

Vessel Sink Installation Guide

STEP 1.



1. Carefully turn the vessel sink upside down and apply silicone to the bottom of the sink approximately 1/3 inch (8 mm) away from the drain hole and the edges.



STEP 2.



2. Turn the sink right side up and position it over the drain hole on the counter, carefully lower it into its permanent place, and ensure the holes line up.



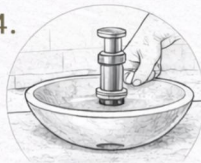
STEP 3.



3. Carefully press down on the sink until it fully contacts the countertop, check for any excess silicone that may have squeezed out.



STEP 4.



4. Proceed to install the vessel sink drain. Refer to the drain installation instructions for guidance.



STEP 5.



5. Before the silicone dries, place a level on both sides the sink to make sure it is perfectly leveled; adjust if necessary.

6. Wait at least 24 hours for the silicone to fully cure before reconnecting water lines and using the sink.

FINISHED!

Reconnect the water lines, turn on the water supply, and check for any leaks around the drain. Carefully clean the sink and surrounding area. Your vessel sink is now installed and ready for use!
