

# Installation Manual

## I. Tools & Parts Required

- . **Tools:** Allen wrench (usually included), Phillips-head screwdriver
- . **Parts:** Desktop, Solid wood base frame (partially pre-assembled), Screws (with washers)

## II. Installation Steps

### Step 1: Prepare the Desktop

- Place the desktop **upside down** on a soft cloth to protect the finish (prevents scratching).

### Step 2: Assemble the Base Frame

- . Position the solid wood base frame (typically a pre-assembled cross-shaped or square frame) over the pre-drilled holes on the bottom of the desktop.
- . Align the frame's mounting holes with the holes in the desktop. Using the Allen wrench, **insert and tighten** the provided screws.
- **Important:** Hand-tighten all screws lightly first to align the frame, then tighten them securely one by one. Do this to prevent misalignment.

### Step 3: Secure the Frame & Adjust

- . Ensure all frame screws are **evenly and securely tightened. Do not overtighten**, as this could crack the wood.
- . Carefully **turn the table upright**. Gently rock the table to check for stability.
- **If unstable:** Slightly adjust the tightness of the leg screws OR add leveling pads under the legs.

## III. Important Notes

- . **Two-person assembly is recommended** due to the weight of the desktop.
- . **After assembly, do not drag the table.** Always **lift it to move**.
- . **Periodically check** all screws to ensure they remain tight and prevent loosening over time.
