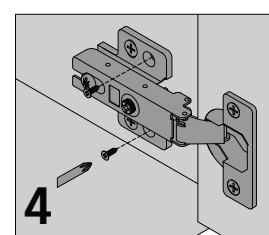
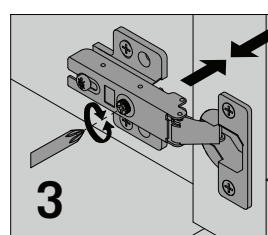
Regarding the installation and adjustment of the door hinge:

1. Use the "waist round hole" marked with a triangle to adjust the position of the door panel (ensure that the gap between the door panel and the upper and lower panels is consistent).
2. Use the screw at the back end of the hinge to adjust the front and back position of the door panel (ensure that the front of the door panel is in the same plane as the upper and lower panels).



3. Use the screw at the front end of the hinge to adjust the left and right position of the door panel (ensure that the left and right sides of the door panel are in the same plane as the upper and lower panels).

4. After completing these three steps, secure the other two screws on the hinge.



WARNING

Serious or fatal injuries can occur from furniture tipping over. To prevent the furniture from tipping over we recommend that it is permanently fixed to the wall.

Wall anchor and hardware are included with this product. Please make sure hardware is suitable for your walls before installing, as different wall materials may require different types of anchors.

Adjusting Floor Levelers

Your furniture has been expertly crafted and pre-adjusted by professionals. However, slight shifts can occur during transportation. If you notice that the doors are not perfectly aligned or the furniture wobbles, a quick adjustment can help ensure stability and a seamless look.

Adjust the Floor Levelers

Check for Stability - Place the furniture in its final position on a level surface.

If it wobbles or doesn't sit evenly, the floor levelers need adjusting.

Locate the Levelers - These are small adjustable feet found at the bottom corners of your furniture.

Adjust as Needed - Using your hand or a wrench, turn the levelers clockwise to raise or counterclockwise to lower the furniture. Make small adjustments and check stability after each turn.
