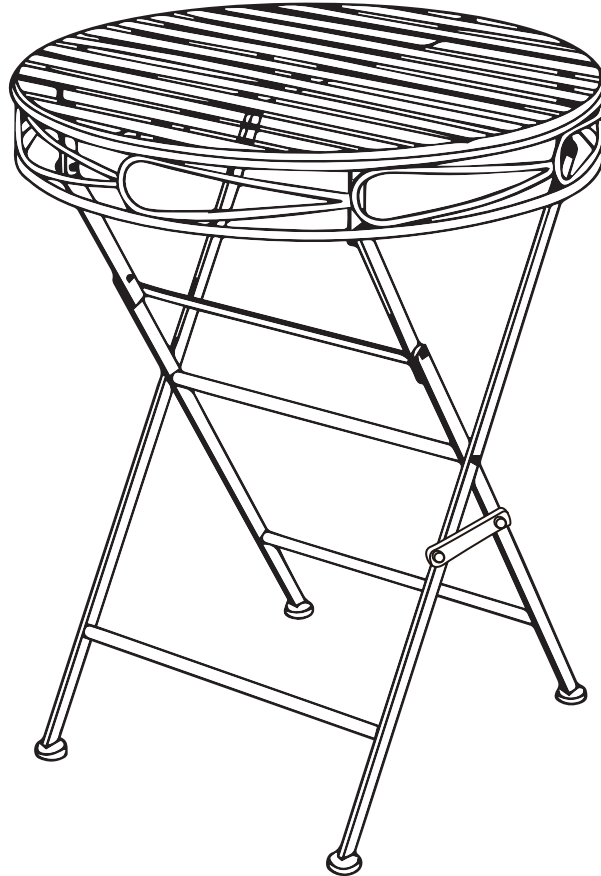


60cm Folding Bistro Table

Assembly Instructions

Product Size:

The frame of this product is manufactured from mild steel coated with a weather resistant paint. Steel has a natural tendency to rust over time and, whilst we expect you to be able to enjoy your furniture for many years to come, we recommend that you check the product from time to time for signs of paint damage and/ or rust. If the paint should become damaged, or if rust begins to form, you should clean the affected area and apply a suitable “thinners based” touch-up paint. Such paints are readily available for all good hardware and DIY stores.

Ensure that this product is fully assembled as illustrated before use.

This product should only be used on firm, level ground.

Keep small parts out of reach of children.

Do not stand or climb onto this product.

This product is intended for **domestic use** only.

Ensure the product is always placed on level ground.

Furniture can be dangerous if incorrectly used. No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrect use of this product.



Dos

When you are ready to start, make sure that you have the right tools, plenty of space and a clean, dry area for assembly.

Unwrap all packaging materials and place the components on suitable surface to prevent scratching your product.

Check the pack and make sure you have all of the parts listed.

Check all screws and bolts and tightened and inspect regularly.

We recommend the use of furniture covers to protect your product when not in use.

To clean, simply wipe down by hand with a damp sponge and a weak solution of soap and water. Do not use abrasive cleaners, as these will damage the finish to the metal surface.

To ensure the maximum life from your garden furniture, we recommend storing in a dry well-ventilated place such as a garage or wooden shed over winter.

In the event of the surface paint chipping or scratching, take care to touch up the damage as quickly as possible to prevent corrosion to the exposed steel. This will prevent the damaged area from further deterioration and/or corrosion.

X Don'ts

Do not stand or climb onto the product.

Do not use power tools to construct this product.

Do not sit or lean onto the rims of this product.

Do not use this product if parts are missing, damaged or worn.

Never use scourers, abrasives or chemical cleaner.

Do not strike the product with hard or pointed items.

Never drag furniture when moving it, always lift it.

Never use this product as a ladder as it may cause the product overbalancing.

Never tilt the product.

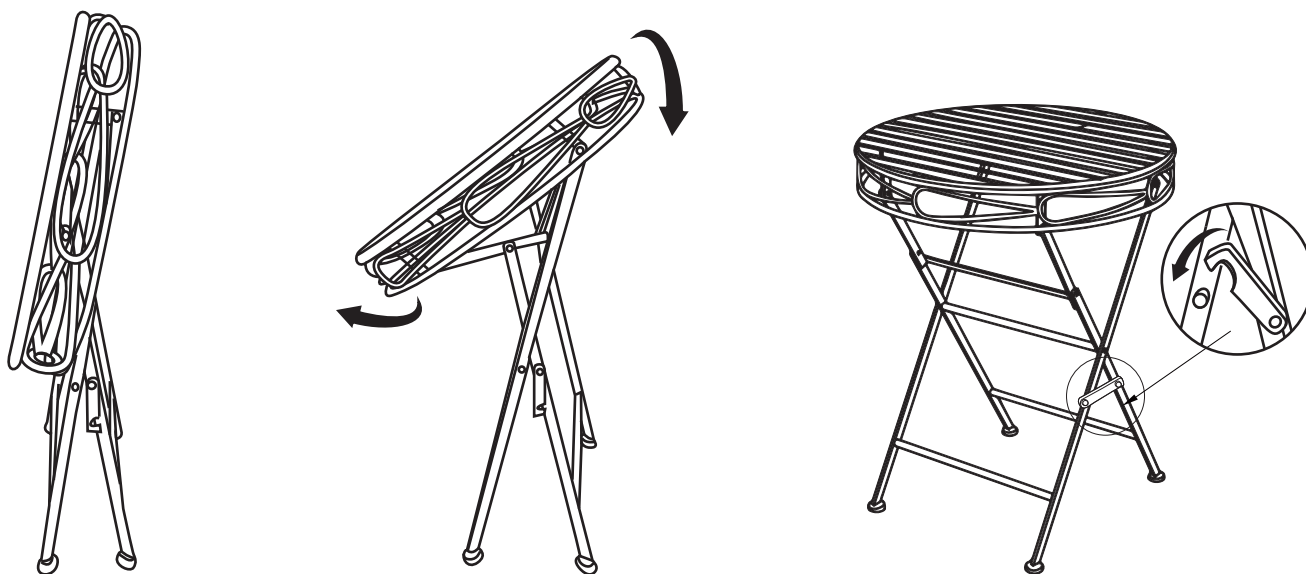
Assembly Instructions

This Bistro Table is a pre-assembled Set. No need of assembly steps. But we strongly recommend you to finish reading the Dos and Don'ts in this manual for the safe use of your products.

Opening and Closing the Table

1. To unfold the table, lift the lower table edge and lower the upper table edge until the table legs are fully opened;
2. Place the table on a flat level surface;
3. Attach the safety lock; your table is now ready for use.
4. The table is folded by reversing the above steps.

Note: Make sure the safety lock is released before folding to avoid damaging the table.
