

- Once you have opened your package, remove all inner hardware packages and take the
 parts out. One by one, Place the parts out neatly in front of you, then refer to the
 instructions to ensure no parts are missing. If any pieces are found missing, please
 carefully look in the box first, as the hardware packaging might have torn making the
 hardware spill in the box.
- Some key parts of your product may be stored and hidden inside of other parts. Please open any zippered or hook & loop storage compartments to remove all parts. (example: cushions and legs being stored in the underside of a sofa)
- IMPORTANT: When setting up your product, DO NOT INSTALL THE SCREWS ALL THE WAY IN THE BEGINNING. Place each screw into their proper hole and use your hand to twist the screw halfway. Twist all the screws in halfway to ensure the holes will match up properly and the product is level on the ground. When everything seems fitted, then tighten the screws.
- When you have completed assembly, we suggest you have more than one person to assist you with lifting and placing the product.

Care & Maintenance

- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface

 Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish

 Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents


 Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface



Do not use power tools to assemble your furniture. Power tools may strip or damage the parts.






Note:

- 50% Tighten before fixing all screws, Allen wrench is recommended instead of an electric drill.
- 2. Place the item on a flat ground to adjust and make sure it remains stable.
- 3. Tighten up all screw with tools gradually.
- If screw are not aligned with holes during assembly, please loosen all the other screws to 50% and continue the assembly process.
- If the item is not stable, please loosen all screws, adjust it on a flat ground and tighten up all screws again.
- 6. Note: If one or some screws are fully tighten during assembly, chances are the others will not be aligned with holes. In addition, all the holes are designed to be relatively larger to provide more space for the adjustment of the screws.



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


Connect The Table Leg (A) & Table Panel (B), tighten Bolt (1), Flat Washer (4) with Allen Key (5).




Connect The Part from STEP 1 & Table Leg (A), tighten Bolt (1), Flat Washer (4) with Allen Key (5).

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


Connect The Part from STEP 2 & Table Top (T), tighten Bolt (1), Flat Washer (4) with Allen Key (5).




Put the Table upright and make sure all legs are level, then firmly tighten Bolts with Allen Key (5) & Put Table Glass (C) on Table to finish Table.

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


Connect The Arm Right (D) & Back Bench (F), tighten Bolt (1), Flat Washer (4) with Allen Key (5).




Connect The Part from STEP 4 & Seat Bench (G).

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


Connect The Part from STEP 5 & Arm Left (E), tighten Bolt (1), Flat Washer (4) with Allen Key (5).




Connect The Part from STEP 6 & Front Bench (H), tighten Bolt (1), (3) Flat Washer (4) with Allen Key (5).

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


Connect The Part from STEP 7 & Panel Bench (I).




Put the Bench upright and make sure all legs are level, then firmly tighten Bolts with Allen Key (5). Put on Seat Bench Cushion (P) & Back Cushion (S) to finish Bench.

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


Connect The Arm Left (E) & Back Chair (J), tighten Bolt (1), Flat Washer (4) with Allen Key (5).




Connect The Part from STEP 11 & Arm Left (E), tighten Bolt (1), (3), Flat Washer (4) with Allen Key (5).

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



Connect The Part from STEP 12 & Seat Chair (K), tighten Bolt (2), Flat Washer (4) with Allen Key (5).




Put the Chair upright and make sure all legs are level, then firmly tighten Bolts with Allen Key (5) & Put on Seat Chair Cushion (Q) & Back Cushion (S) to finish Chair.

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







Finish Sofa Option 1
