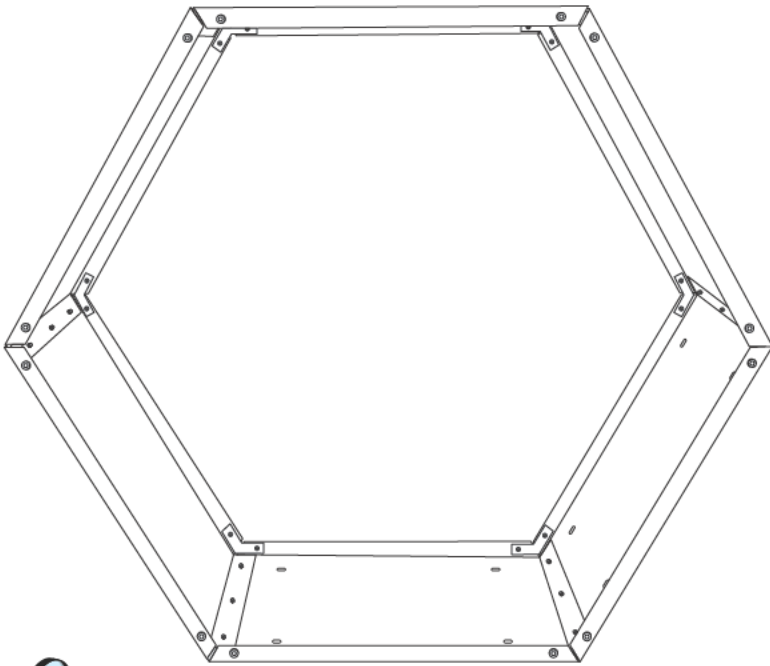


HEXAGON RUSTIC HONEYCOMB LOG STORAGE

Review all assembly and care information carefully before using this product. Save this manual for future reference.
Assemble components on a soft, clean surface to avoid damaging the finish.







Inspect packaging to ensure all parts are accounted for before disposing of packing materials.
Save the packing slip.

Placement of panels varies by configuration.

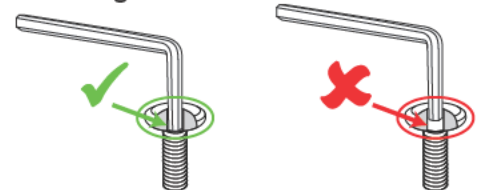
CHOKING HAZARD — This item contains small parts that can be swallowed. Keep children and pets away during assembly.

***NOTE:** The rust patina finish is a result of the alloy steel being exposed to water and oxygen. The color may continue to change over time. When used outdoors, help limit color change and further oxidization by covering the unit.

Because rust will flake away from the unit, use a drop cloth during assembly. The rust flakes may cause staining, especially when in contact with water; avoid contact with clothing.

INCLUDED TOOLS
 Hex Key

Tip: Always fully insert the hex key inside the designated notch of the bolt.



If the hex key is not fully inside the notch, the hex key could slip out, causing damage to the bolt head. Repeated hex key slipping will cause the notch to become rounded, making it difficult or impossible to tighten the bolt with the hex key.

ASSEMBLY

IMPORTANT: Placement of Expansion Panel (A), as shown below, is recommended but not required for only one storage rack. However, if assembled as shown, the expansion panels will be in the correct position for expanding into a honeycomb configuration; refer to *Configuration Options*, page 3.

Do not fully tighten hardware until all components have been loosely assembled.

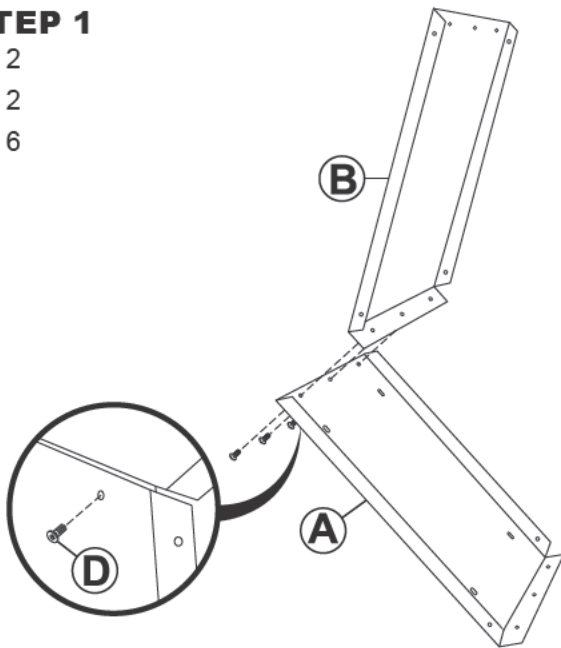

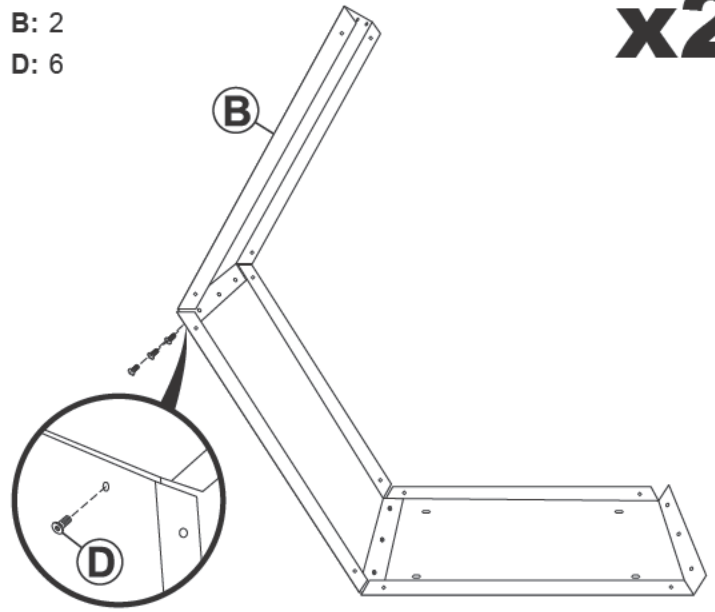
Align the lip of one Solid Panel (B) with the inside of one Expansion Panel (A) and loosely secure using three M6x10mm Bolts (D).

STEP 2

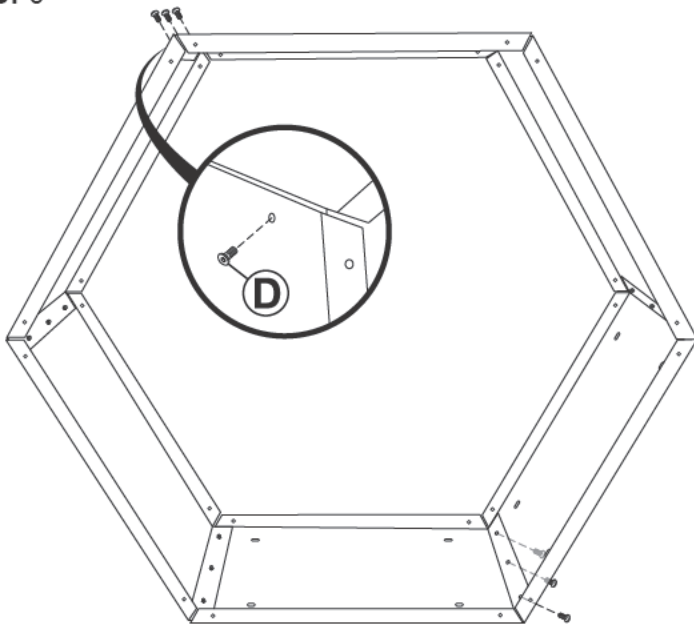

Align the lip of one Solid Panel (B) with the inside of the solid panel from the previous step and loosely secure using three M6x10mm Bolts (D).

STEP 3

D: 6

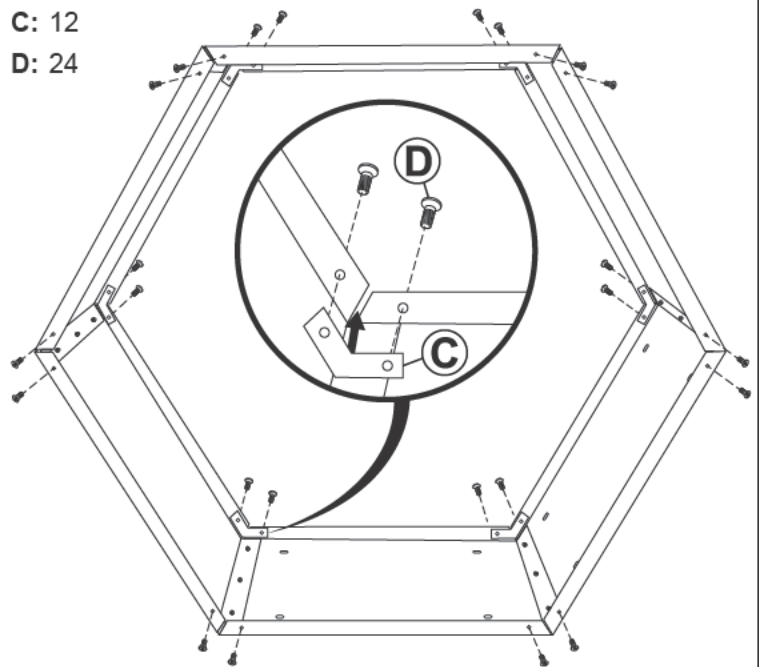


Align the expansion panels and the solid panels. Then, loosely secure using six M6x10mm Bolts (D).

STEP 4

C: 12

D: 24



Loosely secure one Bracket (C) onto each inside corner using two M6x10mm Bolts (D).

Fully tighten all hardware on the entire unit.

CONFIGURATION OPTIONS

Position each unit with Expansion Panels (A) aligned as shown.

Firmly secure each set of expansion panels using four M6x15mm Bolts and four M6 Nuts.

NOTE: Hardware required for securing configurations is only included with

CARE & MAINTENANCE

SAFE USE: Only use on a flat, level surface. To prevent injury and potential damage, always have assistance when moving this item.

Use a protective barrier to prevent damage and/or staining to surfaces such as, but not limited to, wooden decks, concrete patios, paved patios, and indoor flooring.
