Exploded View



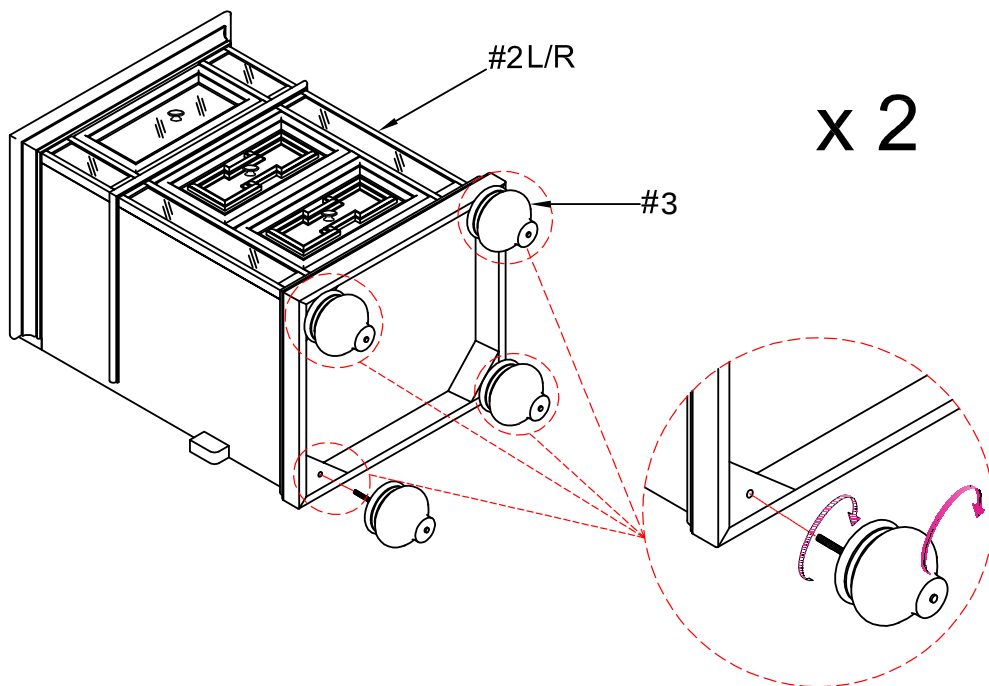

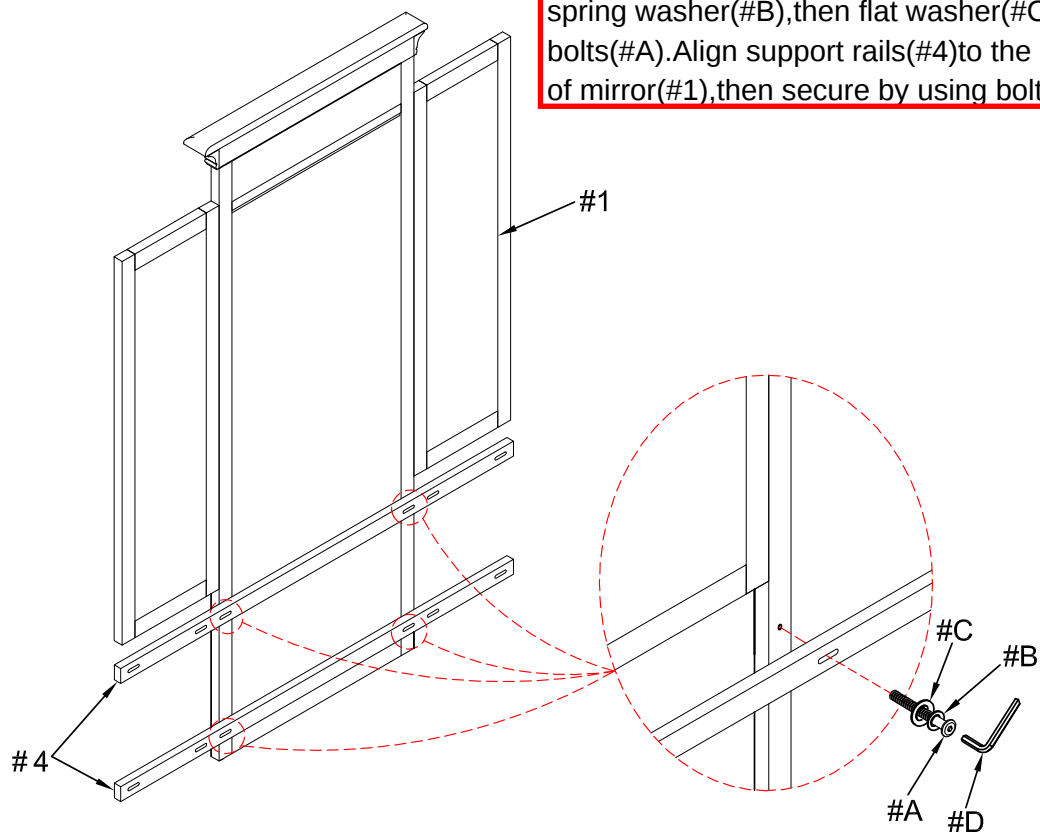

Prepare 4 bolts assembly by inserting spring washer(#B), then flat washer(#C) onto bolts(#A). Align support rails(#4) to the holes of mirror(#1), then secure by using bolts(#A).

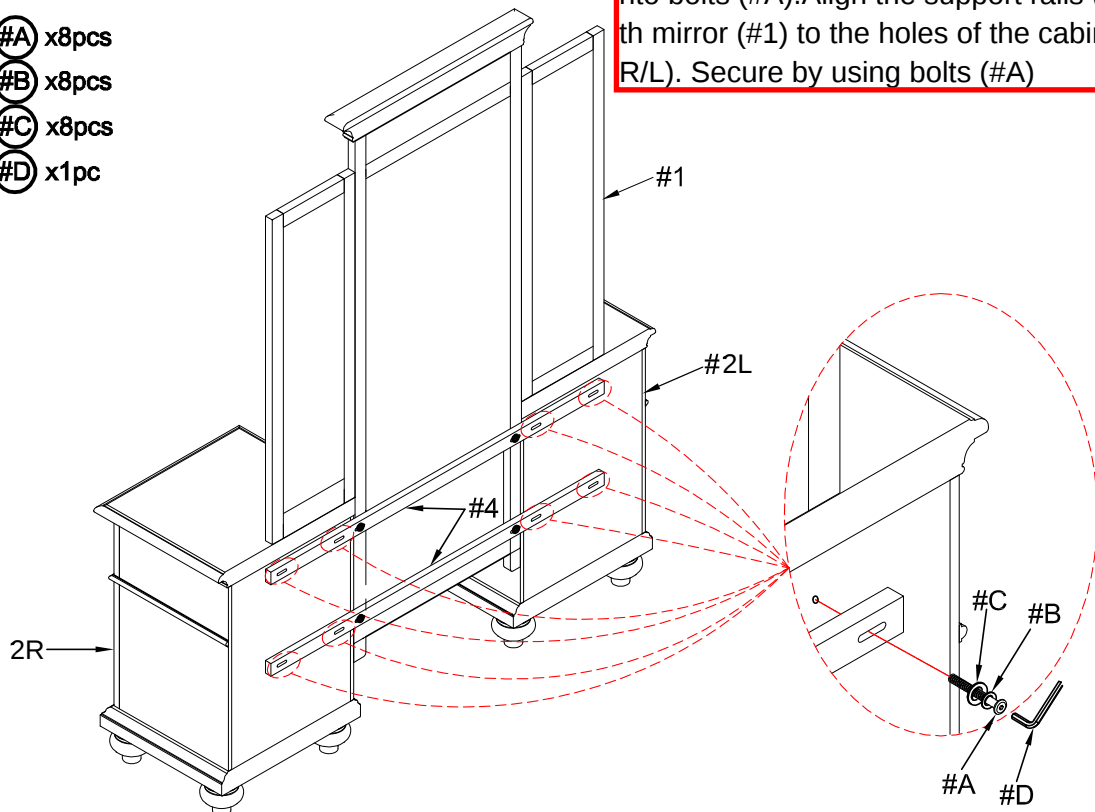

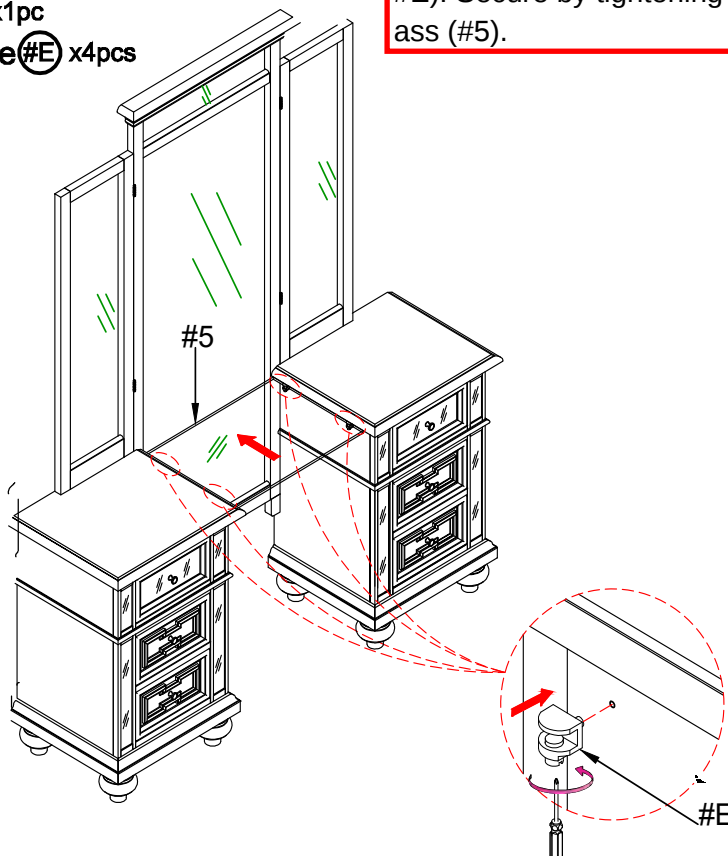
Prepare 8 bolts assembly by inserting spring washer (**#B**), then flat washer (**#C**) onto bolts (**#A**). Align the support rails (**#4**) with mirror (**#1**) to the holes of the cabinets (**#2R/L**). Secure by using bolts (**#A**)

Part **#5** x1pc
 Hardware **#E** x4pcs

Insert shelf pins (**#E**) to the holes of the cabinets (**#2R/L**), then slide glass (**#5**) to the shelf pins (**#E**). Secure by tightening shelf pins (**#E**) with glass (**#5**).



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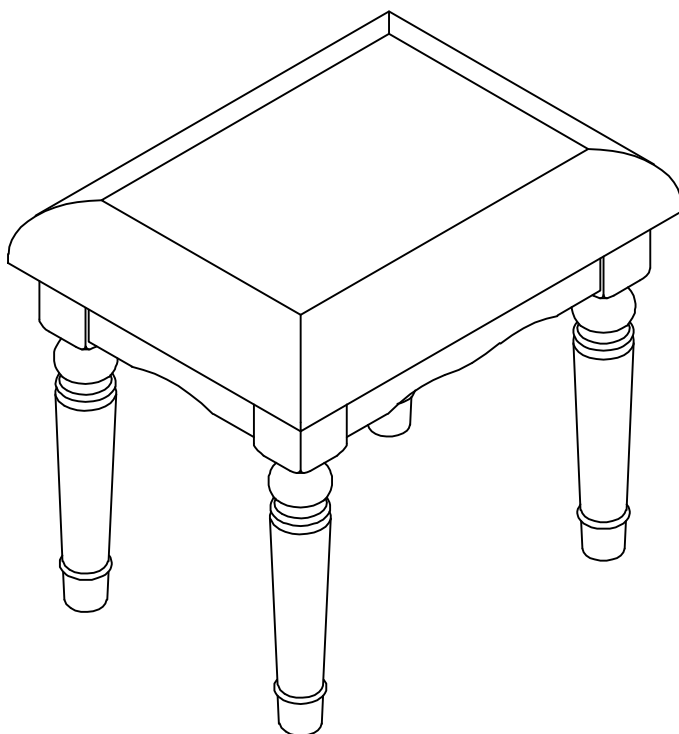
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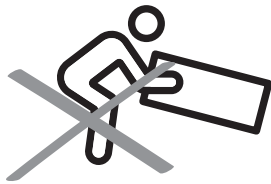
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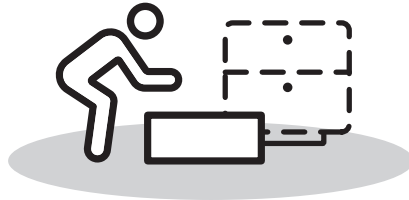
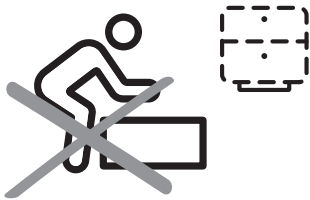
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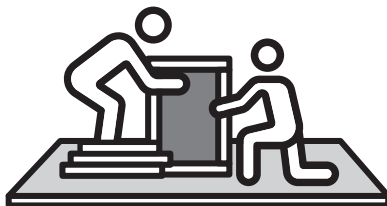
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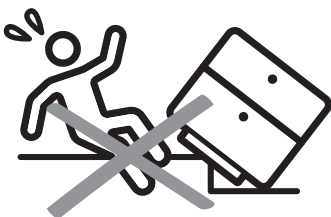
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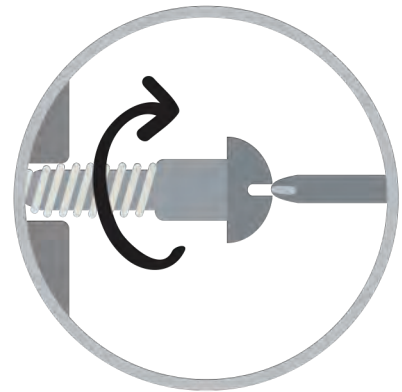
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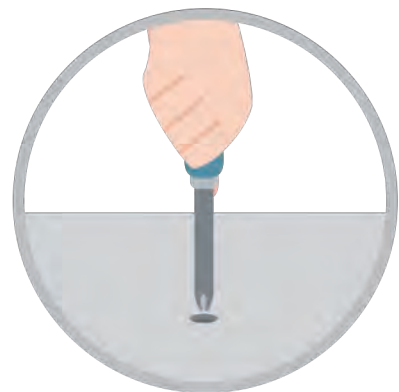


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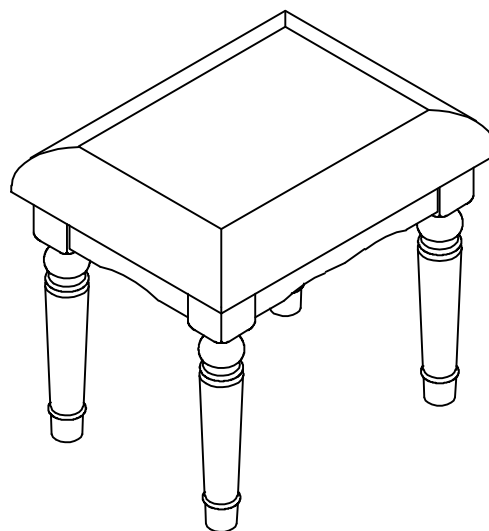
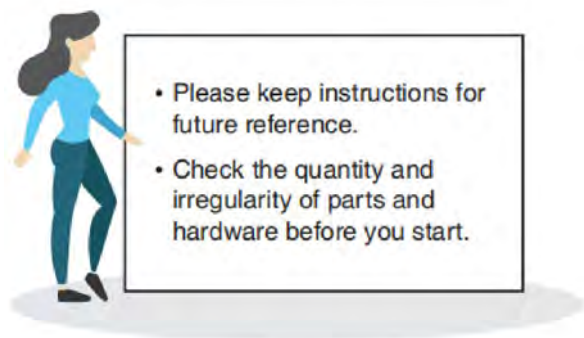
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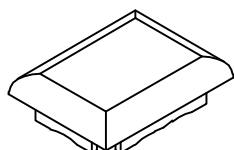
