


















WARNING: Do not leave the gazebo where there is a risk of high wind, as possible damage will occur to the structure.



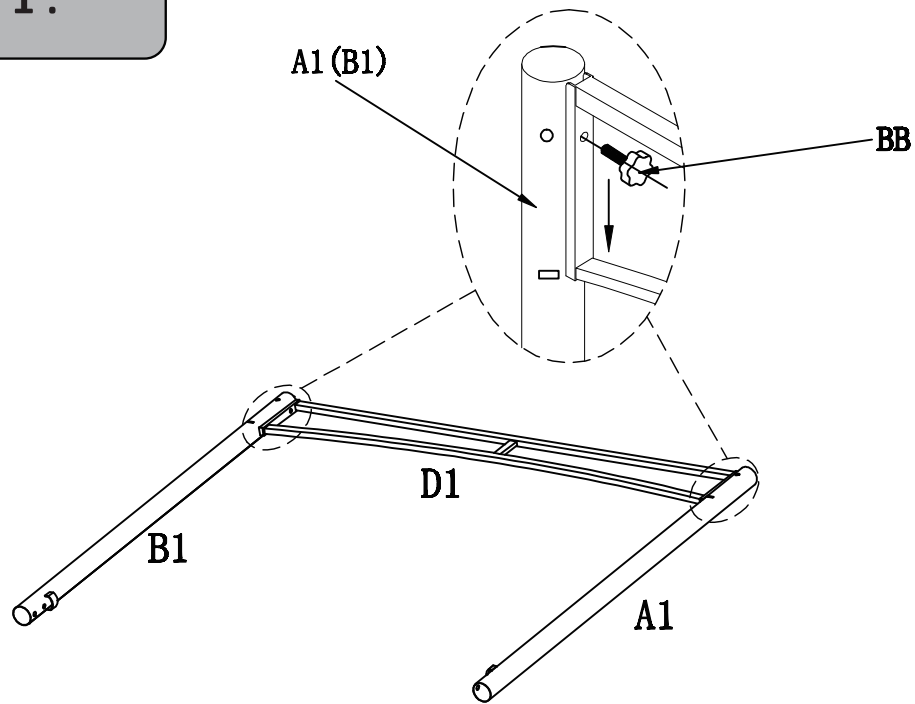

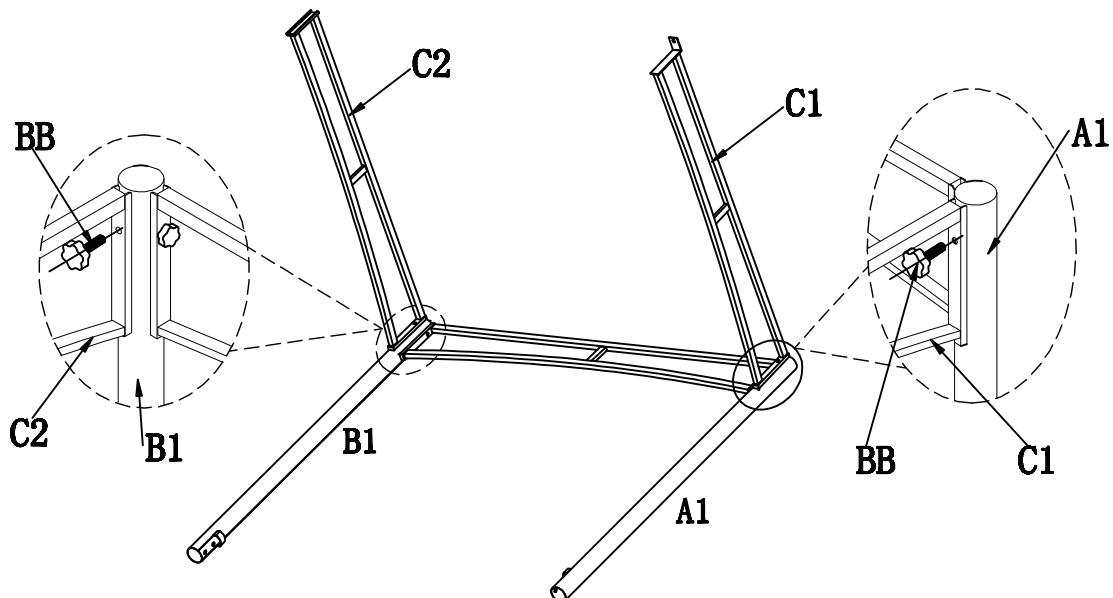

STEP 1 :



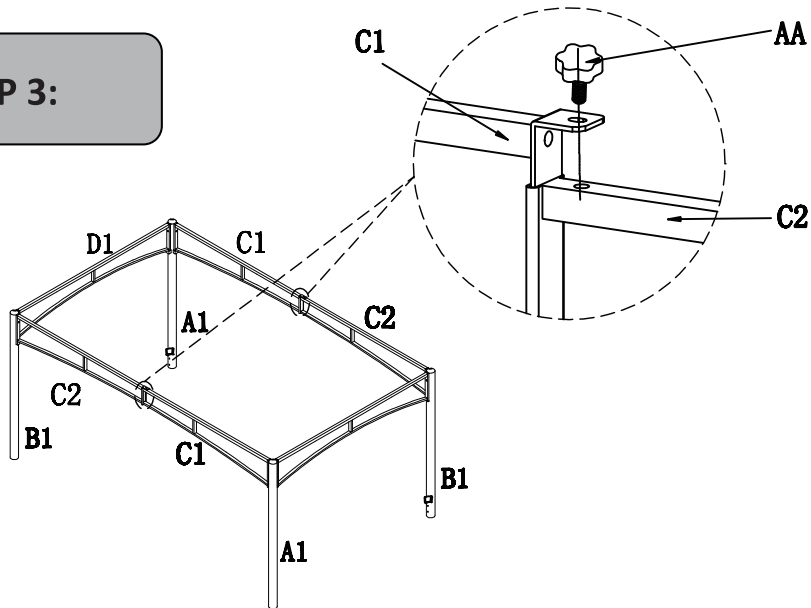
Please assemble legs of B1 and A1 into Side Beam (D1) by using screws (BB)
We need to assemble 2 sets of above parts.

STEP 2:



Based on Step 1, we have to assemble C1 into leg (A1) by using Screws (BB)
And assemble C2 into leg (B1) by using screws (BB) too.
Please do 2 sets of this part also.

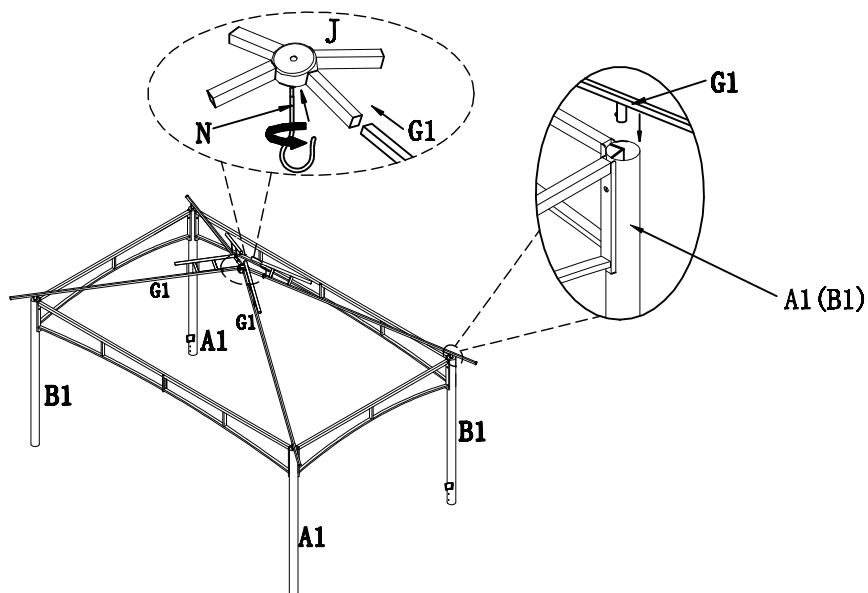
STEP 3:



Now we have to assemble the 2 parts of Step 2 together.
You can see the picture that the C2 can be assembled into C1 by screws AA.
For both 2 sides.

Then we have finished the the core part of the main structure.

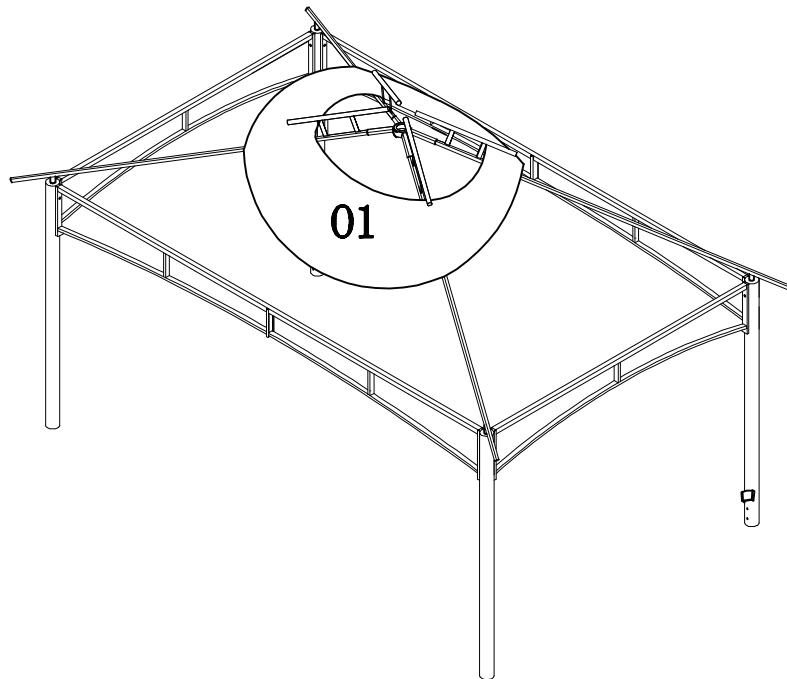
STEP 4:



In this step, firstly we have to find the hook (N) and the top plate (J). Please assemble N into J.
And please note the hook should be under the top plate when assembled.
Now we have to find out 4 PCS of G1 which we have to assembled them into the Top plate (J).
Choose the side with Inclined pipe jacking to connect with J please, and assemble another side into the hole of Leg (A1 and B1) There is a small pole as a connector.

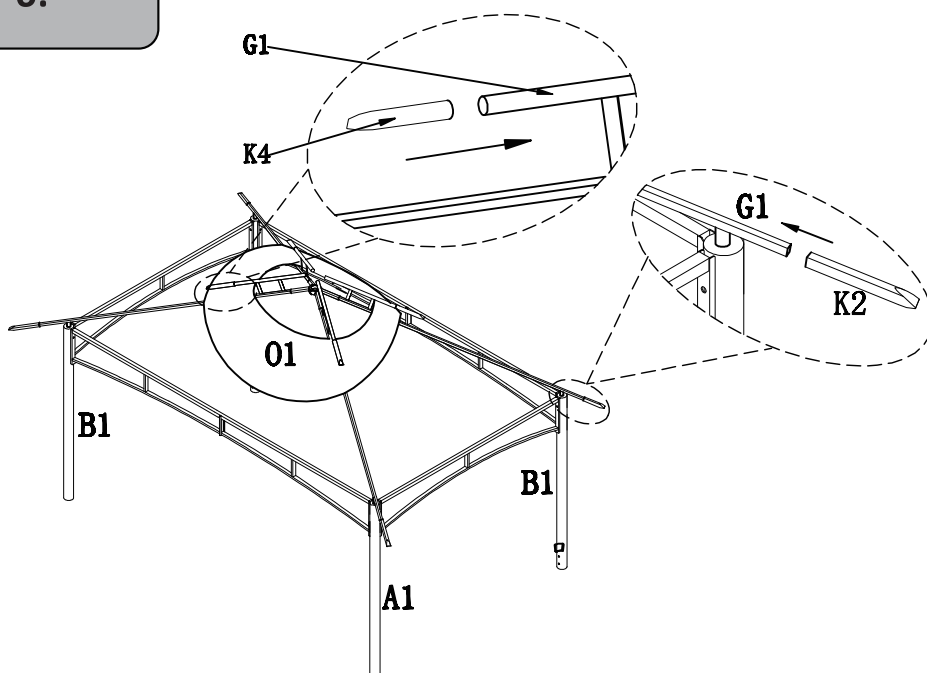
Now we have already finished the structure.

STEP 5:



Now we are going to place the Big canopy (01) above the frame first. And make sure the frame of skylight is on top of the 01.

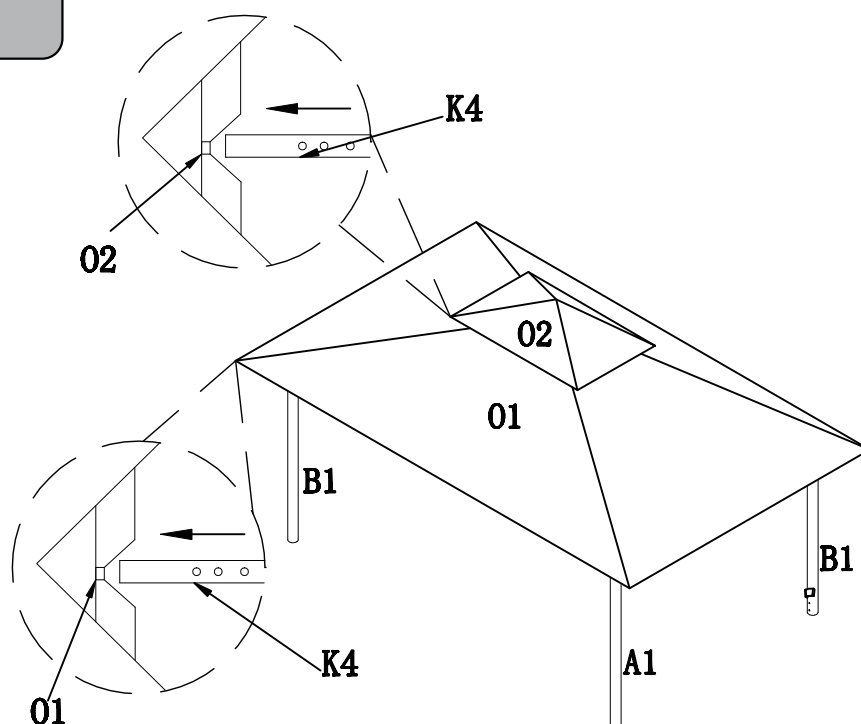
STEP 6:



After Step 6, we need to assemble the Telescopic rods (K2) into the end of G1 as picture shows.

Also please assemble Telescopic rod (K4) into the end of G1.

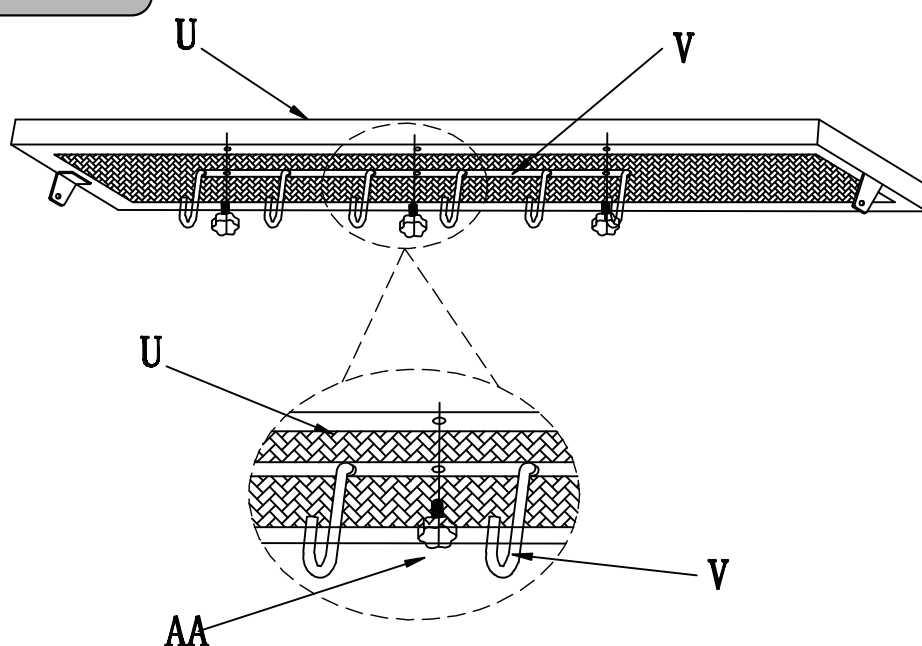
STEP 7:



Please place the small canopy (02) above the skylight and Insert K4 into pocket and then adjust the tightness of the 02 in 4 sides

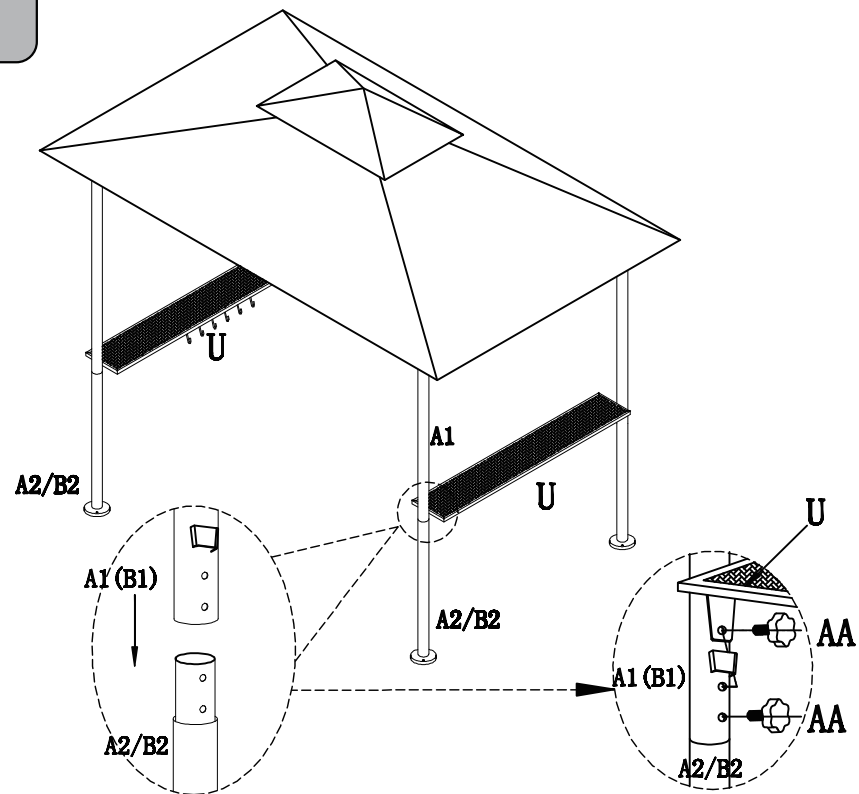
Also please insert K2 to the pocket of 01 and then adjust the tightness in 4 sides.

STEP 8:



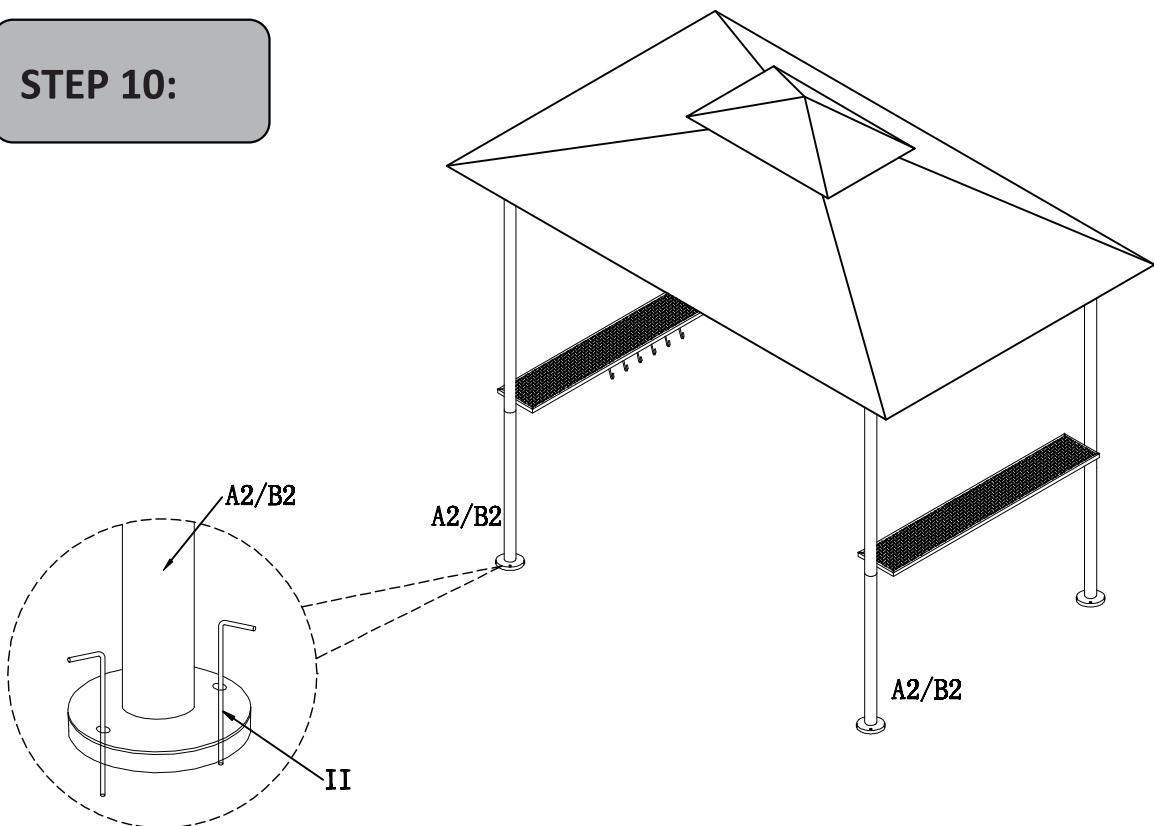
Please assemble V part into U part with screws AA.

STEP 9:



Please assemble the second Legs (A1/B2) into each leg, and do not lock them with screws first. We have to place the U part into the card slot on the legs at the same time then lock up by screws AA.

STEP 10:



Finally, we have to insert the long screws II into the holes at the bottom of each second legs. To make sure this BBQ gazebo is strong enough.

And then congratulations, the assembly has finished.

Care and Maintenance

Our steel components for garden accessories and furniture are treated with rust inhibiting paint that protects it from rusting. However, due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur once these protective coatings are scratched. This is not a defect and thus not covered by the warranty.

To minimize this condition, we recommend care when assembling & handling the product to prevent scratching the paint. Should any scratching or damage occur, we recommend immediate touch-up with rust inhibiting paint.

Surface rust can also be easily removed with a very light application of common cooking oil. If surface oxidation (rusting) occurs and if no measure is taken to prevent this, the oxidation may start dripping on to deck or patio and caused damaging stains, which may be difficult to remove. This can be prevented if the above-mentioned measures are taken to keep the product from oxidizing.

Use damp cloth to wipe off the stains as quickly as possible.

If necessary, wash with a mild solution of soap and water; rinse thoroughly and dry completely.

Periodically check and ensure that all bolts are well-tighten during use
