

WARNING: To avoid risk of electrical shock, be sure to shut off power while installing or servicing this fixture.

NOTE: We advise calling a qualified electrician when making the wire connections to the junction box.


- 1. Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts on a clean surface.
- 2. Thread the 2 mounting screws through the mounting screw holes from the back of the mounting bracket.
- Attach mounting bracket to the outlet box using 2 box screws. The side of the mounting bracket marked "GND" must face out.
- 4. Follow the wiring instruction carefully as detailed below.
- 5. Attach the fixture main body onto the outlet box by protruding 2 mounting screws through the mounting screw holes on the fixture cover plate (A), then tighten with 2 ball nuts (B).
- 6. Assembly the shade (C) onto the socket sleeve (D).
- 7. Install the bulb into the socket.

 BULB(S) NOT INCLUDED. DO NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM WATTAGE RATING.
- 8. Installation is now complete. Turn on power.



CONNECT THE ELECTRICAL WIRES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Connect the black wire from the fixture to the black (HOT) house wire with wire connector.
- 2. Connect the white wire from the fixture to the white (NEUTRAL) house wire with wire connector.
- 3. Connect the ground wire to the house ground wire (GREEN OR BARE COPPER). Or attach the bare copper fixture wire to the green ground screw on the cross bar.
- 4. Tuck the wire connections neatly into the junction box.
