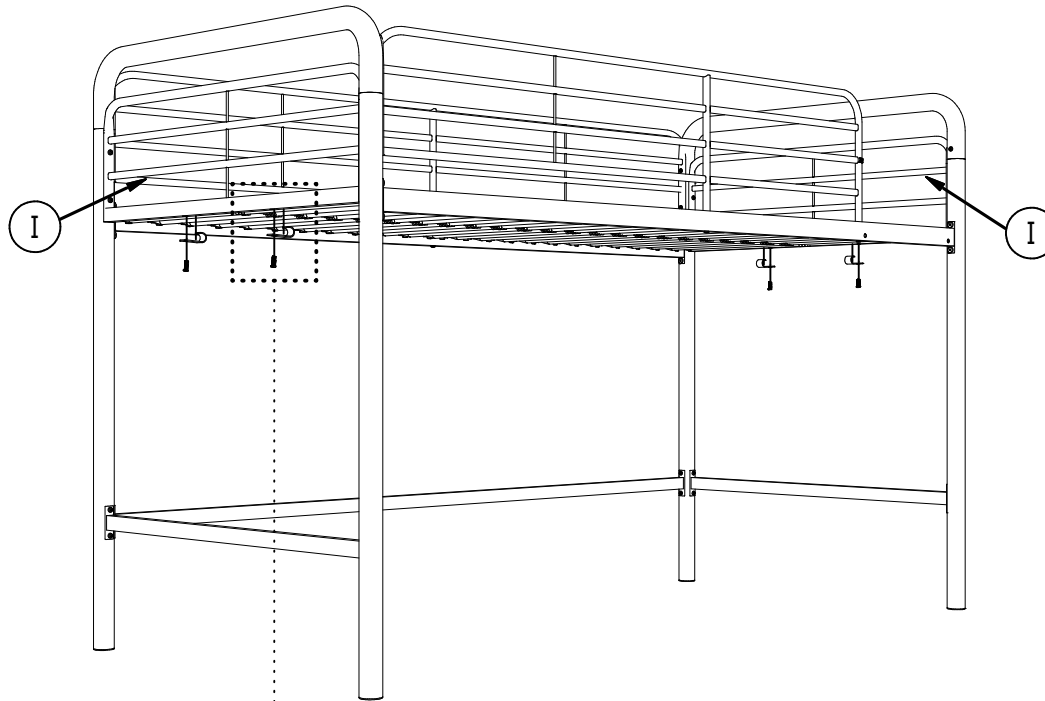


Step 6

Interlock (Q) onto (O) down the middle of the bed as shown.

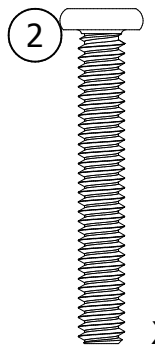
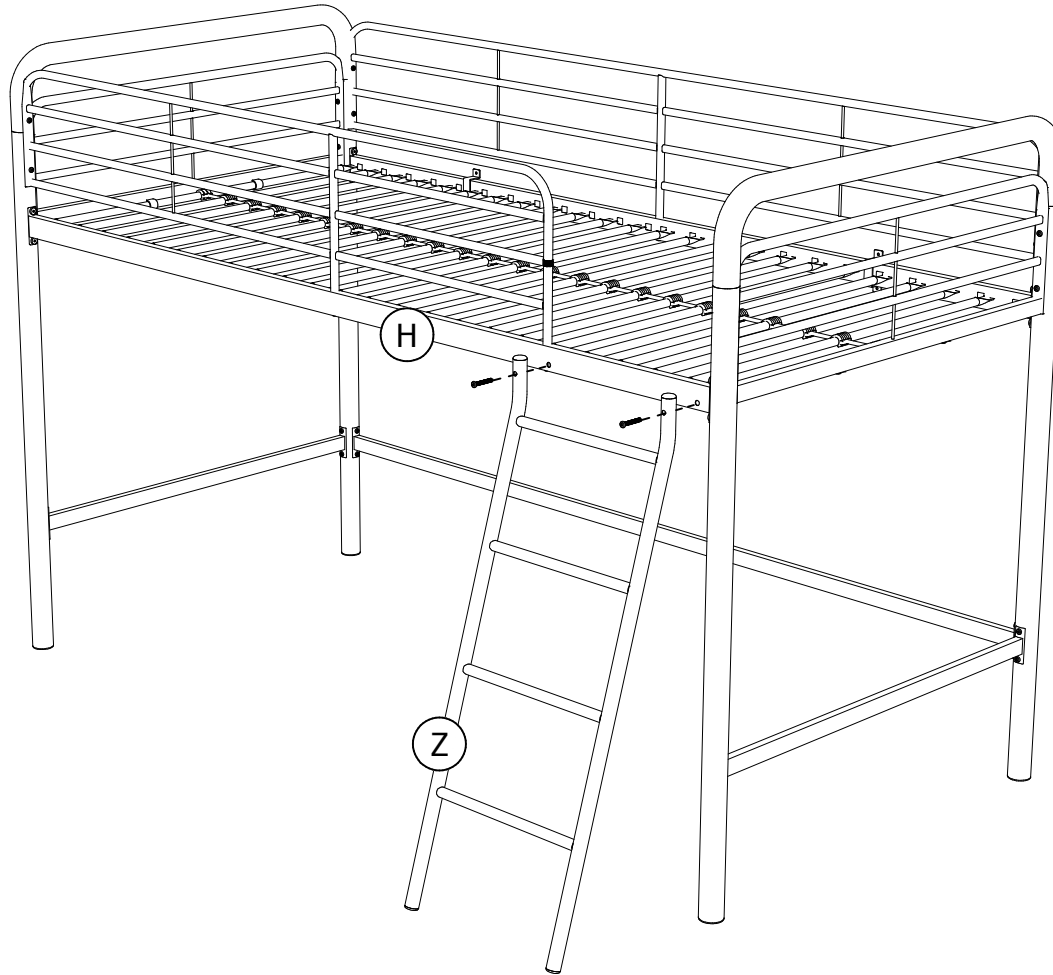

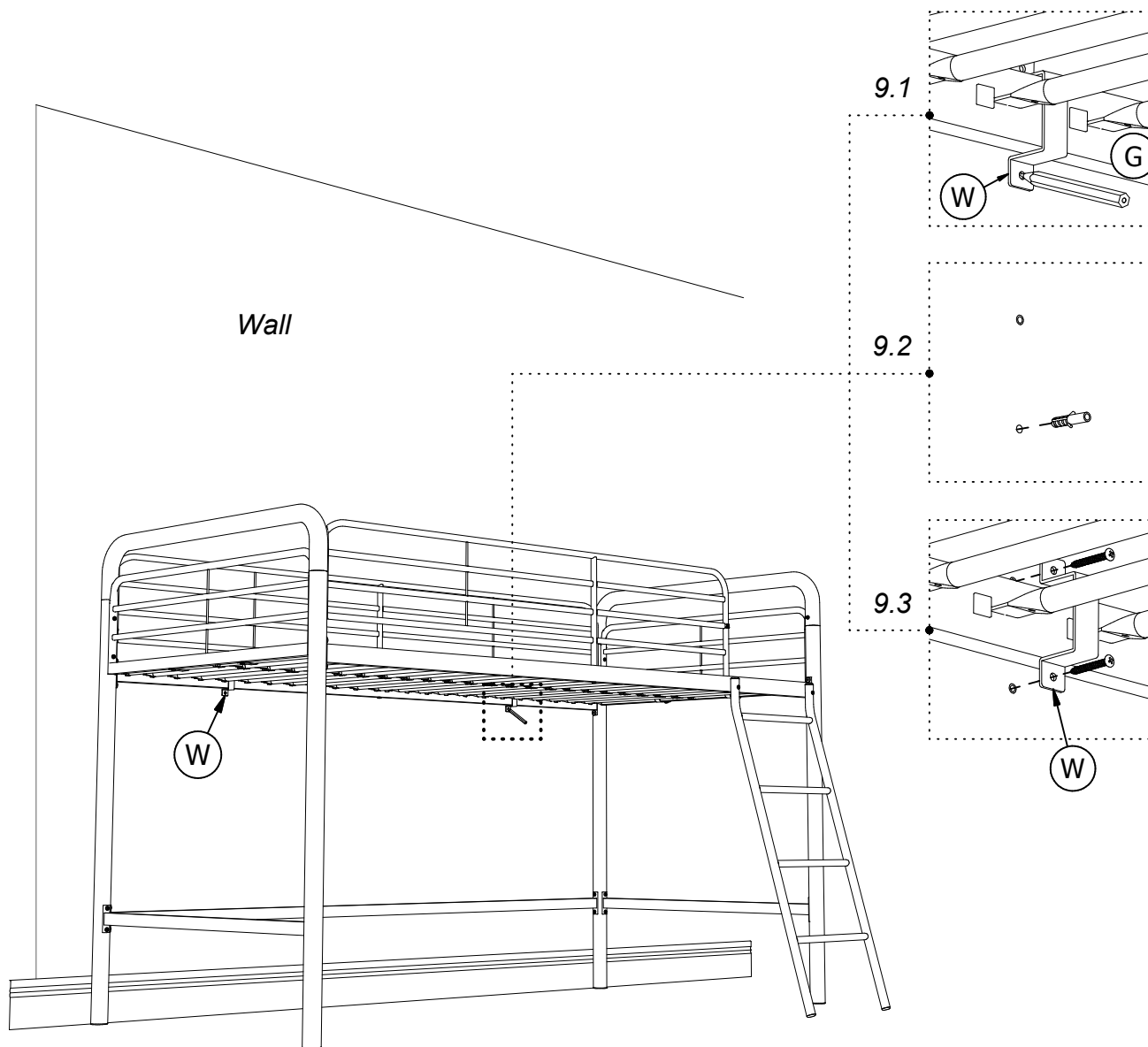
Attach (X) x 4 onto (I) x 2 with the other end of (X) Hooking with O.

Attach (Z) to (H) with BOLTS 2.



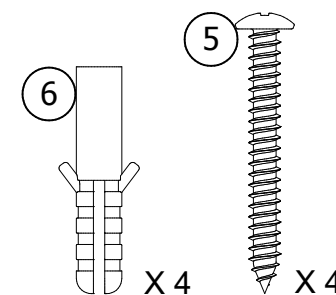


Step 9

9.1 Place (W) around (G), inside the fifth slat from each end. Mark the 4 holes to be drilled;

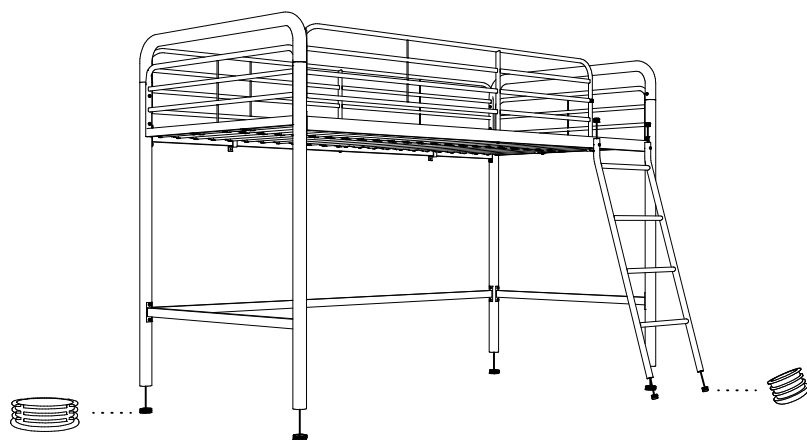
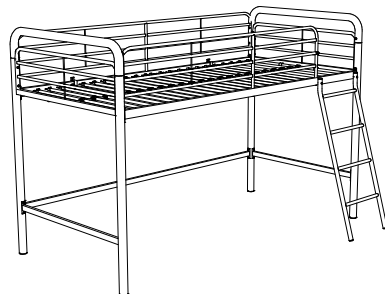
9.2 Drill with 1/4"(6mm) drill bit to a depth of 40mm. Plug holes with 6;

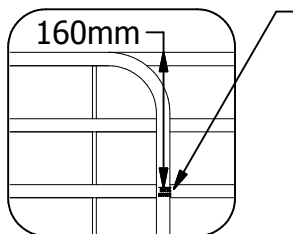

Helpful Hints

- Move your new furniture carefully, with two people lifting and carrying the unit to its new location.
- Your furniture can be disassembled and reassembled to move.
- Some parts have been pre-assembled for this item. They are illustrated on this page and available for replacement.

WARNINGS

- Always follow the manufacturer's instructions;
- High beds and the upper bed of bunk beds are not suitable for children under six years due to the risk of injury from falls;
- Bunk beds and high beds can present a serious risk of injury from strangulation if not used correctly. Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed to be used with the bed, for example, but not limited to ropes, strings, cords, hooks, belts and bags;
- Children can become trapped between the bed and the wall, a roof pitch, the ceiling, adjoining pieces of furniture (e.g. cupboards) and the like. To avoid risk of serious injury the distance between the top safety barrier and the adjoining structure shall not exceed 75 mm or shall be more than 230 mm
- Do not use the bunk bed/high bed if any structural part is broken or missing;
- Periodically check and ensure that all assembly fastenings are properly tightened;
- Always use the recommended size mattresses or mattress supports, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls;
- Use only a single mattress which is **1900mm** long and **900mm** wide on the upper bed;
- The maximum thickness of the mattress used on the upper bed is **160mm**. The top of the mattress shall be at least 160mm below the upper edge of the guardrails;
- Ventilation of the room is necessary in order to keep the humidity low and to prevent mould in and around the bed;
- Use of a night light may provide added safety for a child using the upper bunk;
- Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed;
- Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk;
- This bunk bed conforms to BS EN 747-1&2:2012 + A1:2015.
