Charging the Drive Battery:



IMPORTANT! Before using the unit for the first time the battery needs to be charged for at least **8 to 12** hours - no more than **20** hours. Once battery is depleted, recharge for **8 to 12** hours - no more than **20** hours.

IMPORTANT!

Check the drive battery and charger (supply cord, connector) for wear and damage before charging. Do not charge the battery if damage has occurred. Only replace with the same type and voltage rechargeable battery and charger supplied by the manufacturer.

- Only use the rechargeable battery (or equivalent replacement) and charger supplied with your vehicle.
- Always turn power off and charge battery after riding.
- The drive battery should be charged when depleted, or if not used regularly, once a month. Failure to charge the battery as directed will cause permanent damage to the battery and will void the warranty.

STEPS:

1. Locate Charging Port.
2. Plug Charger plug into unit Charging Port.
3. Plug Charger into Wall outlet.
4. When battery is fully charged, unplug charger from the wall outlet and disconnect from charger port.

NOTE: The charger may feel warm during the charging. If excessively hot, unplug and replace.

NOTE: This product has charging protection: When charging, all functions are turned OFF.

20. Please mind fingers when opening and closing doors.

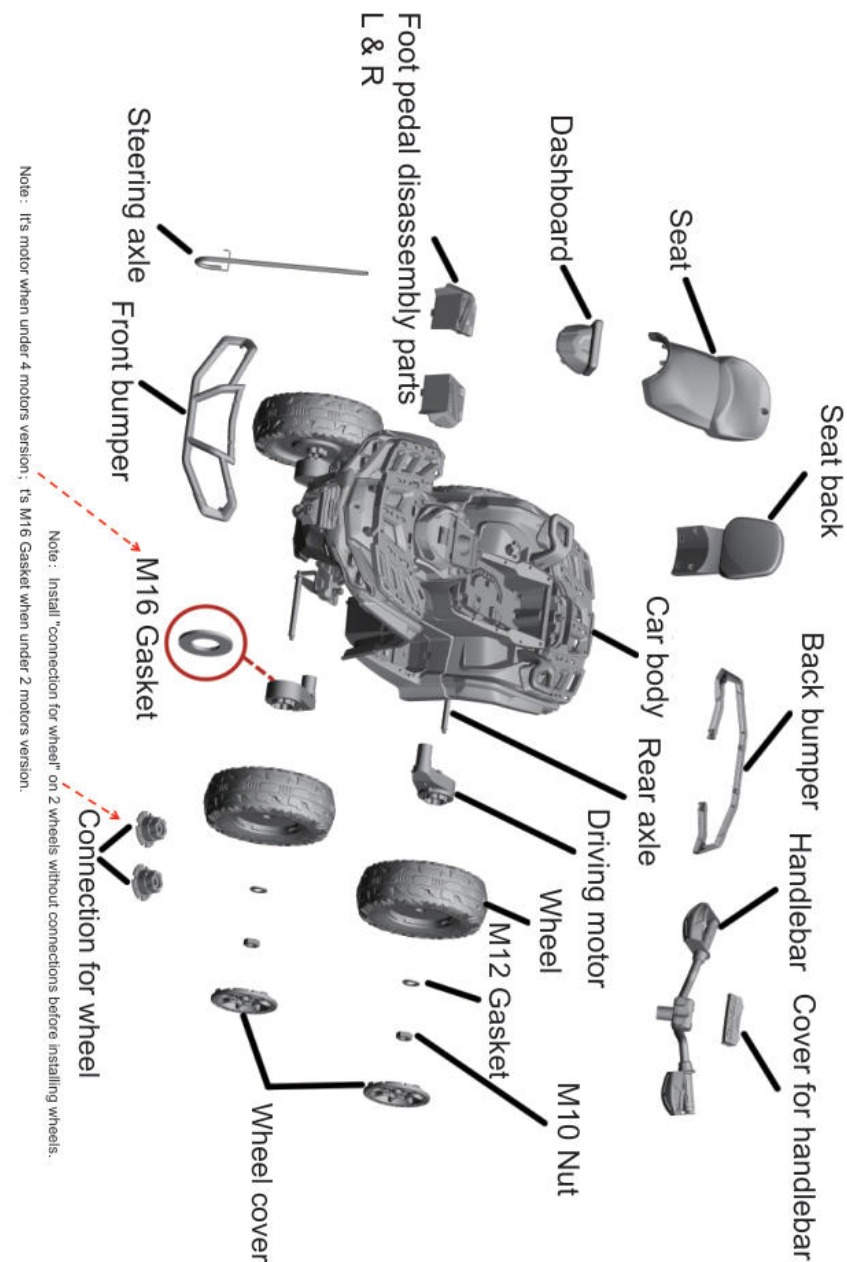

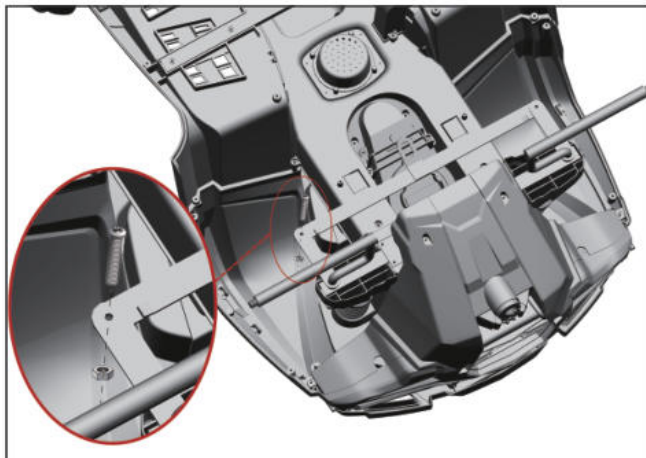

3. Installation steps

Step 1: Adjust front axle

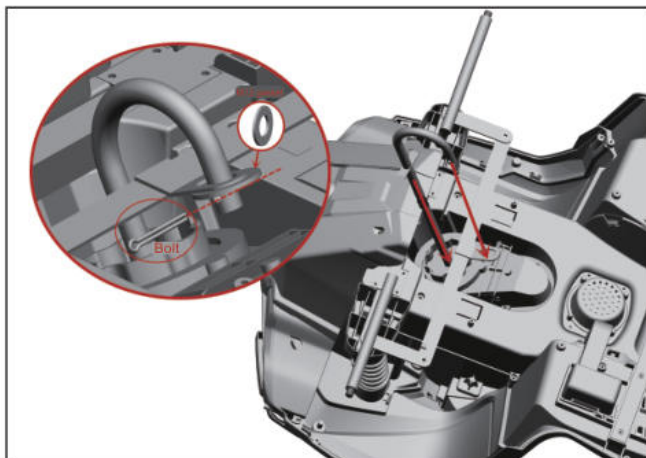
Please adjust front axle to be in place as picture shows, and then insert 1 PC of M6*13mm screw bolt through the cross holes from two iron parts of the front axle. Finally, fix them with 1 PC of M6 nut. Please note that no need to fix very tight, we should ensure that the front axle of changing direction can be turning smoothly.

PS: 1 PC of M6*13mm screw and 1 PC of M6 nut are already on the iron parts of the front axle and need to be removed before installation.



Step 2: Install steering axle

Insert the steering axle into the car body, and use 1PC of M12 gasket and 1PC of bolt to fix.

Troubleshooting

Problem: The vehicle cannot be driven.

Cause of the problem: the battery is insufficient

Please charge in time after each use, and charge at least once a month.

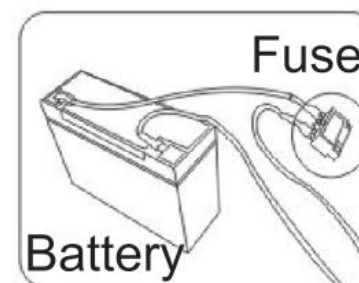
It is recommended to charge for 8-12 hours, not more than 20 hours.

Problem: The car does not move.

Answer : The battery is low, please charge for 8-12 hours

but not exceeding 20 hours.

Charge at least once a month to keep the battery cells active.



To avoid short fuse or power cut off:

1. Do not overload the product. Max load is 50 Kg.
2. Do not drag any item behind this product.
3. Do not allow water or any liquid into electric parts.
4. Do not change wire system without a professional.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem: The car only runs for a short time.

Answer 1: The battery is low, please charge for 8-12 hours

but not exceeding 20 hours.

Charge at least once a month to keep the battery cells active.

Answer 2: The battery may need to be replaced depending on its charging history and age.

Problem: The sound does not work.

Please ensure the volume is turned up and the MP3 line is not connected. Sounds from steering wheel will not work when MP3 is plugged in.

Problem: Charger overheating.

It is normal for battery and charger to be slightly warm during charging. If the charger feel excessively hot, please check for a current overload or battery short circuit.

7. Remote control instructions

Notes: Remote Control is not available for 24V version

Warning! It is not suitable for children under 3 years old.
There are small parts inside and there is a risk of suffocation

- Install two AAA / 7 (1.5V) dry batteries as shown in the figure
- Use a non rechargeable battery, do not charge the battery
- Different types of batteries or old and new batteries cannot be mixed
- Take out the battery from the product in time when the battery runs out
- The positive and negative terminals of the power supply shall not be short circuited
- The package of this product contains important information, please keep it

*This remote is to be used by adult only.

-This toy is unsuitable for children under 3 years due to its maximum speed.

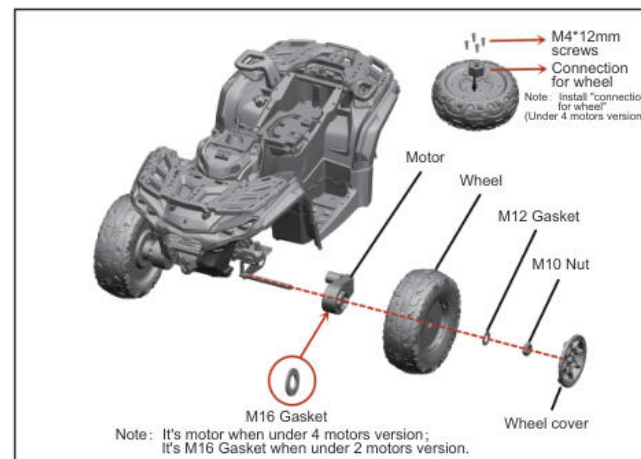

Step 3: Install front wheels

PS: Use 4PCS M4*12mm screws to fix the "connection for wheel" onto the wheels under 4 motors version first.

A: Under 2 motors version: install spare parts onto front axle following the sequences: M16 gasket - Wheels - M12 gasket - M10 nut - Wheel cover.

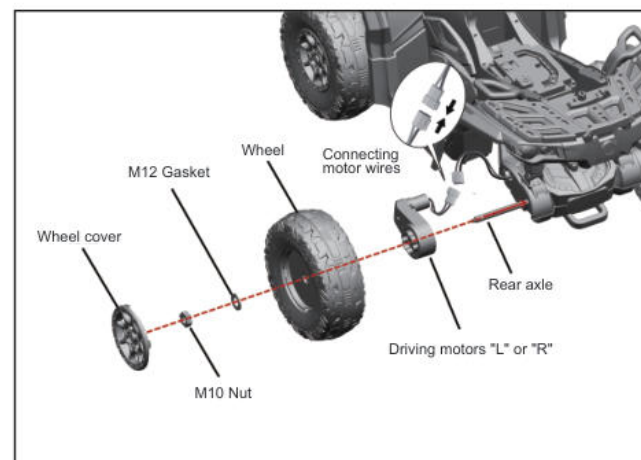
B: Under 4 motors version: install spare parts onto front axle following the sequences: Wheels - M12 gasket - M10 nut - Wheel cover.



Step 4: Install rear wheels

A: Insert rear axle into the car body.

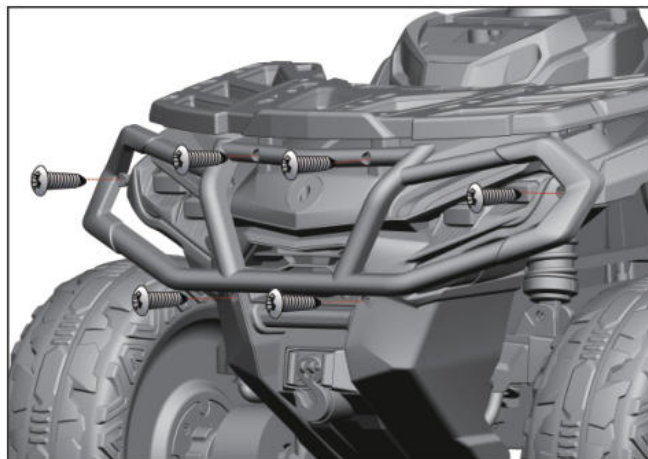
B: Install spare parts following sequences: Driving motors "L" or "R" - Wheel - M12 gasket - M10 nut - Wheel cover.

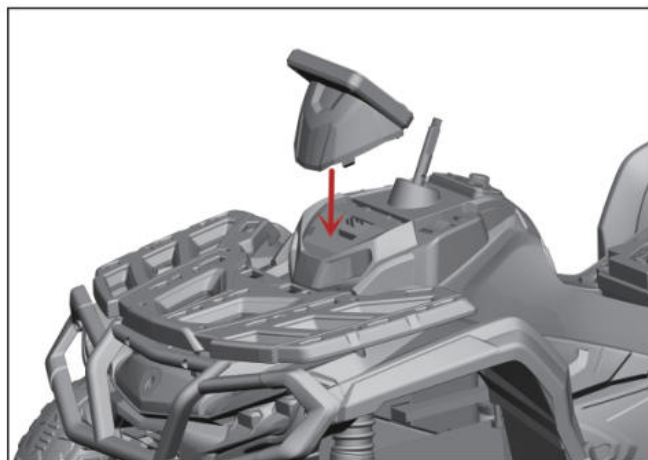
Step 5: Install front bumper

Install front bumper onto the car body, and use 6 PCS of M4*12mm screws to fix.



Step 6: Install dashboard

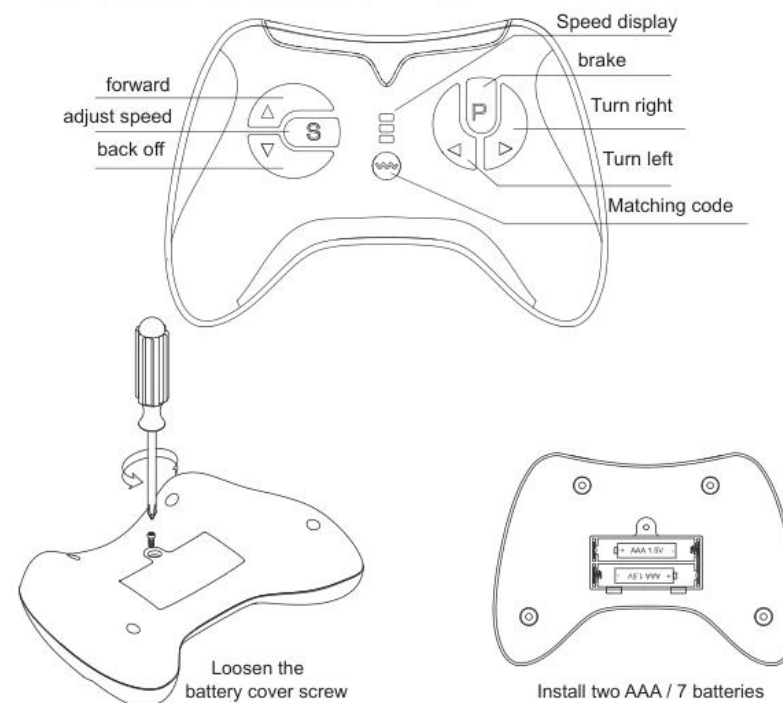
Install dashboard into the car body according to the picture.

6. Remote control frequency matching

Notes: Remote Control is not available for 24V version



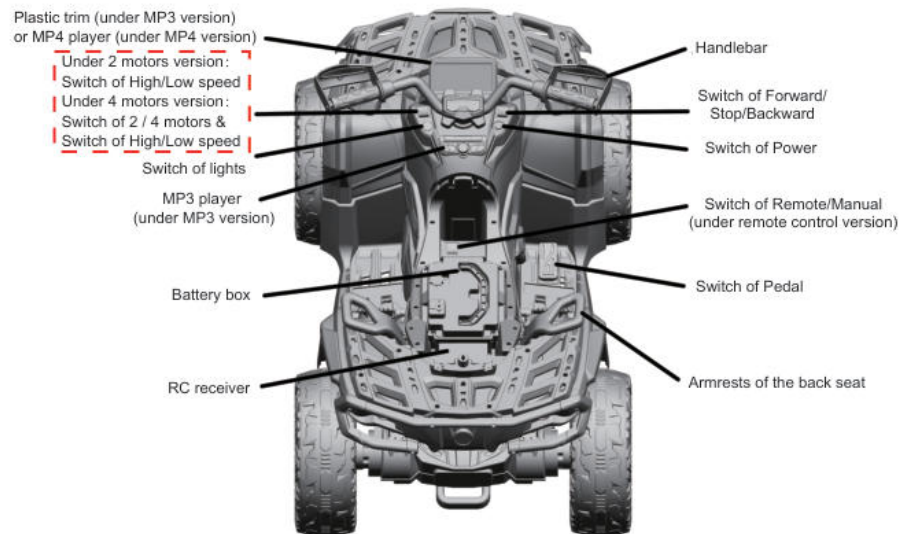
2.4G remote control manual

The first use requires code matching. This product has built-in memory, and it is unnecessary to code after replacing the battery.

1. Turn off the power of the car body, press and hold the "m" key of the remote control, the first indicator light starts to flash after 3 seconds, and then release the key
2. At this time, turn on the power switch of the car body, the first indicator light of the remote control will become normally on, and the code matching is successful
3. When the remote control is not in use, it will enter the sleep state after 10 seconds. Press any key to wake up.
4. Key function description: "forward", "backward", "left", "right", "s" speed regulation, "P" brake. Press the "s" key to set the speed, one light is low speed, two lights are medium speed, three lights are high speed, only medium speed when reversing. Press the "P" key to enter the braking state, the indicator lights all flash, and press the "P" key again to exit the braking state

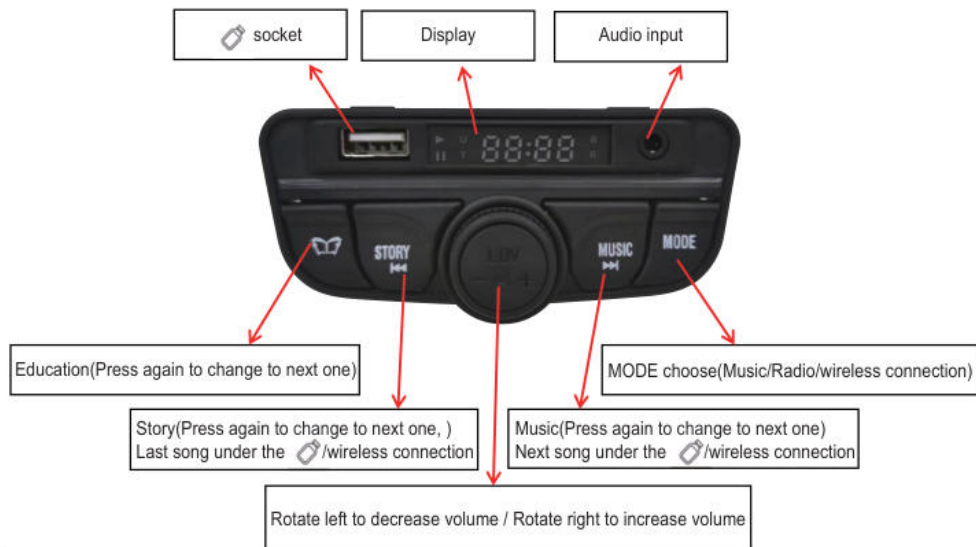

 Under the Remote: the car only can drive by the remote control;

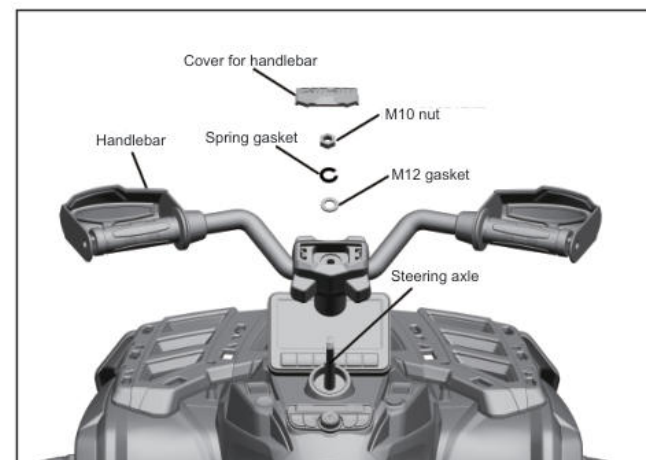

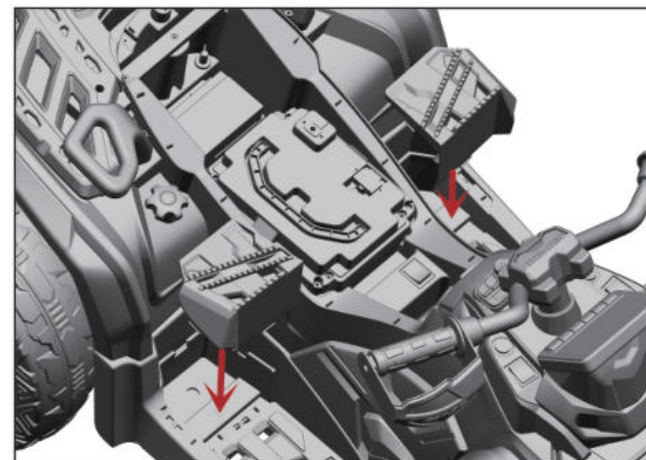
Step 7: Install handlebar

Install the handlebar into the car body, then place: "M12 gasket" - "Spring gasket" - "M10 nut" in sequence to fix on the steering axle(Tighten as tight as possible), finally, cover the "Cover for handlebar".



Step 8: Install foot pedal disassembly parts L & R

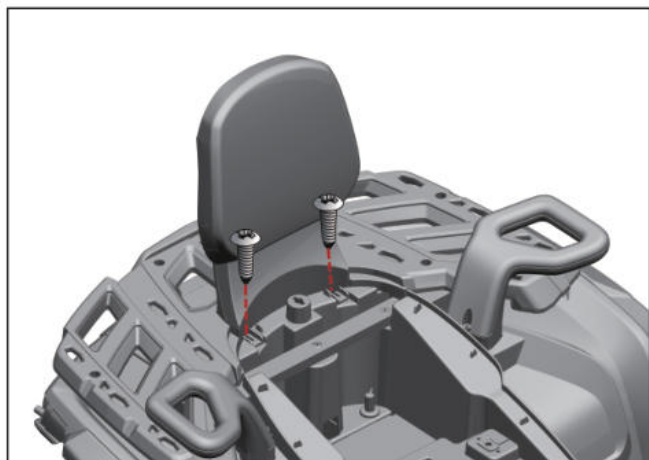
Install foot pedal disassembly parts L & R into the car body according to the picture.

Step 9: Install seat back

Install seat back onto the car body, and use 2 PCS of M4*12mm screws to fix.



Step 10: Connect the power

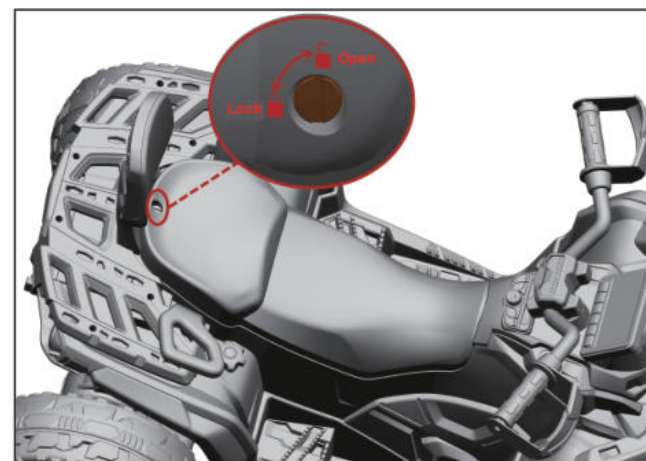
Connect power cables with red plug in part.

Install the seat onto the car body and rotate the seat to fix.



Step 12: Install back bumper

Install back bumper onto the car body, and use 6 PCS of M4*12mm screws to fix.
