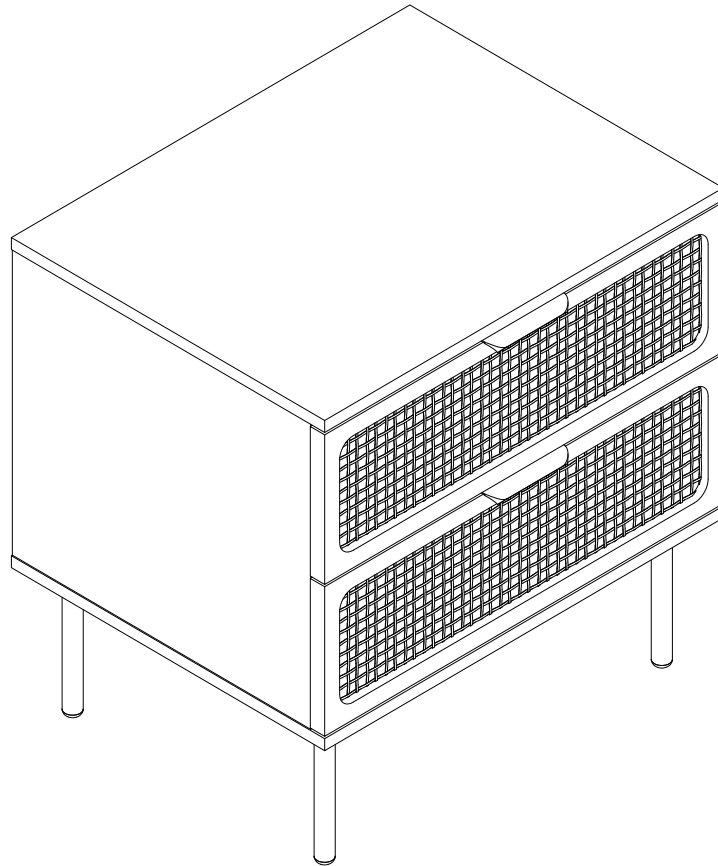

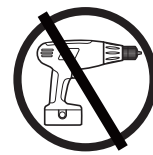


Safety and Care Advice

Important – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

Handy Hints

- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts
- Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightened properly.

WARNING

In order to help prevent overturning – please follow these instructions

To help prevent product toppling over please follow the below steps:-

Use the anti tip strap or wall fixing method provided (if applicable)

Do not allow children to climb or hang on the furniture

Do not open more than one drawer at a time

Do not place heavy items in the top drawers

Do not place heavy items on top of the furniture, unless the furniture has been designed for this purpose

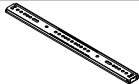
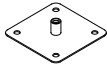
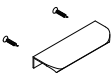

The screws length is measured from the head to the point (30mm screw shown).

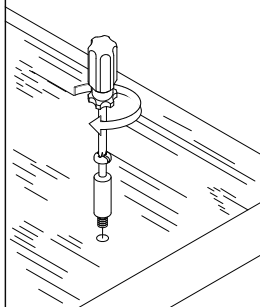
Using Camlocks

Step 1

Connect the male camlock as directed in the assembly instructions using a screwdriver.

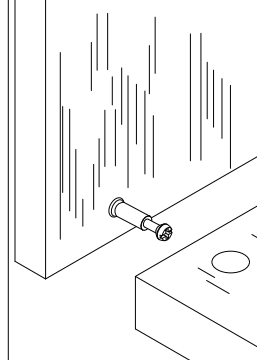

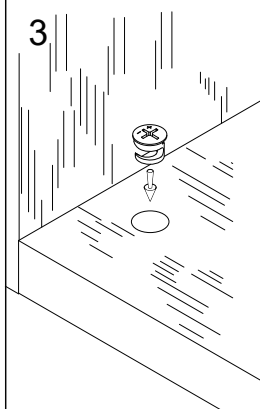


Step 3

Insert the female camlock as shown in the instructions.

Note: ensure that the arrow on the top of the camlock points towards the entry hole for the male camlock.

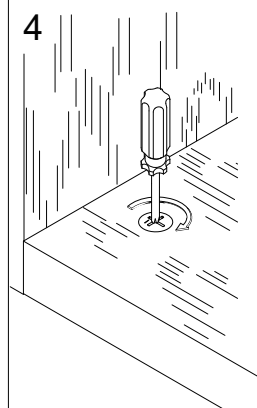
Step 4

Turn the female camlock clockwise with a screwdriver.

You should feel a click when the camlock is locked in place.

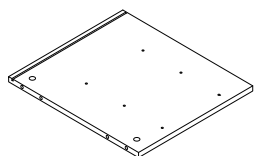
The joint is now secure.

Note: Please pay attention to the direction of the arrows on the drawer slides.



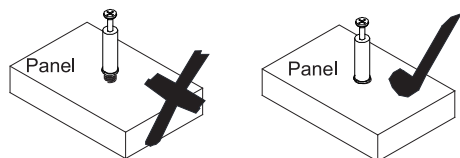
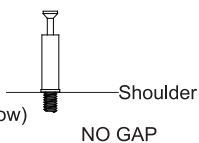
Attach drawer slide (F) to part (1, 2) using screw (E) with a screwdriver.

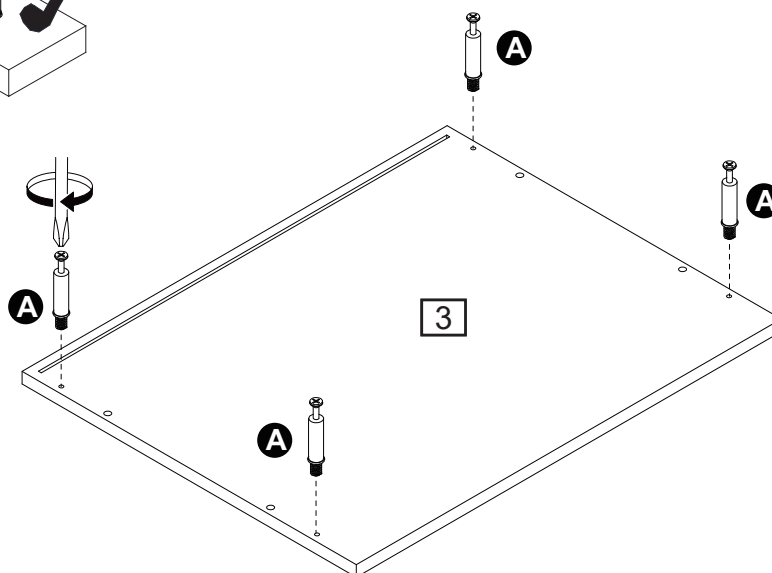

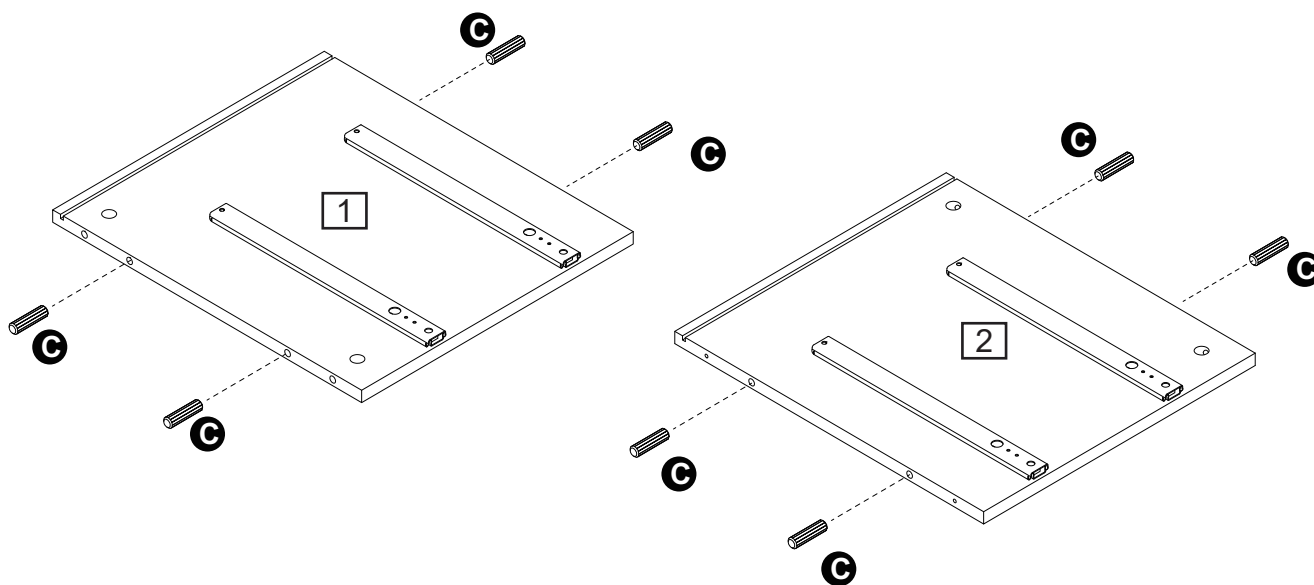


Attach cam bolt (A) to part (3) with a screwdriver.

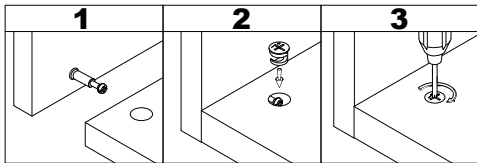

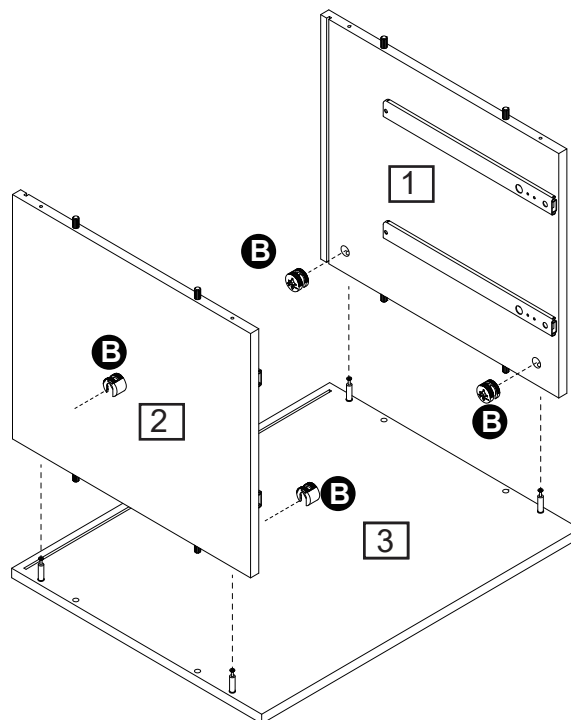

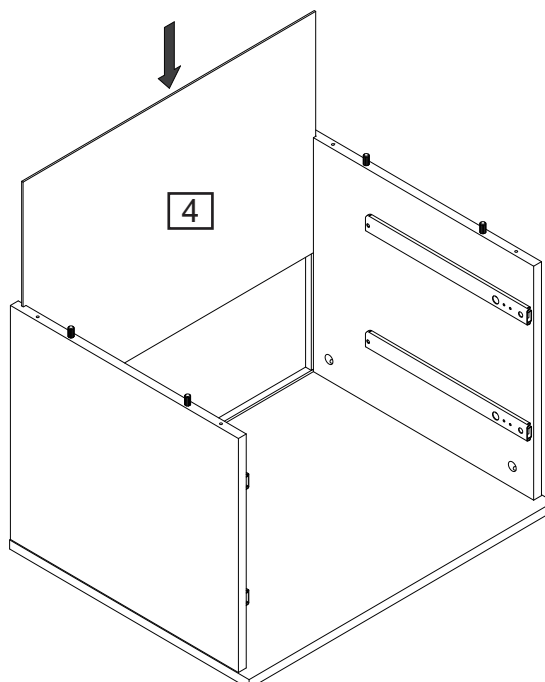

Attach part (1, 2) to part (3), then insert and secure cam lock (B) to part (1, 2) to lock it.

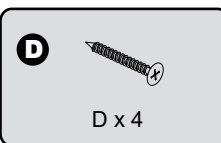
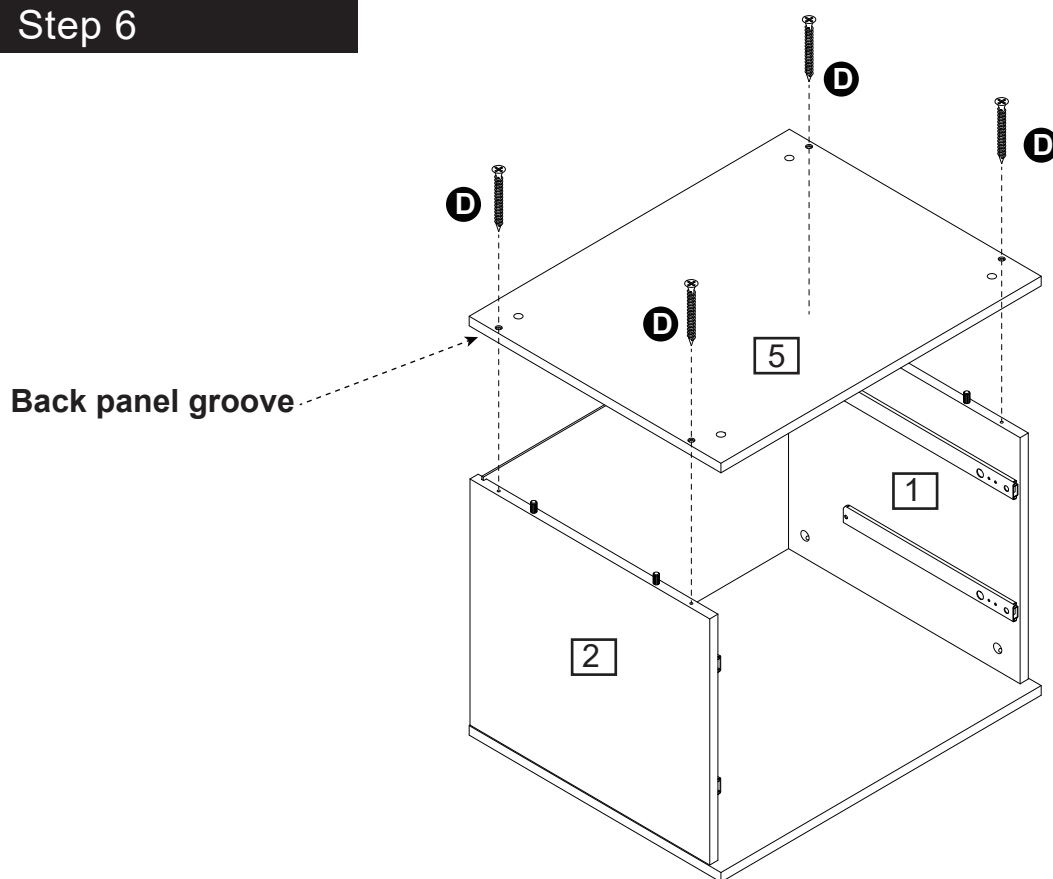

Slide the back panel (4) into grooves as per diagram.

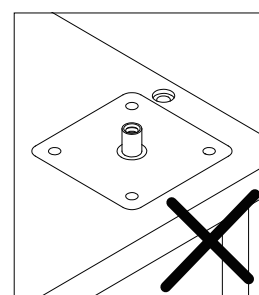
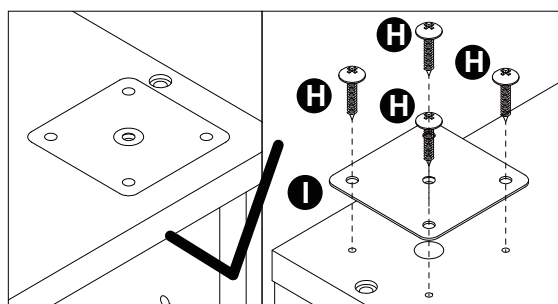
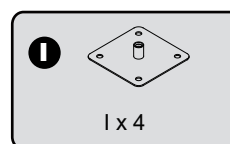
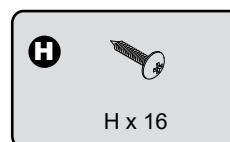
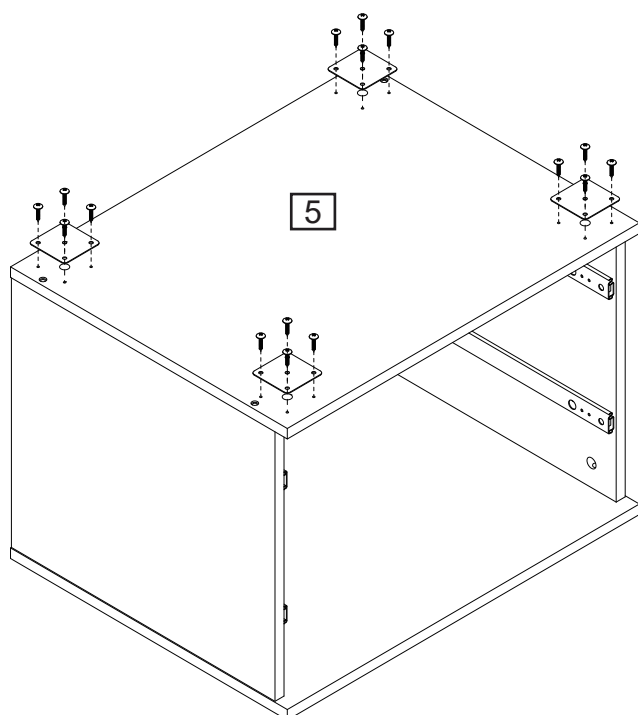

Attach part (5) to part (1, 2) using screw (D) with a screwdriver.

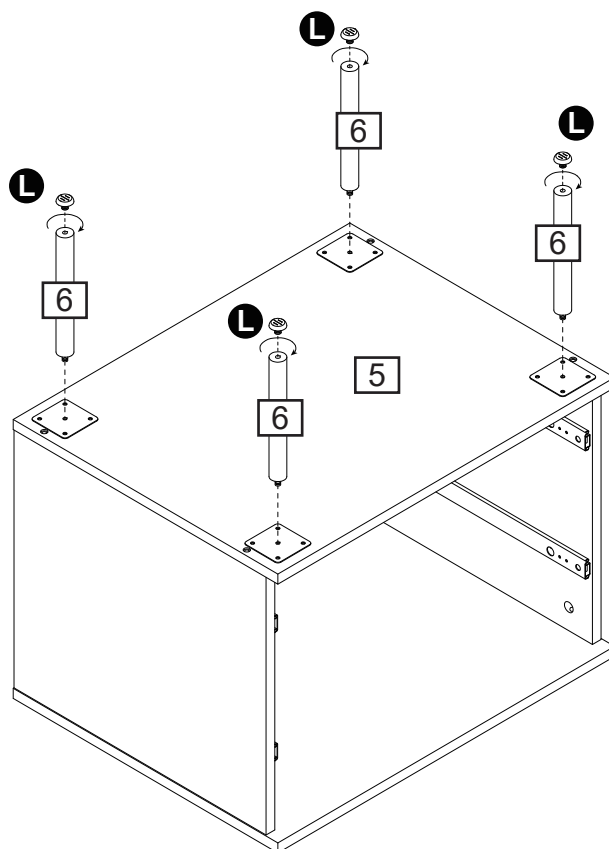

Attach metal plate (I) to part (5) using screw (H) with a screwdriver.

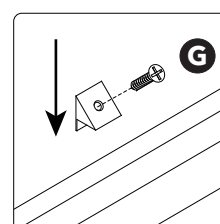
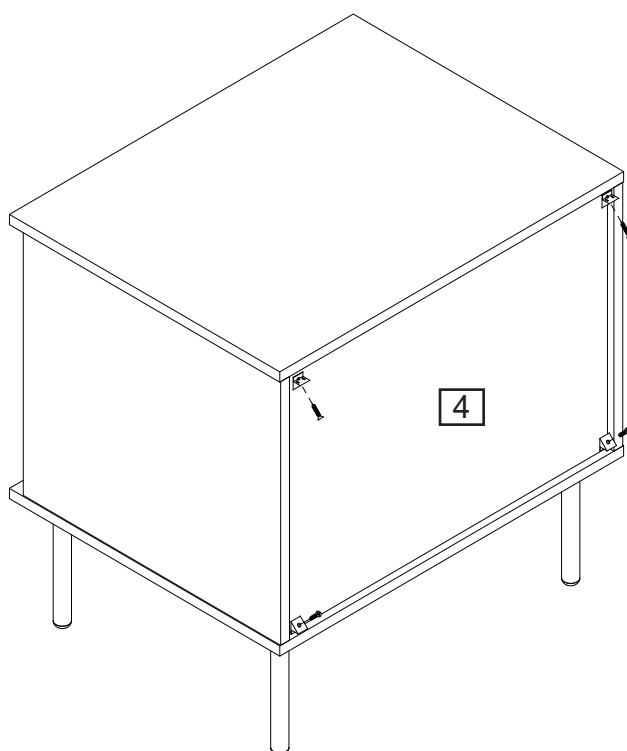

Screw the leg(6) into part (5), then screw the adjustable foot(L) into the leg(6).

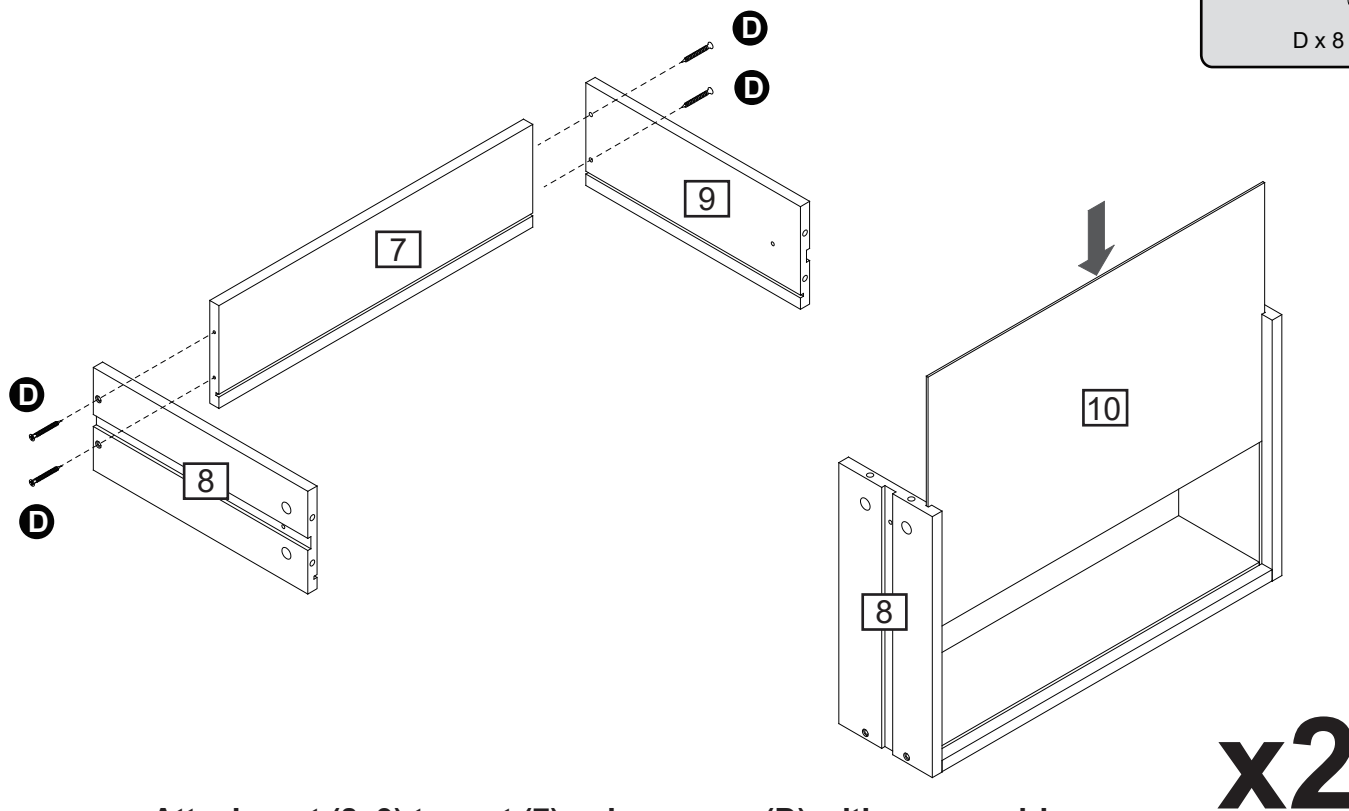

Attach plastic wedge (G) to back panel (4) using screw (G) with a screwdriver.

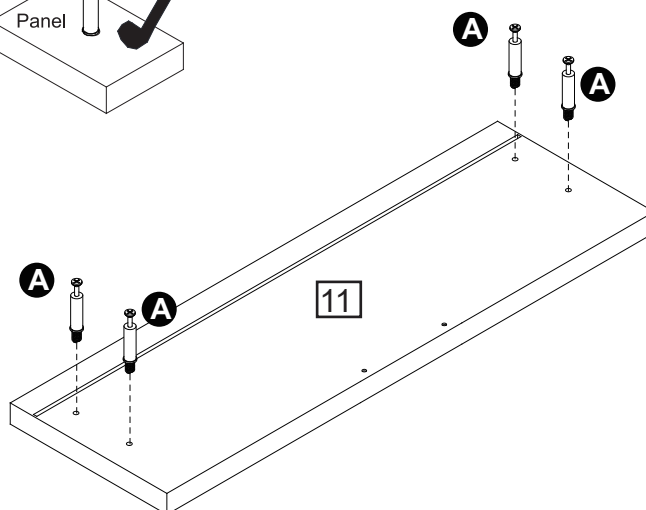
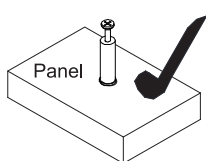
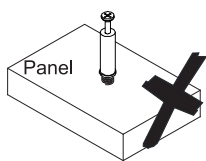
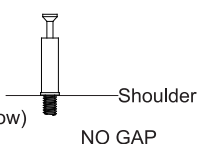


Attach part (8, 9) to part (7) using screw (D) with a screwdriver.

Attach handle (J) to part (11) using screw (J) with a screwdriver.

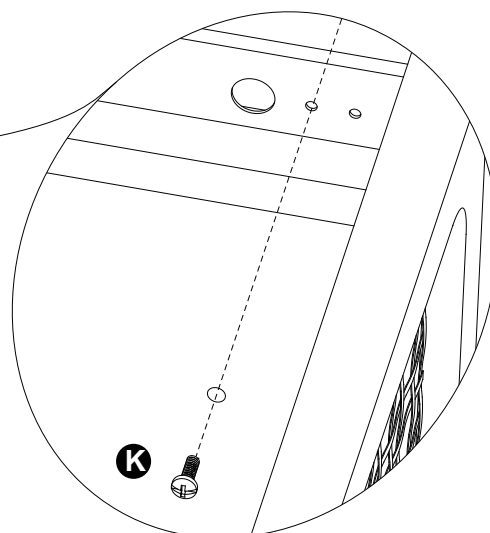
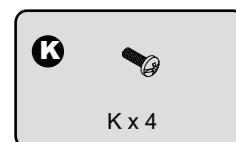
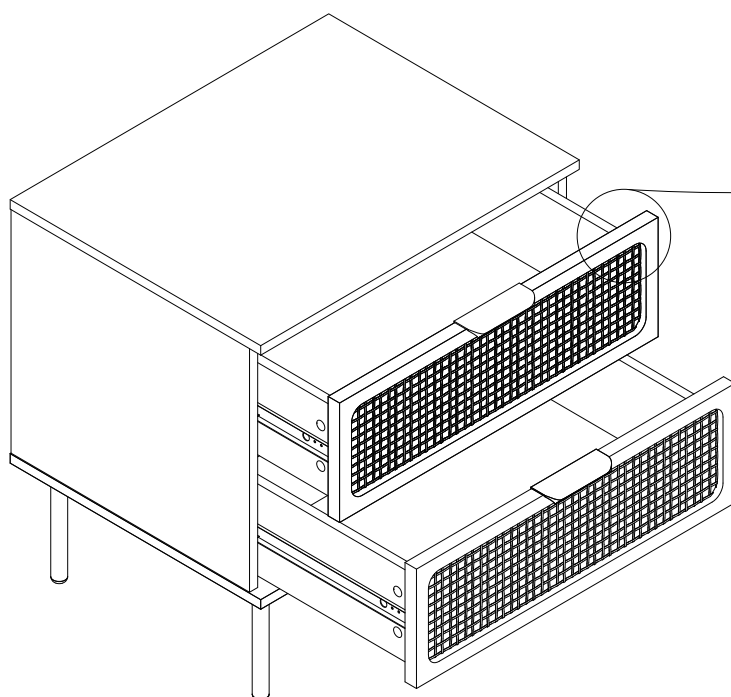

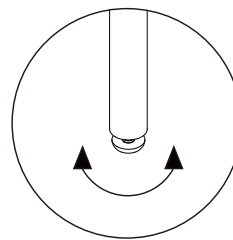
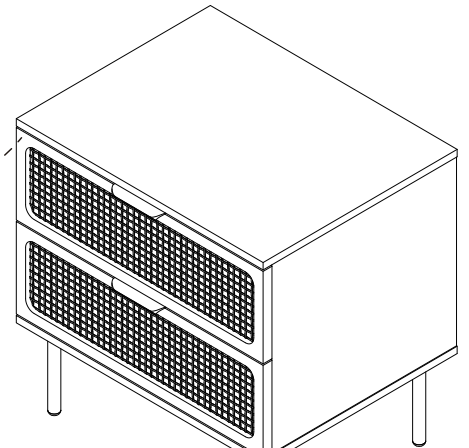
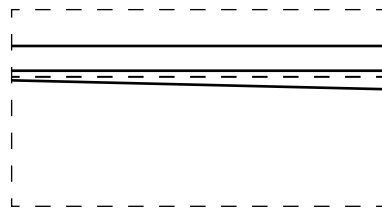


Use screw (K) to secure drawer slide (F) to the drawer.

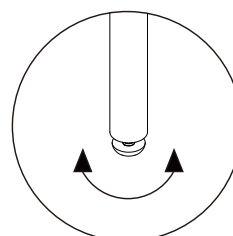
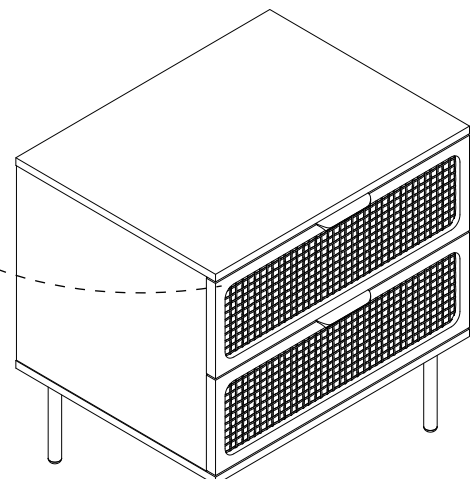
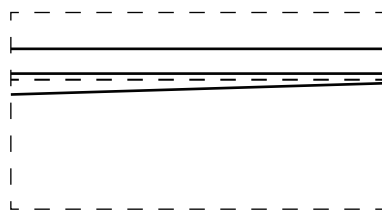
Is your dresser chest door looking crooked or unevenly spaced?

If you're still having trouble lining everything up, your next step should be to try to adjust the feet slightly to square up the dresser chest and doors. Follow the instructions below:

If the right side of the door appears to be hanging low, you can adjust the adjustable leveler on the front right until the door is better aligned.

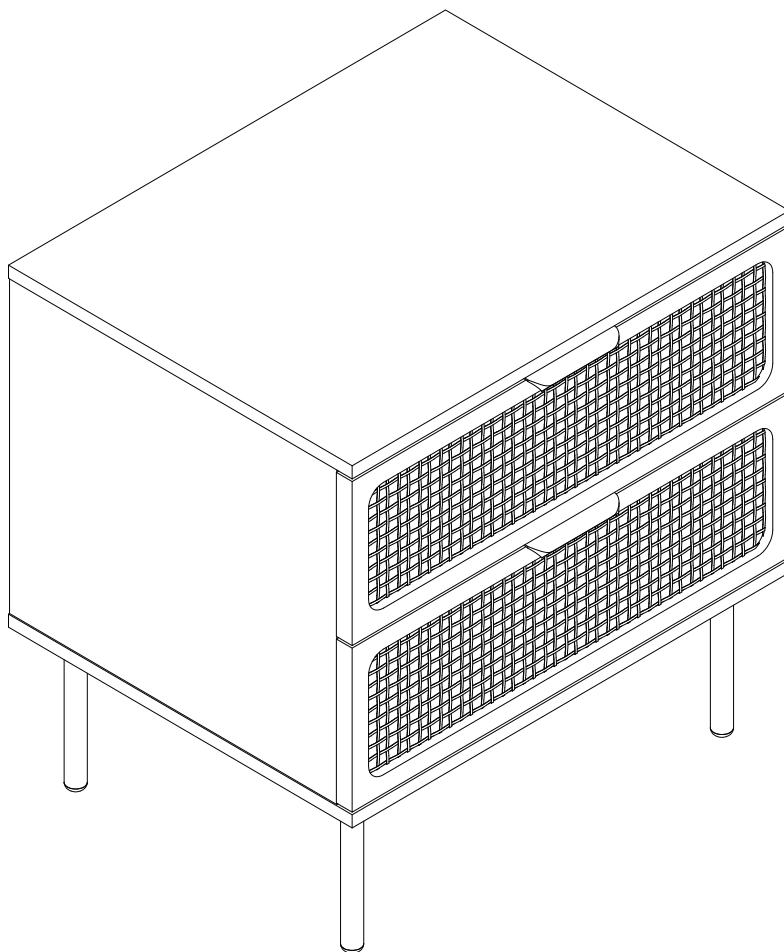


If the left side of the door appears to be hanging low, you can adjust the adjustable leveler on the front left until the door is better aligned.
