Do not dispose of any contents until assembly is completed.

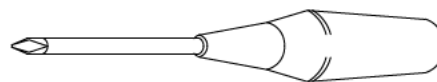

3. Headboard frame (1 pc)
4. Footboard Posts (2 pcs L&R)
7. Left sideboard (1 pc)
8. Right sideboard (1 pc)

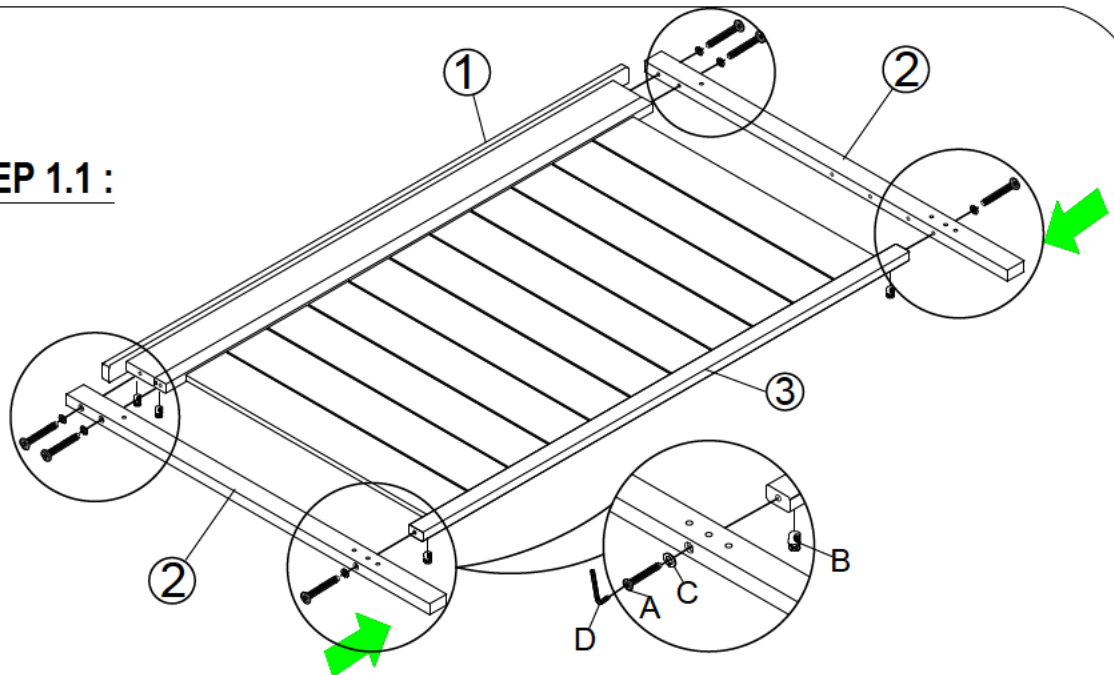

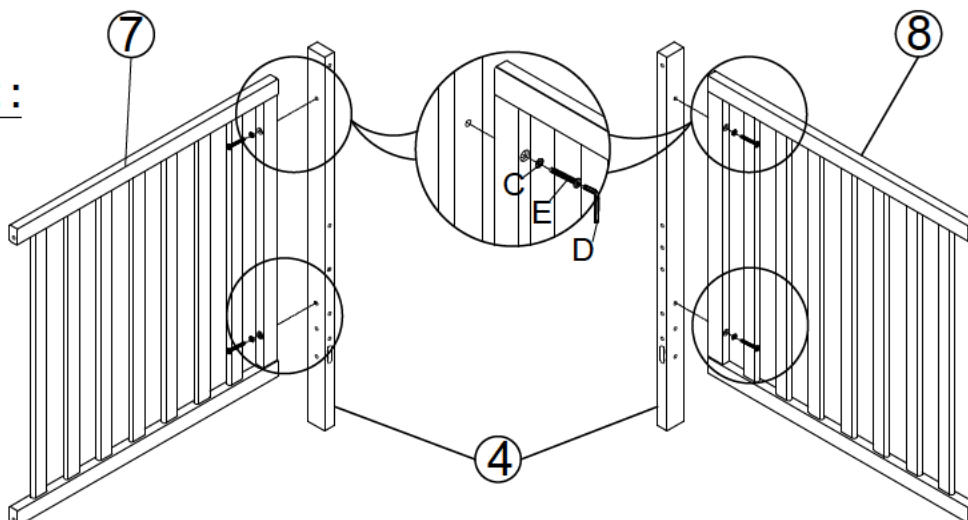

- Assembly the Headboard post (L&R) (2) to the hole on Headboard top frame (1) and Headboard bottom frame (3) by Allen bolt (A), Spring washer (C) and Barrel Nut (B). Tighten all bolts by Allen Key (D).

STEP 1.2 :

- Assembly Left sideboard (7) and Right sideboard (8) with Footboard Post (L&R) (4) by Allen bolt (E) and Spring washer (C) . Tighten all bolts by Allen key (D).

STEP 2 " ASSEMBLY OF HEADBOARD TO SIDE FRAME"

5. Stabilizer bar (1 pc)

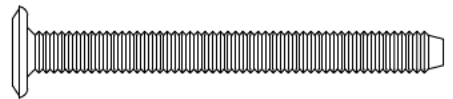
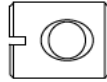

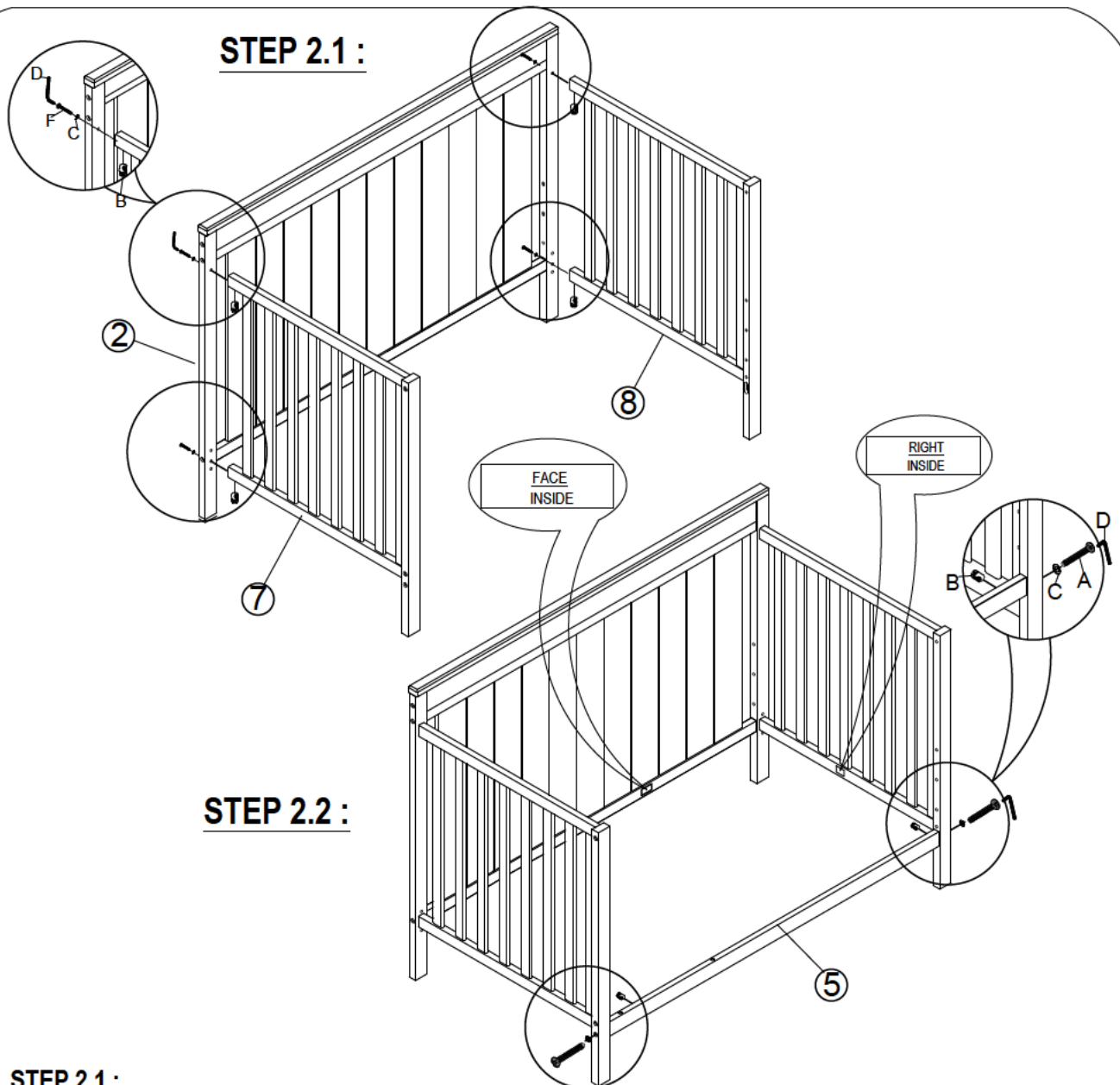

- Assembly the Sideboard (L&R) (8) (7) to the hole on Headboard post (L&R)(2) by Allen bolt (F), Spring washer (C) and Barrel Nut (B). Tighten all bolts by Allen Key (D).

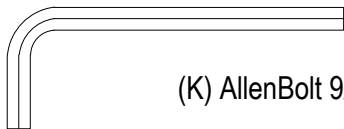
- Assembly Footboard Post (L&R) (4) with Stabilizer bar (5) by Allen bolt (A), Spring washer (C) and Barrel Nut (B) . Tighten all bolts by Allen key (D).

- Make sure the Mattress Spring (9) is leveled after assembly.

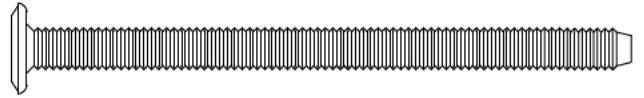

STEP 4 :

Assembly the upper rail of Footboard frame (6) to the Footboard Post (L&R) (4) by Allen bolt (A), Spring washer (C) and Barrel Nut (B) as shown in FIG.4. Tighten all bolts by Allen Key (D).

Assembly the bottom rail of Footboard frame (6) to the Footboard Post (L&R) (4) by Allen bolt (F), Spring washer (C) as shown in FIG.5. Tighten all bolts by Allen Key (D). Complete assembly as shown in FIG.6.

 **“CAUTION: ANY MATTRESS USED IN THIS CRIB MUST BE AT LEAST 27 1/4 INCHES (69 CM) BY 51 5/8 INCHES (131 CM) WITH A THICKNESS NOT EXCEEDING 6 INCHES (15 CM). THE DIMENSIONS OF THE MATTRESS SHALL BE TAKEN FROM SEAM TO SEAM OR EDGE TO EDGE WHERE APPROPRIATE.”**

- FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE WARNINGS AND THE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH.
- INFANTS CAN SUFFOCATE ON SOFT BEDDING. NEVER ADD A PILLOW OR COMFORTER. NEVER PLACE ADDITIONAL PADDING UNDER AN INFANT.
- TO REDUCE THE RISK OF **SIDS**, PEDIATRICIANS RECOMMEND HEALTHY INFANTS BE PLACED ON THEIR BACKS TO SLEEP, UNLESS OTHERWISE ADVISED BY YOUR PHYSICIAN.

STRANGULATION HAZARD:

- STRINGS CAN CAUSE STRANGULATION! **DO NOT** PLACE ITEMS WITH A STRING AROUND A CHILD'S NECK, SUCH AS HOOD STRINGS OR PACIFIER CORDS. **DO NOT** SUSPEND STRINGS OVER A CRIB OR ATTACH STRINGS TO TOYS.
- TO HELP PREVENT STRANGULATION TIGHTEN ALL FASTENERS. A CHILD CAN TRAP PARTS OF THE BODY OR CLOTHING ON LOOSE FASTENERS.
- **DO NOT** PLACE CRIB NEAR WINDOW WHERE CORDS FROM BLINDS OR DRAPES MAY STRANGLE A CHILD.

FALL HAZARD:

- WHEN CHILD IS ABLE TO PULL TO A STANDING POSITION, SET MATTRESS TO LOWEST POSITION AND REMOVE BUMPER PADS, LARGE TOYS AND OTHER OBJECTS THAT COULD SERVE AS STEPS FOR CLIMBING OUT.
- STOP USING CRIB WHEN CHILD BEGINS TO CLIMB OUT OR REACHES THE HEIGHT OF 35 IN (89 CM). THE CHILD SHOULD BE PLACED IN A YOUTH OR REGULAR BED.

WARNING!

- IF REFINISHING, USE A NON-TOXIC FINISH SPECIFIED FOR CHILDREN'S PRODUCTS.
- FOLLOW WARNINGS ON ALL PRODUCTS IN A CRIB.
UPON COMPLETION OF ASSEMBLY, BE SURE ALL SCREWS, BOLTS AND FASTENING DEVICES HAVE BEEN SECURELY TIGHTENED. A FREQUENT CHECK SHOULD BE MADE.
- WHEN STORING CRIB, USE CAUTION AS EXTREME CHANGE IN TEMPERATURE OR HUMIDITY CAN COMPROMISE THE FINISHING QUALITY OF CRIB, MAKING IT EXTREMELY DANGEROUS TO YOUR CHILD
- STORE THE CRIB IN A CLEAN DRY PLACE.
- USE CAUTION WHEN A VAPORIZER OR HUMIDIFIER IS IN USE. ALWAYS AIM VAPOR AWAY FROM THE CRIB AS WELL AS ANY OTHER WOODEN FURNITURE. PROLONGED PERIODS OF HUMIDITY IN STORAGE AS WELL AS THE HOME CAN COMPROMISE THE FINISHING QUALITY OF CRIB.
- AVOID USING VAPORIZERS AND HUMIDIFIER FOR PROLONGED PERIODS OF TIME.
- PLEASE DISPOSE ALL PACKAGING AND PLASTIC BAGS.
- PLEASE CLEAN THE CRIB WITH A DRY CLOTH AND USE MILD WOOD POLISH IF REQUIRED.
- NEVER USE PLASTIC SHIPPING BAGS OR OTHER PLASTIC FILM AS MATTRESS COVERS BECAUSE THEY CAN CAUSE SUFFOCATION.
- INFANTS CAN SUFFOCATE IN GAPS BETWEEN CRIB SIDES AND A MATTRESS THAT IS TOO SMALL.

CANADIAN WARNING

- DO NOT USE THIS CRIB IF YOU CANNOT EXACTLY FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTION THAT COMES WITH IT.
- DO NOT USE THIS CRIB FOR A CHILD WHO CAN CLIMB OUT OF IT OR WHO IS TALLER THAN 89 CM.
- DO NOT PLACE ANY CORD, STRAP OR SIMILAR ITEM IN OR NEAR THIS CRIB THAT COULD BECOME WRAPPED AROUND A CHILD'S NECK.
- DO NOT PLACE THIS CRIB NEAR A WINDOW OR A PATIO DOOR WHERE A CHILD COULD REACH THE CORD OF A BLIND OR A CURTAIN AND BE STRANGLED.
- CHECK THIS CRIB REGULARLY BEFORE USING IT AND DO NOT USE IT IF ANY PARTS ARE LOOSE OR MISSING OR IF THERE ARE ANY SIGNS OF DAMAGE. DO NOT SUBSTITUTE PARTS. CONTACT M DESIGN VILLAGE IF REPLACEMENT PARTS OR ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS ARE NEEDED.
- CHILDREN CAN SUFFOCATE ON SOFT BEDDING. DO NOT PLACE PILLOWS, COMFORTERS OR SOFT MATTRESSES IN THIS CRIB.
- USE A CRIB MATTRESS THAT IS NO THICKER THAN 15 CM AND IS OF SUCH A SIZE THAT, WHEN IT IS PUSHED FIRMLY AGAINST ANY SIDE OF CRIB, IT DOES NOT LEAVE A GAP OF MORE THAN 3 CM BETWEEN THE MATTRESS AND ANY PART OF ANY OTHER SIDES OF THE CRIB.

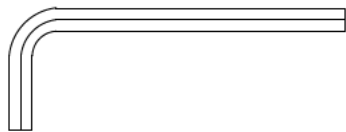
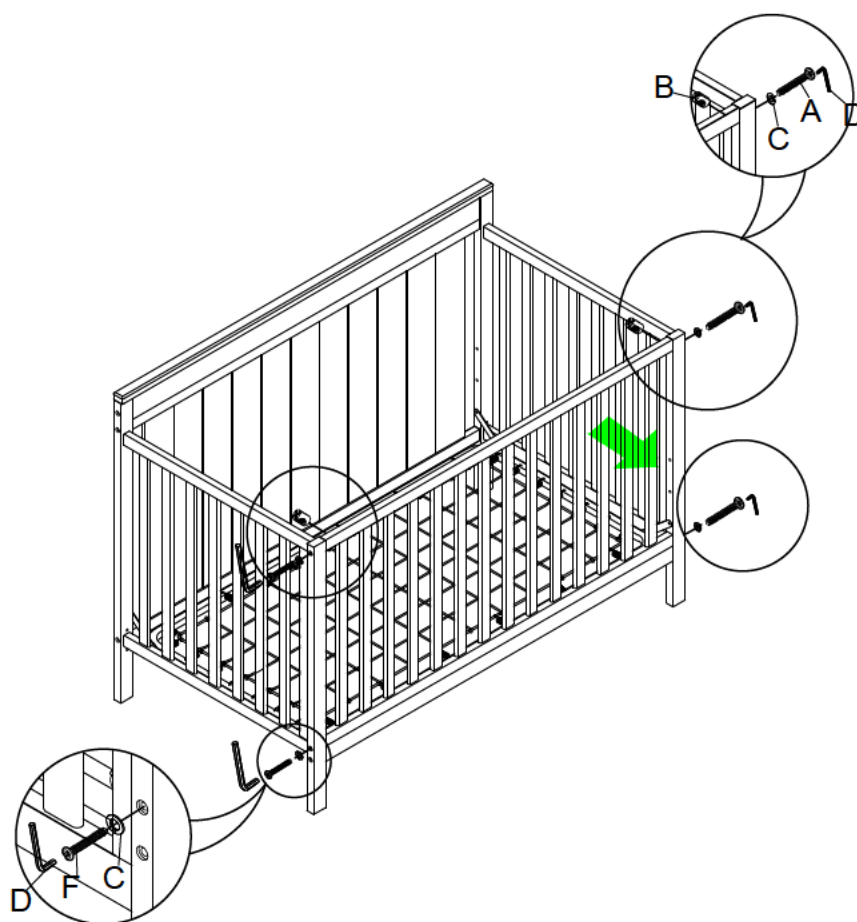

Remove the Footboard frame (6) from the Footboard Post (L&R) (4) by unscrewing (2 pcs) Allen bolt (A) and (2 pcs) Allen bolt (F) as shown in FIG.1.

STEP 2 " MATTRESS SUPPORT HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT "

THIS STEP REQUIRES:

These hardware are included in the CRIB.

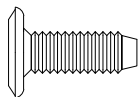

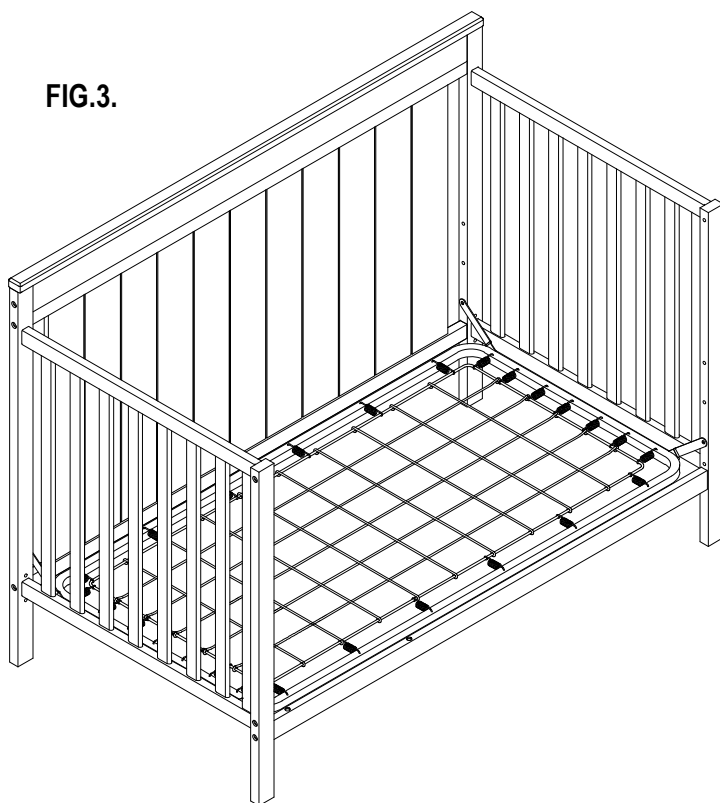
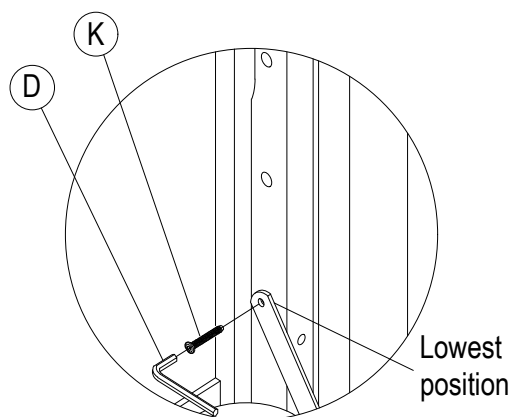

- Remove the Allenbolt 9/16"(15 mm) (K) on the Mattress spring.
- Move Mattress spring to the lowest position as shown in FIG.2.
- Attach the Allenbolt 9/16"(15 mm) (K) on the lowest hole of Sideboard.
- Use Bolt (K) to fill in all holes after assembled mattress spring (8). Tighten all bolts with Allen key (D).
- Final position as shown in FIG.3.

FOR TODDLER BED USE

- READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE ASSEMBLING TODDLER BED.
KEEP INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE USE.
- FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE WARNINGS AND THE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH FROM ENTRAPMENT OR STRANGULATION.
- **CAUTION:** THE MATTRESS INTENDED FOR USE ON THE BED SHALL BE A FULL-SIZE CRIB MATTRESS HAVING MINIMUM DIMENSION OF 51 5/8 INCHES (1310 MM) IN LENGTH AND 27 1/4 INCHES (690 MM) IN WIDTH AND NOT EXCEEDING 6 INCHES (150 MM) IN THICKNESS. THE DIMENSION OF THE MATTRESS SHALL BE TAKEN FROM SEAM TO SEAM OR EDGE TO EDGE WHERE APPROPRIATE.
- THE MINIMUM AGE OF THE INTENDED USER SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN 15 MONTHS AND THE MAXIMUM WEIGHT SHALL NOT BE GREATER THAN 50 LB (22.7 KG).
- **GUARDRAIL (SOLD SEPARATELY) MUST BE USED** WHEN CRIB USED AS A TODDLER BED TO AVOID THE FORMATION OF A GAP BETWEEN THE MATTRESS AND THE BED THAT COULD CAUSE AN ENTRAPMENT.
- **DO NOT** PLACE BED NEAR WINDOWS WHERE CORDS FROM BLINDS OR DRAPES MAY STRANGLE A CHILD.
- **DO NOT** PLACE ITEMS WITH A STRING, CORD, OR RIBBON AROUND A CHILD'S NECK, SUCH AS HOOD STRINGS OR PACIFIER CORDS.
- **DO NOT** SUSPEND STRINGS OVER A TODDLER BED FOR ANY REASON.
- WHEN STORING TODDLER BED USE CAUTION AS EXTREME CHANGE IN TEMPERATURE OR HUMIDITY CAN COMPROMISE THE TODDLER BED MAKING IT EXTREMELY DANGEROUS TO YOUR CHILD. STORE THE TODDLER BED IN A CLEAN DRY PLACE.
- USE CAUTION WHEN A VAPORIZER OR HUMIDIFIER IS IN USE. ALWAYS AIM VAPOR AWAY FROM THE TODDLER BED AS WELL AS ANY OTHER WOODEN FURNITURE. PROLONGED PERIODS OF HUMIDITY IN STORAGE AS WELL AS THE HOME CAN COMPROMISE THE TODDLER BED.
- AVOID USING VAPORIZERS AND HUMIDIFIER FOR PROLONGED PERIODS OF TIME.
- PLEASE DISPOSE ALL PACKAGING AND PLASTIC BAGS.
- PLEASE CLEAN THE TODDLER BED WITH A DRY CLOTH AND USE MILD WOOD POLISH IF REQUIRED.

STRANGULATION HAZARD

- **NEVER** PLACE BED NEAR WINDOWS WHERE CORDS FROM BLINDS OR DRAPES MAY STRANGLE A CHILD.
- **NEVER** SUSPEND STRINGS OVER BED.
- **NEVER** PLACE ITEMS WITH A STRING, CORD, OR RIBBON, SUCH AS HOOD STRINGS OR PACIFIER CORDS, AROUND A CHILD'S NECK. THESE ITEMS MAY CATCH ON BED PARTS
