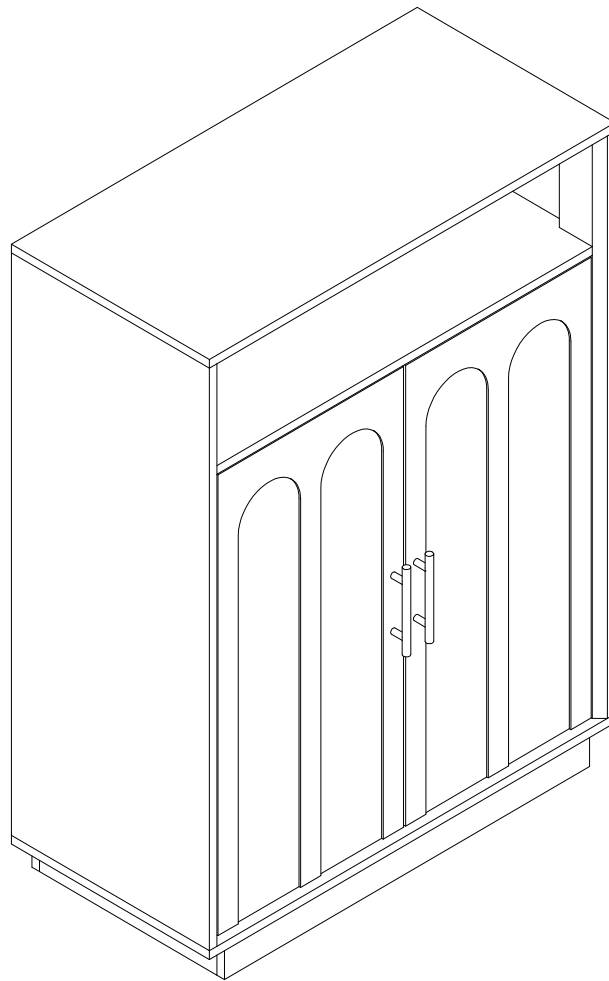


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

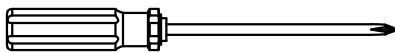

NOTES BEFORE YOU START

1. If an odor is present when first opening the package, please leave the unwrapped product in a shaded and ventilated area for a few days to air out.
2. Open and assemble the item in the area you plan to keep it to avoid excessive heavy lifting.
3. Assemble the product in a spacious space, and on a soft, clean surface to avoid damage and scratches.
4. **TWO PEOPLE** are recommended for ease in the assembly of this product.
5. Ensure all parts and hardware are available before assembly. If you find any part is damaged or missing, please email us, we will send you the replacement asap.
6. Follow each step in the manual to ensure the proper assembly.
7. You will use the following tools: a Phillips head screwdriver and rubber hammer.
The wood dowels may need to be gently tapped in lightly with a rubber hammer.

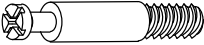
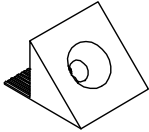
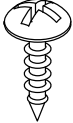
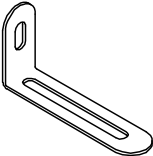
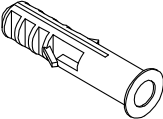
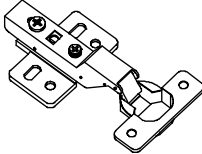
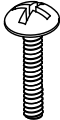
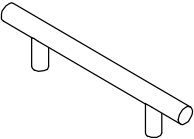
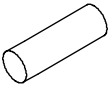
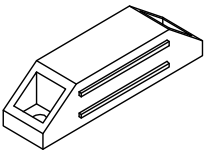
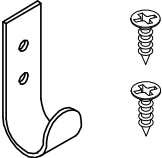
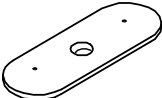
WARNINGS

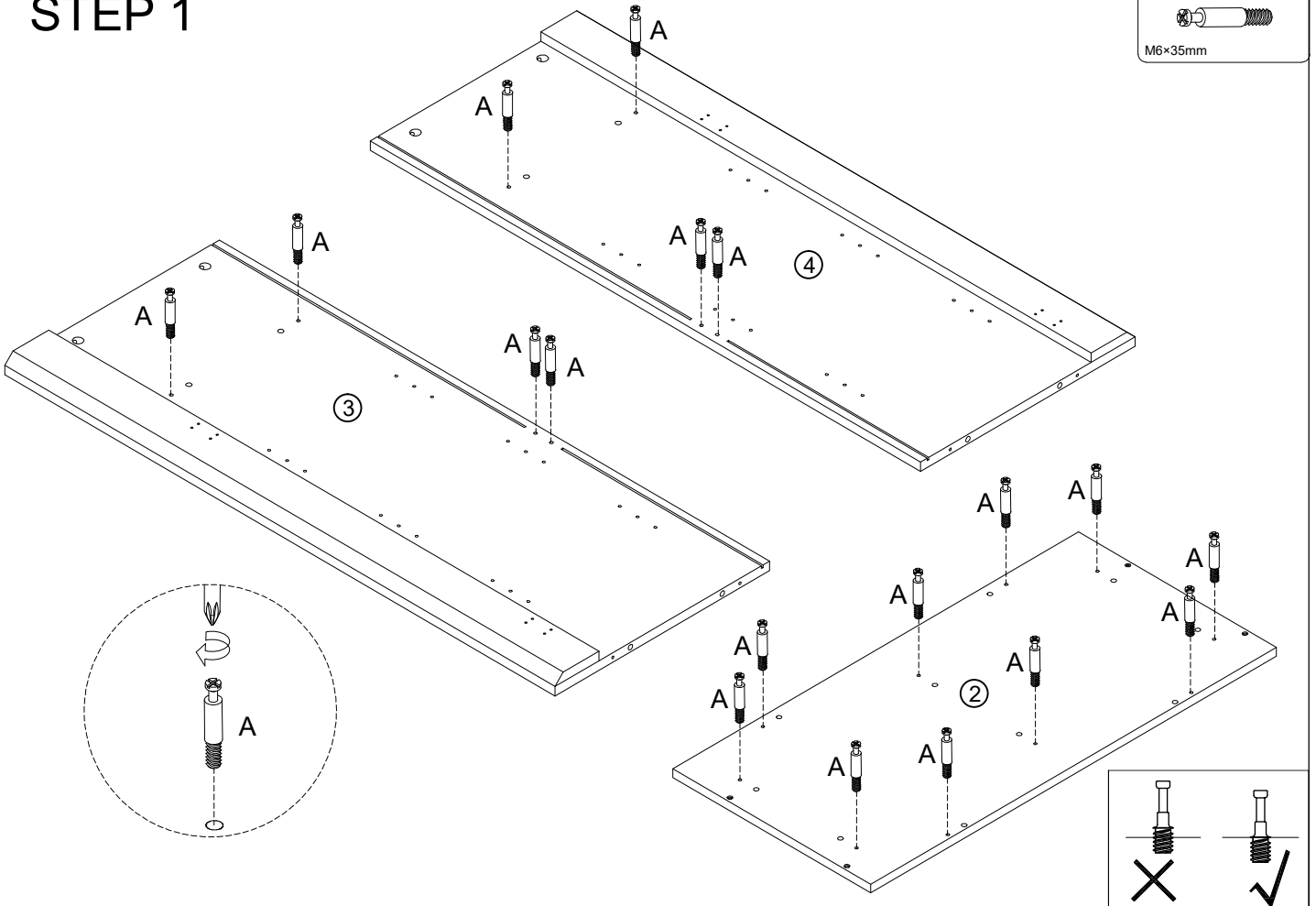
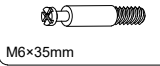
CAM LOCK/BOLT FASTENING INTRODUCTION

(You will use it during assembly)

1 	2 	3 	4 
1.Screw cam bolt into the threaded anchor gently. (Attention:don't screw cam bolt too deep or too shallow.)	2.Please connect the two boards you want connect by inserting cam bolt.	3.Insert the cam lock into the round hole of the board. (Attention:point the arrow on the top of the cam lock to the outer edge.)	4.Turn the cam lock clockwise until it is firmly tightened.

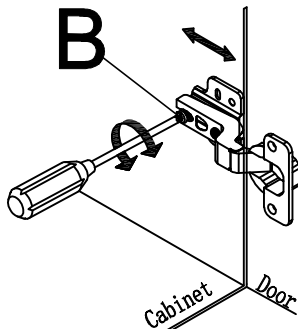
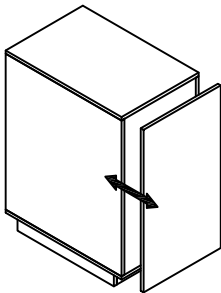
If you find a large gap above or below the door.

To adjust the vertical height.

Loosen the four screws "A" on both hinges.

Two of them are usually in slotted holes which allows you to adjust up or down by a few mm.

Then tighten back up.



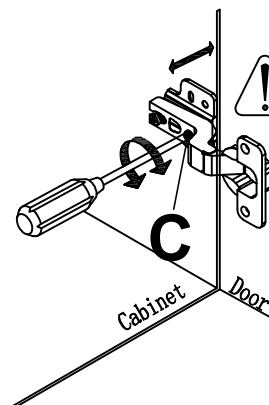
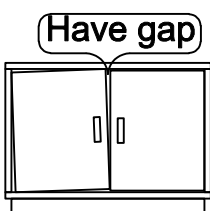
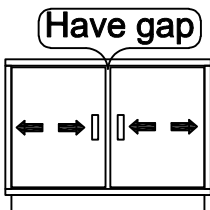
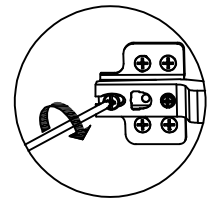
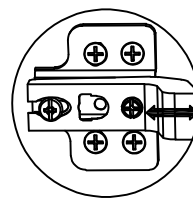
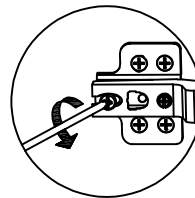
If you find the door is too protruding or too inside.

To adjust depth.

Loosen screw "B" on both hinges and move the door to suit.

If the door doesn't move, turn screw "C" on both hinges 1-2 turns and try again.

Finally, tighten both screw "B" and reset both screw "C".



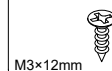
