PRE ASSEMBLY

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.















Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.

Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.

Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.

Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches.


Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

CAM LOCK FASTENER ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


Note :

Every cam lock bolt must have a cam lock connector in order to fasten the parts together.











Screw the cam bolt into panel.




Align the cam lock with its side opening (or arrow) pointing to cam bolt.

Insert the cam bolt into the bolt hole of joint panel.




Turn the cam lock clockwise gently until it will not turn any more.






Identifying Drawer Rails

Each drawer requires a set of 4 rails. Please review the below instructions to help identify the different rails. Left and right determined from the viewpoint of opening the drawer.


Right/Left Panel Rail:

(C-shaped frame)

Align the drawer rails horizontally, with the oval and round holes resting flat against a surface. Rotate as needed so the rollers are located on your right-hand side. If the roller is closer to the bottom corner, this is the RIGHT panel rail. If the roller is closer to the top corner, this is the LEFT panel rail.

Right/Left Drawer Rail:




(S-shaped frame)

Align the panel rails horizontally. Rotate as needed so the rollers are located on your right-hand side. If the roller faces away from you, this is the RIGHT drawer rail. If the roller faces towards


Left Drawer Rail

When grouped together, the right drawer rail and right panel rail will interlock with rollers at opposite ends. Likewise for the left drawer and left panel rails.












Wall Mounting and Fixing




EXPANSION WALL ANCHOR

Our provided expansion wall anchors are only suitable for masonry walls, such as drywall, plaster or concrete, and are best for holding lightweight items or for anti-tip prevention. If you are unsure of the correct wall anchor to use with the product, please request professional guidance. liability for product damage or failure due to using the incorrect anchors will fall on the installer.



CHECK BEFORE PROCEEDING

Prior to drilling or hammering, please check for wires or pipes. We recommend using a stud finder to locate a stud, which will offer more appropriate resistance and hold more weight.



) MAINTENANCE



We recommend a yearly check to see if the wall anchor or screw has loosened. If so, please remove the existing wall anchor and screw, and use a new anchor.
