

MAGNETIC HEART CURTAIN TIEBACK

Installation Guide

What's Included

In Your Package:

- 1 or 2 × Decorative magnetic tiebacks with heart design (depending on selected quantity)
- Strong magnetic closure system on each
- Flexible cord connector (12" total length each)

Color Selection:

Your heart tieback(s) come in the color you selected. All colors feature the same high-quality magnetic system and durable construction.

Tools Needed:

- None required - no drilling or hardware installation needed!
- Clean, dry cloth (for initial cleaning if desired)

Important Safety Information

- Keep away from children under 3 years - contains strong magnets
- Do not use near pacemakers or electronic devices sensitive to magnets
- Avoid pinching fingers when magnets snap together
- Check curtain weight capacity before use

Step-by-Step Installation

1 Prepare Your Curtains

Ensure your curtains are clean and properly hung. The tieback works best with curtains that are already in their final position.

Tip: If curtains are new, let them hang for 24 hours to settle before installing tiebacks.

2 Determine Tieback Position

Decide where you want the tieback positioned on your curtain. Common positions are:

- **High position:** 1/3 from the top - creates an elegant drape
- **Middle position:** Center of curtain - balanced look
- **Low position:** 2/3 down - more casual appearance

3 Gather the Curtain

Pull your curtain to one side and gather the fabric at your chosen position. The gathered fabric should be no more than 9 inches in circumference for proper magnetic closure.

Note: This model has a shorter inside length (9") than our flower model, making it ideal for lighter curtains.

4 Position the Heart Element

Place the decorative heart element on the front-facing side of your gathered curtain where you want it to be visible. The heart design adds a charming, romantic touch to your decor.

5 **Wrap Around Curtain**

Bring the magnetic cord around the back of the gathered curtain fabric. The cord should wrap comfortably around the curtain without being too tight or too loose.

6 **Connect the Magnets**

Bring the magnetic ends together behind the curtain. You should feel the strong magnetic pull as they approach each other. Let them snap together securely.

7 **Adjust and Perfect**

Adjust the curtain draping and the position of the heart element until you achieve the desired look. The tieback should hold securely while allowing natural curtain movement.

Pro Installation Tips

- For heavier curtains, position the tieback slightly higher for better support
- With a set of 2, install tiebacks at the same height for perfect symmetry
- For wide windows with multiple panels, use one tieback per panel
- The heart element can be rotated to find the most appealing angle
- For sheer curtains, the magnetic connection may be visible - consider this in positioning
- The shorter 9" inside length makes this perfect for lighter, more delicate curtains

Usage Instructions

To Open Curtains:

Simply pull the curtain toward the tieback. The magnetic connection will hold the gathered fabric securely in place.

To Close Curtains:

Gently separate the magnetic connection and allow the curtain to fall naturally back into position.

Maintenance & Care

Regular Care:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe heart element with a soft, damp cloth as needed
- **Magnetic Care:** Keep magnets free from metal debris and dust
- **Cord Care:** Check cord for wear; replace if fraying occurs
- **Storage:** When not in use, keep magnets connected to maintain strength
- **Color Care:** Clean gently to preserve the color finish

Troubleshooting

Problem: Magnets won't hold curtain

Solution: Curtain may be too thick or heavy. Try gathering less fabric or consider our longer model for better fit around thicker curtains.

Problem: Heart element keeps spinning

Solution: Adjust the cord tension or position. The heart should rest naturally against the curtain fabric.

Problem: Tieback slips down curtain

Solution: Ensure magnets are properly connected and positioned. Some fabrics are more slippery - try positioning slightly higher.

Problem: Magnets difficult to separate

Solution: Pull apart using a sliding motion rather than straight pulling. This is normal for strong magnets.

Problem: Heart element looks crooked

Solution: Rotate the heart until it sits naturally. The flexible cord allows for adjustment of the decorative angle.

⚠ When NOT to Use

- With very heavy drapes or curtains (over 3 lbs per panel - lighter than flower model)
- On curtains with thick padding or lining that exceeds 9" circumference when gathered
- Near heat sources that could damage the decorative finish
- On outdoor curtains exposed to weather

- If curtain is too thick, consider our longer model instead

Final Check

Installation Complete When:

- ✓ Heart element is positioned attractively on curtain front
 - ✓ Magnets connect securely behind curtain
 - ✓ Curtain drapes naturally and attractively
 - ✓ Tieback holds firmly without slipping
 - ✓ Easy to connect and disconnect as needed
 - ✓ Color complements your room's decor
