In each of the previous steps, tighten all screws to approximately 70% to stabilise the overall frame during assembly. Do not fully tighten any screws until the final step is completed.

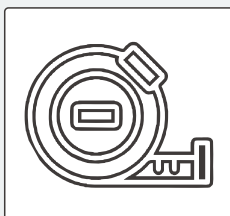

2. Use metal plate (23) to connect wooden board (17) and upholstered headboard part (12), and tighten with screws (A) and (B).



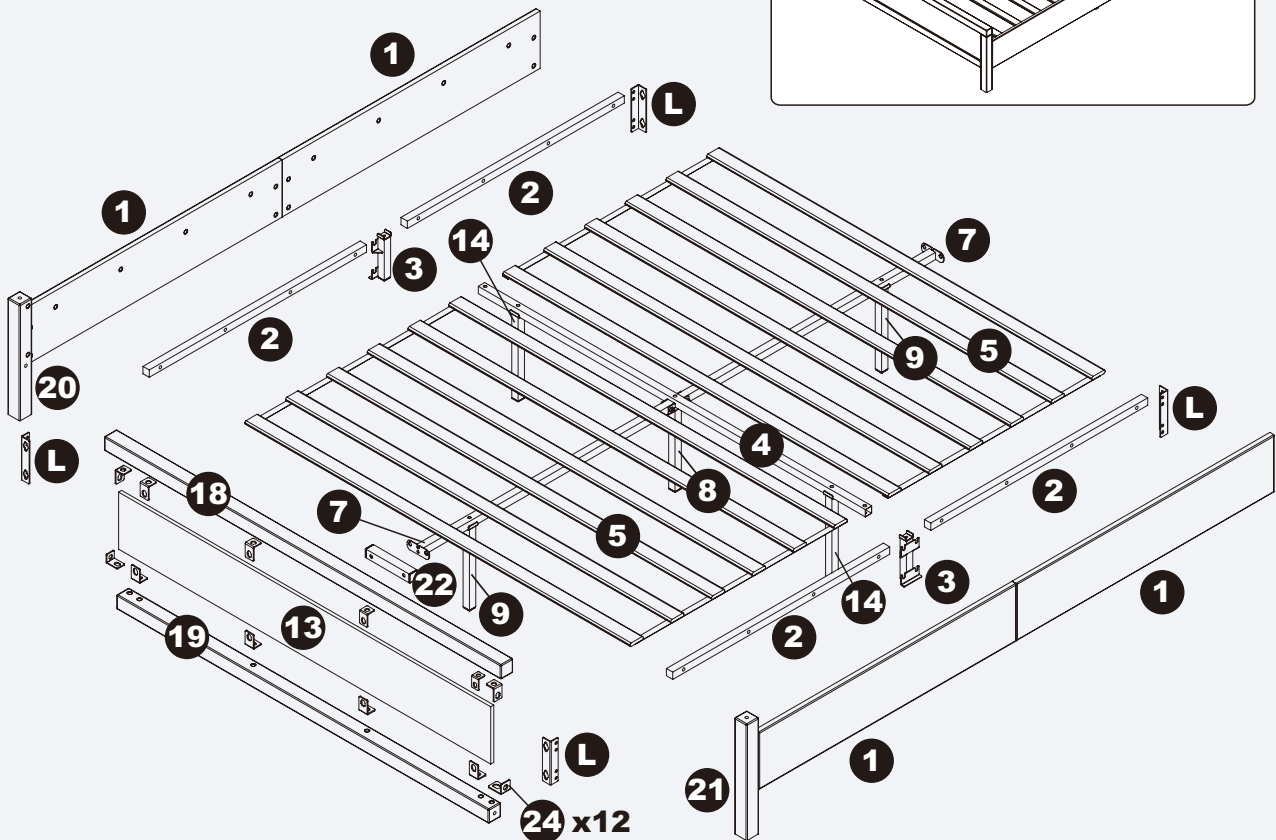
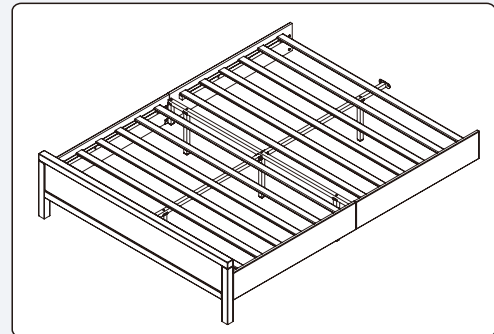

Use screw (B) to fix L-shaped piece (24) onto part (19).

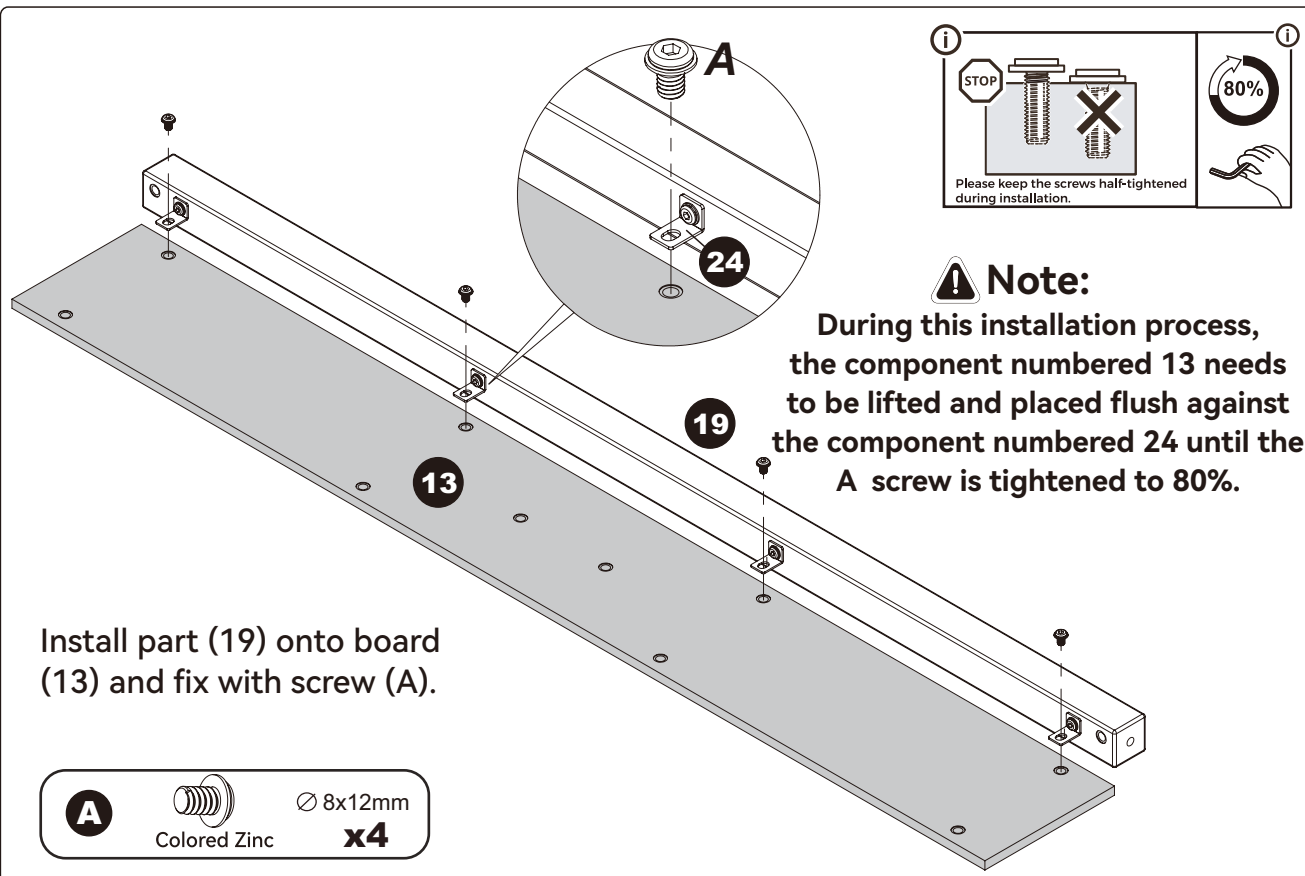

Note: At this step, tighten all screws used in steps 6–8 completely.

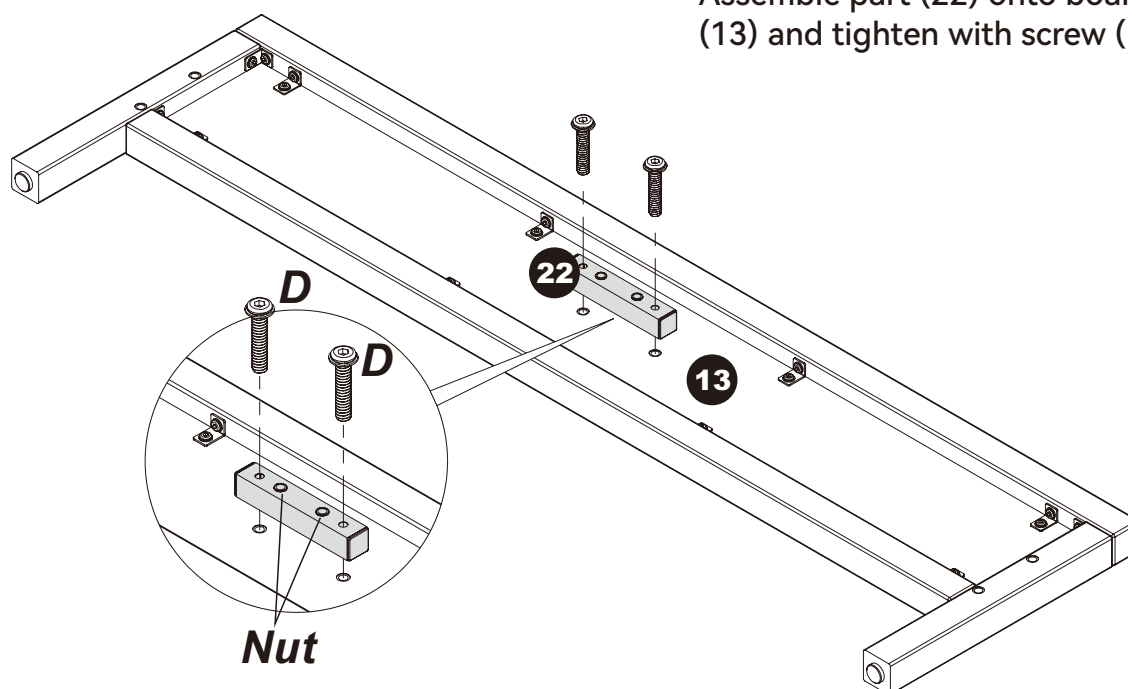

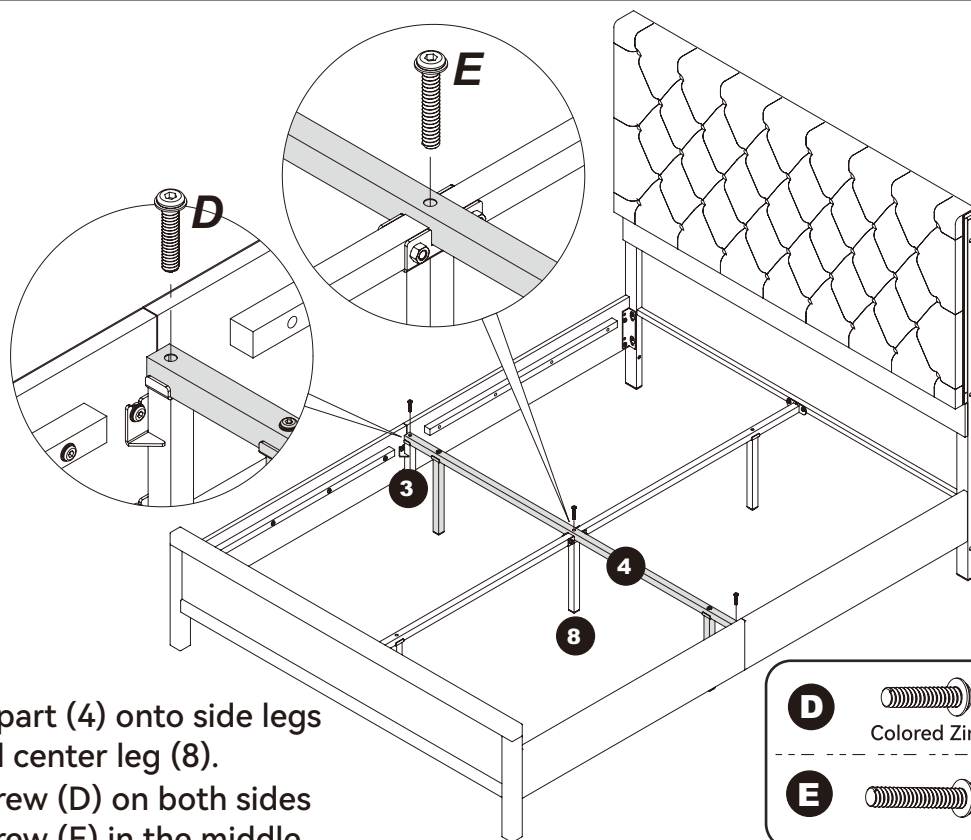
Connect two pieces of part (14) and part (4) as shown, using screw (D).
